

External Trade – 3rd Quarter 2007

Introduction

This issue of the Economic and Social Indicators presents external trade statistics for the third quarter of 2007 and for the years 2005 and 2006. These statistics are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are at times revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) - Customs Department.

Thus while figures for 2005 and 2006 published in this indicator are final, those for 2007 are subject to revision as and when the MRA - Customs Department submits latest amendments to the Central Statistics Office.

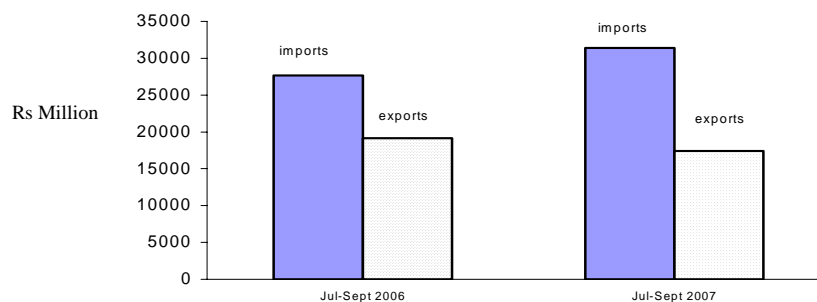
Data on international trade are compiled as per the recommendations of the United Nations General Trade System. According to this system, all goods entering and leaving the national frontier, including trading activities of the Freeport zone should be accounted for. However, it was not possible prior to 2002 to include Freeport transactions in our general trade statistics because of different processing systems at the Customs Department and at the Mauritius Freeport Authority. Since mid-October 2001, transactions of the Freeport are being lodged through the Customs Management System (CMS), thus making it possible to integrate data of the Freeport zone with those of Customs.

Hence, as from 2002, data on imports and exports include transactions through the Mauritius Freeport. It is to be noted that all exports of the Freeport are included in re-exports of Mauritius because it is not possible to distinguish between domestic exports and re-exports of freeport licensees. It is estimated that for the third quarter of 2007 some 49% of freeport exports are sourced locally.

1. Total value of trade and trade balance

Total international trade for the third quarter of 2007 was valued at Rs 48,834 million, i.e 8.0% higher than the previous quarter and 4.3% higher than the corresponding quarter of 2006.

During the third quarter of 2007, total exports were valued at Rs 17,410 million against imports of Rs 31,424 million, resulting in a trade deficit of Rs 14,014 million.



Based on trends for previous years, total exports for the year 2007 are expected to be of the order of Rs 73,500 million, against imports of Rs 118,000 million inclusive of aircraft worth Rs 2,700 million. The trade deficit would therefore be around Rs 44,500 million.

2. Exports

2.1 Total exports (Table 1)

Total export proceeds for the third quarter of 2007, including domestic exports¹, re-exports² and ships' stores and bunkers, amounted to Rs 17,410 million, showing an increase of 5.2% over the previous quarter but a decrease of 9.0% over the corresponding quarter of 2006.

Domestic exports, which accounted for 74.4% of total exports, rose by 11.4% from the previous quarter to reach Rs 12,947 million. Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2006, domestic exports registered a decrease of 4.8% mostly due to lower exports of sugar. Re-exports also went down by 27.9% as a result of a substantial decrease in the re-exports of mobile phones (-69.8 %).

Total exports for January to September 2007 attained Rs 49,417 million, that is, a decrease of 5.7% over the corresponding period of 2006. During this period domestic exports rose by 6.4% while re-exports went down by 34.0%.

2.2 Exports by SITC section (Table 3)

Compared to the first nine months of 2006, exports of "Food and live animals" went down by 9.6% to reach Rs 12,344 million on account of a decrease of 28.5% in the exports of sugar. With exports for the first nine months of 2007 amounting to Rs 5,833 million, "Fish and fish preparations" is now the main component of exports of this section, followed by sugar (Rs 5,178 million).

For the first nine months of 2007, exports of "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" stood at Rs 4,424 million, showing an increase of 8.0% compared to the first nine months of 2006.

Compared to the first nine months of 2006, export proceeds from "Miscellaneous manufactured articles", contributing 52.6% of total exports, increased by 17.1% to reach Rs 23,952 million. "Articles of apparel & clothing accessories" which represents 86.4% of exports of this section increased by 19.1%.

It is worth pointing out that total exports of "Machinery and transport equipment" dropped significantly from Rs 9,065 million in the first nine months of 2006 to Rs 2,838 million in the corresponding period of 2007 (-68.7%) as a result of a substantial fall in the re-exports of mobile phones to the United Arab Emirates (UAE).

