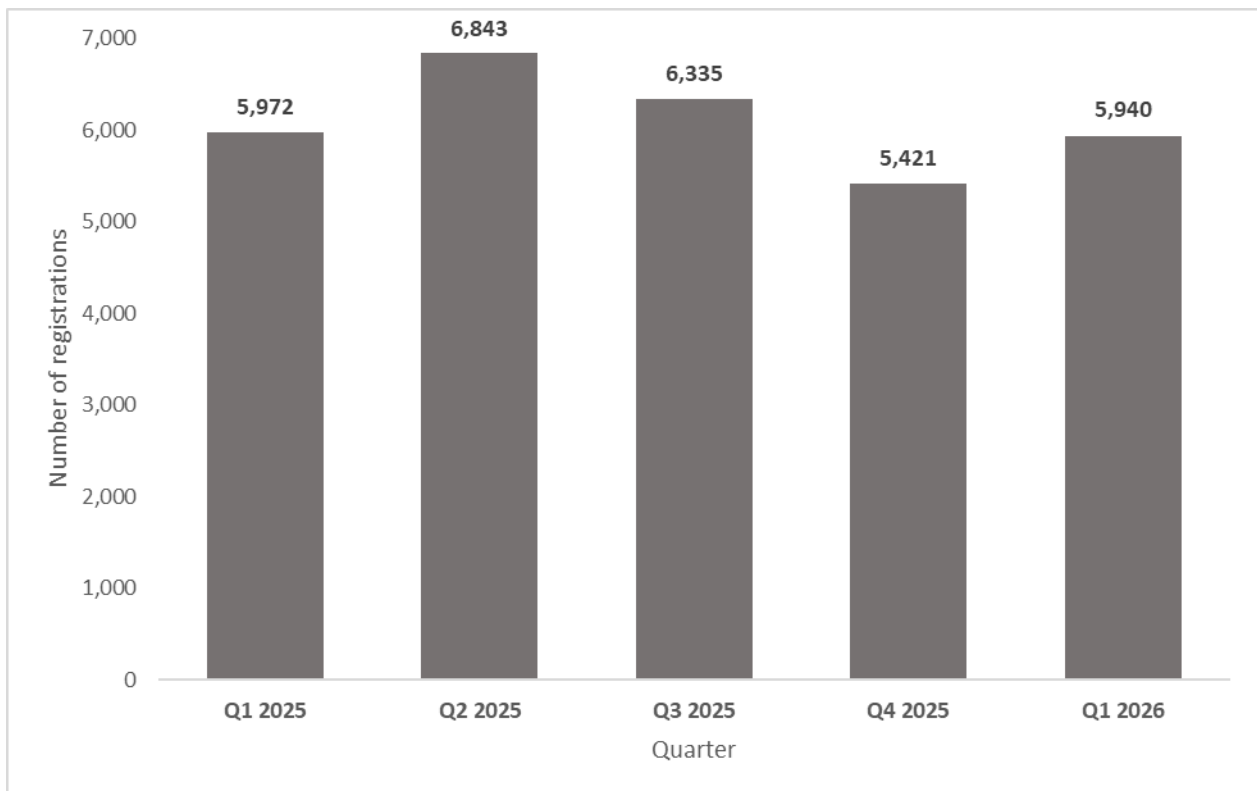
1. INTRODUCTION

The business statistics on enterprise dynamics provides insights into quarterly changes in the number of enterprises registered in the Republic of Mauritius. These statistics, received from the Corporate and Business Registration Department (CBRD) and compiled within the Statistical Business Register (SBR), focus mainly on quarterly new enterprise registrations, changes in the registered enterprise population, and percentage changes by [National Standard Industrial Classification \(NSIC\)](#) Section.

2. ENTERPRISE REGISTRATIONS

New enterprise registrations in the first quarter of 2026 showed a mixed trend when compared to both the same quarter of the previous year and the preceding quarter. Registrations declined slightly from 5,972 in Q1 2025 to 5,940 in Q1 2026. However, compared to the fourth quarter of 2025, registrations increased notably from 5,421 to 5,940 (Table 1).

