

## **External Trade – 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter 2006**

### **Introduction**

This issue of the Economic and Social Indicators presents external trade statistics for the fourth quarter of 2006 and for the years 2005 and 2006. These statistics are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are at times revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) - Customs Department.

Thus while figures for 2005 published in this indicator are final, those for 2006 are subject to revision as and when the MRA - Customs Department submits latest amendments to the Central Statistics Office.

Data on international trade are compiled as per the recommendations of the United Nations General Trade System. According to this system, all goods entering and leaving the national frontier, including trading activities of the Freeport zone should be accounted for. However, it was not possible prior to 2002 to include Freeport transactions in our general trade statistics because of different processing systems at the Customs Department and at the Mauritius Freeport Authority. Since mid-October 2001, transactions of the Freeport are being lodged through the Customs Management System (CMS), thus making it possible to integrate data of the Freeport zone with those of Customs.


Hence, as from 2002, data on imports and exports include transactions through the Mauritius Freeport. It is to be noted that all exports of the Freeport are included in re-exports of Mauritius because it is not possible to distinguish between domestic exports and re-exports of freeport licensees. It is estimated that currently some 24% of freeport exports are sourced locally.

### **1. Total value of trade and trade balance**

Total international trade for the fourth quarter of 2006 was valued at Rs 58,760 million, a figure which is 25.0% higher than the previous quarter and 35.2% higher than the corresponding quarter of 2005. It is to be noted that imports for the fourth quarter of 2006 included aircraft worth Rs 6,700 million.

During the fourth quarter of 2006, total exports attained Rs 21,687 million against imports of Rs 37,073 million, resulting in a trade deficit of Rs 15,386 million.

For the year 2006, the trade deficit amounted to Rs 41,441 million, i.e 37.8% higher than the previous year. Exclusive of the acquisition and re-exports of aircraft, the trade deficit worked out to Rs 35,096 million, representing an increase of 17.2% over a figure of Rs 29,943 million in 2005.



## 2. Exports

### 2.1 Total exports (Table 1)

Total export proceeds for the fourth quarter of 2006, including domestic exports<sup>1</sup>, re-exports<sup>2</sup> and ship's stores and bunkers, amounted to Rs 21,687 million, showing increases of 12.3% over the previous quarter and 21.8% over the corresponding quarter of 2005.

Domestic exports, which accounted for 66% of total exports, went up by 4.7% from the previous quarter to reach Rs 14,409 million in the fourth quarter of 2006. Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2005, domestic exports registered an increase of 24.5%.

Total exports for the year 2006 stood at Rs 74,171 million, indicating a 17.3% increase over 2005. During the same period, domestic exports increased by 13.4% while re-exports went up by 25.7% as a result of growing transactions of the Freeport and the re-exports of aircraft worth Rs 480 million to Fiji.

### 2.2 Exports by SITC sections (Table 3)

Exports of "Food and live animals" for the year 2006 expanded by 17.1% to reach Rs 20,201 million. Exports of sugar, representing 16.2% of total exports, rose by 6.0% compared to the previous year to attain Rs 11,165 million. A substantial increase of 48.8% was noted in the product group "fish and fish preparations" where exports value moved from Rs 4,785 million in the year 2005 to reach Rs 7,120 million in 2006.

During the year 2006, export receipts from "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" stood at Rs 5,536 million, showing a growth of 10.7% over the previous year.

Export proceeds from "Miscellaneous manufactured articles", contributing 42% of total exports for the year 2006, reached Rs 29,073 million or an increase of 12.9% over 2005. This was mainly due to a 12.3% increase in the exports of "Articles of apparel & clothing accessories" which reached a value of Rs 24,531 million in 2006.

### 2.3 Exports of enterprises formerly holding an EPZ Certificate (Table 1)

It is to be noted that following its integration with the non-EPZ sector as from October 2006, it is no longer possible to provide data separately for the EPZ sector. However, exports of the enterprises formerly holding an EPZ certificate amounted to Rs 9,628 million during the fourth quarter of 2006. This represented an increase of 12.1% over the previous quarter and another of 25.2% over the corresponding quarter of 2005.

For the year 2006, exports of the EPZ sector amounted to Rs 33,707 million, registering an increase of 16.4% over the year 2005. Details on exports of EPZ will be presented in the Economic and Social Indicators on the Export Processing Zone, which will be released on 22 March 2007.



<sup>2</sup> Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.

## 2.4 Exports by Country of destination (Table 6)

Analysis by country of destination for the year 2006 shows that the European countries absorbed 61.8% of our exports for an amount of Rs 42,691 million. The United Kingdom remained the main market with Rs 22,406 million, or 32.4% of total exports. The other major destinations for our exports were France (12.6%), United Arab Emirates (11.4%), U.S.A (8.3%), Madagascar (4.8%) and Italy (4.0%).

Compared to 2005, total exports to UK, France and U.S.A rose by 16.6%, 4.1% and 2.1% respectively. Total exports to the United Arab Emirates increased by 60.7% from Rs 4,903 million in 2005 to Rs 7,881 million in 2006 as a result of a 51.6% increase in the re-exports of cellular phones by Freeport operators. Similarly, a substantial increase was noted in the exports to South Africa which went up by 88.7% from Rs 788 million in 2005 to reach Rs 1,487 million in 2006 on account of an increase in exports of textile products.



As far as goods of national origin (domestic exports) are concerned, the main buyers in 2006 were U.K. (45.9%), France (14.5%) and U.S.A (10.1%).

