The situation of Rodriguans living in the island of Mauritius

1. Introduction

The island of Rodrigues is a constituent island of the Republic of Mauritius with an economy mostly based on agriculture, handicraft and fishing. Many of its residents have migrated to the relatively more developed island of Mauritius with the aim of enjoying a better quality of life.

This report highlights the situation of Rodriguans living in the island of Mauritius based on data from the 2022 Housing and Population Census and also when compared to their situation in 2011, thus aiming to shed some light on whether they are better off in the island of Mauritius and to what extent they are at par with Mauritians.

For the purpose of this analysis,

- A Rodriguan is a person who is born in the island of Rodrigues; and
- A Mauritian is a person who is born in the island of Mauritius.

2. Highlights

- (i) At Census 2022, around 8,516 Rodriguans were living in the island of Mauritius, compared to 13,700 in 2011;
- (ii) Rodriguans are geographically dispersed across Mauritius, with the highest concentration in the town of Port Louis;
- (iii) Their age structure remains strongly concentrated in the working-age¹ group 25–59 years, indicating that migration continues to be mainly driven by employment;
- (iv) Compared to Rodriguans living in Rodrigues, their situation in Mauritius remains mixed. They benefit from better access to basic amenities and household durables, but hold lower-skilled occupations and work longer hours;
- (v) Compared to Mauritians, Rodriguans continue to experience less favourable conditions in terms of housing quality, education and occupational status.

¹ Working-age group has been retained as in 2011 to facilitate direct comparison across the two census years

3. Rodriguans living in the island of Mauritius

Rodriguans living in the island of Mauritius ...

...represent 19.5% of the total resident population of the island of Rodrigues, and

At the 2022 Population Census, around 8,516 Rodriguans (3,775 men and 4,741 women) were living in the island of Mauritius. They represented around 0.7% of the resident population of Mauritius and 19.5% of the resident population of Rodrigues.

... are spread in the island of Mauritius with highest numbers in the town of Port Louis

They reside all over the island of Mauritius with highest numbers in the town of Port Louis (28%) followed by Baie du Tombeau VCA (12%), and the town of Beau-Bassin/Rose-Hill (10%).

4. Situation of Rodriguans living in the island of Mauritius v/s those living in Rodrigues

Compared to Rodriguans living in Rodrigues, those living in the island of Mauritius...


... are made up of a higher proportion of women

Women account for 56% of Rodriguans living in Mauritius, compared with 51% in Rodrigues, indicating a higher propensity for females to migrate. One possible explanation could be the wider range of employment opportunities available in the main island.

... are more concentrated among the working-ages

Around 63% of Rodriguans in Mauritius fall within the 25–59 age group, compared with 44% in Rodrigues. In contrast, the proportion aged below 25 years is much lower in Mauritius (20%) than in Rodrigues (43%), again indicating that migration is largely employment-driven.


Figure 1 - Distribution (%) of Rodriguans living in the islands of Mauritius and Rodrigues by age group, Census 2022



... are less qualified

52% of Rodriguans living in Mauritius have an educational attainment of below secondary compared to 44% among Rodriguans living in the island of Rodrigues, indicating that Rodriguans living in the island of Mauritius are less educated.


Figure 2 - Distribution (%) of Rodriguans aged 16 years and over living in the islands of Mauritius and Rodrigues by educational attainment, Census 2022



...but more likely to be economically active...

In both Mauritius and Rodrigues, a high proportion of Rodriguans are employed, with employment clearly exceeding both unemployment and economic inactivity. This is particularly evident in Mauritius, where 54.6% are employed, compared with 38.7% who are inactive and 6.7% who are unemployed. A similar pattern is observed in Rodrigues, although the proportion employed is slightly lower (52.1%), while inactivity is marginally higher (40.0%).

... and be in paid employment rather than being self-employed, ...

In terms of employment status, 79% of Rodriguans working in Mauritius are in paid employment, compared to 67% for Rodriguans living in the island of Rodrigues, while self-employment is more common in Rodrigues.


Figure 4 - Distribution (%) of employed Rodriguans aged 16 years and over living in the islands of Mauritius and Rodrigues by employment status, Census 2022



... and work mainly in the service providing sector

Rodriguans in Mauritius work mainly in the tertiary sector (57%), though this is slightly below the level in Rodrigues (63%). Their contribution in the secondary sector is also significant (39%) compared to Rodriguans in the island of Rodrigues (16%). Their presence in the primary sector is very limited (4%), much lower than in Rodrigues (21%).

