AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION

(January - June 1991)

1. Introduction

This issue presents data on agricultural production during the first semester of the year 1991.

2. Sugar cane

During the first semester of 1991, only 1700 hectares yielding around 113,000 tonnes of sugar cane were harvested against 3,420 hectares with a production of about 236,000 tonnes in the corresponding period of 1990.

The significant decrease registered in cane production is mainly explained by the fact that only 7 factories, particularly those in the southern regions, had started operating as at June 1991. As a result of the adverse effect of the drought that prevailed during the vegetative stage, it is estimated that the 1991 crop will attain around 590,000 tonnes against 624,302 tonnes last year.

3. *Tea*

The area harvested increased by some 100 hectares to reach 3,000. Tea production of green leaves grew by around 5% compared to the previous semester of 1990 and reached nearly 18,300 tonnes.

4. Tobacco

The first half of 1991 recorded a substantial increase of about 55% in terms of area harvested which increased to nearly 180 hectares from 120 a year ago. Consequently, the production of tobacco raised to nearly 230 tonnes from 150 tonnes in the same period last year.

5. Foodcrops

Production of foodcrops during the first six months of the year dropped by nearly 13%, to almost 21,600 tonnes compared to 24,900 tonnes in the corresponding period of 1990. It is recalled that the drought conditions that prevailed from September 1990 to February 1991 had adversely affected the foodcrop production and also led to the late plantation of some main crops viz. potatoes and onions. Furthermore, some crops, for example cauliflower, were also affected by disease.

The comparative table given below shows main changes in the production of some foodcrops between January-June 1990 and January-June 1991.

6. Livestock

Cattle meat production from abattoir slaughters increased by 8% to reach 1,050 tonnes in the first semester of 1991. Meat production from local and imported cattle stood at about 210 tonnes and 760 tonnes in the first six month of 1990. Corresponding figures for 1991 were 155 tonnes and 900 tonnes respectively, which shows a decrease of nearly 25% in meat produced from local sources offset by an increase of around 18% in that from imported live cattle.

Production of goat and sheep meat went up by 30% to attain 100 tonnes as compared to around 75 tonnes in the first semester of 1990. It is worth noting that meat production from the slaughter of imported live goats which represents around 75% of total goat meat production doubled in 1991.

As regards production of pig meat, an increase of nearly to 7% was observed. During the first six months of this year, the production was 425 tonnes against about 395 tonnes last year.

7. Fisheries

Fish production during the first half of 1991 registered a substantial increase of around 32% over the corresponding period of 1990 and attained almost 7,975 tonnes. Fresh fish (coastal) grew by about 17% and frozen fish from banks and tuna, by around 36%, following the coming into operation of an additional vessel.
