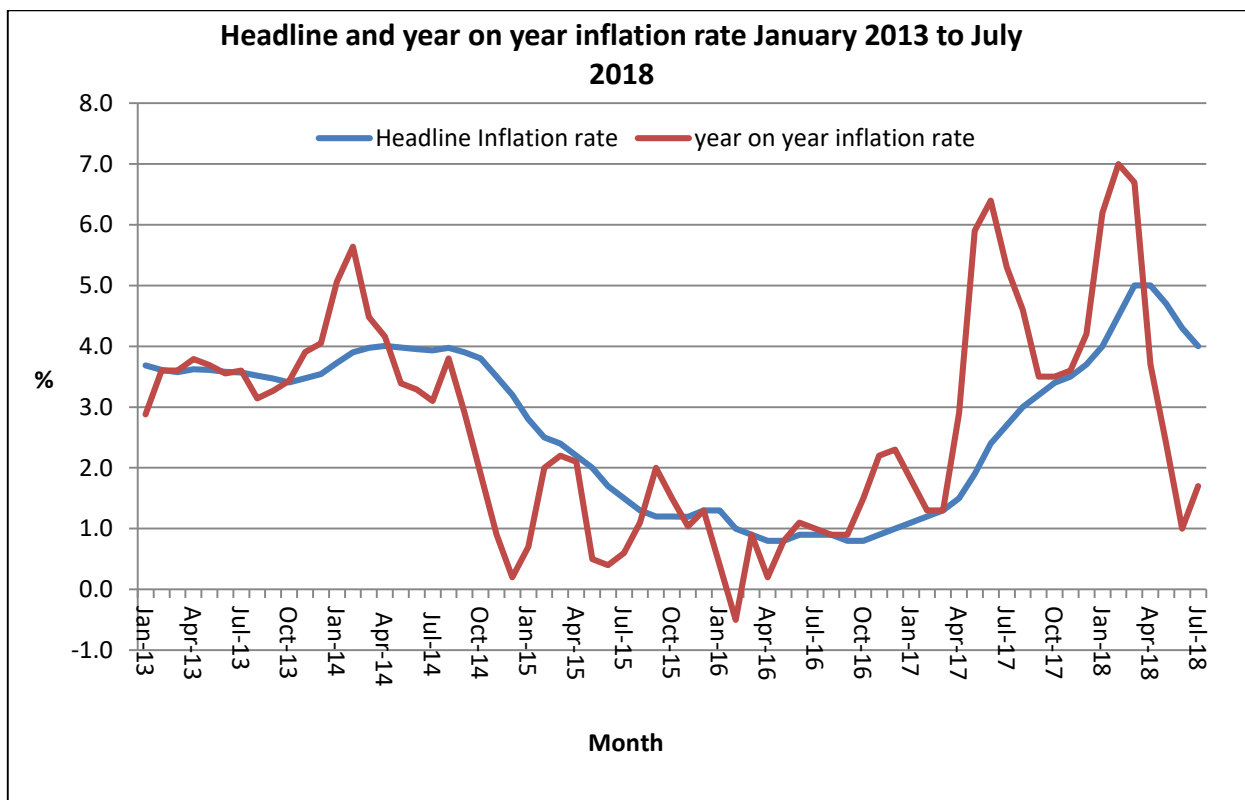

The **headline** inflation rate for the twelve months ending July 2018 works out to 4.0%, compared to 2.7% for the twelve months ending July 2017.

The **year-on-year** inflation rate for July 2018, as measured by the change in the CPI for July 2018 relative to July 2017 works out to 1.7%.
