Foreword

This report, on External Trade Statistics used to be published every quarter since 1985. In 1987 and 1988, only one single annual report consolidating the four quarterly data was published and as from 1989, it is being published on a semester basis.

This issue contains quarterly data on exports and imports relating to the year 1992. The figures are provisional and are liable to revision in the next issue.

The basic data for the preparation of this publication are obtained from the Bills of Entry filed in at the Customs & Excise Department and from the Mauritius Sugar Syndicate and the State Trading Corporation which provide supplementary information. The Central Information Systems Division (CISD) of the Ministry of Finance is responsible for the processing of the data. Grateful acknowledgement is expressed here to all these departments for their continued cooperation.

It is hoped that data given in this report proves useful to the public in general and to all those in the field of external trade.

3. COMMODITY CLASSIFICATION

The classification used for the compilation of trade statistics is since January 1988 based on the Standard International Trade Classification (Revised III) or S.I.T.C. (Rev. III). However, import and export bills of entry are being worked upon according to the Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature, shortly known as the Harmonized System Nomenclature (H.S.N.).

4. DATA PROCESSING

As from September 1990 the data on bills on entries are being captured using the Asycuda software installed at the Customs Department. All tabulations are processed by the C.I.S.D. of the Ministry of Finance.

5. ROUNDING OF FIGURES

Figures have been rounded off to the nearest final digit and in some cases to the nearest one decimal place and as a result in some tables there may be discrepancies between the sum of the constituent items and the total.

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EXTERNAL TRADE — YEAR 1992

INTRODUCTION

1. Total value of trade and balance of visible trade

The total value of international trade during the fourth quarter of 1992 was Rs 12,953 million, that is about 3 percent higher than in the corresponding quarter of 1991 and 8% above that of the third quarter.

With exports worth Rs 5,955 million and imports Rs 6,980 million, the fourth quarter yielded a negative trade balance of Rs 1,025 million. This deficit figure compares favourably with the Rs 1,400 million registered in the corresponding quarter of 1991.

Total exports for the year 1992 attained Rs 20,600 million registering an increase of Rs 1,300 million or 6.5 percent, over the previous year. The import bill was some 4 percent higher and amounted to Rs 25,300 million.

Consequently, the trade balance for year 1992 recorded a deficit of the order of Rs 4,750 million, which is an improvement of 7 percent over 1991 when the deficit was Rs 5,100 million and 18 percent lower than the Rs 5,800 million deficit of 1990.

Trade balance figures for 1991 and 1992 have been revised downward following adjustments of Rs 300 million and Rs 400 million respectively made to imports of aircraft parts returned to the Country after repairs. These figures were not included in the relevant export figures. The revised figures are as follows:

2. Terms of trade (Base year 1988 = 100)

The terms of trade which show price movements of exports relative to imports improved by 5 percentage points in 1992 and reached 105 from 100 in 1991.

The favourable terms of trade resulted from relatively higher prices fetched for our exports. Export prices as shown by the unit value indices were up by about 6.5 percent whilst import prices are estimated to have gone up by only 1.5 percent. The effect of increases in the price of imported food products and manufactured goods were offset by drops in prices of petroleum and chemical products.

3. Exports

Total export proceeds for the year 1992 increased by about 6.5 percent to Rs 20,600 million from Rs 19,300 million in 1991. However, as prices also increased by around 6.5 percent, exports recorded no real growth.

EPZ exports increased by about 8 percent to Rs 13,100 million and accounted for 67 percent of domestic exports. As most of the value increases are explained by price rises estimated at about 7 percent, in quantity terms, EPZ products grew marginally by only 1 percent.

Sugar exports fetched Rs 5,700 million from the sale of 598,000 metric tons against Rs 5,300 million for 551,000 metric tons in 1991.

Slight decreases are noted in re-exports and ships' stores and bunkers: Some Rs 559 million worth of goods were re exported against Rs 615 million a year ago. Ships stores and bunkers i.e fuel and goods supplied to ships and aircraft dropped to Rs 500 million from Rs 600 million in 1991 .

3.1 Main markets

The Country's main buyer remained the European Economic Community (EEC) which purchased nearly 80 percent of our exports. The United States absorbed another 12 percent of the total.

4. Imports

The import bill for the year 1992 was valued at Rs 25,310 million nearly Rs 1,000 million or about 4 percent above the 1991 figure of Rs 24,380 million. As import prices are estimated to have risen by around 1.5 percent, in volume terms, imports grew by 2 percent.

Table 6 shows that trade was mainly concentrated in the manufactured products which accounted for 45 percent of total imports, followed by machinery and equipment 23 percent, food, 12 percent, whilst fuel and chemicals contributed 8 percent each.

In the period under review, the bill in respect of manufactured goods recorded an increase of Rs 602 million (+13 percent). Food, beverages and tobacco went up by Rs 271 million (+10 percent) and chemicals by Rs 163 million (+9 percent). On the other hand, machinery and equipment in the non-EPZ Sector registered a decrease of Rs 313 million (-6 percent) whilst petroleum products fell by some Rs 123 million (-6 percent).

4.1 Main suppliers

Data on imports by country of origin shows that the major source of our imports was the EEC (32 percent) with France accounting for 41 percent of EEC imports and 13 percent of total imports. The other suppliers were mainly: Republic of South Africa, 13 percent, Japan, 9 percent, India, 5 percent and Hong Kong, 4 percent.

5. The EPZ Sector

EPZ exports in 1992 rose in nominal terms by nearly 8 percent to reach Rs 13,100 million from Rs 12,100 million in 1991. After eliminating the effect of price increases which are estimated at around 7 percent, quantity-wise, EPZ exports registered a slight growth of only 1 percent.

As in the previous years, EPZ exports were concentrated in textile and clothing which accounted for 80 percent of the total.

The EPZ sector's import bill stayed at the previous year's level of around Rs 7,150 million. Purchase of machinery and equipment dropped by some 6 percent to Rs 680 million from Rs 720 million whilst that of raw materials was only 2 percent higher reaching Rs 6,500 million from Rs 6,350 million.

Consequently, net EPZ exports (Rs 5,950 million) yielded an increase of 17 percent over last year's figure of Rs 5,100 million and the ratio of net exports to exports rose to 45 percent from 42 percent in 1991 and 36 percent in 1990.

1987-1992




Fig 2-IMPORT & EXPORT PRICES,
ANNUAL CHANGE,1987-1992