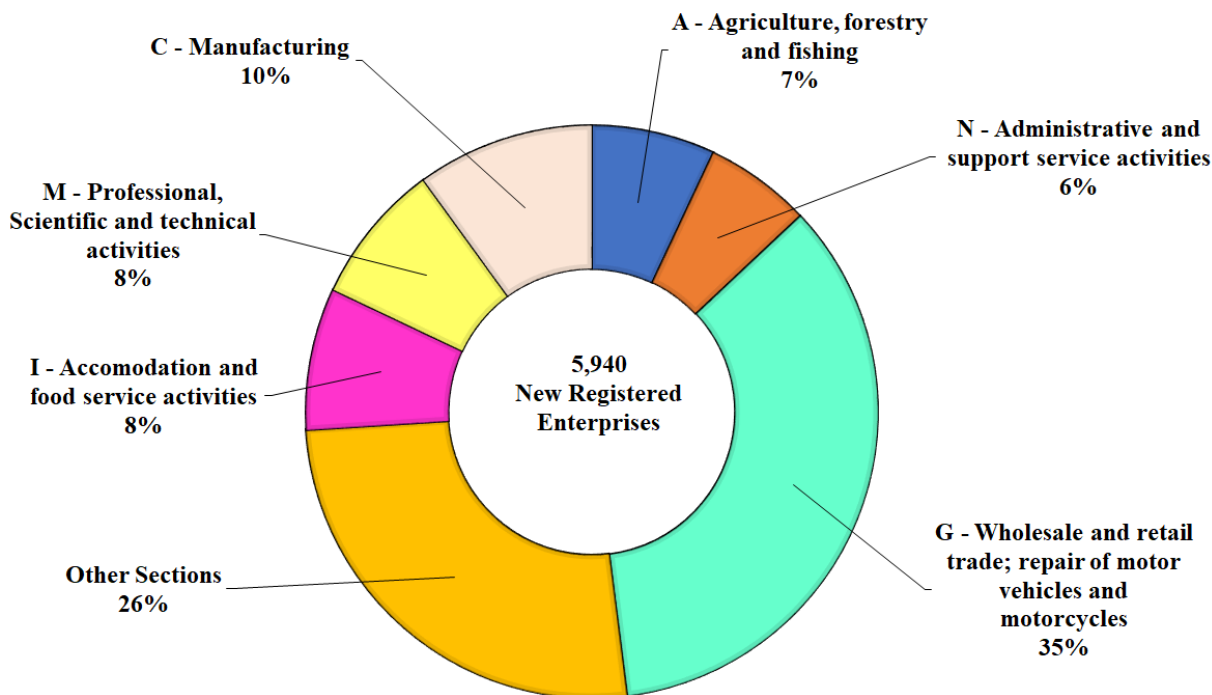
Figure 1: Comparison of Enterprise registrations for Quarter 1 2025 – Quarter 1 2026



3. SECTORAL BREAKDOWN

For the first quarter of 2026, new registrations were primarily concentrated in Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles (35%), followed by Manufacturing (10%), Accommodation and food service activities (8%) and Professional, Scientific and Technical Activities (8%). Agriculture, forestry and fishing accounted for 7%, while Administrative and support service activities followed at 6% and other sections accounted for 26% of the total (Table 2).

Figure 2: Distribution (%) of New Registered Enterprises by Industrial Section, Quarter 1 2026



