EDUCATION STATISTICS - 1994

INTRODUCTION

This issue of Education Statistics consists of data obtained from the Annual Survey of schools carried out in March 1994, as well as data from other sources for the Republic of Mauritius. The aim of the annual survey is to collect information relating to school infrastructure, students, personnel and examination results from all primary and secondary schools.

1. PRIMARY EDUCATION

1.1 Schools

The number of primary schools (excluding 2 schools not offering a complete stream) has been reduced to 279, due to the closing down of 4 government primary schools and the opening of 1 government and 1 private school.

Of the 279 schools (267 in the Island of Mauritius and 12 in Rodrigues), 220 were administered by government, 51 by the Roman Catholic Education Authority (RCEA), 2 by the Hindu Education Authority and the remaining 6 were private unaided schools (refer table 1). The school population size varied from 65 to 1,350.

1.2 Enrolment

Enrolment in 1994 totalled 123,167 (62,436 boys and 60,731 girls). Government schools enrolled 76% of pupils while the remaining 24% attended aided and private schools. There has been a 2% decline in total enrolment between 1993 and 1994.

The number of pupils in each standard ranged from 18,313 to 20,168 in 1994 except in standard VI where the number reached 27,789 mainly because of repeaters attempting to obtain better results and thus increasing their chance for access to colleges of their choice (table 5). However, there was a decline in the number of repeaters from 10,410 in 1992 to 9,569 in 1993 and 8,087 in 1994.

Seven Asian Languages are taught in primary schools. The total number of pupils studying any one of these languages was 78,532 or 67% of total enrolment in the Island of Mauritius in 1994.

1.3 Personnel

The number of persons employed in primary schools totalled 8,150, of whom 67% were teaching staff (including Asian Language teachers). With the recent nomination the number of headteachers and deputy headteachers has increased from 438 to 967. The others are non-teaching staff. The pupil teacher ratio was 32 in 1994 against 29 in 1993.

1.4 Certificate of Primary Education (CPE)

In November 1994, the number of pupils examined at CPE level in the Republic of Mauritius was 29,535 (15,094 boys and 14,441 girls). Of these 18,074 (8,663 boys and 9,411 girls) obtained their CPE representing a pass rate of 61.2% compared to 58.6% in 1993 (refer table 7).

2. SECONDARY EDUCATION

2.1 Schools

There were 123 secondary schools (120 schools in the Island of Mauritius and 3 in Rodrigues) in 1994. Of these schools, 23 were state and the rest were confessional and private schools. However, with the setting up of the Mauritius Education Development Company (MEDCO), 5 of the existing private schools were taken over by MEDCO. The school size ranged from 100 to 2000.

2.2 Enrolment

Pupils enrolled in the secondary schools numbered 89,581, of whom 43,753 were boys and 45,828 girls. Comparing the figures with those of 1993 (table 11), there has been an increase of 2% in the secondary school population in 1994 compared to 1993. The State Secondary schools had 21% of the total enrolment, the remaining students were enrolled in private schools. The percentage distribution by sex is the same as in 1992 and 1993, that is 49% for boys and 51% for girls.

2.3 Personnel

Employment in secondary schools totalled 6,316. This comprised 4,234 teaching staff, and 2,082 administrative and other staff. The state schools employed 25% of all secondary school teachers. The pupil/teacher ratio is estimated as 21, the same as in 1993.

2.4 School Certificate and Higher School Certificate

In November 1994, out of a total of 11,480 students (5,561 boys and 5,919 girls) who took part in the School Certificate Examination, 7,563 (3,551 boys and 4,012 girls) were successful. The overall pass rate of 65.9% reflects a slight increase as compared to 63.9% for the preceding year.

At the Higher School Certificate Examination held in November 1994, of a total of 5,009 students (2,482 boys and 2,527 girls) examined, 63.3% (boys 62.3% and girls 64.3%) passed the examination. The comparative figures for 1993 and 1994 in table 14 show that there has not been any improvement in the overall results.

3. TERTIARY EDUCATION

3.1 University of Mauritius

3.1.1 Enrolment

The five faculties of the University of Mauritius offer a variety of courses ranging from certificate level to higher degree. Some external award courses are also offered. The comparative table (table 15) for the academic years 93/94 and 94/95 reflects an overall increase in enrolment at all levels and for all faculties. This is in keeping with the desire to gradually phase out the certificate courses and develop the University primarily into a degree awarding Institution.

Out of a total enrolment of 2,186 students in 1994/95, 1,391 are engaged in full-time academic pursuits and 795 are on a part time basis. This reflects a slight improvement of the figures for 93/94 when only 1,302 were on a full time basis. The number of part-timers has gone down from 859 for 93/94 to 795 for 94/95.

3.1.2 Output

For the academic year 93/94, the total output has been 675, consisting of 416 boys and 259 girls. When compared to the overall figure of 92/93, there has been a slight increase of 32. The figure for degree holders was 195 for 93/94 as against 141 for 92/93. At the higher degree level there has been a sharp decline from 23 to 3.

