The results which show information relating to schools, enrolments, teaching and administrative staff, examinations, etc. are presented in this publication.

Data on primary education refer to 28th February 1985. The reference date for information on secondary data is the 25th April 1985.

It is hoped that the statistics which have been assembled in this report will be useful to the public in general and to education planners and policy makers in particular.

The assistance of the Ministry of Education, Arts and Culture in the collection and processing of the data and the co-operation of all head teachers and managers of educational institutions in providing the data are gratefully acknowledged.




Fig. 2 - Primary School Leaving Certificate/Certificate of Primary Education, School Certificate and Higher School Certificate Examination Results, 1970 - 1984