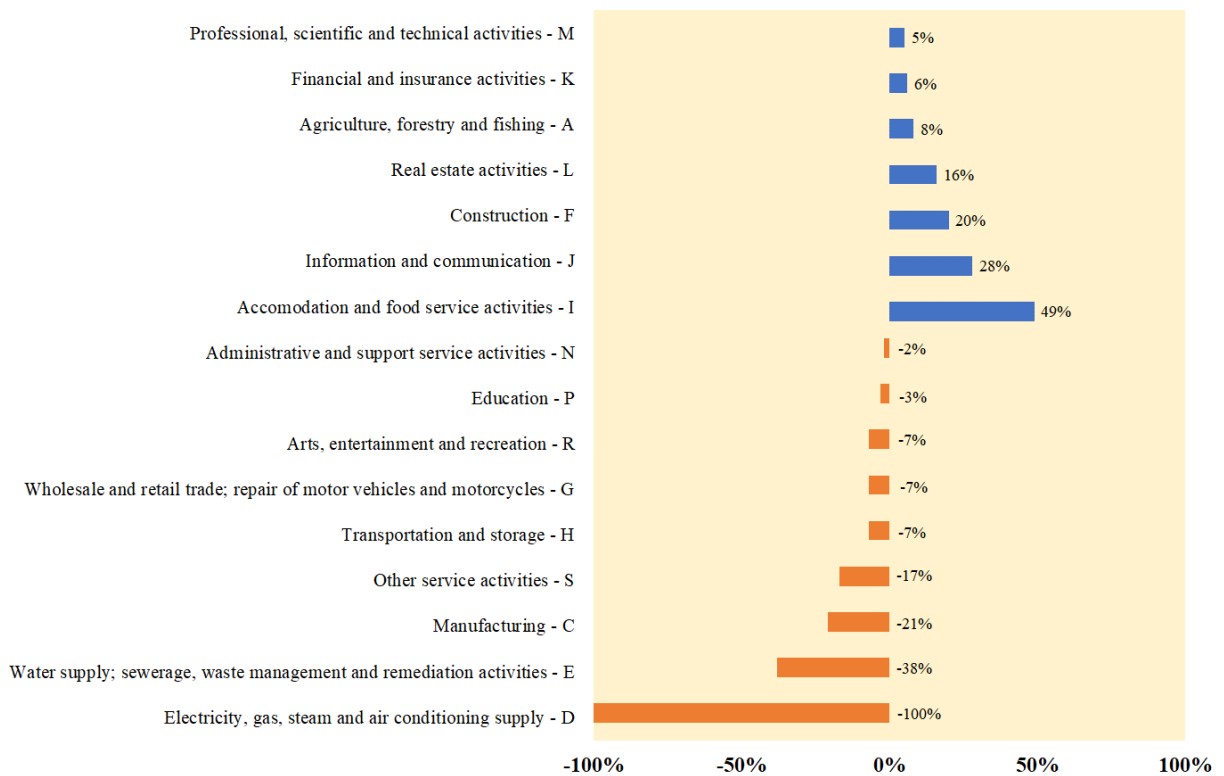
Other sections include F- Construction (5%), H - Transportation and storage (4%), J - Information and communication (4%), K - Financial and insurance activities (3%), L - Real estate activities (2%), P - Education (1%), Q - Human health and social work activities (1%), R - Arts, entertainment and recreation (2%) and S - Other service activities (4%).

4. SECTORAL CHANGES

New enterprise registrations in the first quarter of 2026 showed varied performance across different industries compared to the same period of 2025. The strongest growth was seen in Accommodation and Food Service Activities (49%), followed by Information and Communication (28%), Construction (20%) and Real Estate (16%). Moderate growth was also noted in Agriculture (8%), Financial and Insurance Activities (6%), Professional, Scientific, and Technical Activities (5%).

In contrast, several sectors experienced declines. The sharpest drops were in Electricity, Gas, Steam, and Air Conditioning Supply (-100%), Water Supply and Waste Management (-38%), Manufacturing (-21%) and Other Service Activities (-17%). Smaller decreases occurred in Wholesale and Retail Trade; Repair of Motor Vehicles and Motorcycles (-7%), Transportation and Storage (-7%), Arts, Entertainment and Recreation (-7%), Education (-3%) and Administrative and Support Service activities (-2%) (Table 3).

