

## External Trade – 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter 2007

### Introduction

This issue of the Economic and Social Indicators presents external trade statistics for the fourth quarter of 2007 and for the years 2006 and 2007. These statistics are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are at times revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) - Customs Department.

Thus while figures for 2006 published in this indicator are final, those for 2007 are subject to revision as and when the MRA - Customs Department submits latest amendments to the Central Statistics Office.

Data on international trade are compiled as per the recommendations of the United Nations General Trade System. According to this system, all goods entering and leaving the national frontier, including trading activities of the Freeport zone should be accounted for. However, it was not possible prior to 2002 to include Freeport transactions in our general trade statistics because of different processing systems at the Customs Department and at the Mauritius Freeport Authority. Since mid-October 2001, transactions of the Freeport are being lodged through the Customs Management System (CMS), thus making it possible to integrate data of the Freeport zone with those of Customs.

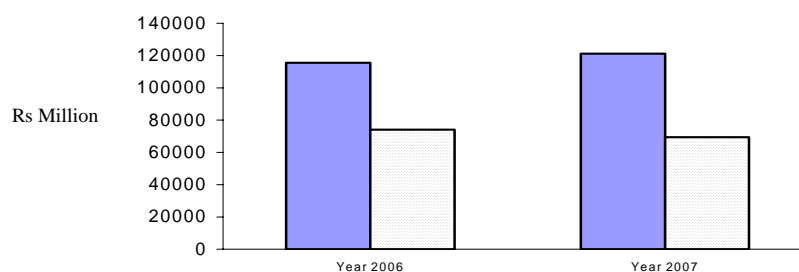
Hence, as from 2002, data on imports and exports include transactions through the Mauritius Freeport. It is to be noted that all exports of the Freeport are included in re-exports of Mauritius because it is not possible to distinguish between domestic exports and re-exports of freeport licensees. It is estimated that for the year 2007 some 48% of freeport exports are sourced locally.

### 1. Total value of trade and trade balance

Total international trade for the fourth quarter of 2007 was valued at Rs 56,662 million, i.e 16.0% higher than the previous quarter but 3.4% lower than the corresponding quarter of 2006. It is to be noted that import figures for the fourth quarter of 2007 include acquisition of aircraft worth Rs 2,730 million whilst for the corresponding quarter of 2006, import of aircraft was valued at Rs 6,700 million.

During the fourth quarter of 2007, total exports were valued at Rs 20,065 million against imports of Rs 36,597 million, resulting in a trade deficit of Rs 16,532 million.

For the year 2007, total exports amounted to Rs 69,482 million (-6.2%) and imports Rs 121,081 million (+4.8%) resulting in a trade deficit of Rs 51,599 million, i.e 24.4% higher than the previous year. Exclusive of aircraft, the trade deficit for 2007 worked out to Rs 48,869 million against Rs 35,790 million for 2006, representing an increase of 36.5%.



## 2. Exports

### 2.1 Total exports (Table 1)

Total export proceeds for the fourth quarter of 2007, including domestic exports<sup>1</sup>, re-exports<sup>2</sup> and ships' stores and bunkers, amounted to Rs 20,065 million, showing an increase of 15.2% over the previous quarter but a decrease of 7.2% over the corresponding quarter of 2006.

Domestic exports, which accounted for 74.3% of total exports, rose by 15.1% from the previous quarter to reach Rs 14,904 million. Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2006, domestic exports registered an increase of 3.7%. For the same period, re-exports went down by 39.4% as a result of a substantial decrease in the re-exports of mobile phones.

Total exports for the year 2007 attained Rs 69,482 million, showing a decrease of 6.2% over 2006. Exclusive of re-exports of aircraft worth Rs 1,150 million for the year 2006, the decrease in total exports was 4.7%. During the period under review, domestic exports rose by 5.6% while re-exports went down by 35.5%.

### 2.2 Exports by SITC section (Table 3)

Exports of "Food and live animals" for the year 2007 went down by 4.0% to reach Rs 19,380 million on account of a decrease of 17.2% in the exports of sugar together with an increase of 15.5% in "Fish and fish preparations".

