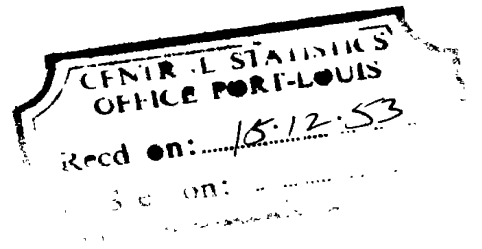

SUMMARY

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FOREWORD

Owing to the necessity of producing a report on the Census at an early date, it has not been possible to do more than to give in the present issue the bare results of the population enumeration with only very brief occasional notes. No attempt has been made, in the short time available, to go more deeply into the analysis of the data themselves.

For the same reason, it has been found convenient to produce the whole Census Report in separate sections, the truly demographic data constituting this much needed part, while the results which have an economic and social significance will be included in subsequent issues.

PART I

Introduction

The previous census of population had been taken in 1944. The Population Commission of the United Nations in its report to the United Nations Economic and Social Council (Paper E/805, 26th May 1948) had recommended that a world-wide population census be taken in 1950, to be repeated in 1960 and every tenth year thereafter. Besides certain difficulties of a local character which made the year 1950 too early for implementing the United Nations' recommendation as regards Mauritius, there were reasons for considering that it would be more advantageous to the Colony to obtain the data of a fresh census some time in the middle of the period 1944-60. The decision was accordingly taken by the Governor in Executive Council in June 1950, to carry out this population census in 1952. Subsequently on the 7th March, 1951, His Excellency proclaimed the night of the 28th-29th June, 1952 as the date at which the census would be taken.

The Director of the Central Statistical Office, Mr. M. V. M. Herchenroder, was designated by the Governor to be the Census Commissioner for Mauritius and its Dependencies. On the 14th of December, 1951, the Census Regulations (G.N. 244 of 1951), drafted by the Census Commissioner under Section 13 of the Statistics Ordinance 1951, were approved, by the Governor in Council.

The Census was planned to give the *de facto* population, i.e., the count was made of persons present in the Island at the date of the Census, whether they were or were not habitually resident in the Island. An exception to this rule was made, however, in respect of the members of the King's African Rifles Regiment, temporarily stationed in the Island. These were not included in the population enumeration.

For accuracy of enumeration and ease of control, the island was divided into districts and each district subdivided into sections or blocks, the boundaries whereof were clearly delineated on the Census map. The enumeration was effected in strict conformity with these boundaries. As regards the established townships, the enumeration was effected in conformity with the boundaries indicated on maps furnished by the local authority.

The Census was planned in its details and carried out in accordance with the recommendations contained in the Population Census Handbook of the Statistical Office of the United Nations Organisation (1949). Consideration was also given to certain requirements of the local administration and to the recommendations of the First Conference of Colonial Government Statisticians (1950).

Enumeration Procedure

Each Superintendent was in charge of one Census district. In addition, 101 enumerators were appointed to carry out the work of house to house enumeration and numbering under the direction of the District Superintendents; subsequently for the distribution and collection of the Census First Schedules (final census), the Enumerators were assisted by 863 sub-enumerators.

Before entering on his duties, every Superintendent, Enumerator or sub-enumerator had to subscribe to an oath of office before a magistrate. A booklet containing full instructions was then issued to every Superintendent and Enumerator.

The Town areas of Port Louis, Curepipe, Beau Bassin, Rose Hill, Quatre Bornes were censused separately; the rest of the island was subdivided into district blocks as stated previously, one enumerator being, as a rule in charge of one district block or section. By kind permission of the Director of Education, a number of rural school teachers were authorised to take charge of the enumeration in certain sections.

The house numbering and preliminary enumeration (on the Census second schedule) were started at the beginning of February and were, for the greater part, completed by the 15th of May. At about the middle of June, the final enumeration schedules (Census first schedule) all addressed and numbered in accordance with the house numbering recorded on the Census Second Schedules, were handed over to the District Superintendents for apportionment among the enumerators.

The distribution of these schedules to each household was begun one or two days before the appointed date for the Census, which was the night of the 28th-29th June, 1952, each enumerator being aided in this work by a requisite number of sub-Enumerators. Whenever the occupier of a house was unable to write in English or French, the duty was incumbent on the enumerator or sub-enumerator to call for from this person a true and full declaration of the particulars specified in the schedule in respect of every person who abode in this dwelling house or premises on census appointed date and to write down the declarations on the schedule.

