## 1. Introduction

This report presents the key findings of the National Multidimensional Poverty Index (MPI) for the Republic of Mauritius. The index is computed using data from the 2022 Housing and Population Census and encompasses five non-monetary dimensions of poverty, namely employment, living standards, education, health and housing.



The National MPI was developed through a national consultative process involving policymakers, parliamentarians, academics, non-governmental organisations and other stakeholders. Technical guidance was provided by experts from the Oxford Poverty and Human Development Initiative (OPHI), with the collaboration and financial assistance of SADC supporting the capacity-building activities undertaken for the development of the National MPI.

### Key note to users

A person is classified as **multidimensionally poor** if they live in a household that has a weighted deprivation score of 30% or more under the National MPI framework.

The results are to be interpreted according to the dimensions, indicators, deprivation cut-offs and weights presented in Table 1.

The results provide a comprehensive picture of multidimensional poverty in Mauritius by identifying the multiple deprivations experienced by individuals and households. They also show where multidimensional poverty is more prevalent, which population groups are most affected, and the main drivers of poverty.

The MPI results<sup>1</sup> are presented in the form of tables and thematic maps<sup>2</sup>.

## 2. Multidimensional Poverty Index

### 2.1 Concept, Relevance and Scope

#### What is MPI?

The Multidimensional Poverty Index (MPI) is a measure of poverty that goes beyond income or expenditure. It captures the overlapping deprivations that individuals or households may experience at the same time across different areas of life, such as education, health, employment, living standards and housing.

The MPI therefore provides a broader picture of poverty by identifying not only who are poor, but also the nature and extent of the deprivations they face.

#### Global MPI and National MPI

The most widely recognised MPI is the Global MPI<sup>3</sup>, developed by OPHI and UNDP and published in the Human Development Reports since 2010. The 2025 Global MPI provides estimates for 109 countries, using a common set of dimensions and indicators to measure acute multidimensional poverty, and allows for international comparison.

A National MPI, on the other hand, is designed to reflect a country's own priorities, and policy context. It is therefore mainly used to assess and monitor poverty within a country. Since a National MPI is adapted to the national context, it is generally not comparable across countries. As at 2024, more than 40 countries across the world produced National MPIs.

#### Relevance of the National MPI for Mauritius

The National MPI complements existing monetary poverty measures by providing additional information on non-monetary deprivations. As a measurement and policy tool, it:

- provides a broader picture of poverty by capturing several deprivations experienced at the same time;
- identifies not only who are poor, but also the nature and intensity of their poverty;
- shows the dimensions and indicators that contribute most to multidimensional poverty;
- allows results to be disaggregated by geographical area and population group (e.g., sex, age, household composition, etc.);
- provides statistical evidence to inform national policy discussions and guide targeted interventions for poverty alleviation; and
- supports the monitoring of regional and international development commitments, including the SADC Protocol<sup>4</sup> on Statistics and UN SDG<sup>5</sup> Target 1.2 on reducing poverty in all its dimensions according to national definitions.

## Scope, data considerations and limitation

The 2022 National MPI is computed using data from the 2022 Housing and Population Census (HPC). For a small country like Mauritius, the use of census data is particularly useful, as it allows MPI to be produced by detailed geographical area and population group. This supports more targeted policy formulation and helps identify people and geographical areas most in need.

The scope of the 2022 National MPI is therefore determined by the information available in the 2022 HPC, particularly on housing and living conditions, and socio-economic characteristics. In line with the MPI methodology, the index is computed using a single dataset, where all households and persons are assessed across the selected dimensions and indicators.

Some important thematic areas, such as food security, nutrition and detailed health conditions, are not covered in the index as they require data from other targeted surveys.

## 2.2 Headline indicators

The MPI is summarised through three headline indicators, which together provide a clearer picture of multidimensional poverty:

- **Headcount ratio (H):** the proportion of the population identified as multidimensionally poor that is, those experiencing multiple deprivations. It is expressed as a percentage and is also referred to as incidence of poverty or poverty rate.
- **Intensity of poverty (A):** the average percentage of weighted deprivations experienced by the multidimensionally poor. It measures how many deprivations the poor suffer, on average.
- **Multidimensional Poverty Index (MPI):** a measure of poverty that captures simultaneous deprivations experienced by individuals across multiple dimensions of life. It is a composite measure that captures both the incidence and intensity of poverty. It is computed as the product of Headcount ratio (H) and Intensity of poverty (A).

$$MPI = H \times A$$

**The MPI value ranges from 0 to 1, and higher values imply higher poverty.**

The MPI methodology also produces additional measures, including the Censored and Uncensored Headcount Ratios, percentage contribution to MPI (drivers of poverty), as well as the number of people in multidimensional poverty. More details are provided at Sections 5 (Analysis) & 6 (Methodology).

### 3. Structure of the National MPI Framework

#### 3.1 Dimensions, indicators and weights

The structure of the National MPI is crucial, as it defines the dimensions, indicators, deprivation cut-offs and weights used to assess multidimensional poverty. For Mauritius, the MPI comprises five dimensions, namely employment, education, living standards, health and housing. Each dimension is represented by a set of indicators with defined deprivation cut-offs.

An equal nested weighting structure is applied. Each dimension carries an equal weight of one-fifth, and the indicators within each dimension are equally weighted. The dimensions, indicators, deprivation cut-offs and weights are presented in Table 1.

### 3.2 Poverty cut-off

Under the Alkire-Foster method<sup>7</sup>, each household is assigned a weighted deprivation score based on the deprivations it experiences across the selected indicators. A household is classified as multidimensionally poor when its weighted deprivation score is equal to or above the poverty cut-off.

For the National MPI, the poverty cut-off is set at 30%. This means that a household is identified as multidimensionally poor if it experiences 30% or more of the total weighted deprivations included in the index.

## 4. Highlights of the 2022 National MPI

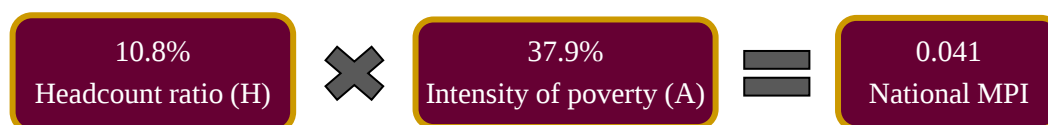
Based on the 2022 Housing and Population Census data and applying a poverty cut-off of 30% of the total weighted deprivations, the main findings of the 2022 National MPI for the Republic of Mauritius are as follows:

### National picture

- ❖ In 2022, around one in ten persons in the Republic of Mauritius was multidimensionally poor, representing around **130,000 persons<sup>8</sup>** – a poverty Headcount ratio of **10.8%**



- ❖ The intensity of poverty among the multidimensionally poor households is **37.9%**, meaning that poor persons experienced, on average, 37.9% of the total weighted deprivations.
- ❖ The National MPI value stood at **0.041**, indicating that people in Mauritius experienced 4.1% of all possible weighted deprivations captured by the indicators.



### Geographical disparities

- ❖ Le Morne VCA and Case Noyale VCA recorded the highest MPI values, at **0.225** and **0.189** respectively.
- ❖ **Rodrigues** recorded a higher level of multidimensional poverty, with an MPI of **0.120** and a headcount ratio of 29.2%, compared to **0.038** and 10.2% respectively for the **Island of Mauritius**.

### Population groups

- ❖ Multidimensional poverty is highly prevalent among:
  - Households with four or more children (35.5%)
  - Single member households (21.4%)
  - One-parent households with unmarried children (17.7%)
  - Female-headed households (16.8%)

## 5. Analysis

This section presents a more detailed analysis of the 2022 National MPI for the Republic of Mauritius, using the three headline indicators at national level: headcount ratio (H), intensity of poverty (A) and MPI value.

