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External Trade – 2nd Quarter 2005

Introduction

This issue of the Economic and Social Indicators presents external trade statistics for the second quarter of 2005 and for the years 2003 and 2004. These statistics are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are at times revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Customs Department.

Thus while figures for 2003 published in this indicator are final, those for 2004 and 2005 are subject to revision as and when the Customs Department submits latest amendments to the Central Statistics Office.

Data on international trade are compiled as per the recommendations of the United Nations General Trade System. According to this system, all goods entering and leaving the national frontier, including trading activities of the Freeport zone should be accounted for. However, it was not possible prior to 2002 to include Freeport transactions in our general trade statistics because of different processing systems at the Customs Department and at the Mauritius Freeport Authority. Since mid-October 2001, transactions of the Freeport are being lodged through the Customs Management System (CMS), thus making it possible to integrate data of the Freeport zone with those of Customs.

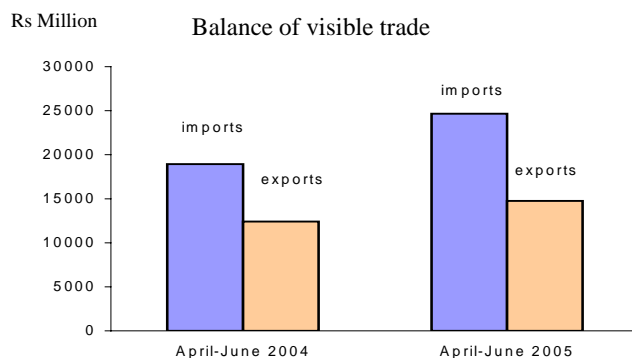
Hence, as from 2002, data on imports and exports include transactions through the Mauritius Freeport. It is to be noted that all exports of the Freeport are included in re-exports of Mauritius because it is not possible to distinguish between domestic exports and re-exports of freeport licensees. It is estimated that currently some 18% of freeport exports are sourced locally.

As from the first quarter of 2005, the terms of trade are based on the Exports and Imports Price Indices instead of unit value indices. Thus, as mentioned in previous issues, the Economic and Social Indicator on trade statistics no longer contain data on terms of trade. Such data now appear in the Economic and Social Indicator on Import and Export Price Indices which also provides an analysis of imports and exports in volume terms.

1. Total value of trade and trade balance

Total international trade for the second quarter of 2005 was valued at Rs 39,387 million, a figure which is 25.2% more than that of the previous quarter and 25.7% higher than that of the corresponding quarter of 2004.

During the second quarter of 2005, total exports reached Rs 14,745 million and total imports amounted to Rs 24,642 million, thus resulting in a trade deficit of Rs 9,897 million.



Based on trends for previous years and the first six months of 2005, total exports for the year are expected to be of the order of Rs 56,800 million, against Rs 86,200 million for imports which would include aircraft worth Rs 120 million. The trade deficit would be around Rs 29,400 million.

2. Exports

2.1 Total exports

Total export proceeds for the second quarter of 2005, including domestic exports, re-exports and ship's stores and bunkers, amounted to Rs 14,745 million, up by 13.2% over the previous quarter and by 18.8% over the corresponding quarter of 2004.

Domestic exports, which represented 62% of total exports, went down by 2.6% from the previous quarter to reach Rs 9,190 million. Compared to the second quarter of 2004, domestic exports dropped by 4.6%.

Total exports for the first semester attained Rs 27,775 million, that is a 12.8% increase over the first semester of 2004. However, during this period domestic exports fell by 4.0% while re-exports went up by 77% as a result of a significant increase in transactions of the Freeport.

2.2 Exports by SITC sections

Exports of "Food and live animals" for the first semester of 2005 went up by 29.3% to reach Rs 6,176 million. Exports of sugar, representing 12% of total exports, registered an increase of 22.2% over the corresponding period of last year to reach Rs 3,215 million.

During the first semester of 2005, export receipts from "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" stood at Rs 2,350 million, showing an increase of 5.9% over the first six months of 2004.

Export proceeds from “Miscellaneous manufactured articles”, representing 50% of total exports for the first semester of 2005 reached Rs 13,001 million. This figure represented a fall of 13.0% when compared to the corresponding period of 2004. In this section, exports of “Articles of apparel & clothing accessories” were valued at Rs 11,104 million, that is 16.2% less than the corresponding period of last year.

