

This is the eighth issue of a regular publication of the Central Statistical Office on educational statistics.

Detailed and comprehensive data on primary and secondary education have been collected from all schools and colleges of the country in 1991 and processed by micro-computer at the Ministry of Education and Science. The results which show information relating to schools, enrolments, teaching and administrative staff, examinations, etc. are presented in this publication.

Data on teaching staff refer to 30th April 1991 while those on enrolment and infrastructure refer to 30th June 1991.

It is hoped that the statistics which have been assembled in this report will be useful to the public in general and to education planners and policy makers in particular.

The assistance of the Ministry of Education and Science in the collection and processing of the data and the co-operation of all head teachers and managers of educational institutions in providing the data are gratefully acknowledged.



Island of Mauritius




Fig.2 - Primary and Secondary enrolment, 1976-1991