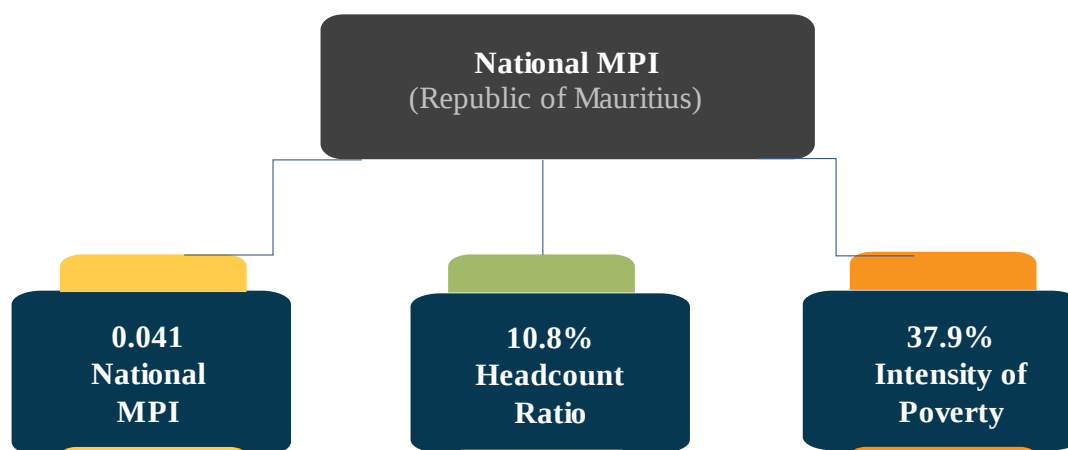
The analysis also sheds light on deprivations by indicator, the contribution of each dimension and indicator to overall multidimensional poverty, and differences by geographical area and population group. Together, these results help identify where poverty is more prevalent, the population groups that are most affected, and the deprivations that contribute most to the National MPI.

### 5.1 Overall Headcount, Intensity and MPI

***Around one in ten persons in the Republic of Mauritius was multidimensionally poor in 2022***

In 2022, the proportion of persons who were multidimensionally poor, as measured by the Headcount ratio (H), was estimated at **10.8%** (around 130,000 persons)<sup>8</sup> for the Republic of Mauritius, indicating that around **one in ten persons** lived in a multidimensionally poor household.

The intensity of poverty (A), calculated among the poor, worked out to **37.9%**, implying that multidimensionally poor persons experienced, on average, 37.9% of the total weighted deprivations.



The **Multidimensional Poverty Index (MPI)**, which captures both the incidence and intensity of poverty, stood at **0.041**. In other words, it means that Mauritians experienced 4.1% of all possible weighted deprivations captured by the National MPI indicators. It is to be noted that an MPI value of 1 would mean that everyone is deprived in all indicators simultaneously.

## 5.2 Uncensored and Censored Headcount Ratios

The uncensored and censored headcount ratios provide a more detailed understanding of the specific deprivations experienced by the population. These measures complement the MPI results by showing which indicators are more widespread across the whole population and which are more concentrated among the multidimensionally poor. The results are presented below.

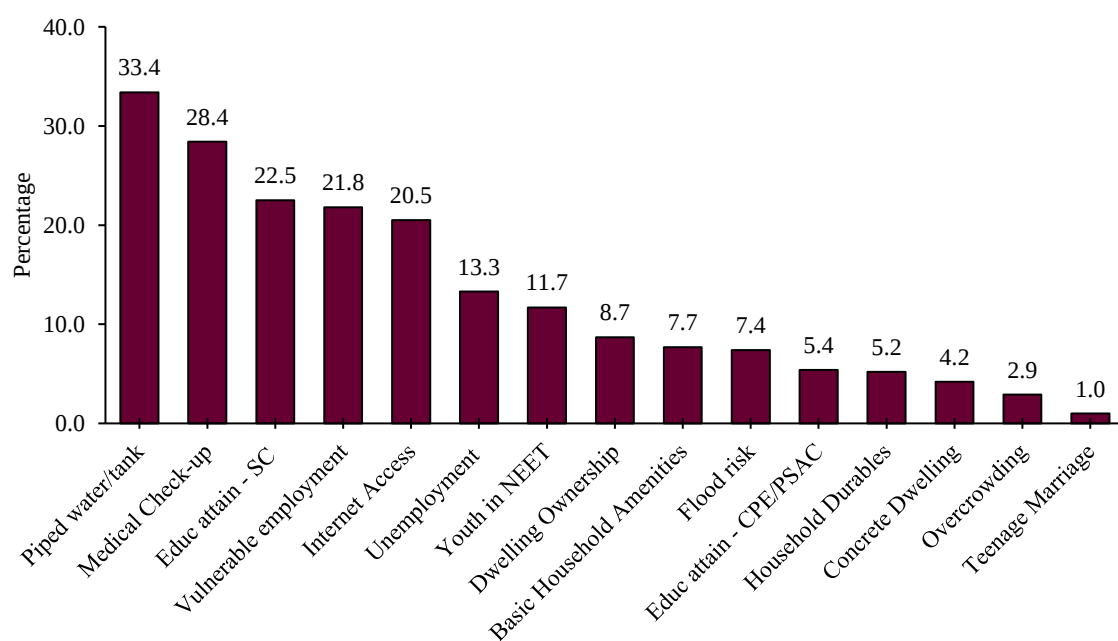
### Uncensored headcount ratio

***Lack of piped water inside housing unit or no water tank (33.4%) was the most widespread deprivation in the whole population***

The uncensored headcount ratio refers to the proportion of persons deprived in a particular indicator, irrespective of being multidimensionally poor. It shows how widespread each deprivation is across the whole population.

In 2022, the highest uncensored headcount ratios are observed for lack of piped water inside housing unit or no water tank (33.4%), no regular medical check-ups (28.4%), low educational attainment that is below SC level (22.5%), vulnerable employment (21.8%), and no internet access (20.5%). These deprivations affected a relatively large share of the population, whether poor or non-poor.

**Figure 1 – Uncensored headcount ratio by indicator<sup>6</sup>, 2022 National MPI**



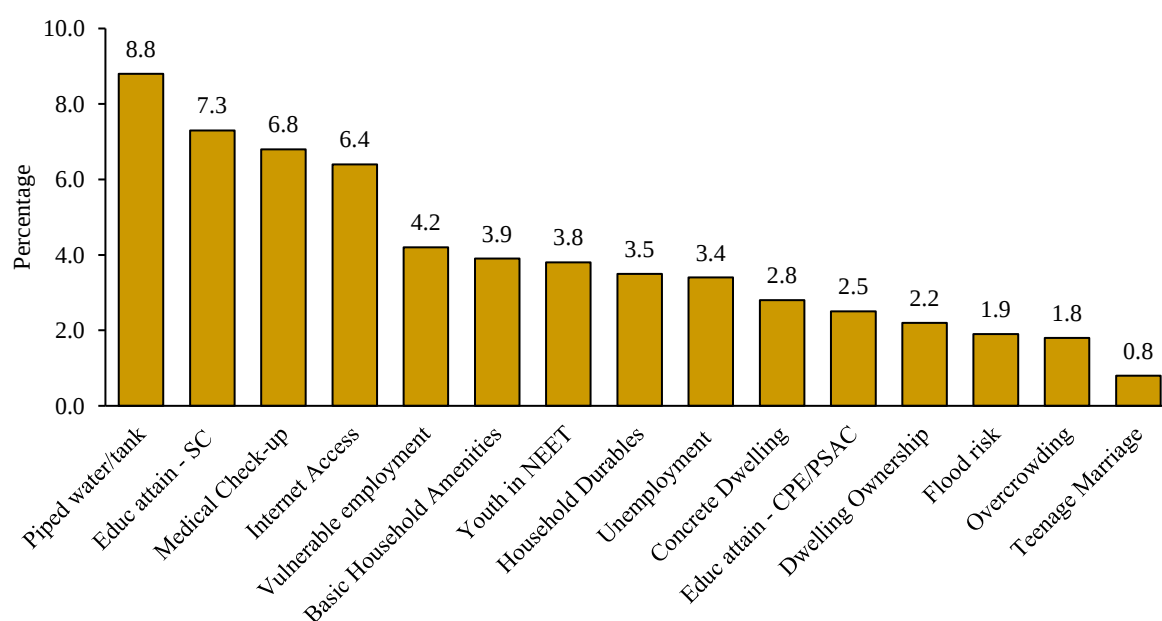
### Censored headcount ratio

***Among multidimensionally poor people, piped water inside housing unit or no tank, low education below SC level, medical check-up and internet access were the main deprivations***

The censored headcount ratio refers to the proportion of persons who are both multidimensionally poor and deprived in a particular indicator. It, therefore, shows which deprivations are concentrated among the multidimensionally poor.

