This report, on External Trade Statistics used to be published every quarter since 1985. In 1987 and 1988, only one single annual report consolidating the four quarterly data was published and as from 1989, it is being published on a semester basis.

This issue contains quarterly data on exports and imports relating to the year 1990. The figures are provisional and are liable to revision in the next issue.

The basic data for the preparation of this publication are obtained from the Bills of Entry filed in at the Customs & Excise Department and from the Mauritius Sugar Syndicate and the State Trading Corporation which provide supplementary information. The Central Information Systems Division (CISD) of the Ministry of Finance is responsible for the processing of the data. Grateful acknowledgement is expressed here to all these departments for their continued cooperation.

It is hoped that data given in this report proves useful to the public in general and to all those in the field of external trade.

3. COMMODITY CLASSIFICATION

The classification used for the compilation of trade statistics is since January 1988 based on the Standard International Trade Classification (Revised III) or S.I.T.C. (Rev. III). However, import and export bills of entry are being worked upon according to the Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature, shortly known as the Harmonized System Nomenclature (H.S.N.).

4. DATA PROCESSING

As from September 1990 the data on bills of entries are being captured using the Asycuda software installed at the Customs Department. All tabulations are processed by the C.I.S.D. of the Ministry of Finance.

5. ROUNDING OF FIGURES

Figures have been rounded off to the nearest final digit and in some cases to the nearest one decimal place. As a result in some tables there may be discrepancies between the sum of the constituent items and the total.

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External Trade - Year 1990

Introduction

1. Total value of international trade - 1990

The total value of trade for the second semester of 1990 attained Rs 23,000 million, some 18% higher than in the corresponding semester of 1989 and 25% higher than in the previous semester . Total trade for the year 1990 therefore amounted to Rs 42,000 million representing an increase of Rs 6,300 million or 18% over the previous year's level of Rs 35,700 million.

2. Balance of visible trade

During the year 1990, the country exported goods worth of Rs 18,100 million compared to Rs 15,500 million in 1989 representing an increase of around 16%. Total imports for the year likewise rose by Rs 4,000 million or 19% to attain Rs 24,000 million. Consequently the trade balance for the year 1990 resulted in a deficit of around Rs 6,000 million compared with Rs 4,700 for the year 1989. The import figures for both years 1989 and 1990 include the purchase of aircrafts and marine vessels. Exclusive of these irregular items comparative trade deficit figures were Rs 4,200 and Rs 4,800 respectively.

The balance of visible trade is only one of the components of the balance of payments which relates to the net value of transactions involving merchandise only. It should not therefore be used as the sole indicator of how the country's balance of payments is behaving. The current account balance which includes merchandise, services and unrequited transfers is a more appropriate indicator.

3. Terms of trade (Base year 1988 = 100)

The terms of trade which show price movements of exports relative to imports improved by 5 percentage points to 98 from 93 in 1989. The favourable terms of trade recorded last year resulted from relatively higher prices of exports. Export prices rose by 12% whilst those of imports by 7%.

4. Exports

Total exports proceeds for the year 1990 went up by 16% in nominal terms, from Rs 15,500 million in 1989 to Rs 18,000 million. After elimination of the effects of price increases of around 12% total exports grew by only 4% in volume. A lower volume of sugar was exported : 578,000 m/tons compared to 638,000 m/tons in 1989. The total proceeds from the sale of sugar amounted to Rs 5,100 million compared to Rs 4,950 million in 1989.

EPZ exports registered a nominal increase of 27% from Rs 9,060 million to Rs 11,470 million, (15% in price and 10% in volume).

Goods valued at Rs 358 million were re-exported compared to Rs 506 million in 1989. Fuel and other goods supplied to aircraft and ships amounted to Rs 488 million.

The main markets of the country remained the EEC countries which purchased nearly 80% of the total exports, or Rs 14,000 million worth of goods. Another important market was the U.S.A which absorbed almost 13% of the total.

5. Imports

The import bill for the year 1990 was valued at Rs 24,000 million representing a nominal increase of 19% over the 1989 figure of Rs 20,200 million. The total includes around Rs 1,200 million related to the purchase of ships and aircraft by the government and by the national airline. Exclusive of these irregular items, total imports amounted to Rs 22,800 million. As mentioned earlier, import prices went up by 7% in 1990 after having increased by around 19% in 1989. In volume terms, imports exclusive of aircraft and ships, grew by about 8%. The prices of refined petroleum products went up by around 27% and those of other manufactured goods by 10%. These increases were however offset by substantial drops of around 10% recorded in the prices of raw wool and cotton.

Table 9 on imports by country of origin shows that the EEC was the major supplier accounting for 36% of the total imports. Other suppliers were: Republic of South Africa, 9%, Japan, 6%, U.S.A, 5% and China, 3%.

EPZ exports recorded a substantial increase of 27% attaining Rs 11,470 million from Rs 9,060 million in 1989. After elimination of the effect of price increases estimated at around 15%, EPZ exports grew by 10% in volume. Textile and made up garments worth of Rs 9,100 million were exported which accounted for nearly 80% of the total.

The EPZ sectors import bill was much lower than expected. The earlier estimate of Rs 8,000 million is now revised to Rs 7,400 million which compares with Rs 7,500 million for the year 1989. Imports of machinery and equipment represented Rs 800 million compared to Rs 960 million in 1989. The relatively lower import bill resulted mainly from substantial drops of around 10% in the prices of basic inputs of the textile industries namely raw wool and cotton.

Consequently net EPZ exports shot up to Rs 4,100 million from Rs 1,555 million in 1989 and Rs 2,300 million in 1988. The rates of net exports to exports doubled last year's 17% and reached 36%. This ratio calculated as an average of the two consecutive years works out to 28% maintaining the same level of 1988.

1985-1990**



IMPORT & EXPORT PRICES, 1985-1990


