

External Trade – 1st Quarter 2006

Introduction

This issue of the Social and Economic Indicators presents external trade statistics for the first quarter of 2006 and for the years 2004 and 2005. These statistics are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are at times revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Customs Department.

Thus while figures for 2004 published in this indicator are final, those for 2005 and 2006 are subject to revision as and when the Customs Department submits latest amendments to the Central Statistics Office.


Data on international trade are compiled as per the recommendations of the United Nations General Trade System. According to this system, all goods entering and leaving the national frontier, including trading activities of the Freeport zone should be accounted for. However, it was not possible prior to 2002 to include Freeport transactions in our general trade statistics because of different processing systems at the Customs Department and at the Mauritius Freeport Authority. Since mid-October 2001, transactions of the Freeport are being lodged through the Customs Management System (CMS), thus making it possible to integrate data of the Freeport zone with those of Customs.

Hence, as from 2002, data on imports and exports include transactions through the Mauritius Freeport. It is to be noted that all exports of the Freeport are included in re-exports of Mauritius because it is not possible to distinguish between domestic exports and re-exports of freeport licensees. It is estimated that currently some 18% of freeport exports are sourced locally.

1. Total value of trade and trade balance

Total international trade for the first quarter of 2006 was valued at Rs 39,414 million, a figure which is 9% lower than that of the previous quarter but 25.3% higher than that of the corresponding quarter of 2005.

During the first quarter of 2006, total exports reached Rs 15,808 million compared to total imports of Rs 23,606 million, thus resulting in a trade deficit of Rs 7,798 million.



Based on trends for previous years, total exports for the year 2006 are expected to be of the order of Rs 69,918 million, against Rs 118,160 million for imports which would include acquisition of aircraft for a value of Rs 10,125 million. The trade deficit would be around Rs 48,242 million.

2. Exports

2.1 Total exports

Total export proceeds for the first quarter of 2006, including domestic exports, re-exports and ship's stores and bunkers, amounted to Rs 15,808 million, showing a decrease of 10.8% over the previous quarter and an increase of 21.3% over the corresponding quarter of 2005.

Domestic exports, which represented 61% of total exports, fell by 15.6% from the previous quarter to reach Rs 9,688 million. Compared to the first quarter of 2005, domestic exports increased by 2.6% while re-exports rose by 74% as a result of a significant increase in transactions of the Freeport.

2.2 Exports by SITC sections

Exports of "Food and live animals" for the first quarter of 2006 were valued at Rs 4,393 million, showing a decrease of 11.4% over the previous quarter but an increase of 15.9% when compared to the corresponding quarter of 2005. Exports of sugar, representing 56% of exports of this section, registered an increase of 4.3% over the corresponding period of last year to reach Rs 2,465 million.

For the same period under review, export receipts from "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" stood at Rs 1,223 million, showing a drop of 9.8% compared to the previous quarter but an increase of 17.6% over the first quarter of 2005.

Export proceeds from "Miscellaneous manufactured articles", representing 40% of total exports for the first quarter of 2006 reached Rs 5,784 million. This figure represented a decrease of 14.9% compared to the previous quarter and another of 6.4% over the corresponding period of 2005. Exports of "Articles of apparel & clothing accessories" were valued at Rs 4,868 million, that is 14.6% less than the previous quarter and 7.4% less than the first quarter of 2005.


2.3 Exports of EPZ

During the first quarter of 2006, exports of EPZ products amounting to Rs 6,629 million decreased by 14.4% as compared to the previous quarter. However, when compared to the first quarter of 2005, these exports showed a slight increase of 1.3%. Details on exports of EPZ are presented in the Economic and Social Indicator on the Export Processing Zone.

2.4 Exports by Country of destination

Analysis by country of destination shows that our main buyers, i.e the European countries, purchased some 63% of our exports amounting to Rs 9,064 million. The United Kingdom remained the main buyer with Rs 4,724 million, or 32.6% of total exports, followed

by France with Rs 1,816 million (12.5%). The other major markets were United Arab Emirates (UAE) (9.3%), U.S.A (7.3%), Malagasy Republic (5.1%) and Italy (4.3%). Compared to the first quarter of 2005, total exports to UK were up by 12.1% while those to U.S.A and France fell by 22.5% and 8.3% respectively. It is worth noting that exports to UAE rose by around 270% from Rs 364 million to Rs 1,345 million mainly due to re-exports of mobile phones by the Freeport. Further details are given in Table 6.