The main deprivations experienced by the multidimensionally poor persons were lack of piped water inside the housing unit or no water tank (8.8%), low educational attainment that is below SC level (7.3%), no regular medical check-ups (6.8%), and no internet access (6.4%).

### 5.3 Contribution of dimensions and indicators: Drivers of MPI

***No regular medical check-ups (16.4%) and lack of piped water inside housing unit or no water tank (14.4%) were the main contributors to the National MPI***

The percentage contribution of each dimension and indicator also helps to identify the main drivers of the National MPI. It shows which dimensions and indicators have the greatest influence on the MPI results, thereby helping users better understand the factors behind multidimensional poverty.

At dimension level, the living standards and education had the largest contribution to the 2022 National MPI, at 26.4% and 26.1% respectively. Together, these two dimensions account for

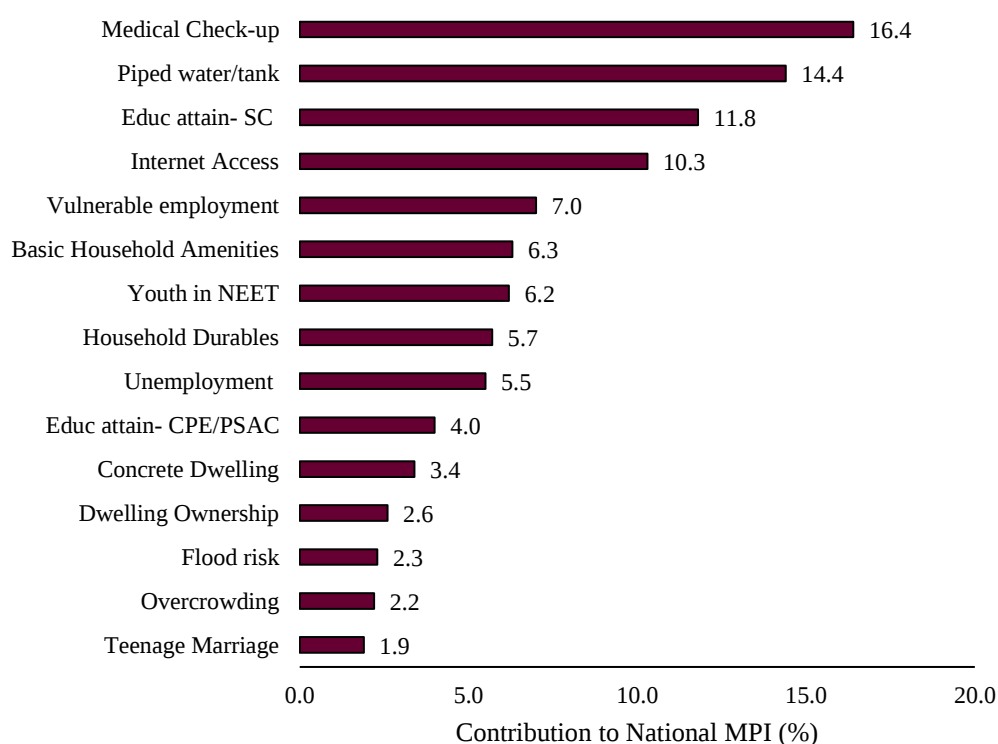
more than half of overall multidimensional poverty. Employment and health contributed 18.7% and 18.3% respectively, while housing contributed 10.5%.

At indicator level, the main contributors were lack of regular medical check-ups (16.4%), lack of piped water inside the housing unit or no water tank (14.4%), low educational attainment below SC level (11.8%), and lack of internet access (10.3%).

Employment-related indicators contributed 18.7% of the total National MPI, comprising vulnerable employment (7.0%), youth in NEET (6.2%) and unemployment (5.5%).

The lowest contributing indicators were teenage marriage (1.9%), overcrowding (2.2%) and living in a flood-affected dwelling (2.3%).

#### 5.4 National MPI results by geographical area

The National MPI results, disaggregated by geographical area and population group, provide a more in-depth analysis of disparities across the Republic of Mauritius. This highlights the importance of census data in producing detailed results and identifying the areas and groups most affected by multidimensional poverty.

### 5.4.1 By island

***Multidimensional poverty was higher in Rodrigues (0.120) than the Island of Mauritius (0.038),***

For the Island of Mauritius, the MPI stood at 0.038, with 10.2% of the population classified as multidimensionally poor and an average poverty intensity of 37.5%. For the Island of Rodrigues, the MPI was relatively higher at 0.120, with a much higher headcount ratio of 29.2% and an average intensity of 41.2%.

***However, the difference in intensity between the islands was relatively smaller***

The gap in the poverty incidence was more pronounced (nearly three times higher in Rodrigues), while the difference in intensity between the two islands was relatively smaller (Table 2).

### 5.4.2 By administrative area

***Multidimensional poverty varied considerably across administrative areas, the MPI values ranging from 0.006 to 0.225***

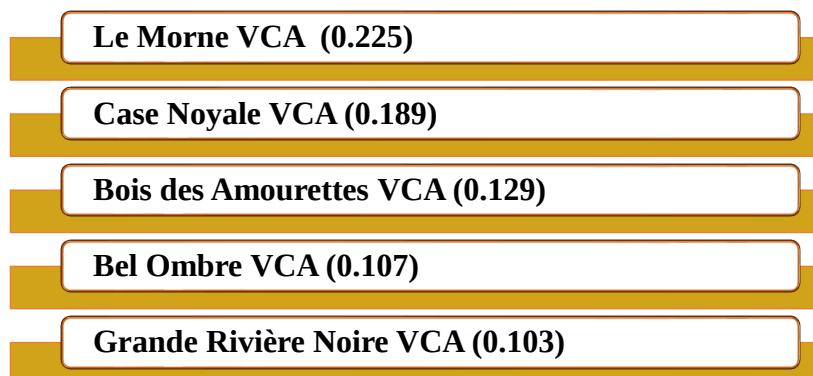
The MPI value disaggregated by administrative area – covering 160 Municipal Wards and Village Council Areas (MVCA) on the Island of Mauritius, and six Regions of Island of Rodrigues - ranges from 0.006 (Town of Quatre Bornes Ward 2) to 0.225 (Le Morne VCA), indicating regional inequalities in the distribution of multidimensional poverty across the Republic of Mauritius.

***Multidimensional poverty was highly concentrated in the districts of Port Louis (0.068) and Black River (0.066), and throughout the Island of Rodrigues (0.120)***

Overall, multidimensional poverty was present across all the districts of the Island of Mauritius but it was more concentrated in the districts of Port Louis (0.068) and Black River (0.066), and throughout the Regions of the Island of Rodrigues (0.120). *Detailed results by geographical area are found in annexed Tables A1 and A2, and thematic maps.*

Le Morne and Case Noyale VCAs recorded the highest MPI values, 0.225 and 0.189 respectively, with relatively high poverty headcount ratios (above 40%).