A week before Census date a talk was delivered on the local broadcasting station explaining the aims and purpose of the Census; this talk ended with an appeal to the population for its co-operation. On three occasions between the 19th and the 25th of July notices were published in the local papers, requesting the return of any uncollected Census Schedule and asking for notification to the Census Office of any uncensused persons.

A certain number of unsatisfactorily filled schedules had to be returned to the householders concerned for completion, but by the end of August, all schedules had been delivered to the Census Office by the District Superintendents.

Compilation

The compilation of the census information contained in the two schedules was carried out for the first time in Mauritius with the mechanical aid of the Hollerith Punched Card System. Coding and punching in part of the data of the Preliminary enumeration (Second Schedule) were started in August. In the course of September, the coding and punching of the information recorded on the First Schedule were begun and were carried out till completion in April, 1953.

The first tabulations on the Hollerith tabulator were not secured until the end of October, 1952; but an important period of staff training on these machines by Mr. F. A. Hudson, the Hollerith Supervisor, and of planning the tabulator work had to be effected during the months of August and September.

Ethnical Classification

In compiling the data, the whole population was divided into three main ethnical groups, viz :—

- The General Population,
- The Indo-Mauritian Population,
- The Chinese Population.

The Indo-Mauritian Population itself was further subdivided into three groups: The Hindu Group, the Mahomedan Group and the Christian Group.

In deciding of the ethnical classification to which each individual should belong, a number of criteria were used. These were:—

- The Name; the Religion; the Mother Tongue; the Birth Place; the Nationality.

It should hardly be necessary to add that no single one of these criteria was by itself deemed to be sufficient evidence of the ethnical character of a person; it was, as a rule, the consideration of a number of these in conjunction which decided of the classification.

Results

The detailed results of the Census are given in the tables hereafter. It might serve some purpose to quote here for comparison the figures of:—

- (a) The population as estimated throughout the intercensal period to date on the basis of the previous census (1944)
- (b) The preliminary enumeration as recorded by the enumerators themselves and which, starting in February and ending in mid-May, might be taken as approximately situated in time as at the 31st March, 1952
- (c) The final enumeration from the Schedules returned by each householder, and which gave the final figure of population as at the 29th June, 1952.

I. Total population of the Colony of Mauritius and of its Dependencies

The whole *de facto* population for Mauritius was found to be 501,471, a total figure which, however, includes the European members of the military garrison and the passengers and crews of merchant vessels lying in the harbour on the date of the Census. This total population was made up of 252,088 males and 249,383 females.

The *de facto* population for the dependencies was found to be 15,085 and accordingly the total population for the Colony and its Dependencies works out to 516,556 persons.

This figure of population, however, includes some persons not habitually resident in these islands, while it excludes at the same time a number of persons belonging to the community of Mauritius and of its Dependencies, who are temporarily absent overseas. When adjustment is effected in respect of these absentees and also in respect of persons who are not habitual residents but who have been included in the enumeration, a computed figure of 522,700 for the *de jure* population of the Colony and of its dependencies is arrived at.

The *de facto* population of Mauritius thus shows an increase as at the 29th June, 1952, of 82,286 persons or 19.6 per cent on the figure of the previous census in June 1944. The population of Rodrigues, the main dependency, shows a corresponding increase of 1,448 or 12.2 per cent.

Table I gives the results of the 1952 Census in respect of the total population in each ethnical group, with the results of previous censuses for comparison.

The changes which are apparent throughout the period 1846-1952 between the relative numbers in the General and the Indo-Mauritian groups are, however, not very significant, as it is probable that different criteria of classification were utilised in respect of these groups from one census to another.

II. The Population by Major Civil Divisions

The distribution of the population of Mauritius by administrative districts is given in Table II for each census year from 1901 to 1952.

The largest proportional increases have taken place in Port Louis: 28 per cent, and in Plaines Wilhems: 24 per cent; the smallest proportional increases have taken place in Black River: 7 per cent, and in Savanne: 7 per cent.

In Table III, a further division of the population of Mauritius at the date of Census into males and females is given for each administrative district.

