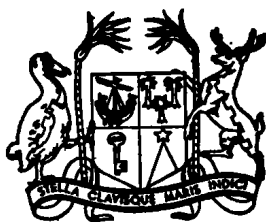

DIGEST OF EDUCATIONAL STATISTICS

This is the fourth issue of a regular publication of the Central Statistical Office on educational statistics.

Detailed and comprehensive data on primary and secondary education have been collected from all schools and colleges of the country in 1987 and processed by the micro-computer of the Ministry of Education, Arts and Culture. However, a breakdown in the computer has compelled us to perform part of the processing for secondary education manually with the result that some of the tables, mainly on teaching staff, which usually appear in this publication have not been presented in this issue.

Data refer to 30th June 1987.

It is hoped that the statistics which have been assembled in this report will be useful to the public in general and to education planners and policy makers in particular.

The assistance of the Ministry of Education, Arts and Culture in the collection and processing of the data and the co-operation of all head teachers and managers of educational institutions in providing the data are gratefully acknowledged.

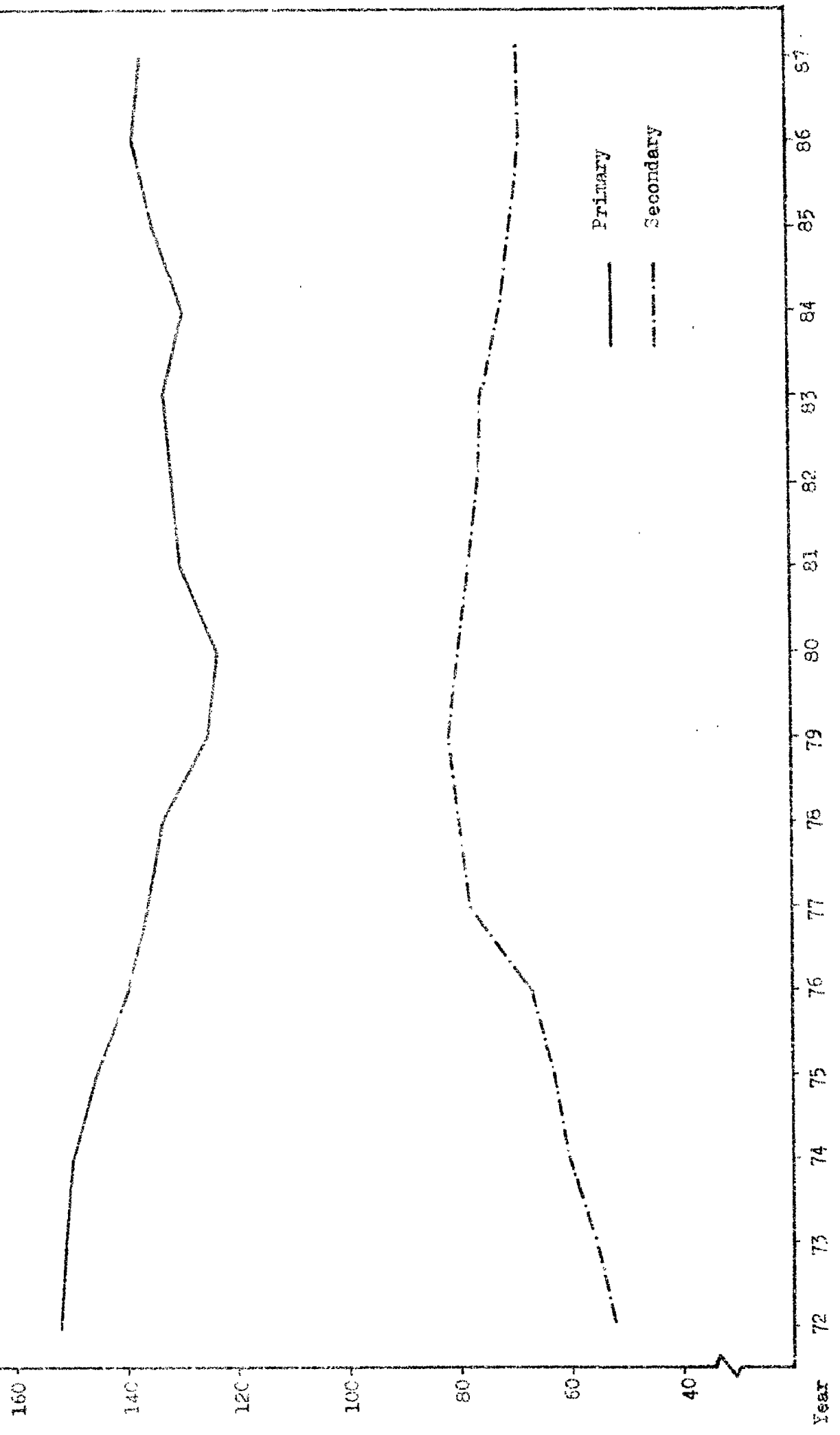

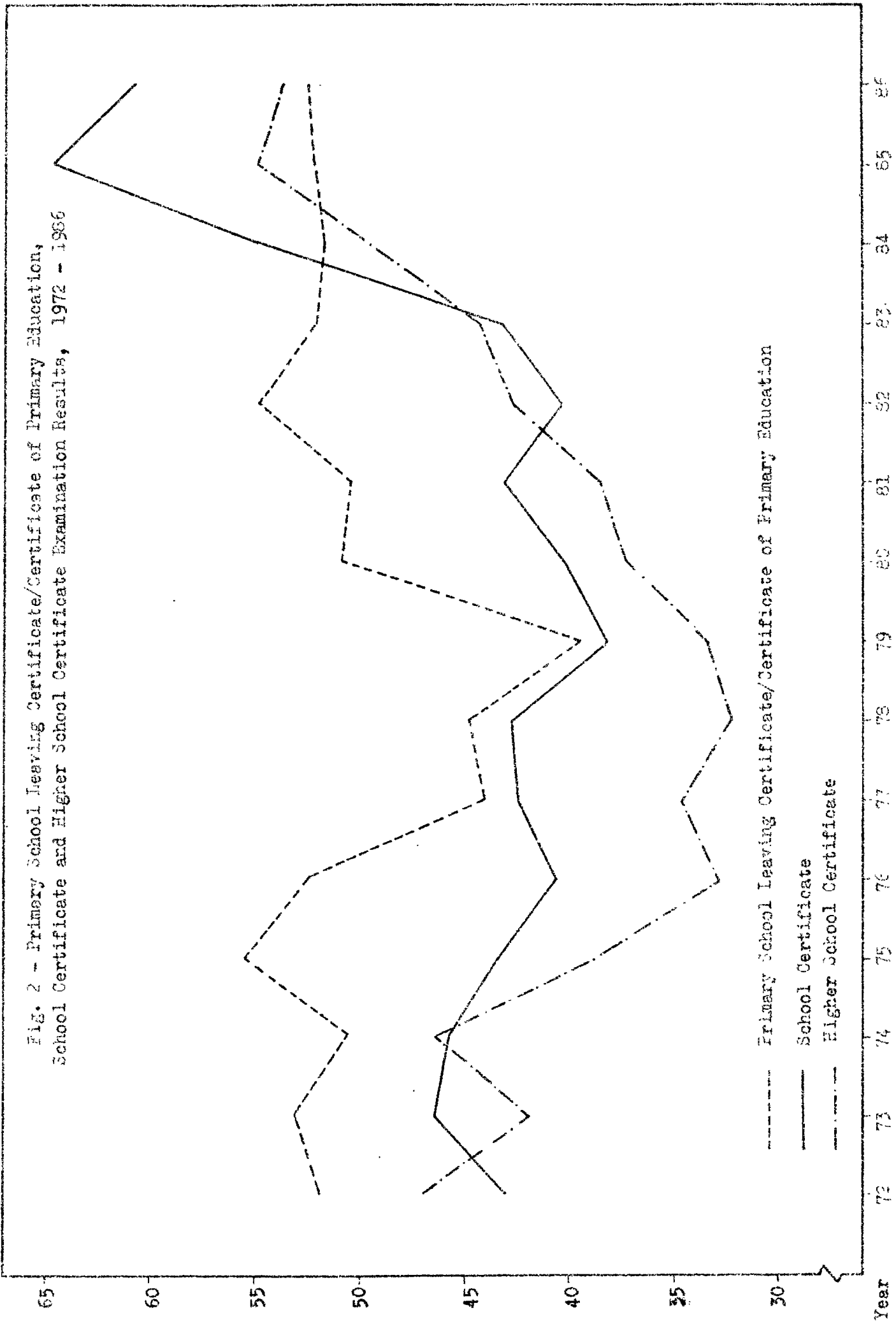
Fig. 1 - Primary and Secondary enrolments, 1972 - 1987