2.3 Exports of Export Oriented Enterprises (Table 1)

During the first nine months of 2007, Export Oriented Enterprises comprising enterprises formerly operating with an EPZ certificate, and those establishments manufacturing goods for exports and holding a registration certificate issued by the Board of Investment exported some Rs 27,974 million worth of goods. Details on exports of these enterprises will be presented in the Economic and Social Indicators on the Export Oriented Enterprises, which will be released on 12 December 2007. It is to be noted that exports of the enterprises formerly holding an EPZ certificate amounted to Rs 27,957 million, i.e 16.2% higher than the figure of Rs 24,052 million registered in the corresponding period of 2006.

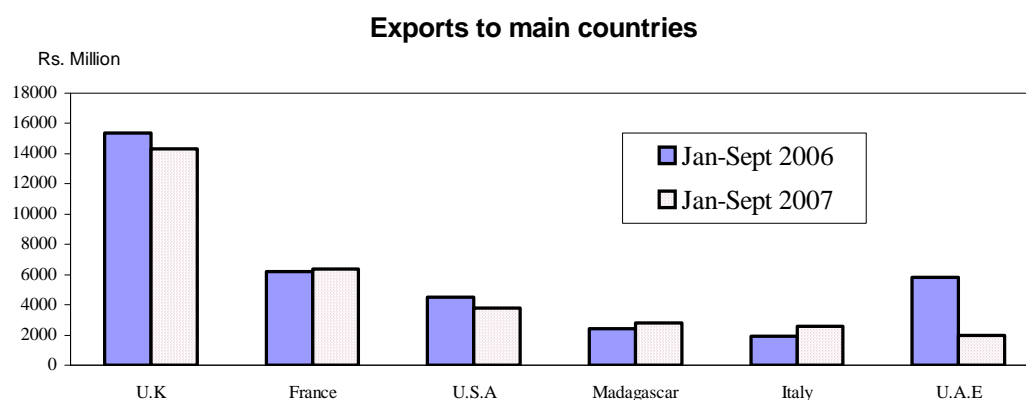
¹ Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin

² Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.

2.4 Exports by Country of destination (Table 6)

Analysis by country of destination for the first nine months of 2007 shows that the European countries purchased some 66.9% of our exports for an amount of Rs 30,462 million. The United Kingdom remained the main market with Rs 14,307 million, or 31.4% of total exports. The other major destinations for our exports were France (13.9%), U.S.A (8.4%), Madagascar (6.1%), Italy (5.7%) and U.A.E (4.3%).

Compared to the first nine months of 2006, total exports to UK and U.S.A fell by 7.0% and 15.8% respectively while those to France showed an increase of 2.7%. It is worth noting that exports to U.S.A for the first nine months of 2006 included re-exports of aircraft worth Rs 670 million. A significant drop of 65.8% is recorded in total exports to the United Arab Emirates as a consequence of the decrease in re-exports of cellular phones to this country. Further details are given in Table 6.



3. Imports

3.1 Total imports (Table 1)

Total imports for the third quarter of 2007 reached Rs 31,424 million, showing increases of 9.5% over the previous quarter and 13.6% over the corresponding quarter of 2006.

Total imports for the first nine months of 2006 amounted to Rs 84,484 million, showing an increase of 7.7% over the corresponding period of 2006.

3.2 Imports by SITC section (Table 9)

Imports of “*Food and live animals*” for the first nine months of 2007 were valued at Rs 13,869 million, i.e 15.7% higher than the first nine months of 2006.

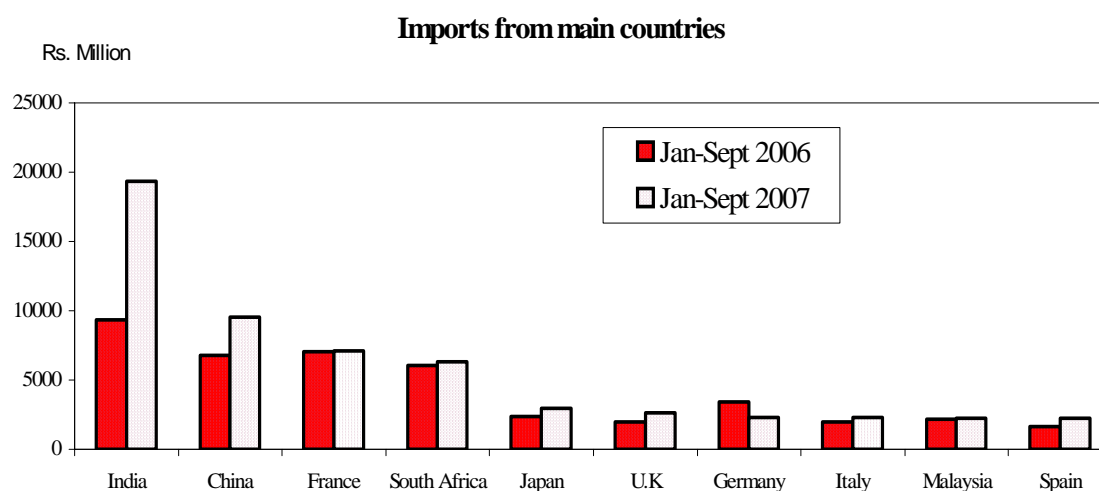
The import bill of “*Mineral fuels, lubricants, & related products*” stood at Rs 16,657 million representing a rise of 15.1% compared to the corresponding period of last year.