2.3 Exports of EPZ

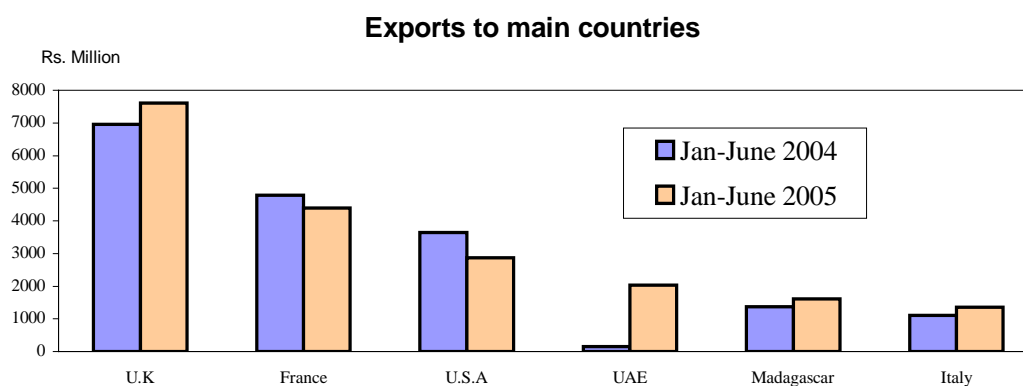
During the second quarter of 2005, exports of EPZ products increased by 17.6% to reach Rs 7,701 million. However, compared to the second quarter of 2004, these exports showed a decrease of 9.0%.

For the first six months of the year, exports of EPZ reached Rs 14,247 million, a figure which is 10.3% lower than the corresponding period of 2004. Details on exports of EPZ are presented in the Economic and Social Indicator on the Export Processing Zone.

2.4 Exports by Country of destination

Analysis by country of destination for the first six months of 2005 shows that our main buyers, i.e the European countries, purchased some 64% of our exports amounting to Rs 16,709 million. The United Kingdom remained the main buyer with Rs 7,609 million, or 29% of total exports, followed by France with Rs 4,397 million (17%). The other major markets were U.S.A (11%), UAE (8%), Malagasy Republic (6%) and Italy (5%).

Compared to the first semester of 2004, total exports to UK went up by 9% while those to U.S.A and France fell by 21% and 8% respectively. During this period total exports to the UAE increased significantly from Rs 157 million to Rs 2,036 million on account of an increase in re-exports of cellular phones by Freeport operators. Table 6 shows further details.



3 Imports

3.1 Total imports

Total imports for the second quarter of 2005 reached Rs 24,642 million, showing increases of 33.7% over the previous quarter and 30.2% over the corresponding quarter of 2004.

Total imports for the first semester of 2005 amounted to Rs 43,068 million, showing an increase of 22.8% over the corresponding period of 2004.

3.2 Imports by SITC sections

Imports of “*Food and live animals*” for the first semester of 2005 increased by 17.2% compared to the corresponding semester of 2004 to reach Rs 6,478 million.

Import bill of “*Mineral fuels, lubricants, & related products*” stood at Rs 6,702 million, which was 50.1% higher than the corresponding period of last year.

During the first semester of 2005, imports of “*Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material*” declined by 2.7% to attain Rs 9,148 million, while imports of “*Machinery & transport equipment*”, representing 29% of total imports, went up by 51.3% to reach Rs 12,286 million.

Further details by section and commodity are given in tables 9 and 10.

3.3 Imports by country of origin

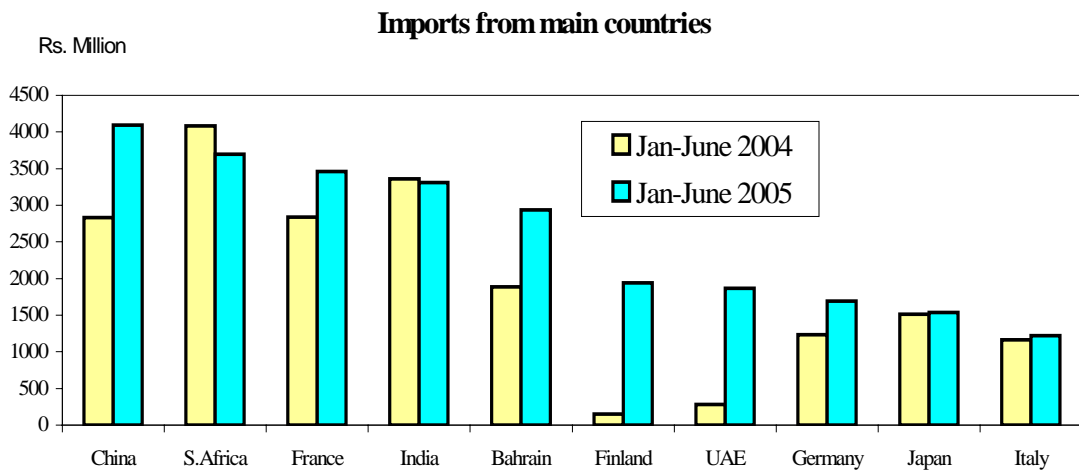


Table 11 shows imports by country of origin. During the first semester of 2005, Mauritius imported goods from Asia amounting to Rs 20,384 million, representing 47% of total imports for that period.