... and engaged in lower-skilled occupations, ...


In both the islands of Mauritius and Rodrigues, a high proportion of Rodriguans hold low-skilled occupations such as skilled agricultural, forestry and fishery workers; craft and related trade workers; plant and machine operators and assemblers; and elementary occupations. However, the proportion engaged in these low-skilled occupations was higher among Rodriguans living in the island of Mauritius (66%) than those in Rodrigues (54%).

Tertiary sector - Trade, hotels & restaurants, transport, communication, financial services, education, health, social and other services


Figure 6 - Distribution (%) of employed Rodriguans aged 16 years and over living in the islands of Mauritius and Rodrigues by major occupational group, Census 2022



... and work longer hours

Overall, Rodriguans in Mauritius work longer hours on average (43.6 hours per week) than those in Rodrigues (41.4 hours), with the difference more pronounced among women (43.0 against 40.1 hours) than among men (44.2 against 42.6 hours).


Figure 7 - Average number of hours worked by Rodriguans aged 16 years and over living in the islands of Mauritius and Rodrigues by sex, Census 2022



... and on the whole, they enjoy better housing and living conditions


Rodriguans in Mauritius benefit from better access to piped water and flushed toilet, but are less likely to be home owners.

They also show higher ownership of household durables, particularly washing machines, possibly since more of them work and have less time for household chores.

5. Situation of Rodriguans v/s those of Mauritians living in the island of Mauritius


As defined earlier, a Mauritian refers to a person born in the island of Mauritius

On this basis, a comparison between Rodriguans and Mauritians living in Mauritius shows that Rodriguans...

... are less educated

A clear gap in educational attainment is observed. Only 36% of them had reached upper secondary level or higher, compared with nearly 59% among Mauritians residing in the main island. This indicates that Rodriguans in Mauritius remain, on average, less formally educated than their Mauritian counterparts.


Figure 10 - Distribution (%) of persons aged 16 years and over living in the island of Mauritius by educational attainment, Census 2022



... but more likely to be economically active.

Rodriguans living in the island of Mauritius show a higher level of labour-market participation than Mauritians, as reflected in a higher proportion employed (54.6% compared with 50.8%) and a lower proportion economically inactive (38.7% against 45.0%). At the same time, the proportion of unemployed among Rodriguans is slightly higher (6.7%) than among Mauritians (4.2%).


Figure 11 - Activity status (%) of persons aged 16 years and over living in the island of Mauritius, Census 2022



Young Rodriguans are less likely to hold a job than young Mauritians


Figure 12 - Employment rate (%) of persons aged 16 years and over living in the island of Mauritius, Census 2022

Figure 12 shows that employment rates are high for both Rodriguans and Mauritians across all age groups, with only slight differences between them. Young Mauritians (16–24) and Mauritians aged 25–29 years are more likely to be employed than their Rodriguan counterparts, while at older ages the rates are almost the same.

... and Rodriguans are more likely to be engaged in low-skilled occupations

About two-thirds (66%) of persons born in Rodrigues and working are engaged in occupations such as skilled agricultural, forestry and fishery workers; craft and related trades workers; plant and machine operators and assemblers; and elementary occupations, compared with 39% among Mauritians. This indicates a clear disparity between the two groups.


Figure 13 - Distribution (%) of employed persons aged 16 years and over living in the island of Mauritius by major occupational group, Census 2022



...with almost similar number of hours of work

Average weekly working hours are broadly similar for Rodriguans and Mauritians living in the island of Mauritius. Among men, Rodriguan and Mauritian workers report almost identical hours (44.2 and 44.5 hours respectively). Among women, Rodriguan women work slightly longer hours on average (43.0 hours) than Mauritian women (41.7 hours), though the difference remains modest.

Figure 14 - Average number of hours worked by persons aged 16 years and over living in the island of Mauritius by sex, Census 2022




Their housing and living conditions are less favourable

The housing and living conditions of Rodriguans living in the island of Mauritius remain less favourable than those of Mauritians. Rodriguans are less likely to be home owners (71% compared with 91% among Mauritians) and live in fully concrete houses (85% against 96%).