The five poorest regions with the highest MPI values in the **Island of Mauritius** were:

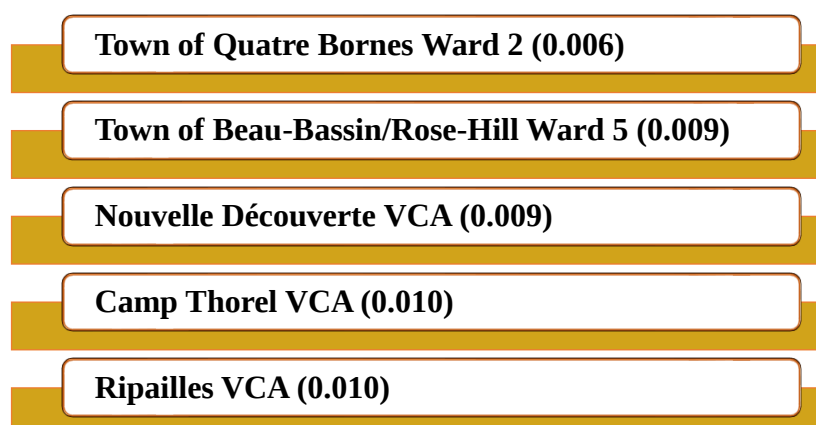


*The regions in the districts of Plaines Wilhems (0.020) and Moka (0.027) had a relatively low burden of multidimensional poverty*

In contrast, multidimensional poverty is comparatively lower in the urban and central regions of the Island of Mauritius, particularly in the districts of Plaines Wilhems and Moka.

Town of Quatre Bornes Ward 2 recorded the lowest MPI value, at 0.006, and the lowest headcount ratio, at 1.8%. Town of Beau-Bassin/Rose-Hill Ward 5 and Nouvelle Découverte VCA were tied for the second-lowest MPI value, at 0.009.

The five regions with the lowest MPI values in the **Island of Mauritius** were:



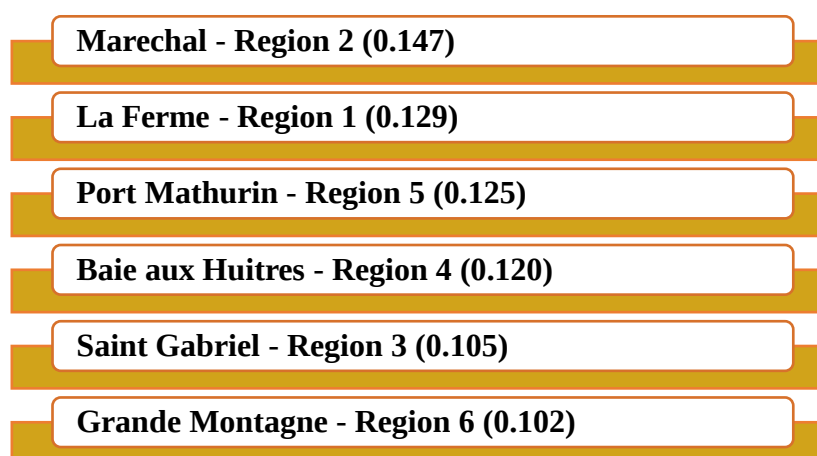
*Port Louis had a higher MPI value compared to other towns*

The Town of Port Louis has relatively higher levels of multidimensional poverty, with all the eight wards having higher MPI values: Wards 6,7 and 8 are particularly more disadvantaged. (Table A1)

### ***Marechal, La Ferme and Port Mathurin were the most disadvantaged regions in the Island of Rodrigues***

In the Island of Rodrigues, multidimensional poverty is widespread across all regions, with MPI values ranging from 0.102 (Grande Montagne) to 0.147 (Marechal). Headcount ratios ranged from 25.4% to 35.0%, while the intensity of poverty was around 40% across the regions. Marechal, La Ferme and Port Mathurin are the most disadvantaged regions, as reflected by their high MPI values.

The MPI values for the Regions in the **Island of Rodrigues** are:



#### **5.4.3 Main deprivations in the MVCAs with the highest MPI values**

***The MVCAs with the highest MPI values recorded higher levels of deprivation, above the national average***

The five administrative areas with the highest MPI values in the Island of Mauritius were Le Morne, Case Noyale, Bois des Amourettes, Bel Ombre and Grande Rivière Noire VCAs. Their MPI values ranged from 0.103 to 0.225, relatively higher than the national MPI of 0.041, indicating a higher burden of multidimensional poverty in these VCAs.

The main deprivations identified in these VCAs, for which the censored headcount ratios (*the proportion of population who are multidimensionally poor and are deprived in the specific indicator*) are above the national levels, were:

- piped water inside housing unit/tank: 20.0% to 37.1%, compared with 8.8% national level;
- educational attainment below SC level: 18.4% to 36.1%, compared with 7.3%;
- internet access: 13.1% to 39.6%, compared with 6.4%; and
- regular medical check-ups: 12.1% to 36.5%, compared with 6.8%.

*Detailed results on censored headcount ratios for administrative areas are found at annexed Table A2.*

#### 5.4.4 Main deprivations in the Island of Rodrigues

**Levels of deprivation were higher in Rodrigues, particularly in terms of basic household amenities, piped water inside housing unit or no water tank and low educational attainment below SC level.**

All the six Regions of the Island of Rodrigues recorded MPI values above the national level. Their MPI values ranged from 0.102 to 0.147, compared with the national MPI of 0.041 (Table A1).

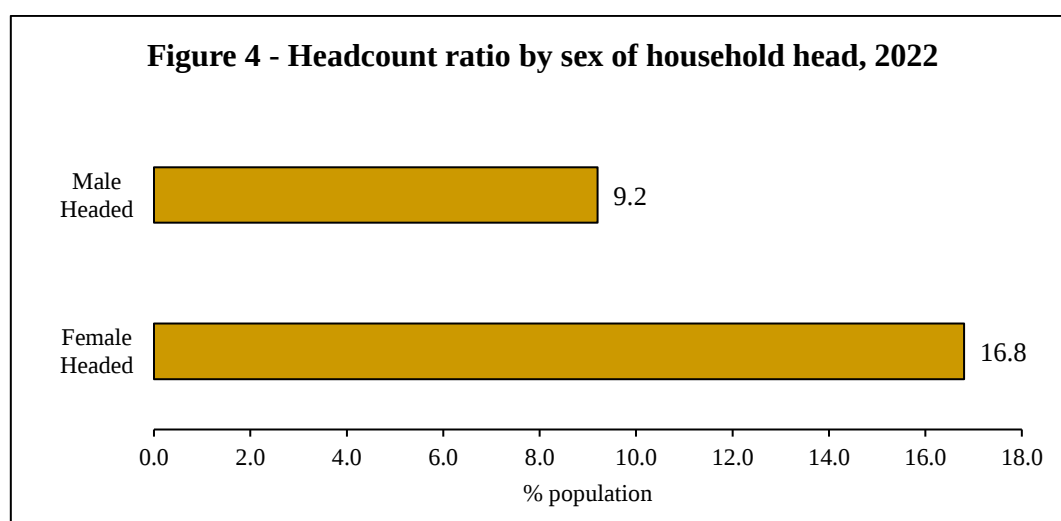
The main deprivations identified in these regions, for which the censored headcount ratios were above the national levels, were:

- basic household amenities: 19.8% to 28.4%, compared with 3.9% at the national level;
- piped water inside housing unit/tank: 17.6% to 25.7%, compared with 8.8%;
- educational attainment below SC level: 17.6% to 25.5%, compared with 7.3%;
- household durables: 12.6% to 24.1%, compared with 3.5%;
- concrete dwelling: 11.7% to 15.1%, compared with 2.8%; and
- regular medical check-ups: 10.0% to 18.6%, compared with 6.8%.

