# Business Activity Statistics, July 2005 - June 2006 

## Introduction

Statistics on business activities undertaken in the island of Mauritius are compiled mainly from administrative records. They cover activities which are either licensed with the local authorities (municipalities and district councils) or registered with the appropriate organisations such as the Medical and Dental council, the National Transport Authority, the Tourism Authority, etc. All agricultural activities are presently excluded.

It must be pointed out that the statistics on business activity refer to the total number of licensed or registered activities and not to the total number of operation units or enterprises. For example, one enterprise may hold three licences: one as general retailer of foodstuff, a second for selling tobacco and a third for selling alcoholic beverages.

## 2. Evolution of licences between July 2005 and June 2006

From July 2005 to June 2006, 8,474 new licences were issued, of which 5,888 (69\%) pertained to activities classified under 'Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles, personal and household goods'. During the same period 2,550 licences were cancelled, thus bringing the total number of licences as at June 2006 to 79,672, representing an increase of $8 \%$ over the previous year figure of 73,748 (Table 1).

## 3. Evolution of registrations between July 2005 and June 2006

The number of registered activities increased by 1,713 (6\%) from 27,040 in July 2005 to 28,753 in June 2006. The industry group 'Transport, storage and communications' had the highest number of registered activities with 19,930 (69\%) as at June 2006, followed by 'Real estate, renting and business activities' with 2,608 (9\%) (Table 3).

## 4. Adjusted licences and registrations as at June 2006

Table 4 shows the total number of licences and registered activities as at June 2006, adjusted for double counting. Activities which are both licensed and registered are included in registrations only.

The total number of adjusted licensed and registered activities increased by 7\% from 95,501 in June 2005 to 102,178 in June 2006. Out of these around 55\% $(56,039)$ fell under the industry group 'Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles, personal
and household goods' and another 20\% (20,430), under 'Transport, storage and communications'.

## 5. Distribution of adjusted licences and registrations by region and industry groups

Table 5 shows the distribution of adjusted licensed and registered activities by industry groups and region (urban and rural). The number of activities was slightly higher in rural areas (54\%) than in urban areas. Activities predominant in the rural regions were from the industry groups 'Hotels and restaurants' (65\%) and 'Other community, social and personal service activities’ (65\%). On the other hand, activities pertaining to the following industry groups were found mostly in the urban areas: 'Health and social work' (76\%), 'Real estate, renting and business activities' (64\%) and 'Construction' (63\%).

## Technical Notes

## 1. General

Data compiled in this publication provide useful information on demography and trend of business activities in the different economic sectors of the country.

## 2. Concepts and Coverage

An operator is required to obtain a licence from the Municipal or District Councils for each type of activity or to register with the appropriate Ministry or organisations (e.g Ministry of Education and Human Resources, the Medical Council, the National Transport Authority, the Tourism Authority, etc.). Statistics published in this report pertain only to activities that are either licensed or registered. However, all agricultural related activities, except those in the manufacture of food products, are not covered.

Statistics on licences relate to the number of licences as delivered by the local authorities. Similarly statistics on registrations are those as registered with the appropriate Ministries or organisations. In some cases, an operator may hold both a licence and a registration certificate. To avoid double counting, while compiling statistics on both licences and registrations, such activities have been accounted for in registration only. For example the owner of a bus, besides registering his vehicle with the National Transport Authority may also hold a licence issued by a district council. In the table giving figures for both licences and registrations, the activity of the bus owner is accounted for in registration only.

## 3. Classification and presentation of data

To cater for the wide range and diverse business activities and for classification purposes, each activity has been assigned an activity code according to the National Standard Industrial classification of Economic Activities (NSIC), which is an adapted version of the International Standard Industrial Classification (ISIC), Rev. 3, 1990.

The NSIC consists of 5 levels of classification namely:
Level $1 \quad$ Section: $\quad 17$ sections identified by one of the letters A to Q
Level 2 Division: 56 divisions identified by the first 2 digits
Level $3 \quad$ Group: 151 groups identified by the first 3 digits
Level $4 \quad$ Classes: 302 classes identified by the first 4 digits
Level 5 Sub-classes: 546 sub-classes identified by the first digits
