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## INTRODUCTION

The thirteenth census of the population of Mauritius and its Dependencies was taken on Saturday, the 30th June 1962, exactly ten years after the preceding one.

The Census was planned to give the de facto population, i.e. the count of all persons physically present in Mauritius and its Dependencies at the time of the Census, whether they were residents or not.

Planning work started around mid - 1961. The preliminary enumeration of all buildings and their occupiers lasted from the beginning of March to mid - May 1962.

During the next stage which extended to the end of June 1962, the work done by the enumerators was checked, the central and local organisations for the final enumeration set up, the staff of sub-enumerators chosen and briefed, and the census schedules were numbered and addressed.

Census schedules were delivered and collected in a satisfactory manner. All the schedules, except a few which had to be returned to the householder for completion, were handed over by the sub-enumerators by the 5th of July. They were then checked both by enumerators and superintendents and reached the Central Statistical Office at the beginning of August.

A preliminary count of the population for Mauritius as a whole, as well as for each electoral district, was released at the end of 1962.

The information recorded on the census schedules was coded, transferred to punched cards and processed on "International Computers and Tabulators Limited" equipment.

The analysis of the census data was impeded because the processing equipment was almost fully occupied by the current work of the statistical and other departments. Most of the census work could only be undertaken after office hours and on Sundays and public holidays.

#### THE 1962 CENSUS SCHEDULE

The questions were drafted in accordance with the recommendations laid down in the United Nations Handbook of Population Census Methods; some of the questions asked at previous censuses being redrafted to eliminate ambiguity and to facilitate the interpretation of the results. New questions were included to obtain information about:-

- (1) The "population group" to which every member of the population claimed to belong;
- (2) the period of residence of aliens;
- (3) fertility - the number of children by duration of marriage.

A specimen of the Census First Schedule and the accompanying instructions will be found at the end of this volume.

#### LEGAL AUTHORITY

In accordance with the procedure set out in Section 5 of Ordinance No.11 of 1951 (the Statistics Ordinance) and with the approval of the Legislative Council signified by a resolution moved and adopted on the 19th December 1961, the Governor in Council made an order on the 29th December 1961 that a census of the Colony and its Dependencies should be taken on the 30th June 1962.

The detailed machinery for the taking of the census and the precise forms of return to be used were prescribed in the Census Regulations 1961 (Government Notice No.9 of 1962).

#### CENSUS REPORTS

In order not to delay unduly the publication of the census results it is proposed to issue the report in two volumes. This, the first volume, covers the demographic, social and economic characteristics of the population of Mauritius and of its main dependency, Rodrigues. The second volume will give detailed information about population by localities, households and families, buildings, dwellings and housing conditions.

STAFF

Some 2,040 persons were employed in addition to the staff of the Central Statistical Office and each of them took an oath of secrecy and swore not to disclose to any unauthorised person any information which might come to their knowledge while performing their census work.

The four senior officers of this department acted as supervisors and gave help and guidance to the other census officers.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

To the government and private organisations, to the Press and to the many individuals who have contributed to the success of the Census, grateful acknowledgement is expressed.

The larger population to be enumerated, the wider scope of the questions asked so as to meet as far as possible the requirements of the different Ministries, the planning of units of enumeration so as to fit not only geographical districts, but also electoral areas, townships, village councils areas, etc., all made the task of the Central Statistical Office much more arduous and complex than on previous occasions.

Thanks are due to all field officers from supervisors to sub-enumerators for the cheerful way in which they discharged their difficult duties and for the patience, tact and courtesy they showed in securing the co-operation of the public.

In particular I should like to express my appreciation to those members of the Central Statistical Office staff who were engaged in the Census in addition to their normal duties, for the invaluable assistance they gave at the planning, enumeration and compilation stages and without whose unstinted assistance this report would never have been issued.



AGE STRUCTURE: MAURITIUS (1962) AND THE UNITED KINGDOM (1961)