## 3 Imports

### 3.1 Total imports (Table 1)

Total imports for the fourth quarter of 2006 were valued at Rs 37,073 million, showing increases of 33.9% over the previous quarter and 44.6% over the corresponding quarter of 2005. The sharp rise in imports for the fourth quarter of 2006 is accounted for by the imports of aircraft from France valued at Rs 6,700 million.

Total imports for the year 2006 amounted to Rs 115,612 million against a figure of Rs 93,282 million in 2005 (+23.9%).

### 3.2 Imports by SITC sections (Table 9)

Compared to the year 2005, imports of “*Food and live animals*” for year 2006 went up by 25.3% to attain Rs 17,312 million.

The import bill of “*Mineral fuels, lubricants, & related products*” amounted to Rs 19,367 million, i.e 25.8% more than that of 2005.


In 2006, imports of “*Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material*” stood at Rs 21,825 million, increasing by 13.1% over a figure of Rs 19,297 million in 2005.

Imports of “*Machinery & transport equipment*”, representing 31.1% of total imports, went up by 37.7% to reach Rs 35,945 million. This is mainly explained by the acquisition of aircraft worth Rs 6,825 million during the year. Exclusive of aircraft, the increase in imports over the year 2005 worked out to 12.0%.

### 3.3 Imports by country of origin (Table 11)

Imports from the Asian continent, our major supplier, reached Rs 52,745 million in 2006 with a share of 46% of total imports.

Our imports originated mainly from the following countries: France (14.2%), India (13.6%), China (8.6%), South Africa (7.3%), Germany (4.0%), Hungary (3.5%), Saudi Arabia (3.4%), UAE (2.9%), Japan (2.8%) and Australia (2.7%). It is to be noted that compared to 2005, imports from France were up by 136.2 % due to the purchase of aircraft and those from India rose by 142.9% following a substantial increase in the imports of petroleum products.



### 4. Trade with Regional Organisations (Tables 12-14)

Total exports to African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) States during the fourth quarter of 2006 stood at Rs 1,982 million, against imports of Rs 3,221 million (Table 12).

During the year 2006, total exports to these countries, inclusive of aircraft worth Rs 480 million to Fiji, were valued at Rs 6,619 million and imports, Rs 11,816 million.

Exports to COMESA countries reached Rs 1,213 million in the fourth quarter of 2006, while imports from these countries amounted to Rs 955 million.

In 2006, Mauritius exported goods worth Rs 4,275 million to COMESA countries. Imports from these countries amounted to Rs 3,540 million, resulting in a favourable balance of Rs 735 million for Mauritius. Madagascar was the main buyer (77%) while the main suppliers were Seychelles (29.3%), Egypt (25.0%) and Madagascar (13.5%). The main products exported to Madagascar were yarn of carded wool, preparations used in animal feeding and carded yarn of fine animal hair. The main products imported from Seychelles were frozen yellowfin tunas and frozen skipjack while iron bars and urea constituted the main imports from Egypt.

Trade with SADC countries for the fourth quarter of 2006 showed a deficit of Rs 1,281 million, resulting from imports of a value of Rs 2,719 million and exports amounting to Rs 1,438 million.

For the year 2006, Mauritius imported Rs 9,955 million worth of goods from SADC countries while exports were of the order of Rs 5,070 million. The main supplier was South Africa (85.3%) while our main buyers were Madagascar (65.0%) and South Africa (29.3%).

## **5. Trade in Freeport Zone (Table 2)**

During the fourth quarter of 2006, total imports of the Freeport Zone were Rs 3,657 million, a figure which is higher by 22.8% compared to the previous quarter and by 7.2% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2005. Re-exports to overseas markets were valued at Rs 4,875 million, showing increases of 38.8% over the previous quarter and another 20.4% over the corresponding quarter of 2005.

Total imports for the year 2006 totalled Rs 14,101 million against Rs 17,413 million worth of re-exports.

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## Notes

### (1) Coverage

Trade figures are compiled according to the **General Trade System** as recommended by the United Nations. Using the national boundary as the statistical frontier, the General Trade System is a record of all goods entering (imports) and leaving the country (exports).

- Imports include goods brought in directly for domestic consumption plus goods imported into customs bonded warehouses
- Exports cover domestic exports and re-exports which include re-exports from customs bonded warehouses. Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin. Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.
- Ships stores and bunkers are included in total exports and are shown separately.
- Trade by parcel post is also included in imports and exports

### (2) Valuation

Imports are valued on a C.I.F. (Cost, Insurance and Freight) basis whilst exports on a F.O.B. (Free On Board) basis.

C.I.F. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her imports of merchandise, other goods, etc. including all charges for transporting and insuring the goods from the country of exports to the given country but excluding the cost of unloading from the ship, aircraft etc. unless it is borne by the carrier.

F.O.B. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her exports of merchandise and other goods, including all costs of transporting the goods to the Customs frontier, export duties and the cost of loading the goods on to the carrier unless the latter cost is borne by the carrier.

### (3) Classification

#### (i) Commodity Code

Commodities are coded according to the Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature (HS2002). However, for the purposes of economic analysis and to facilitate international comparison of trade by commodity data, the commodities are also classified according to the Standard International Trade Classification (Revision 3) or SITC Rev. 3. The HS and the SITC Rev. 3 are six and five digit codes respectively but have been extended to eight and seven digits to accommodate national requirements.