3.2 Mauritius Institute of Education (MIE)

3.2.1 Enrolment 1994

The MIE offers series of different courses ranging from the Post Graduate Certificate in Education to a Certificate in Educational Administration. The clientele consists basically of those engaged (or to be engaged) in teaching or educational administration.

The total enrolment of 2,564 in 93/94 consists of 1,451 males and 1,113 females. The majority (2,217) were following courses on a part-time basis while 347 trainee primary teachers were on a full-time basis.

3.3 Mahatma Gandhi Institute (MGI)

3.3.1 Enrolment

The Mahatma Gandhi Institute offers courses in 3 broad areas, viz the Performing Arts, Fine Arts and Indian languages. These are classified under Certificate, Diploma and Joint Honours degree.

For 93/94 there was a total enrolment of 628 for the Performing Arts and 22 for the Fine Arts. As for the Indian Languages, there was a total enrolment of 245, including 22 who followed full-time Joint Honours Degree.

The enrolment figure was highest for the Part-time Certificate in Indian Music and Dance (570) followed by the 3 year part-time Diploma in Indian Languages (132).

3.3.2 Output

The number of students who were examined at all levels totalled 543. Of these 416 were successful, thus representing a pass rate of 76.6%.

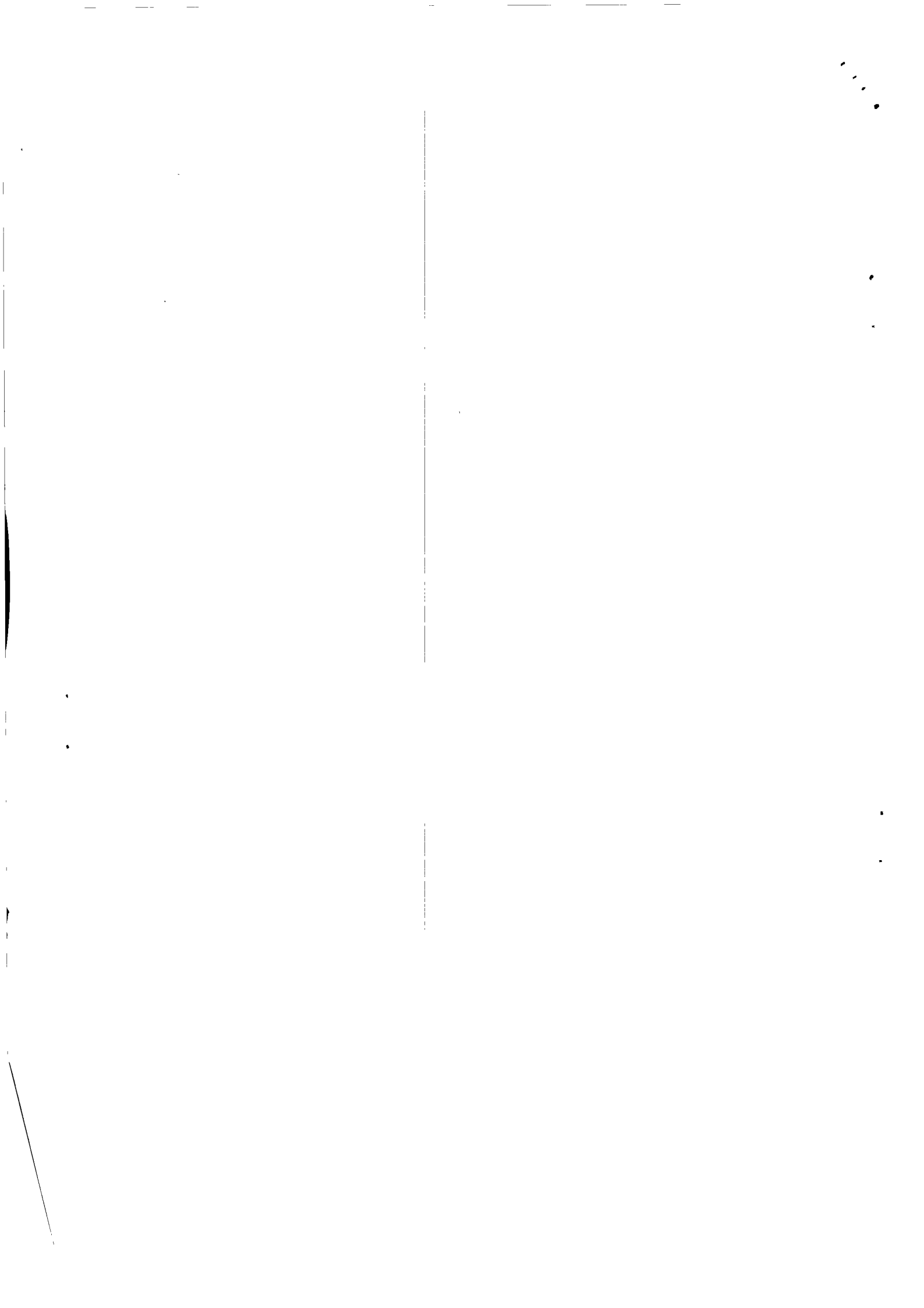