In terms of basic amenities, access remains high for both groups; however, Rodriguans continue to be slightly disadvantaged. The proportions of Rodriguan households with electricity (98%), piped water inside the house (94%), a flush toilet (97%), a bathroom (91%) and a kitchen inside the house (98%) are all marginally lower than the corresponding proportions observed among Mauritian households.

Figure 15 - Proportion of households in the island of Mauritius by housing and living conditions, Census 2022




... and they are less likely to possess household durables and ICT devices

Ownership of household durables such as washing machine, refrigerator and television remain high among both Mauritian and Rodriguan households.

Gaps are more pronounced for ICT equipment. Only 35% of Rodriguan households have a fixed telephone, compared with 62% among Mauritian households, while ownership of computers, laptops or tablets stands at 33% for Rodriguans against 48% for Mauritians. Access to the Internet through any device is also lower (67% compared to 75%).

6. Changes in the Situation of Rodriguans Living in Mauritius between 2011 and 2022

A comparison of the 2011 and 2022 Population Censuses reveals important changes in the demographic profile, labour-market participation, housing conditions and living standards of Rodriguans living in the island of Mauritius

Sex composition

Between 2011 and 2022, the number of Rodriguans living in the island of Mauritius declined markedly, from 13,700 to 8,516. This reduction was observed for both sexes, though it was more pronounced among men, both in numbers and percentage points. The female share, on the other hand, slightly rose from 54.0% in 2011 to 55.7% in 2022. This confirms a continued female predominance among Rodriguans residing in Mauritius and that female is more likely to migrate to the main island.



Age structure

Between 2011 and 2022, the age structure of Rodriguans in Mauritius shifted noticeably. The proportion of young persons below 25 years declined from 22.2% to 20.2%, while the share of the prime working-age population (25-59 years) also decreased from 67.4% to 63.4%. In contrast, the proportion of persons aged 60 years and above increased markedly from 10.4% to 16.4%, indicating a clear ageing trend among Rodriguans living in Mauritius.


Figure 17 - Distribution (%) of Rodriguans living in the island of Mauritius by age group, 2011 vs 2022



Educational attainment

Educational attainment improved significantly over the eleven-year period. The share of Rodriguans with below secondary education fell from 62.2% in 2011 to 51.9% in 2022. At the same time, the proportion attaining upper secondary education increased from 23.6% to 34.2%, while those with certificate, diploma and tertiary qualifications also rose modestly. These changes reflect a gradual improvement in educational outcomes among Rodriguans living in Mauritius.


Figure 18 - Distribution (%) of Rodriguans aged 16 years and over living in the island of Mauritius by educational attainment, 2011 vs 2022



Economic activity rate

Labour-force participation shows contrasting movements across age groups. Among young persons aged 16-24, the economic activity rate declined sharply from 61.5% in 2011 to 38.6% in 2022, suggesting a delayed entry into the labour market, possibly linked to longer participation in education. For those aged 25-59, participation remained broadly stable, while a slight increase was observed among persons aged 60 years and above. These patterns reflect evolving life-course dynamics in employment participation.


Figure 19 - Economic activity rate (%) of Rodriguans aged 16 years and over living in the island of Mauritius by selected age group, 2011 vs 2022



Employment rate by age group

Employment rates declined slightly among younger and prime working-age Rodriguans. Among those aged 16-24, the employment rate fell from 84.4% in 2011 to 74.0% in 2022, while among those aged 25-59, it decreased from 95.0% to 89.9%. In contrast, the employment rate among persons aged 60 years and above increased slightly from 97.7% to 99.1%, suggesting continued economic participation at older ages.


Figure 20 - Employment rate (%) of persons aged 16 years and over living in the island of Mauritius by age group, 2011 vs 2022



Type of employment

The distribution of employment status has evolved since 2011. The proportion of employees decreased slightly from 82.9% to 78.9%, while the share of own-account workers increased from 12.8% to 16.3%. The proportion of employers also rose from 3.4% to 4.3%. This indicates a gradual shift towards greater involvement in self-employment.


Figure 21 - Distribution (%) of employed Rodriguans aged 16 years and over living in the island of Mauritius by employment status, 2011 vs 2022



Industrial sector of employment

A substantial structural transformation is observed in the sectoral distribution of employment. The share of Rodriguans employed in the primary sector declined sharply from 8.1% to 3.7%, while employment in the secondary sector fell from 48.2% to 39.1%. In contrast, the proportion employed in the tertiary sector increased from 43.7% to 57.2%, indicating a clear transition towards service-based employment.