The number of persons living on a square mile has considerably increased since 1944 in the district of Port Louis which includes the Capital town. In the town itself the density of inhabitants has increased in the course of 8 years by 5,822 persons per square mile or 21 per cent. In the suburbs of Port Louis and in the rural part of the district, the increase in the population has amounted to 75 per cent.

The next largest relative increase in density is in Plaines Wilhems: 24·5 per cent. The district of Moka appears to have regained some of its lost population, which at the beginning of the century was around 35,000 persons.

The population of the urban areas, with the density corresponding to these areas, is given in Table VI.

The number of inhabitants in the rural areas, which as a whole cover 705·1 square miles, aggregated to 326,090 corresponding to a density of 462 persons per square mile.

As stated before, the minor fluctuations in relative size found between the "general group" and the "indo-mauritian group" from one Census to another cannot be retained as significant, since these variations are probably due to somewhat different rules of classification.

The Indo-Mauritian group can further be sub-divided into Christian Indians—4.9 per cent; Hindus—72.2 per cent and Mohamedans—22.9 per cent.

In the General group, the *sex ratio* has gradually shifted, in the course of time, in favour of the females; in the Indo-Mauritian group, the *ratio*, very preponderant on the male side a hundred years ago by reason of the immigration of men, has gradually adjusted itself towards equality, which it has, however, not quite reached at the present time.

The same phenomenon has taken place in the Chinese group, in which the females have increased markedly in numbers in Mauritius since the end of the First World War. There is still, however, in this group a preponderance of 40 per cent in respect of the males.

The low relative proportion of the males in the dependency of Rodrigues is due in some measure to emigration but mostly to the temporary absence of a number of males on military service overseas. When the population is adjusted in respect of the number of these absentees, the *sex ratio* is improved to 950 males to every 1,000 females.

N.B.—In the following and all subsequent tabulations, the figures are for the island of Mauritius alone; the corresponding data for the main dependency Rodrigues will be found in Appendix III.

The tables for Mauritius do not comprise the 215 European military men, wives and children who are not normally resident of the Island.

VI. Population Distribution By Age

The following table gives the distribution by each month of age of persons under one year and by each year of age of persons aged one year and over. The table also gives the number in the quinquennial age periods adopted internationally. This table is followed by the quinquennial distribution expressed as a percentage of the total. The separation by ethnical groups is maintained throughout. The table is a compilation of ages as stated in the original Census returns. No attempt has been made at this stage to graduate this age distribution.

It will be observed that in the General group of the population, the females exist in prominently larger numbers between the ages 16 and 37. This is accounted for by the fact that the males enlisted for overseas military service belong to this age group.

The generally lower number of females among the Indo-Mauritian group is, for the same reason, hardly apparent between the ages 20 and 30. In this ethnical group, from the age of 60 onwards, the females are in strikingly preponderant numbers. This peculiarity was already recorded in previous censuses.

In the Chinese group, it is noteworthy that the sex ratio is tending towards equality in the lower age brackets, while the males are markedly predominant elsewhere. The adjustment at the lower ages is due to the large birth rate among this ethnical group in recent years.

There is a conspicuously greater proportion of married persons of both sexes in the Indo-Mauritian than in the General group of the population.

VIII. Places of Birth and Nationalities of the Population

In accordance with recommended international practice in respect of the birth places of the population, the tabular statements are given separately for the native-born and for the foreign-born persons.

Owing to the comparatively small number of foreign-born forming part of the population, no attempt has been made to relate the birth place of these persons to their country of citizenship or to give separate tabulations for them in respect of other social characteristics.

IX. Religions of the Population

There exists a great diversity of religions in Mauritius, but it will be observed that in each ethnical group of the population one particular religion predominates.

In the General group, the prevalent religion is the Roman Catholic; the far greater number of Indo-Mauritian Hindus returned themselves as of the Hindu-Sanatan religion; in the Indo-Mauritian Muslim group, the dominant faith is Sunnee Hanafee, while Bhuddism and Roman Catholicism share practically the whole of the Chinese population.

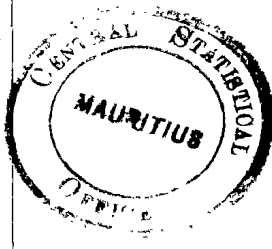
