

## **The Export Processing Zone (EPZ)**

### **4th Quarter and Year 1994**

#### **Introduction**

The Quarterly Survey of Employment carried out among the EPZ enterprises provides up to date data on the evolution of the workforce in the Export Processing Zone. This issue of the "Economic Indicators" presents the results of the survey carried out at the end of December 1994. Provisional figures on EPZ exports and imports for 1994 are also given.

#### **2. Number of enterprises, December 1994**

The number of enterprises at the end of December 1994 stood at 494, 42 fewer than at the end of December 1993. "Wearing apparel" remains the group with the highest number of enterprises (257) in spite of a net loss of 37 during 1994. No significant change occurred in the number of enterprises in the other groups except for "Electric and electronic products" down to 8 from 11 and "Leather products and footwear" now operating with 8 enterprises following 2 closures in 1994.

#### **3. Employment evolution, 4th quarter 1994**

During the 4th quarter, employment in the EPZ dropped by some 1,200: 2,150 jobs were created compared to losses of nearly 3,350 jobs. Twelve enterprises closed down and 4 new enterprises came into operation bringing the number of EPZ enterprises at the end of 1994 to 494 with a total workforce of 82,200 of whom 23,800 males and 58,400 females.

The number of foreign workers employed by the EPZ enterprises stood at 5,492, an increase of 155 in the 4th quarter compared to increases of 398, 583 and 261 in the 1st, 2nd and 3rd quarter respectively.

#### **4. Employment evolution, Year 1994**

After reaching a peak of nearly 91,000 in December 1991, employment in the EPZ sector has since followed a downward trend. In fact, employment dropped further by 3,450 in 1994 after decreases of 3,900 and 1,300 in 1992 and 1993 respectively.

During 1994 a total loss of some 12,100 jobs were reported: 6,802 due to closures of 69 enterprises and 5,327 through contraction in the workforce of 45 existing enterprises. On the other hand, 8,684 jobs were created: 1,222 by the setting up of 27 new enterprises and 7,462 by increases in the workforce of 52 enterprises. The net effect was a loss of 3,450 workers.

An analysis of employment by product group shows that during 1994 "Wearing apparel" suffered a net loss of nearly 4,000 jobs of which 3,550 in the "Pullovers" sub-group. No significant change occurred in the other groups except slight increases in "Food" (291), "Textile yarn and fabrics" (168) and "Leather products" (103).

#### **5. Exports and Imports**

EPZ exports amounted to Rs 16,545 million in 1994, a nominal increase of only 4.6% over the previous year. It will be recalled that, in 1993, exports totalled Rs 15,821 million, an increase of over 20% mainly attributable to a near doubling of exports towards USA.

Imports, on the other hand, reached Rs 10,143 million. Raw materials amounted to Rs 9,024 million, 10% higher than in 1993 whilst imports of machinery and equipment remained at the previous year's level of around Rs 1,100 million.

Net exports, that is, exports minus imports, yielded Rs 6,411 million and its ratio to exports dropped to 39% from 41% in 1993. This decrease is the result of the higher growth of imports over exports, probably due to replenishment of stock of raw materials.


#### **6. Value added and productivity**

On the basis of figures now available, value added generated by EPZ enterprises is estimated at Rs 6,154 million at current prices. In real terms, this represents a growth of around 4% which combined with a decrease in employment results in a favourable increase in productivity of nearly 7% in 1994.
