

The Export Processing Zone and Pioneer Status Enterprises,

3rd Quarter 2000

Introduction

This issue of the "Economic and Social Indicators" presents the findings of the Quarterly Survey of Employment carried out at the end of September 2000. Figures are given separately for the Export Processing Zone and Pioneer Status Enterprises. The latter are "small and medium" enterprises engaged, mainly in activities involving the application of high technology.

Provisional figures on EPZ imports and exports for the 3rd quarter 2000 as well as revised figures for the previous years are also given.

2. The Export Processing Zone (EPZ)

2.1 Number of enterprises

The number of EPZ enterprises at the end of the 3rd quarter of 2000 stood at 523 compared to 519 at the end of the 2nd quarter and 508 in March 2000.

During the 3rd quarter, 9 enterprises closed down and 13 new enterprises started operation, resulting in a net gain of 4 enterprises. In "Wearing apparel", the most important group in the EPZ, 5 closures were reported whilst 4 new units came into operation, bringing the number of enterprises to 249 compared to 250 at the end of the previous quarter.

The distribution of enterprises by product group is given in Table 1.2.

2.2 Employment evolution, 3rd quarter 2000

At the end of September 2000, employment in the EPZ stood at 89,869, a decline of 896 compared to the previous quarter. The number of female employees dropped by 364 from 61,068 to 60,704 whilst male employment fell by 532 from 29,697 to 29,165. The ratio of male to female employment in the EPZ workforce remains at approximately 1 to 2.

During the 3rd quarter of 2000, a total of 2,571 jobs were created, of which 2,342 through expansion in 22 existing enterprises. The number of jobs created by the 13 new enterprises was 229. On the other hand, 3,467 jobs were lost: 2,411 through reduction in 25 existing enterprises and 1,056 following the closure of 9 enterprises (Table 1.5).

Employment in the "Wearing apparel" product group fell by 1,098 during the quarter, bringing the number of employees to 74,921. Within the group, employment in "Pullovers" increased by 414 while a drop 1,512 was registered in "Other garments". Details of other changes by product group are shown in Table 1.7.

Foreign workers, who numbered 14,158 at the beginning of the quarter, rose by 518 to reach 14,676 at the end of September 2000. Among females, employment rose by 479 and among males, there was an increase of 39. Table 1.8 shows expatriate employment by product group and sex. It will be noted that the majority of foreign workers in the EPZ are employed in the "Wearing apparel" sector.

2.3 Employment evolution, September 1999 - September 2000

Comparison of September 1999 and September 2000 figures shows a net gain of 15 in the number of enterprises and a decrease of 583 in the EPZ workforce.

In the group "Wearing apparel", employment fell by 1,259 from 76,180 to 74,921. Within this group, declines of 660 in "Pullovers" and 599 in "Other garments" were registered. On the other hand, employment increased in the group "Textile yarn and fabrics" by 235 and in "Jewellery and related articles" by 162. Details of changes in employment by product group are given in Table 1.7.

2.4 Imports and exports, January to September 2000

EPZ exports for the 3rd quarter of 2000 amounted to Rs. 7,704 million, bringing the total for the first nine months to Rs. 22,375 million, which represents a nominal increase of 6.4% compared to the corresponding period of 1999.

Imports for the first nine months of 2000 totalled Rs. 12,388, i.e. an increase of 3.8% compared to Rs. 11,931 million for the same period of 1999. The bill of raw materials increased by 6.6% whilst imports on machinery and equipment dropped by 16% to reach Rs. 1,268 million.

Net exports, i.e., exports minus imports, amounted to Rs. 9,987 million, which is 45% of total exports (Table 1.9).

Exports of manufactured articles of apparel and clothing went up by Rs. 1,216 million to Rs. 17,690 million, representing nearly 80% of EPZ exports (Table 1.10).

The United Kingdom, France and the United States of America remained our principal EPZ markets with 71% of our total exports. An analysis by country of destination (Table 1.12) shows increases to these markets: United Kingdom by 5% (from Rs. 4,693 million to Rs. 4,926 million), France by 11% (from Rs. 4,691 million to Rs. 5,203 million) and the United States of America by 13% (from Rs. 4,991 million to Rs. 5,657 million).

3. The Pioneer Status Enterprises (PSE)

3.1 Number of enterprises

During the 3rd quarter 2000, 12 new enterprises started operation while 2 enterprises closed down, bringing the total number of PSE enterprises to 232. Among these enterprises 77 were operating with 10 or more workers. Further details of these enterprises are given in Table 2.1. The highest number of enterprises was in "Other support services" (45) followed by "Informatics" (42).

3.2 Employment

The total workforce in the PSE sector at the end of September 2000 was 2,723 (2,036 males and 687 females), 167 greater than the previous quarter (Table 2.2).

During the 3rd quarter 2000, 254 jobs were created: 116 by the 12 new enterprises and 138 following expansion in 37 existing enterprises. On the other hand, 87 jobs were lost due to reduction of 80 in existing enterprises and 7 following closures of 2 enterprises (Table 2.4).

The number of expatriates employed as at the end of the 3rd quarter 2000 stood at 127 (119 males and 8 females).