3. Imports

3.1 Total imports

Total imports for the first quarter of 2006 reached Rs 23,606 million, showing a decrease of 7.7% over the previous quarter but an increase of 28.1% over the corresponding quarter of 2005.

3.2 Imports by SITC sections

Imports of “*Food and live animals*” for the first quarter of 2006 reached Rs 3,581 million, i.e 11.6% less than the previous quarter but 20.7% higher than the corresponding quarter of 2005.

Import bill of “*Mineral fuels, lubricants, & related products*”, valued at Rs 4,583 million, increased by 3.3% compared to the previous quarter and 59.4% over the corresponding quarter of 2005.

During the first quarter of 2006, imports of “*Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material*” declined by 7.0% compared to the previous quarter to attain Rs 4,594 million. However, this figure shows a rise of 13.4% over the first quarter of last year.

Imports of “*Machinery & transport equipment*”, representing 26% of total imports for the first quarter of 2006, were valued at Rs 6,190 million. This shows a drop of 7.6% compared to the previous quarter but an increase of 32.7% when compared to the corresponding period of 2005.

Further details by section and commodity are given in Tables 9 and 10.

3.3 Imports by country of origin




Table 11 shows imports by country of origin. During the first quarter of 2006, imports from Asia amounted to Rs 11,740 million, constituting almost half of total imports.

An analysis by country shows that our main suppliers were India (9.9%), Republic of South Africa (8.3%), France (7.9%), China (7.6%), UAE (6.2%), Saudi Arabia (5.1), Germany (4.8%), Bahrain (3.7%), Japan (2.9%), United Kingdom (2.8%) and Australia (2.4%).

4. Trade with Regional Organisations

Total exports to African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) States during the first quarter of 2006 amounted to Rs 1,378 million, while imports stood at Rs 2,667 million. The trade deficit with ACP countries works out to Rs 1,289 million (Table 12).

During the same period, Mauritius exported goods to a value of Rs 956 million to COMESA countries. Imports from these countries amounted to Rs 722 million, resulting in a favourable balance of Rs 234 million for Mauritius. Madagascar was the main buyer (77.4%) and Seychelles was the main supplier (34.0%). The main products exported to Madagascar were: yarn of carded wool, carded yarn of fine animal hair, preparations used in animal feeding, wheat flour and fertilisers. Fish was the main product imported from Seychelles.

Trade with SADC countries for the first quarter of 2006 showed a deficit of Rs 1,154 million, resulting from imports amounting to Rs 2,282 million and exports amounting to Rs 1,128 million (Table 14). The main supplier was the Republic of South Africa (86.0%). Our main buyers were Madagascar (65.5%) and Republic of South Africa (29.8%).

5. Trade in Freeport Zone

During the first quarter of 2006, total imports of the Freeport Zone from overseas amounted to Rs 3,481 million, a figure which is 2.1% higher when compared to the previous quarter but 76.5% higher than the corresponding quarter of 2005. Re-exports to overseas markets amounted to Rs 4,172 million, that is 3.0% higher than those of the previous quarter and 106.6% higher than the corresponding quarter of 2005 (Table 2).

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Notes

(1) Coverage

Trade figures are compiled according to the **General Trade System** as recommended by the United Nations. Using the national boundary as the statistical frontier, the General Trade System is a record of all goods entering (imports) and leaving the country (exports).

- Imports include goods brought in directly for domestic consumption plus goods imported into customs bonded warehouses
- Exports cover domestic exports and re-exports which include re-exports from customs bonded warehouses. Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin. Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.
- Ships stores and bunkers are included in total exports and are shown separately.
- Trade by parcel post is also included in imports and exports

(2) Valuation

Imports are valued on a C.I.F. (Cost, Insurance and Freight) basis whilst exports on a F.O.B. (Free On Board) basis.

C.I.F. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her imports of merchandise, other goods, etc. including all charges for transporting and insuring the goods from the country of exports to the given country but excluding the cost of unloading from the ship, aircraft etc. unless it is borne by the carrier.

F.O.B. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her exports of merchandise and other goods, including all costs of transporting the goods to the Customs frontier, export duties and the cost of loading the goods on to the carrier unless the latter cost is borne by the carrier.

(3) Classification

(i) Commodity Code

Commodities are coded according to the Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature (HS2002). However, for the purposes of economic analysis and to facilitate international comparison of trade by commodity data, the commodities are also classified according to the Standard International Trade Classification (Revision 3) or SITC Rev. 3. The HS and the SITC Rev. 3 are six and five digit codes respectively but have been extended to eight and seven digits to accommodate national requirements.