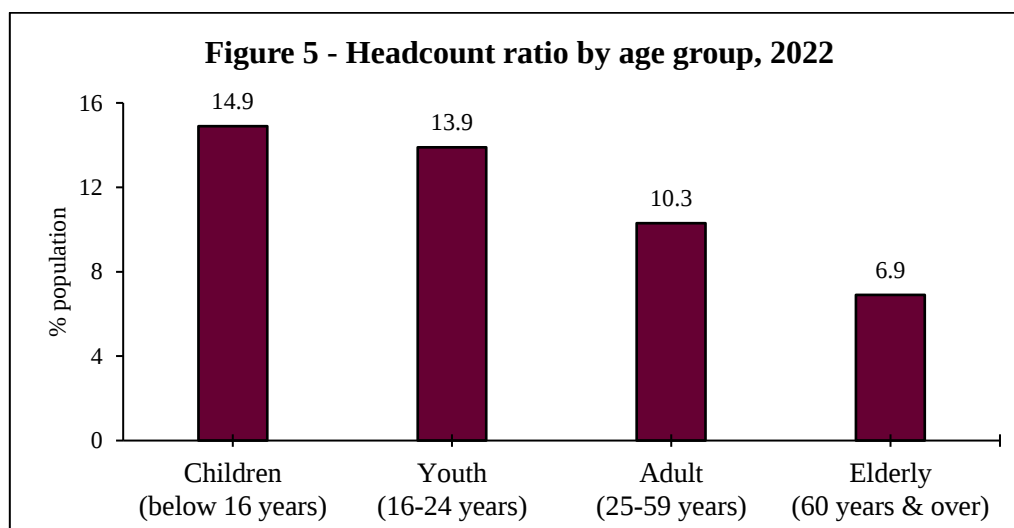
#### 5.5 Multidimensional poverty by population group

This part of the analysis provides deeper insight into the profile of the people in multidimensional poverty. The analysis is based on headcount ratios (*proportion of persons who are multidimensionally poor*). (Table A3)

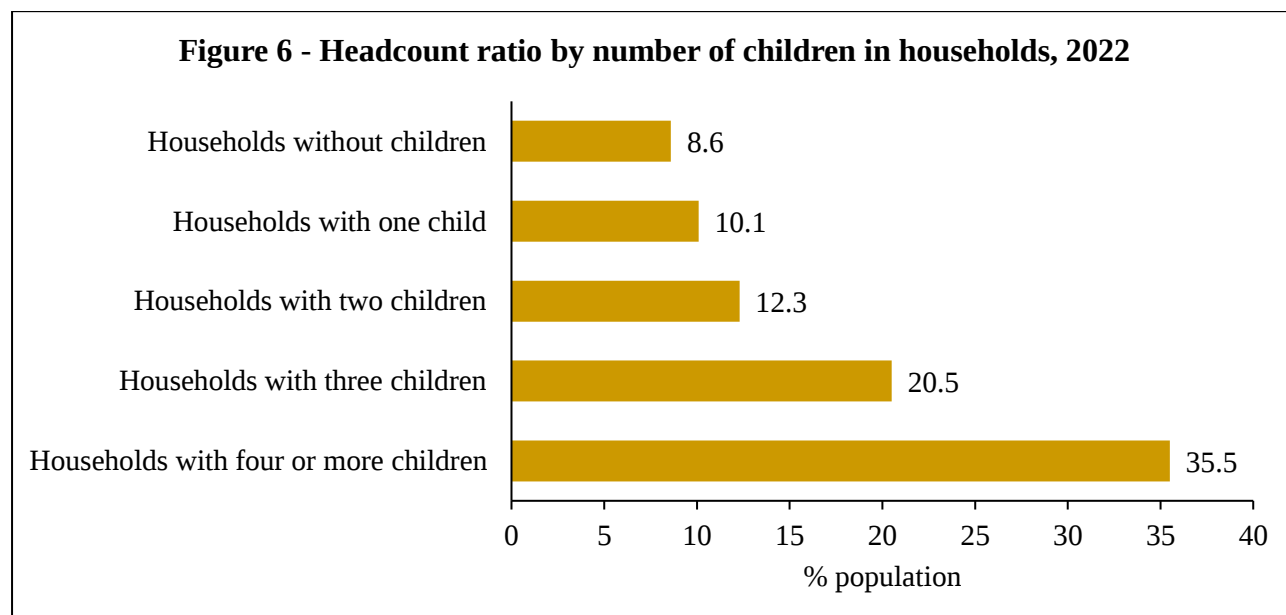
**Female-headed households were more likely to experience multidimensional poverty:** The headcount ratio stood at 16.8%, compared to 9.2% for male-headed households.



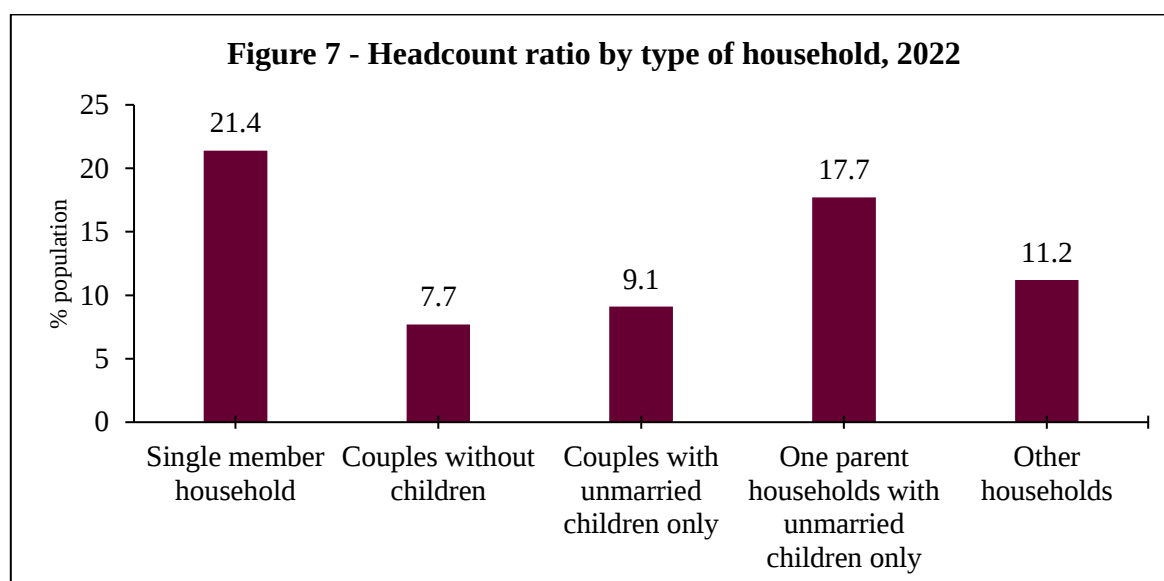
**Multidimensional poverty was more prevalent among younger age groups:** The headcount ratios varied considerably across all age groups, with the highest headcount observed among children (14.9%), followed by youth aged 16 to 24 years (13.9%). In contrast, poverty levels were relatively lower among adults (10.3%) and elderly people (6.9%).



**Households with more children faced higher poverty risk:** Poverty increases with the number of children in the household. Larger households with four or more children had the highest poverty level, at 35.5%. (Figure 6)



**Single member households were the most disadvantaged:** Multidimensional poverty varies considerably by type of household. The poverty incidence was highly prevalent among single member (21.4%) and one-parent households with unmarried children only (17.7%).