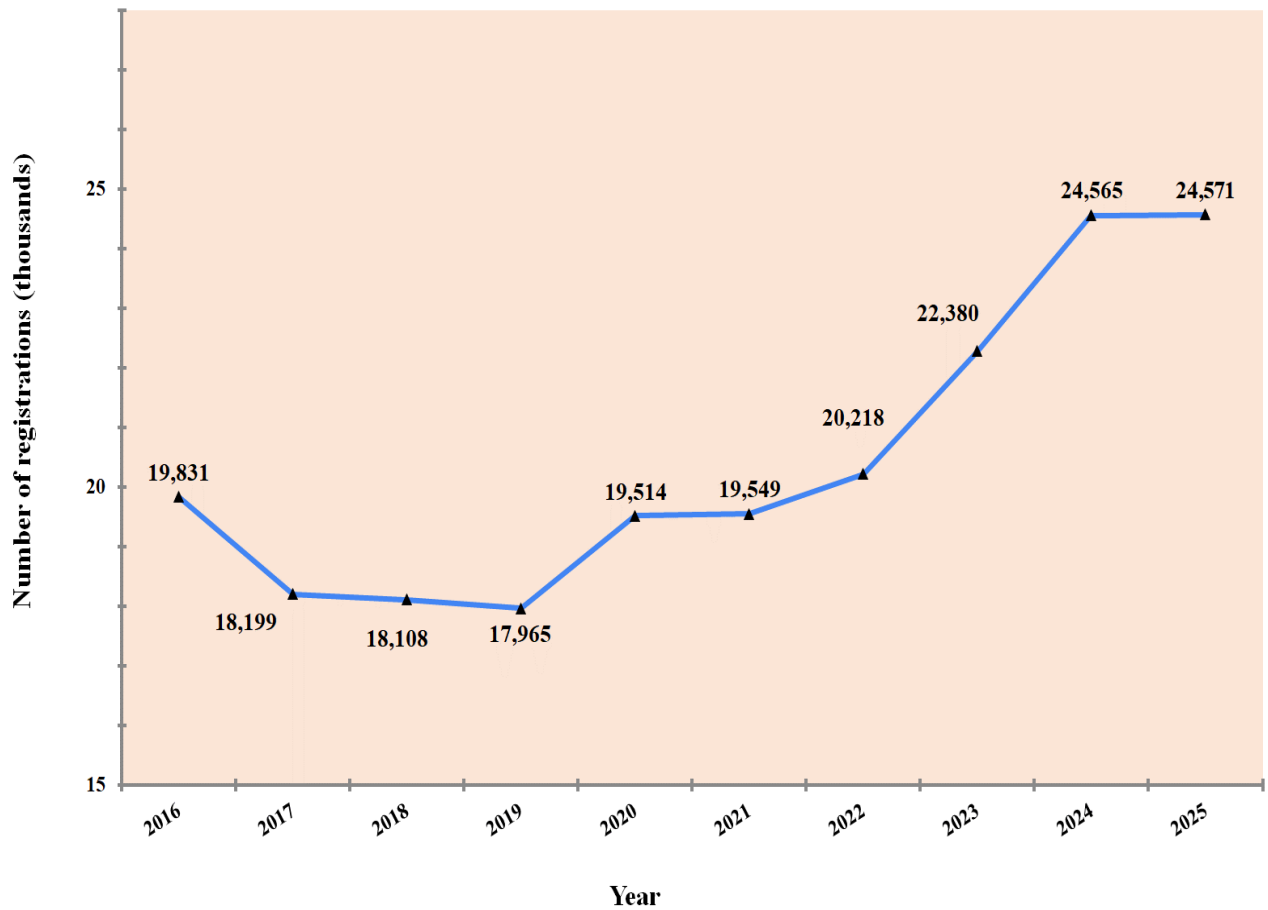
Figure 3: Percentage Change (%) in Industrial Section for Q1 2025 compared to Q1 2026



5. LONG – TERM TRENDS

From 2016 to 2025, the total number of enterprises grew by 24%, from 19,831 to 24,571. After a decline between 2016 and 2019, the number has steadily increased, showing consistent growth in business activity in recent years (Table 4).
