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External Trade – 3rd Quarter 2005

Introduction

This issue of the Economic and Social Indicators presents external trade statistics for the third quarter of 2005 and for the years 2003 and 2004. These statistics are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are at times revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Customs Department.

Thus while figures for 2003 and 2004 published in this indicator are final, those for 2005 are subject to revision as and when the Customs Department submits latest amendments to the Central Statistics Office.

Data on international trade are compiled as per the recommendations of the United Nations General Trade System. According to this system, all goods entering and leaving the national frontier, including trading activities of the Freeport zone should be accounted for. However, it was not possible prior to 2002 to include Freeport transactions in our general trade statistics because of different processing systems at the Customs Department and at the Mauritius Freeport Authority. Since mid-October 2001, transactions of the Freeport are being lodged through the Customs Management System (CMS), thus making it possible to integrate data of the Freeport zone with those of Customs.

Hence, as from 2002, data on imports and exports include transactions through the Mauritius Freeport. It is to be noted that all exports of the Freeport are included in re-exports of Mauritius because it is not possible to distinguish between domestic exports and re-exports of freeport licensees. It is estimated that currently some 13% of freeport exports are sourced locally.


As from the first quarter of 2005, the terms of trade are based on the Exports and Imports Price Indices instead of unit value indices. Thus, as mentioned in previous issues, the Economic and Social Indicator on trade statistics no longer contain data on terms of trade. Such data now appear in the Economic and Social Indicator on Import and Export Price Indices which also provides an analysis of imports and exports in volume terms.

1. Total value of trade and trade balance

Total international trade for the third quarter of 2005 was valued at Rs 42,601 million, a figure which is 8.2% more than that of the previous quarter and 21% higher than that of the corresponding quarter of 2004.

During the third quarter of 2005, total exports amounted to Rs 17,882 million and total imports to Rs 24,719 million, thus resulting in a trade deficit of Rs 6,837 million.

For the first nine months of the year 2005, Mauritius registered a trade deficit of Rs 22,130 million, a figure which is 53% higher than the deficit of the corresponding period of last year.



Based on trends for previous years and the first nine months of 2005, total exports for the year are expected to be of the order of Rs 60,000 million, against Rs 93,000 million for imports which would include aircraft worth Rs 120 million. The trade deficit would be around Rs 33,000 million.

2. Exports

2.1 Total exports

Total export proceeds for the third quarter of 2005, including domestic exports, re-exports and ship's stores and bunkers, amounted to Rs 17,882 million, an increase of 21.3% over the previous quarter and 14.8% over the corresponding quarter of 2004.

Domestic exports, which constituted 67% of total exports, rose by 29.6% from the previous quarter to reach Rs 11,909 million. However, compared to the third quarter of 2004, domestic exports dropped by 5.4%.

Total exports for the first nine months reached Rs 45,657 million, that is a 13.7% increase over the corresponding period of 2004. However, during this period domestic exports fell by 4.5% while re-exports went up by 86.7% as a result of a significant increase in the transactions of Freeport.

2.2 Exports by SITC sections

Exports of "Food and live animals" for the first nine months of 2005 rose by 17.3% to reach Rs 11,996 million. Exports of sugar, representing 17.1% of total exports, registered an increase of 7.2% over the corresponding period of last year to reach Rs 7,349 million. Exports of "Fish & fish preparations" also registered a significant rise of 39% to attain Rs 3,331 million.

During the first nine months of 2005, export receipts from “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” amounted to Rs 3,658 million, showing an increase of 7.4% over the first nine months of 2004.

Export proceeds from “Miscellaneous manufactured articles”, representing 44.5% of total exports for the first nine months of 2005, attained Rs 19,149 million. This shows a drop of 12.7% when compared to the corresponding period of 2004. Exports of “Articles of apparel & clothing accessories” which constituted 85% of this section were valued at Rs 16,310 million, that is 15.5% less than the corresponding period of last year.

2.3 Exports of EPZ


During the third quarter of 2005, exports of EPZ products, amounting to Rs 7,197 million, decreased by 6.5% when compared to the second quarter and by 9.5% compared to the third quarter of 2004.

On a cumulative basis, exports of EPZ for the first nine months of the year were valued at Rs 21,444 million, representing a decrease of 9.5% in comparison to the corresponding period of 2004. Details on exports of EPZ are presented in the Economic and Social Indicator on the Export Processing Zone.

2.4 Exports by Country of destination

An analysis by country of destination for the first nine months of 2005 shows that the European countries purchased for Rs 27,972 million or 65% of our total exports. The United Kingdom remained the main buyer with Rs 13,656 million, or 31.7% of total exports, followed by France with Rs 6,282 million (14.6%). The other major markets were U.S.A (10.3%), UAE (8.4%), Malagasy Republic (5.8%) and Italy (5.6%).

Compared to the first nine months of 2004, total exports to UK went up by 8.2% while those to U.S.A and France fell by 24.4% and 4.8% respectively. During this period total exports to the UAE increased significantly from Rs 717 million to Rs 3,595 million on account of an increase in re-exports of cellular phones by Freeport operators. Details of total exports by country of destination are given in Table 6.