## 6 Methodology of the National MPI

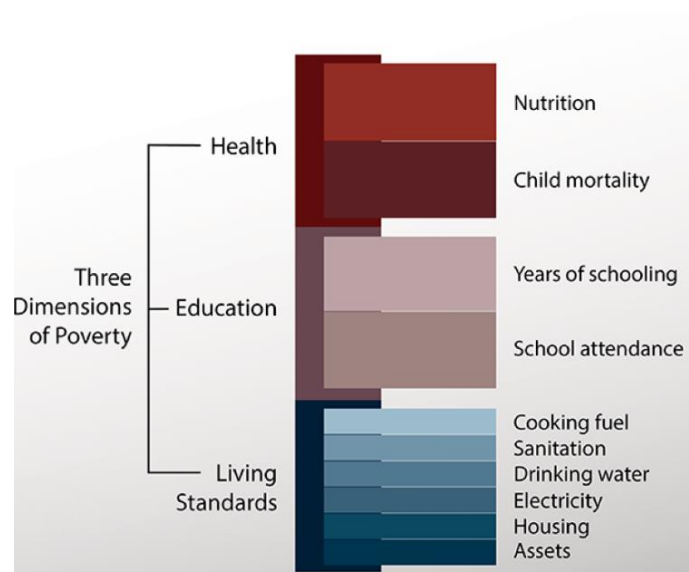
### 6.1 Alkire-Foster Methodology

The National Multidimensional Poverty Index (MPI) for Mauritius is based on the Alkire-Foster methodology, which identifies poverty by examining the multiple deprivations experienced by households across different dimensions. The methodology captures overlapping deprivations, meaning that it identifies households experiencing several disadvantages at the same time, rather than considering each deprivation separately. It therefore provides a broader assessment of poverty beyond traditional monetary measures.

### 6.2 Global MPI

The Global Multidimensional Poverty Index (Global MPI) is an international measure of acute multidimensional poverty developed by OPHI and UNDP. It was first published in 2010, replacing the former Human Poverty Index.

The Global MPI assesses overlapping deprivations across three dimensions: health through nutrition and child mortality; education through years of schooling and school attendance; and living standards through cooking fuel, sanitation, drinking water, electricity, housing and assets.

According to the latest Global MPI release, estimates are available for 109 countries. The Global MPI complements monetary poverty measures and may be considered alongside the World Bank international poverty line, which has been updated to US\$3.00 per person per day in 2021 Purchasing Power Parity (PPP) terms. However, unlike a National MPI, the Global MPI uses a common methodology and standard set of dimensions and indicators to allow international comparison.

### 6.3 Design and technical development of the National MPI

The design and technical development of the National MPI was undertaken in close collaboration with experts from OPHI. The OPHI Handbook on How to Build a National Multidimensional Poverty Index<sup>9</sup> (MPI) was also used as a key reference guide during the development process.

The National MPI framework was developed through a national consultation process involving a broad range of stakeholders, including policymakers from line Ministries, parliamentarians, academia, Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs) engaged in poverty and related alleviation work at grass-root level, and other stakeholders.

These consultations served to familiarise stakeholders with the MPI methodology and its policy benefits, and to gather their views on the selection of dimensions and indicators relevant to the Mauritian context. The process also helped ensure that the selected indicators

are measurable, policy-relevant and useful for guiding targeted poverty alleviation interventions.

## 6.4 Data Source

The National MPI is computed using the 2022 Housing and Population Census (HPC) data. The 2022 HPC was identified as the most relevant data source because it covers an adequate range of topics to support the dimensions and indicators identified through the national stakeholder consultation process.

Additionally, the HPC enables MPI results to be disaggregated by detailed geographical area and population group (e.g., age, sex, household composition, etc.), which is essential for identifying regional disparities and targeting poverty alleviation interventions effectively.

## 6.5 Unit of identification and analysis

The household is the unit of identification – where deprivations are measured at household as well as individual levels. Each household is then assessed and classified as multidimensionally poor or non-poor.

The unit of analysis is the individual, as the results are expressed in terms of persons living in multidimensionally poor households.

## 6.6 Selection of indicators

The indicators and deprivation cut-offs were selected on the basis of their relevance to national development priorities, their policy usefulness and data availability in the 2022 HPC. The dimensions and indicators identified through the national consultation process were assessed to ensure that they are measurable and relevant to the Mauritian context.

The dimensions and most of the indicators of the National MPI are broadly consistent with international MPI practice. For example, housing-related indicators such as overcrowding, housing tenure and materials of construction of dwellings are commonly used in multidimensional poverty measures (OPHI Handbook). Several indicators are also aligned with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG), including youth not in employment, education or training and unemployment under SDG 8, educational attainment under SDG 4, and early marriage under SDGs 3 & 5 (Table 3).

Moreover, given the limited availability of detailed health information in the Census, such as Non-Communicable Disease risk factors or chronic diseases, the indicator on regular medical check-up was included. Similarly, the climate-change-related indicator was limited by the information collected in the 2022 HPC. However, the indicator ‘flooded dwelling’ was retained, given the relevance of flooding as a common and policy-important hazard in Mauritius. Other climate-related impacts could not be included, as they were not captured in the Census. It is worth noting that OPHI highlighted the relevance and impact of climate hazards in assessing multidimensional poverty in its latest publication, 2025 Global MPI report.<sup>10</sup>

Additionally, the indicator on vulnerable employment was measured based on the International Labour Organisation (ILO) definition prior to 2018 as captured in the 2022 HPC.

Indicator selection considered conceptual relevance, policy usefulness, data availability and observed deprivation patterns. Indicators with very low deprivation levels were generally not retained. Some indicators, such as access to piped water and availability of basic household facilities, were retained due to their policy importance and were combined where appropriate to facilitate interpretation.

## 6.7 Weighting structure

An equal nested weighting structure is applied in the National MPI. Each of the five dimensions is assigned an equal weight of one-fifth, or 20%. Indicators within each dimension are equally weighted. For example, in a dimension comprising four indicators, each indicator carries a weight of 1/20. The maximum deprivation score is 100%, which would occur if a household were deprived in all indicators.

## 6.8 Deprivation and Poverty cut-offs

Under the Alkire-Foster method, multidimensional poverty is identified using a dual cut-off approach, that is,

- A **deprivation cut-off** is applied to each indicator to determine whether a household is deprived in that indicator. The weighted deprivations are then summed to obtain each household's weighted deprivation score.
- A **poverty cut-off** is applied to this score to determine whether the household is multidimensionally poor. For the National MPI of Mauritius, the poverty cut-off is set at 30%. A household is considered multidimensionally poor if its weighted deprivation score is equal to or exceeds 30%.

## 6.9 MPI headline indicators

The three headline indicators of MPI are:

- **Headcount ratio (H):** the proportion of the population identified as multidimensionally poor, expressed as a percentage. It is also called incidence of poverty and poverty rate.
- **Intensity of poverty (A):** the average proportion of weighted deprivations experienced by the multidimensionally poor. It measures how many deprivations the poor suffer, on average.
- **MPI value ( $H \times A$ ):** an overall measure of multidimensional poverty, combining both the incidence and intensity of poverty. It is also called *Adjusted Headcount Ratio*.

The MPI value ranges from 0 to 1, with 0 reflecting zero poverty and 1 universal poverty and deprivation.

*e.g., for the Republic of Mauritius, an MPI value of 0.041 implies that people in Mauritius experience 4.1% of all possible weighted deprivations captured by the National MPI*

indicators. By comparison, a value of 1 would mean that everyone is deprived in all indicators simultaneously.

