

Data refer to 30th June 1990.

It is hoped that the statistics which have been assembled in this report will be useful to the public in general and to education planners and policy makers in particular.



Fig. 1 – Primary and Secondary enrolment, 1975–1990




Fig. 2—Primary School Leaving Certificate/Certificate of Primary Education
