## Business Activity Statistics, July 2000 - June 2001

## Introduction

Business Activity Statistics are compiled mainly from the administrative records of the local authorities and government departments responsible for the delivery of licences and registration certificates. Thus only licensed and registered activities are covered. Currently all agricultural related activities are also not covered.

An operator is required to obtain a licence from the Municipal or District Councils for each type of activity or to register with the appropriate Ministry or Organisation. In some cases an operator may hold both a licence and a registration certificate and to avoid double counting, such activities have been accounted for in registrations only.

It must also be pointed out that the statistics on business activity refer to the total number of licensed or registered activities and not to the total number of operation units or establishments. For example, a general retailer may hold three licences: one for trading in foodstuffs, a second for selling tobacco and a third for selling liquor.

Tables 1 to 5.1 present data by main industrial activity while detailed data are given in tables 5.2 to 5.7. Time series data for the period 1997-2001 are given in tables 6 and 7 .
2. Licences issued and cessations between July 2000 and June 2001

During the period July 2000 to June 2001, 4,934 new licences were issued, of which 3,395 (68.8\%) were for activities classified under 'Wholesale \& Retail trade; Repair of motor vehicles, motorcycles and personal and households goods'. During the same period 1,345 licences were cancelled, the net increase in licences works out to 3,589 . The total number of licences as at June 2001 therefore stood at 63,950 which, compared to 60,361 as at June 2000, represents an increase of 3,589 (5.9\%) (Table1).

## 3. Licences and registrations as at June 2001

The number of licensed and registered business activities as at June 2001 totalled 78,197 which, compared to 74,598 at the end of June 2000, shows a net addition of 3,581 (4.8\%). The highest number of such activities was in 'Wholesale and Retail trade; Repair of motor vehicles, motorcycles and personal and households goods' with 43,492 activities (55.6\%), followed by 'Transport, Storage \& Communications', 13,789 (17.6\%).

The highest increases over the previous year are noted in the 'Other Community, social \& personal services' with 361 new activities (15.8\%) and in the Construction sector with 66 new activities ( $12.5 \%$ ).

## 4. Distribution by urban and rural region

The distribution of licences and registration by main activity and region (per Municipal and District Councils boundaries) is given in Table 5.1. Of the 78,179 licensed and registered activities, there were 39,422 (50.4\%) in the rural areas and $38,757(49.6 \%)$ in the urban ones.

Analysis of the data at industry group level shows the predominance of 'Mining and Quarrying' and 'Hotels \& Restaurants' activities in the rural areas because such activities are mainly carried out in the coastal regions. Transport and some other social \& personal services associated with tourist activities followed the same pattern.

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## Technical Notes

## 1. Classification and presentation of data

To cater for the wide range and diverse business activities and for classification purposes, each activity has been assigned an activity code according to the National Standard Industrial classification of Economic Activities (NSIC), which is an adapted version of the International Standard Industrial Classification (ISIC), Rev. 3, 1990.

The NSIC consists of 5 levels of classification namely:
Level $1 \quad$ Section: $\quad 17$ sections identified by one of the letters A to Q
Level 2 Division: 56 divisions identified by the first 2 digits
Level $3 \quad$ Group: 151 groups identified by the first 3 digits
Level $4 \quad$ Classes: $\quad 302$ classes identified by the first 4 digits
Level 5 Sub-classes: 546 sub-classes identified by the first digits
