Data refer to business activities undertaken in the island of Mauritius, which are either licensed with the local authorities (municipalities and district councils) or registered with the appropriate organizations such as the Medical Council, the Ministry of Education and Human Resources, the National Transport Authority, etc.

The business activities have been coded according to the National Standard Industrial Classification of All Economic Activities (NSIC) which is an adapted version of the International Standard Industrial Classification of All Economic Activities (ISIC) Rev. 3, 1990.

It is hoped that this report will be of valuable help to the public in general and to planners and policy makers in particular.

The co-operation and assistance of the local authorities, professional councils and other organisations are gratefully acknowledged.

Technical Notes

1. General

Data compiled in this publication provide the information on demography and trend of business activities in the different economic sectors of the country.

2. Concepts and Coverage

An operator is required to obtain a licence from the Municipal or District Councils or to register with the appropriate Ministry or organisations (e.g Ministry of Education and Human Resources, the Medical Council, the National Transport Authority, the Tourism Authority, etc.) in order to operate. Statistics published in this report pertain only to activities that are either licensed or registered. However, all agricultural related activities, except those in the manufacture of food products, are not covered.

Statistics on licences relate to the number of licences as delivered by the local authorities. Similarly statistics on registrations are those as registered with the appropriate Ministries or organisations. In some cases, an operator may hold both a licence and a registration certificate. To avoid double counting, while compiling statistics on both licences and registrations, such activities have been accounted for in registration only. For example the owner of a bus, besides registering his vehicle with the National Transport Authority may also hold a licence issued by a district council. In the table giving figures for both licences and registrations, the activity of the bus owner is accounted for in registration only.

3. Classification and presentation of data

To cater for the wide range and diverse business activities and for classification purposes, each activity has been assigned an activity code according to the **National Standard Industrial classification of Economic Activities (NSIC)**, which is an adapted version of the International Standard Industrial Classification (ISIC), Rev. 3, 1990.

The NSIC consists of 5 levels of classification namely:

Level 1	Section:	17 sections identified by one of the letters A to Q
Level 2	Division:	56 divisions identified by the first 2 digits
Level 3	Group:	151 groups identified by the first 3 digits
Level 4	Classes:	302 classes identified by the first 4 digits
Level 5	Sub-classes:	548 sub-classes identified by the 5 digits

Business Activity Statistics, July 2006 - June 2007

Introduction

Statistics on business activities undertaken in the Island of Mauritius are compiled mainly from administrative records. They cover activities which are either licensed with the local authorities (municipalities and district councils) or registered with the appropriate organizations such as the Medical and Dental Council, the National Transport Authority, the Tourism Authority, etc. All agricultural activities are presently excluded.

It is to be noted that statistics on business activity presented in this publication refer to the total number of licensed or registered activities and not to the total number of operation units or enterprises.

2. Legal framework

Prior to October 2006, all entities in business had to be licensed with the relevant Municipality or District Council, or registered with the appropriate organisation. For each type of activity, the operator held a different licence. Thus, an entity selling foodstuff and non foodstuff, manufactured tobacco, cakes and pastries would be operating with three licences.

With the coming into operation of the Business Registration and Business Facilitation Acts on the 1st of October 2006 and amendments brought to various regulations, an operator now holds one licence irrespective of the number of activities carried out, provided that all the activities fall within the same cluster. Thus, the entity mentioned above would, upon renewal of its licences, operate with only one licence even though it is still carrying out the same three activities. The other two licences have been treated as cancelled for administrative purposes.

The statistics on licences and registrations collected prior to October 2006 are not strictly comparable with those collected after October 2006. Care should therefore be taken when comparing figures presented in this publication.

3. Evolution of licences between July 2006 and June 2007

As at end June 2007, the total number of licences stood at 84,136, representing an increase of 6% over the previous year figure of 79,651 (Table 1.1). During the period under reference, 9,141 new licences were issued, of which 5,754 (63%) pertained to activities classified under 'Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles, personal and household goods'. The large number of licences which were cancelled during the same period (4,656) is due to a great extent to the effect of the different regulations in place since 1st October 2006, as mentioned above. The distribution of licences by industry group and district is given in Tables 1.2a to 1.2h.

4. Registrations by industry group and district as at 30 June 2007

The number of registrations increased by 561 (2%) from 28,769 in July 2006 to 29,330 in June 2007. The industry group 'Transport, storage and communications' had

the highest number of registrations with 20,637 (70%) as at June 2007, followed by 'Real estate, renting and business activities' with 2,737 (9%) (Table 2).

5. Adjusted licences and registrations as at June 2007

Table 3.1 shows that the number of licences and registrations, adjusted to avoid double counting, has increased by 5% from 102,653 in June 2006 to 107,374 in June 2007. The industry group 'Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles, personal and household goods' remained the most important with 58,839 activities (55%), followed by that of 'Transport, storage and communications' which totalled 21,073 activities (20%). The distribution of adjusted licences and registrations by selected industry groups is given in Tables 3.2a to 3.2h.

6. Net changes in adjusted licences and registrations, June 2006 to June 2007

The net changes in the number of adjusted licenses and registrations from 30 June 2006 to June 2007, by industry group, are given in Table 4. The highest increase in the number of activities was noted in the industry group 'Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles, personal and household goods' with 2,280 activities, representing 48% of total increase. The decrease in the number of activities in the industry group 'Hotels and restaurants' is explained by the effect of the new regulations of the Tourist Act under which a restaurant keeper does not need a separate licence to sell alcoholic beverages. Consequently 525 liquor licences were cancelled during the period under reference.

7. Distribution of adjusted licences and registrations by industry group and region

The number of activities was higher in rural areas (54%) than in urban areas as shown in Table 5.1. Activities which are predominant in rural regions are from the industry groups 'Other Community, social and personal service activities' (65%) and 'Hotels and restaurants' (64%). On the other end, activities which are found mostly in urban areas are from the industry groups 'Health and social work' (76%), 'Real estate, renting and business activities' (63%) and 'Construction' (57%). The distribution of activities by region and selected industry groups is given in Tables 5.2a to 5.2h.

8. Distribution of adjusted licences and registrations by industry group and district

The district wise distribution of activities by industry group, given in Table 6, shows that the Plaines Wilhems district had the highest number of activities (27%) and Black River the smallest number (4%). Further details by selected industry groups are given in Tables 6.2a to 6.2h.

Fig 1- Evolution of total number of Licences¹ & registrations during, June 2000 - 2007





Fig 2 - Licences¹ & registrations by main activity as at June, 2006 and 2007


