Basic data for the preparation of this publication have been obtained from the bills of entry of the Customs and Excise Department.

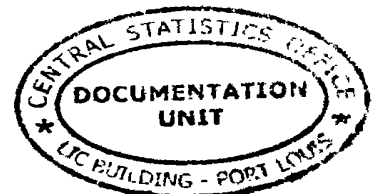

External Trade - Second Quarter 1986

1. Total Trade

Total external trade during the second quarter of 1986 was Rs 3,968 mn - only slightly below the value for the previous quarter when it stood at Rs 3,981 mn. In volume terms however, this represents a 2% increase over the period.

For the first half of 1986, total trade has increased by almost 30% in real terms compared with the corresponding period a year ago. In nominal terms it amounted to Rs 7,949 mn compared with Rs 6,645 mn.

2. Balance of visible trade

During the second quarter of 1986 a deficit of Rs 350 mn was registered in the visible trade of the country with exports amounting to Rs 1,809 mn and imports Rs 2,159 mn. For the whole of the first semester of 1986 this deficit stood at Rs 459 mn compared to Rs 873 mn for the corresponding period of 1985. Total exports reached Rs 3,745 mn in 1986 (Rs 2,886 mn in 1985) while the import bill was of the order of Rs 4,204 mn (Rs 3,759 mn in 1985).

3. Terms of trade (1982 = 100)

The second quarter of 1986 saw a slight increase in the overall price level of exports over the previous quarter. On the other hand import prices registered an overall decrease of about 3% on average, mainly due to fall in the prices of commodities like rice, petroleum products and cement.

As a result the terms of trade rose from 132 to reach 139 in the second quarter of 1986. It is to be noted that this economic indicator has been rising gradually since 1982 and this upward movement has accelerated since the fourth quarter of 1985 when it jumped from 113 to 122 and has since then kept this accelerated motion.

4. Exports

Total revenue from exports during the second quarter of 1986 dropped by about 7% from Rs 1,936 mn the previous quarter to Rs 1,809 mn. In volume terms this represents a decrease of about 8%. For the first half of 1986 export proceeds amounted to Rs 3,745 mn as against Rs 2,886 mn for the corresponding period in 1985 - an increase in value of nearly 30%. Elimination of price effects however shows that the real increase was around 22%.

The main exports during the second quarter were EPZ products (Rs 1,242 mn) and sugar (Rs 364 mn). The first semester of 1986 therefore saw total exports of EPZ products rising to Rs 2,117 mn and those of sugar to Rs 1,209 mn compared with Rs 1,300 mn and Rs 1,160 mn respectively a year ago.

During the first half of 1986, the bulk of our domestic exports was directed towards the EEC countries mainly United Kingdom (Rs 1,041 mn) and France (Rs 987 mn) and the United States of America (Rs 684 mn). These three markets absorbed Rs 1,106 mn, Rs 631 mn and Rs 456 mn respectively of our exports during the corresponding period last year.

5. Imports

Total imports during the second quarter of 1986 rose by about 6% from Rs 2,045 mn the previous quarter to Rs 2,159 mn. For the first half of 1986 the value of imports therefore reached Rs 4,204 mn thus registering an increase of nearly 12% over the corresponding period of 1985. However, the general price level of imported goods declined during that period by about 16% which consequently brought about a growth of 34% in real terms over the two periods. The increase is mainly attributable to higher imports of raw materials and machinery by the EPZ industries. On the other hand there were important decreases in the value of imports of petroleum products and rice. A summary of these changes is given here-below :-

EPZ raw materials, machinery and equipment, and refined petroleum products continued to weigh heavily in the imports bill during the first half of 1986. Together with food these accounted for nearly 75% of total imports (71% during first half of 1985). Of our total imports of Rs 4,204 mn during the first half of 1986, nearly 70% (Rs 2,859 mn) came from preferential tariff countries. France and United Kingdom continued to be the main suppliers of the country with Rs 546 mn and Rs 327 mn respectively. Other important sources of supply were South Africa (Rs 424 mn), Japan (Rs 287 mn), the Federal Republic of Germany (Rs 248 mn) and China (Rs 204 mn). Imports from these sources amounted respectively to Rs 328 mn, Rs 217 mn, Rs 178 mn and Rs 194 mn during the same period last year.
