

The Export Processing Zone and Pioneer Status Enterprises,

3rd Quarter 1997

Introduction

The **Quarterly Survey of Employment** is a regular survey carried out among the EPZ and Pioneer Status enterprises and provides, among other details, up to date data on the evolution of the workforce in the different industry sub-groups. This issue of the "Economic Indicators" presents the results of the survey carried out at the end of September 1997. Figures are given separately for the Export Processing Zone and Pioneer Status Enterprises. The report also includes provisional figures of EPZ imports and exports for the 3rd quarter 1997 as well as revised figures for previous years.

I. The Export Processing Zone (EPZ)

(i) Number of enterprises

The number of EPZ enterprises at the end of the 3rd quarter of 1997 stood at 480 compared to 478 at the end of the previous quarter and 477 a year ago.

During the 3rd quarter, 4 enterprises closed down and 6 new ones started operation resulting in a net gain of 2. In "Wearing apparel", the most important group in the EPZ, 3 new enterprises came into operation and 1 closure was reported bringing the number of enterprises to 233 compared to 231 at the end of the previous quarter. The distribution of enterprises by product group is given in Table 1.5.

(ii) Employment evolution, 3rd quarter 1997

At the end of September 1997, employment in the EPZ stood at 82,083 showing an increase of 168 over the previous quarter. The number of female employees fell by 238 from 56,475 to 56,237 whilst male employment went up by 406 to 25,846.

As shown in Table 1.4, during the 3rd quarter of 1997, a total of 2,191 jobs were created mainly through expansion in 19 existing enterprises. The number of jobs created by the 6 new enterprises was only 176. On the other hand, 2,023 jobs were lost: 1,788 through reduction in 17 existing enterprises and 235 following the 4 closures.

Foreign workers, who numbered 7,700 at the beginning of the quarter, rose by 620 to reach 8,320 at the end of September 1997. Among males, employment went up by 280 and among females, there was an increase of 340.

"Wearing apparel", the product group with the highest employment witnessed an increase of 181 bringing the number of employees to 67,881. Within the group, "Other garments" increased by 311 whilst employment in "Pullovers" fell by 130. Details of net change in employment by product group are shown in Table 1.6.

(iii) Employment evolution, 3rd quarter 1996 - 3rd quarter 1997

Comparison of September 1996 and September 1997 figures shows a net gain of 3 in the number of enterprises and 2,636 in the EPZ workforce.

Employment in "Wearing apparel", rose by 2,425 despite a fall in the number of enterprises from 237 to 233. Within the group "Pullovers" witnessed a decrease of 252 whilst the "Other garments" sub-group increased significantly by 2,677. Moderate increases were also registered in the following groups: "Jewellery and related articles" (+255) and "Textile yarn and fabrics" (+179). On the other hand, there was a decrease of 185 in "Electronic watches and clocks". Details of changes in employment by product group are given in Table 1.6.

(iv) Exports and Imports, 1st quarter 1997 - 3rd quarter 1997

EPZ exports, for the 3rd quarter of 1997, reached R 6,016 million compared to R 5,678 million for the corresponding quarter of 1996, i.e. a nominal increase of 6.0%. This is lower than the 11% and 9.7% registered for the 1st and 2nd quarter respectively. The total for the first 3 quarters of 1997 amounted to R 16,662 million, 8.7% higher than exports for the same period in 1996.

Exports of manufactured articles of apparel and clothing which represents slightly above 75% of EPZ exports went up by 11.8% to R 13,109 million. On the other hand, "Textiles yarn & fabrics and made up articles" for the period January to September fell from R 1,090 million in 1996 to R 979 million in 1997.

Imports from January to September 1997 totalled R 10,064 million compared to R 9,155 million (+9.9%) for the same period in 1996. The bill for raw materials was 10.4% higher (R 9,149 million) whilst imports of machinery and equipment increased by R 49 million to R 915 million.

Net exports, i.e. exports minus imports, yielded R 6,598 million and its ratio to exports works out to 40% (Table 1.8).

On the basis of available figures for the 3 quarters of 1997 and taking into consideration past trends, total exports for the year 1997 is estimated at R 23,000 million.

II. The Pioneer Status Enterprises (PSE)

(i) Number of enterprises

During the 3rd quarter of 1997, 7 new enterprises started operation whilst one enterprise closed down bringing the total number of PSE enterprises to 153. Among these enterprises 53 were "large", that is, as having 10 or more employees. The activities in which the enterprises are engaged are given in Table 2.2. It will be noted that the number of enterprises in "Electric and Electronic products" and in "Informatics" totalled 60.

(ii) Employment

The total workforce in the PSE sector at the end of September 1997 was 2,199 (1,313 males and 886 females), an increase of 97 over the previous quarter (Table 2.1). The "large" enterprises employed 1,759 compared to 1,705 at the end of June 1997.

During the 3rd quarter 1997, a total of 161 jobs were created: 49 by the 7 new enterprises and 112 following expansion in 35 existing enterprises. On the other hand, job losses numbered 64 of which 63 following reduction in 22 enterprises (Table 2.3).

The number of expatriates employed as at the end of the 3rd quarter 1997 stood at 66 (54 males and 12 females).