Imports of “*Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material*” for the period under review registered an increase of 19.5% to reach Rs 18,468 million while those of “*Machinery & transport equipment*” were valued at Rs 17,804 million, 17.9% lower as a result of a sharp decrease in the imports of cellular phones.

3.3 Imports by country of origin (Table 11)

During the first nine months of 2007, imports from the Asian continent, our major supplier, amounted to Rs 44,815 million with a share of 53.0% of total imports.

Our imports originated mainly from the following countries: India (22.9%), China (11.3%), France (8.4%), South Africa (7.4%), Japan (3.5%), U.K (3.1%), Germany (2.8%), Italy (2.7%), Malaysia (2.7%) and Spain (2.6%). The high increase in imports from India (+107.5%) can be explained by the fact that India became our main supplier of petroleum products since the last quarter of 2006.



4. Trade with Regional Organisations (Tables 12-14)

Total exports to African, Carribean and Pacific (ACP) States during the third quarter of 2007 stood at Rs 1,795 million, against imports of Rs 3,427 million (Table 12). The trade deficit with ACP countries worked out to Rs 1,632 million.

During the first nine months, total exports to these countries were valued at Rs 5,469 million and imports at Rs 9,168 million.

Our exports to COMESA countries during the third quarter of 2007 attained Rs 1,201 million, while imports from these countries amounted to Rs 1009 million resulting in a favourable balance of Rs 192 million for Mauritius.

During the first nine months, total exports to COMESA countries amounted to Rs 3,727 million and imports to Rs 2,835 million. Madagascar was the main buyer (75%). The main products exported to Madagascar were cotton fabrics and preparations used in animal feeding. Our main suppliers were Seychelles (32.4%), Egypt (24.6%) and Madagascar (14.0%). The main products imported from Seychelles were frozen yellowfin tunas and frozen skipjack while iron bars constituted the main product imported from Egypt.

Trade with SADC countries for the third quarter of 2007 showed a deficit of Rs 1,117 million, resulting from imports of a value of Rs 2,553 million and exports worth Rs 1,436 million.

For the first nine months of 2007, Mauritius imported Rs 7,415 million worth goods from SADC countries while exports were of the order of Rs 4,419 million. The main supplier was South Africa (84.8%) and our main buyers were Madagascar (63.2%) and South Africa (31.9%).

5. Trade in Freeport Zone (Table 2)

During the third quarter of 2007, total imports of the Freeport Zone stood at Rs 1,395 million. Compared to the third quarter of 2006, freeport imports dropped by 52.8%. Re-exports to overseas markets were valued at Rs 2,434 million, that is 20.4% lower than the previous quarter and 30.7% lower than the corresponding quarter of 2006.

For the first nine months of the year, total imports amounted to Rs 4,467 million compared to Rs 10,417 million in the corresponding period of 2006, showing a decrease of 57.1%. During the same period, re-exports amounted to Rs 8,054 million, 35.8% lower compared to Rs 12,540 million in the first nine months of 2006.

It is worth noting that trade carried out by the Freeport has contracted significantly in nominal terms on account of a decrease in trade of mobile phones by Freeport operators.

Notes

(1) Coverage

Trade figures are compiled according to the **General Trade System** as recommended by the United Nations. Using the national boundary as the statistical frontier, the General Trade System is a record of all goods entering (imports) and leaving the country (exports).

- Imports include goods brought in directly for domestic consumption plus goods imported into customs bonded warehouses
- Exports cover domestic exports and re-exports which include re-exports from customs bonded warehouses. Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin. Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.
- Ships stores and bunkers are included in total exports and are shown separately.
- Trade by parcel post is also included in imports and exports

(2) Valuation

Imports are valued on a C.I.F. (Cost, Insurance and Freight) basis whilst exports on a F.O.B. (Free On Board) basis.

C.I.F. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her imports of merchandise, other goods, etc. including all charges for transporting and insuring the goods from the country of exports to the given country but excluding the cost of unloading from the ship, aircraft etc. unless it is borne by the carrier.

F.O.B. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her exports of merchandise and other goods, including all costs of transporting the goods to the Customs frontier, export duties and the cost of loading the goods on to the carrier unless the latter cost is borne by the carrier.

(3) Classification

(i) Commodity Code

Commodities are coded according to the Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature (HS2002). However, for the purposes of economic analysis and to facilitate international comparison of trade by commodity data, the commodities are also classified according to the Standard International Trade Classification (Revision 3) or SITC Rev. 3. The HS and the SITC Rev. 3 are six and five digit codes respectively but have been extended to eight and seven digits to accommodate national requirements.