On a countrywise basis, the major sources were China (10%), Republic of South Africa (9%), France (8%), India (8%), Bahrain (7%), Finland (5%), UAE (4%), Germany (4%), Japan (4%) and Italy (3%).

Significant increases were registered in imports from Finland (1193%), Hungary (804%) and UAE (568%). Cellular phones were the main products imported from Finland and Hungary while petroleum products constituted 83% of the total imports from UAE.

4. Trade with Regional Organisations

Total exports to African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) States during the second quarter of 2005 amounted to Rs 1,361 million, while imports stood at Rs 2,600 million (Table 12).

During the first semester, total exports to these countries were valued at Rs 2,505 million and imports, Rs 4,899 million.

During the second quarter of 2005, Mauritius exported goods to a value of Rs 1,104 million to COMESA countries. Imports from these countries amounted to Rs 507 million, resulting in a favourable balance of Rs 597 million for Mauritius.

For the first semester, total exports to COMESA countries amounted to Rs 2,013 million and imports, Rs 948 million. Madagascar was the main buyer (80%) and Egypt was the main supplier (29%). The main products exported to Madagascar were: cotton fabrics, yarn of carded wool, preparations used in animal feeding, wheat flour and fertilisers. Bars and rods of iron, napkins for babies, ceramic tiles, sanitary towels, cement, oranges, preparations for cleaning or disinfecting, frozen potatoes and fruit juices were the main products imported from Egypt.

Trade with SADC countries for the second quarter of 2005 showed a deficit of Rs 2,011 million, resulting from imports to a value of Rs 2,339 million and exports amounting to Rs 328 million (Table 14).

For the first semester, Mauritius imported Rs 4,331 million worth of goods from SADC countries while exports were of the order of Rs 610 million. The main supplier was the Republic of South Africa (85%). Our main buyers were Republic of South Africa (50%) and Seychelles (29%).

5. Trade in Freeport Zone

During the second quarter of 2005, total imports of the Freeport Zone from overseas amounted to Rs 3,571 million, a figure which is 81% higher than the previous quarter and 298% higher than the corresponding quarter of 2004. Re-exports to overseas markets were

valued at Rs 4,178 million, that is 107% higher than those of the previous quarter and 150% higher than the corresponding quarter of 2004 (Table 2).

For the first six months of the year, total imports amounted to Rs 5,543 million compared to Rs 6,197 million worth of re-exports.

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External Trade

Notes

(1) **Coverage**

Trade figures are compiled according to the **General Trade System** as recommended by the United Nations. Using the national boundary as the statistical frontier, the General Trade System is a record of all goods entering (imports) and leaving the country (exports).

- Imports include goods brought in directly for domestic consumption plus goods imported into customs bonded warehouses
- Exports cover domestic exports and re-exports which include re-exports from customs bonded warehouses. Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin. Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.
- Ships stores and bunkers are included in total exports and are shown separately.
- Trade by parcel post is also included in imports and exports

(2) **Valuation**

Imports are valued on a C.I.F. (Cost, Insurance and Freight) basis whilst exports on a F.O.B. (Free On Board) basis.

C.I.F. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her imports of merchandise, other goods, etc. including all charges for transporting and insuring the goods from the country of exports to the given country but excluding the cost of unloading from the ship, aircraft etc. unless it is borne by the carrier.

F.O.B. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her exports of merchandise and other goods, including all costs of transporting the goods to the Customs frontier, export duties and the cost of loading the goods on to the carrier unless the latter cost is borne by the carrier.

(3) **Classification**

(i) **Commodity Code**

Commodities are coded according to the Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature (HS 2002). However, for the purposes of economic analysis and to facilitate international comparison of trade by commodity data, the commodities are also classified according to the Standard International Trade Classification (Revision 3) or SITC Rev. 3. The HS and

the SITC Rev. 3 are six and five digit codes respectively but have been extended to eight and seven digits to accommodate national requirements.