The MPI is calculated as the product of the headcount ratio and the average intensity of poverty:

$$MPI = H \times A$$

where:

$$H = \frac{q}{N}$$

with

$q$  = Number of multi-dimensionally poor persons

$N$  = Total population in household

and

$$A = \frac{\sum_{i=1}^q c_i}{q}$$

where

$c_i$  = weighted deprivation score of poor persons  $i$

Therefore:

$$MPI = \frac{q}{N} \times \frac{\sum_{i=1}^q c_i}{q}$$

The  $q$  cancels out:

$$MPI = \frac{\sum_{i=1}^q c_i}{N}$$

The MPI represents the average weighted deprivation score of the multidimensionally poor across the whole population

The number of persons in multidimensional poverty is calculated as follows:

$$\text{Number of persons in multidimensional poverty} = H \times N$$

### How to calculate the MPI

The key steps to calculate the MPI are as follows:

Step 1: Each household is assessed against the selected indicators and deprivation cut-offs

Step 2: A deprivation value of 1 is assigned when the household is deprived in an indicator, and 0 otherwise.

Step 3: Each deprivation is multiplied by its indicator weight.

Step 4: The weighted deprivations are summed to obtain the household deprivation score.

Step 5: Households with a weighted deprivation score of 30% or more are identified as multidimensionally poor.

Step 6: The headcount ratio, average intensity and MPI value are then calculated for persons living in those multidimensionally poor households.

## 6.10 Uncensored and Censored Headcount Ratios

The methodology also produces two complementary measures: uncensored and censored headcount ratios.

- The **uncensored headcount ratio** represents the proportion of persons deprived in a particular indicator, regardless of whether they are multidimensionally poor.

$$\begin{aligned} & \text{Uncensored headcount ratio for a specific indicator} \\ &= \frac{\text{Number of persons deprived in the indicator}}{\text{Total number of persons}} \end{aligned}$$

- The **censored headcount ratio** represents the proportion of persons who are both multidimensionally poor and deprived in that specific indicator.

$$\begin{aligned} & \text{Censored headcount ratio for a specific indicator} \\ &= \frac{\text{Number of persons who are both multidimensionally poor and deprived in the indicator}}{\text{Total number of persons}} \end{aligned}$$

These measures help identify how widespread particular deprivations are, and the extent to which they are concentrated among the poor.

## 6.11 Contribution of Indicators

The contribution of each indicator to the overall MPI identifies the main drivers of multidimensional poverty. Indicators with the highest contributions highlight the dimensions that contribute most significantly to poverty and can therefore guide policy priorities and targeted interventions.

$$\begin{aligned} & \text{Contribution of a specific indicator to the MPI} \\ &= \frac{\text{Indicator weight} \times \text{Censored headcount ratio of the indicator}}{\text{MPI value}} \end{aligned}$$

## 6.12 Disaggregation

The MPI is particularly useful when disaggregated by geographical location and population group (e.g., sex, age, household composition, etc.). Although the national MPI for Mauritius is 0.041, results vary across Municipal Wards, Village Council Areas and the six Regions of Rodrigues, highlighting regional disparities and supporting the identification of priority areas for poverty alleviation programmes.

### 6.13 Scope, data considerations and limitations

The scope of the National MPI is determined by the information available in the 2022 HPC. In line with the MPI methodology, the index is computed using a single dataset, where all households and persons are assessed across the selected dimensions and indicators.

In this regard, some thematic areas, such as food security and detailed health information, including the prevalence of Non-Communicable Disease risk factors, are not covered in the index as they require data from other targeted surveys.

### 6.14 Geographical codes

Geographical codes for administrative areas are provided in the annex tables and thematic maps for ease of reference. These codes correspond to the Municipal Wards and Village Council Areas on the Island of Mauritius, and to the six Regions of the Island of Rodrigues. They allow users to identify the relevant administrative areas and compare results consistently across tables, maps and other outputs.

### 6.15 Resident in private households

The resident population was defined as persons who usually lived in the household, whether they were present or absent on census night. For census purposes, “usual residence” was defined as the place at which the person lived at the time of the census, and has been there continuously for the past 12 months or intended to live there continuously for at least 12 months. Persons who answered “Yes” to the question on “Place of residence” were considered as residents. The resident population also included non-Mauritians working in the country, who reported their usual address as being in Mauritius, as well as their families living with them.

Private households with usual residents were private households with at least one resident member at the time of the census.