3 Imports

3.1 Total imports

Total imports for the third quarter of 2005 were valued at Rs 24,719 million, almost at the same level as the previous quarter, but up by 25.9% over the corresponding quarter of 2004.

Total imports for the first nine months of 2005 amounted to Rs 67,787 million, showing an increase of 24.1% over the corresponding period of 2004.

3.2 Imports by SITC sections

Imports of “*Food and live animals*” for the first nine months of 2005 increased by 13.5% compared to the corresponding period of last year to reach Rs 9,778 million.

Import bill of “*Mineral fuels, lubricants & related products*” stood at Rs 10,889 million, 63.6% higher than the first nine months of 2004.

From January to September of 2005, imports of “*Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material*” declined by 1.8% to attain Rs 14,361 million, while imports of “*Machinery & transport equipment*”, representing 29% of total imports, went up by 51.7% to reach Rs 19,548 million.

Further details by section and commodity are given in Tables 9 and 10.

3.3 Imports by country of origin




Table 11 shows imports by country of origin. During the first nine months of 2005, nearly half of total imported goods, worth Rs 31,990 million, came from Asia.

On a countrywise basis, the major sources were China (10%), Republic of South Africa (8%), France (8%), India (7%), Bahrain (6%), Finland (5%), Germany (4%), UAE (4%), Japan (4%) and Saudi Arabia (3%).

Significant increases were registered in imports from Hungary (744%), Finland (400%) and UAE (102%). Cellular phones were the main products imported from Finland and Hungary while petroleum products constituted 85% of the total imports from UAE.

4. Trade with Regional Organisations

Total exports to African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) States during the third quarter of 2005 amounted to Rs 1,406 million, while imports stood at Rs 2,666 million (Table 12).

During the first nine months, total exports to these countries were valued at Rs 3,911 million and imports, Rs 7,566 million.

During the third quarter of 2005, Mauritius exported goods to a value of Rs 1,085 million to COMESA countries. Imports from these countries amounted to Rs 583 million, resulting in a favourable balance of Rs 502 million.

For the first nine months, total exports to COMESA countries amounted to Rs 3,098 million and imports, Rs 1,532 million. Madagascar was the main buyer (80%) and Egypt was the main supplier (30%). The main products exported to Madagascar were: cotton fabrics, yarn of carded wool, preparations used in animal feeding, wheat flour and fertilisers. Bars and rods of iron, napkins for babies, ceramic tiles, sanitary towels, cement, oranges, preparations for cleaning or disinfecting, frozen potatoes and fruit juices were the main products imported from Egypt.

For the third quarter of 2005, imports from SADC countries amounted to Rs 2,337 million and exports to Rs 394 million, resulting in a trade deficit of Rs 1,943 million (Table 14).

For the first nine months, Mauritius imported Rs 6,668 million worth of goods from SADC countries while exports were of the order of Rs 1,004 million. The main supplier was the Republic of South Africa (85%). Our main buyers were Republic of South Africa (54%) and Seychelles (29%).

5. Trade in Freeport Zone

During the third quarter of 2005, total imports of the Freeport Zone amounted to Rs 3,030 million, showing an increase of 107% over the corresponding quarter of 2004. Re-exports to overseas markets were valued at Rs 4,416 million, that is 6% higher than those of the previous quarter but 127% higher than the corresponding quarter of 2004 (Table 2).

For the first nine months of 2005, total imports amounted to Rs 8,573 million, up by 166% over the corresponding period of last year. Re-exports of the Freeport zone almost doubled to reach Rs 10,613 million.

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External Trade

Notes

(1) Coverage

Trade figures are compiled according to the **General Trade System** as recommended by the United Nations. Using the national boundary as the statistical frontier, the General Trade System is a record of all goods entering (imports) and leaving the country (exports).

- Imports include goods brought in directly for domestic consumption plus goods imported into customs bonded warehouses
- Exports cover domestic exports and re-exports which include re-exports from customs bonded warehouses. Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin. Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.
- Ships stores and bunkers are included in total exports and are shown separately.
- Trade by parcel post is also included in imports and exports

(2) Valuation

Imports are valued on a C.I.F. (Cost, Insurance and Freight) basis whilst exports on a F.O.B. (Free On Board) basis.

C.I.F. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her imports of merchandise, other goods, etc. including all charges for transporting and insuring the goods from the country of exports to the given country but excluding the cost of unloading from the ship, aircraft etc. unless it is borne by the carrier.

F.O.B. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her exports of merchandise and other goods, including all costs of transporting the goods to the Customs frontier, export duties and the cost of loading the goods on to the carrier unless the latter cost is borne by the carrier.

(3) Classification

(i) Commodity Code

Commodities are coded according to the Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature (HS 2002). However, for the purposes of economic analysis and to facilitate international comparison of trade by commodity data, the commodities are also classified according to the Standard International Trade Classification (Revision 3) or SITC Rev. 3. The HS and

the SITC Rev. 3 are six and five digit codes respectively but have been extended to eight and seven digits to accommodate national requirements.
