

Foreword

This is the fifth issue of a regular publication of the Central Statistical Office on educational statistics.

Detailed and comprehensive data on primary and secondary education have been collected through surveys in all schools and colleges of the country in 1988. The completed questionnaires were meant to be processed on the newly acquired IBM PS 2 micro-computer of the Ministry of Education, Arts and Culture. However, the proper software for an exhaustive processing is not ready yet. In order not to delay the publication of this digest unduly, the statistics unit has managed to write programs for simple tables only and in certain cases, tables have even been compiled manually. Thus this issue, like the previous one, does not contain all the tables that usually appear in this publication. It is hoped to publish the missing tables, mainly on teaching staff, in the next issue of the digest.

Data refer to 30th June 1988.

It is hoped that the statistics which have been assembled in this report will be useful to the public in general and to educational planners and policy makers in particular.

The assistance of the Ministry of Education, Arts and Culture in the collection and processing of the data and the co-operation of all head teachers and managers of educational institutions in providing the data are gratefully acknowledged.




Fig. 1 - Primary and Secondary enrolment , 1973-1988