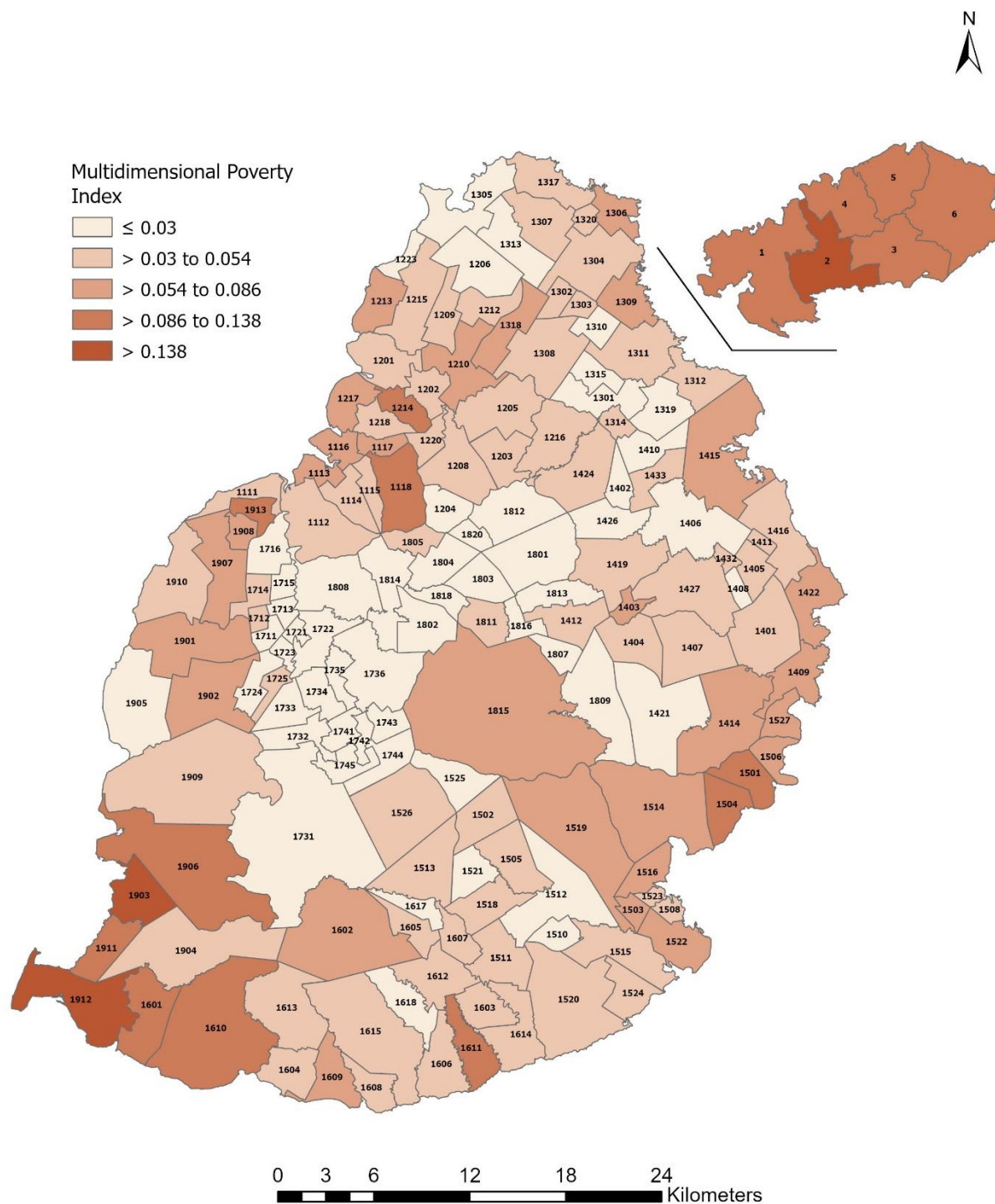

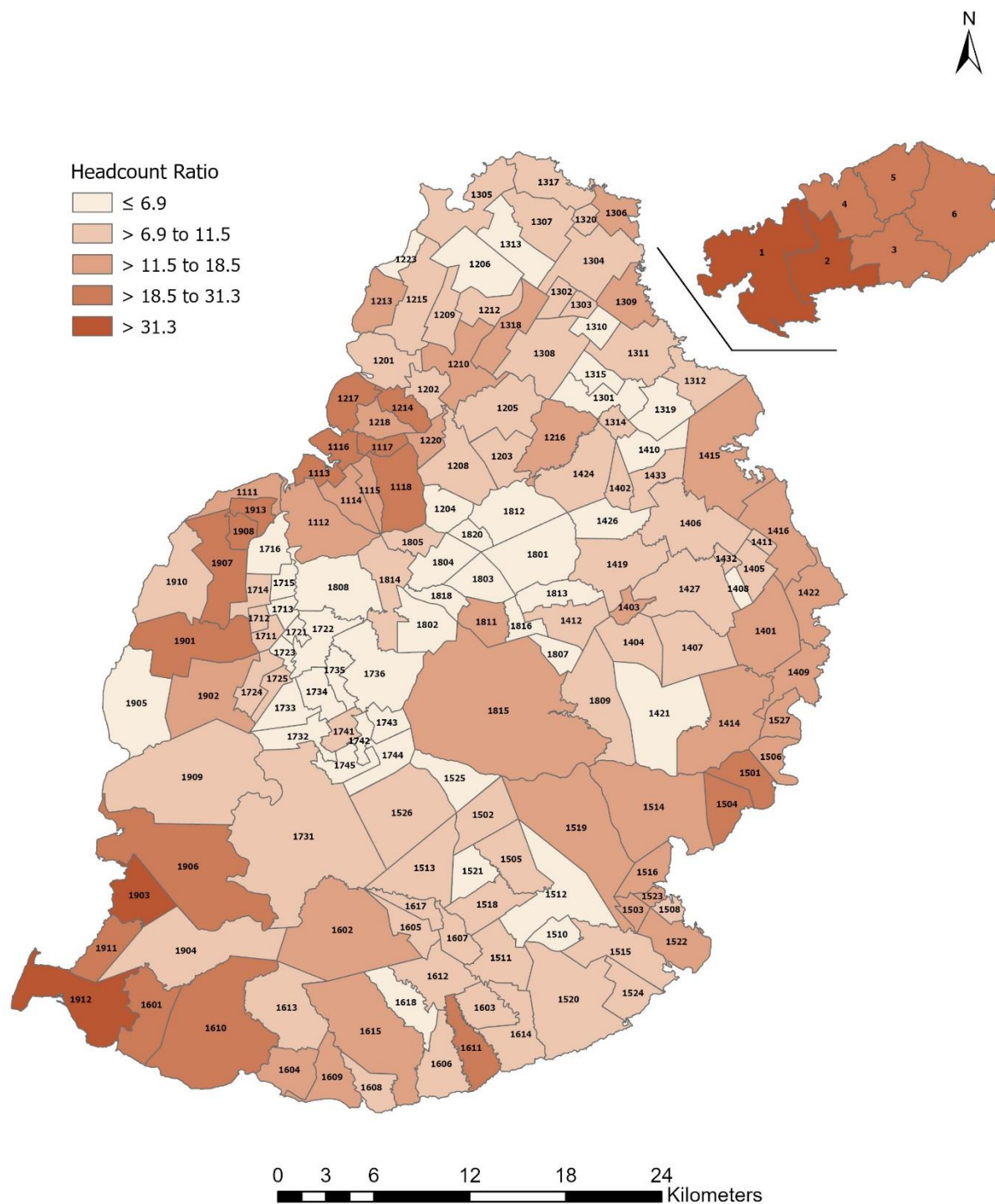

## National Multidimensional Poverty Index by administrative area, 2022

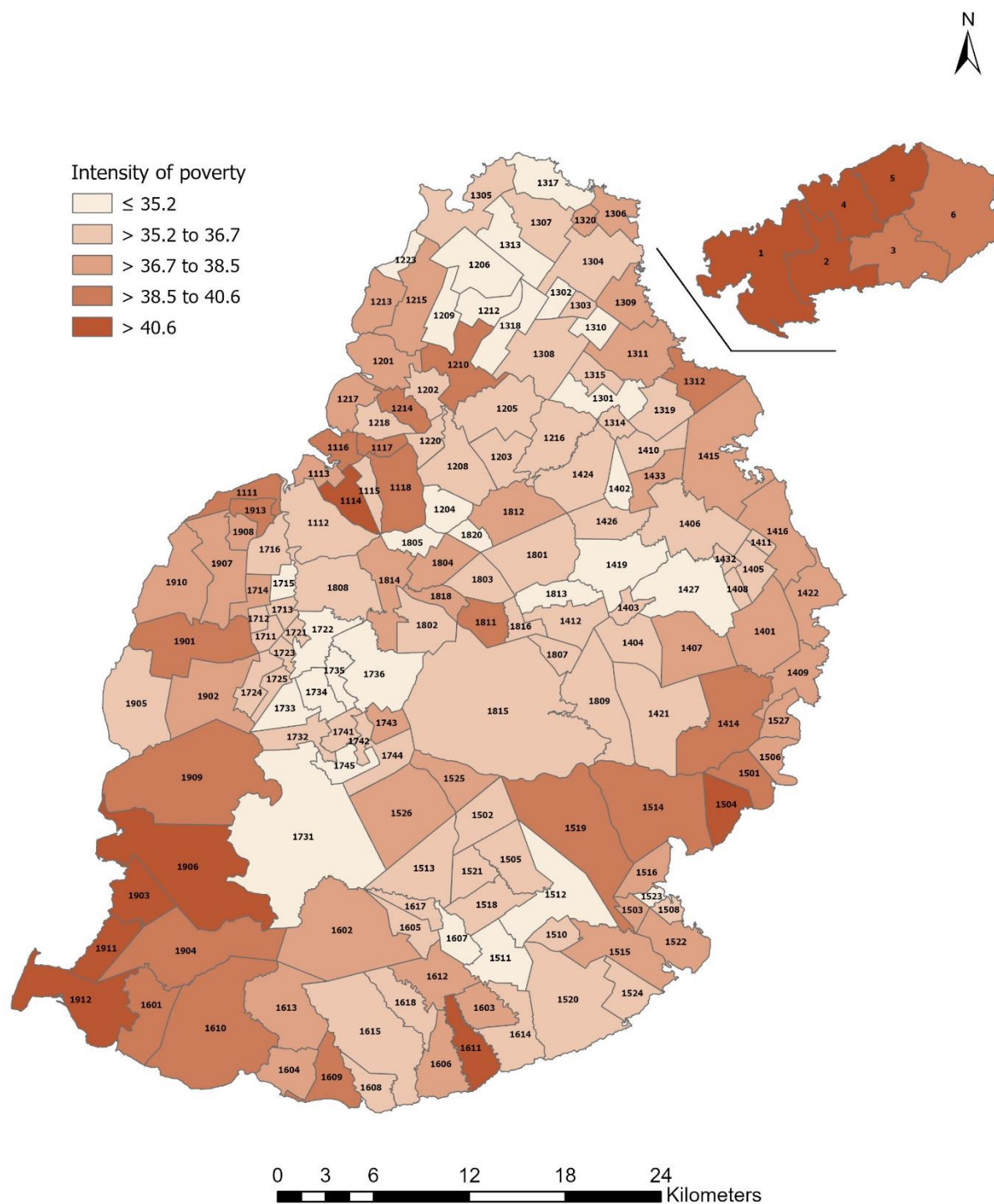