Figure 22 - Distribution (%) of employed Rodriguans aged 16 years and over living in the island of Mauritius by industrial sector, 2011 vs 2022




Occupational group

The concentration in lower-skilled jobs remains significant, particularly elementary occupations and production- and trade-related jobs, which together continue to account for 66% share of employment in 2022.

At the same time, there has been a clear increase in occupations requiring some level of education or formal training, as reflected in the growing shares of clerical support and service sales occupations and, to a lesser extent, professional and technical occupations. This observation is consistent with the improvements in educational attainment among Rodriguans between 2011 and 2022.


Figure 23 - Distribution (%) of employed Rodriguans aged 16 years and over living in the island of Mauritius by major occupational group, 2011 vs 2022



Hours worked

Average weekly working hours evolved differently for men and women. Among Rodriguans men, mean working hours declined slightly from 45 hours per week in 2011 to 44 hours in 2022. In contrast, Rodriguans women recorded an increase from 40 hours to 43 hours per week, suggesting an increase in work intensity among employed women.


Figure 24 - Average number of hours worked by Rodriguans aged 16 years and over living in the island of Mauritius by sex, 2011 vs 2022



Housing and living conditions

Housing conditions and access to basic amenities improved markedly between 2011 and 2022. The proportion of home owners increased slightly from 70.0% to 71.0%, while the share of those living in concrete houses rose from 80.8% to 84.9%. Access to electricity, piped water inside the house, flush toilets, bathrooms and kitchens inside the housing unit all improved substantially, pointing to an overall enhancement in housing quality and living standards.


Figure 25 - Proportion of Rodriguan households in the island of Mauritius by housing and living conditions, 2011 vs 2022



Selected household possessions and ICT devices

Ownership of household durables and ICT devices increased significantly between 2011 and 2022. The proportion of households owning a washing machine rose sharply from 56.6% to 77.0%, while refrigerator ownership increased from 87.0% to 93.1%. Internet access recorded the most dramatic rise, from only 17.4% in 2011 to 66.8% in 2022, indicating rapid digital inclusion among Rodriguans. Computer ownership also increased, while reliance on fixed telephones declined, reflecting changing communication technologies.

7. Concepts & definitions

(a) Household	<p>A household is either:</p> <p>(i) a one-person household, i.e., a person who makes provision for his own food or other essentials for living without combining with any other person to form part of a multi-person household; or</p> <p>(ii) a multi-person household, i.e., a group of two or more persons living together who make common provision for food or other essentials for living. The persons in the group may pool their incomes and have a common budget to a greater or lesser extent; they may be related or unrelated persons or a combination of both.</p>
(b) Resident population	<p>The resident population is a count of all usual residents of a country at the time of the census. For census purposes, “usual residence” is defined as the place at which the person lives at the time of the census, and has been there continuously for the past 12 months or intends to live there continuously for at least 12 months.</p>
(c) Employment	<p>Employed population consists of Mauritians aged 16 years and above (16+) who have worked for pay, profit or family gain for at least one hour during the reference week which was from Monday 27 June to Sunday 3 July 2022 at the 2022 Population Census. It includes those who are temporarily absent from work for reasons such as leave with pay, leave without pay and temporary disorganisation of work (bad weather, breakdown of equipment, lack of order, etc.).</p>
(d) Employment rate	<p>Employment rate is the ratio (%) of the employed population to the labour force participation among people aged 16+ (employed + unemployed population).</p>
(e) Unemployment	<p>Unemployed population comprises all Mauritians aged 16+ who are not working but who are looking for work and are available for work during the reference week.</p>
(f) Active population/ Labour force	<p>Active population is made up of employed and unemployed population.</p>
(g) Activity rate (%)	<p>Activity rate is the ratio (%) of the active population (or labour force) to the population aged 16+ (active and inactive population).</p>
(h) Relative Development Index (RDI)	<p>RDI is a composite index that measures the relative achievement of sub-regions of the country in various dimensions of development. The RDI ranges between 0 and 1, where index values near 0 indicate the least developed areas and index values near 1 indicate the most developed areas.</p>