During the year 2007, exports of "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" were valued at Rs 5,685 million, showing an increase of 2.8% compared to the previous year.

Export proceeds from "Miscellaneous manufactured articles", contributing 50.0% of total exports, increased by 10.6% in 2007 to reach Rs 32,037 million, mainly due to an increase of 13.1% in "Articles of apparel & clothing accessories", the most important component of this section.

It is worth pointing out that total exports of "Machinery and transport equipment" dropped significantly from Rs 12,077 million in the year 2006 to Rs 4,060 million in 2007 (-66.4%) as a result of a substantial fall in the re-exports of mobile phones to the United Arab Emirates (UAE).

### 2.3 Exports of Export Oriented Enterprises (Table 1)

During the year 2007, Export Oriented Enterprises comprising enterprises formerly operating with an EPZ certificate, and those establishments manufacturing goods for exports and holding a registration certificate issued by the Board of Investment exported some Rs 37,798 million worth of goods. Details on exports of these enterprises will be presented in the Economic and Social Indicators on the Export Oriented Enterprises, which will be released on 19 March 2007. It is to be noted that exports of EOE registered an increase of 12.5% over the year 2006.

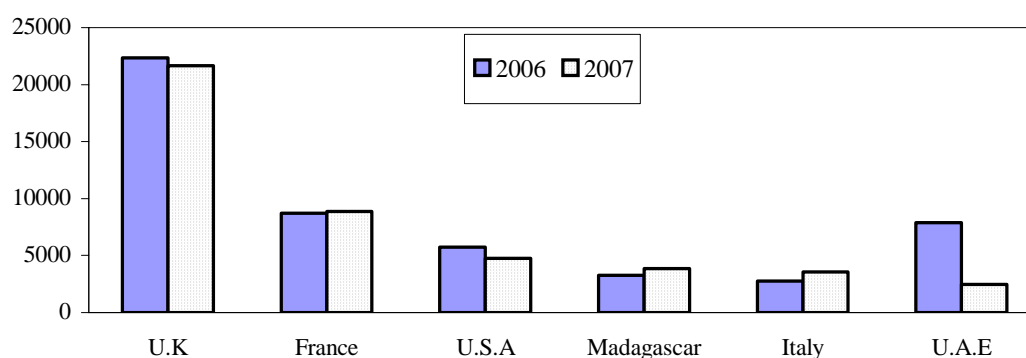
<sup>2</sup> Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.

## 2.4 Exports by Country of destination (Table 6)

Analysis by country of destination for the year 2007 shows that the European countries purchased some 68.6% of our exports for an amount of Rs 43,953 million. The United Kingdom remained the main market with Rs 21,673 million, or 33.8% of total exports. The other major destinations for our exports were France (13.8%), U.S.A (7.5%), Madagascar (6.0%), Italy (5.6%) and U.A.E (3.8%).

Compared to the year 2006, total exports to UK and U.S.A fell by 3.1% and 17.0% respectively while those to France, Belgium and South Africa showed increases of 1.8%, 12.9% and 34.9% respectively. A significant drop of 68.9% is recorded in total exports to the United Arab Emirates as a consequence of the decrease in re-exports of cellular phones to this country. Further details are given in Table 6.

## 3. Imports

### 3.1 Total imports (Table 1)

Total imports for the fourth quarter of 2007 reached Rs 36,597 million, showing an increase of 16.5% over the previous quarter. Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2006 total imports was lower by 1.2%. However, exclusive of aircraft during the fourth quarter of 2006 and 2007, the figures worked out to Rs 33,867 million for the fourth quarter of 2007, compared to Rs 30,354 for the corresponding period of 2006 showing an increase of 11.6%.

Total imports for the year 2007 amounted to Rs 121,081 million, showing an increase of 4.8% over 2006.

### 3.2 Imports by SITC section (Table 9)

Imports of “*Food and live animals*” for the year 2007 were valued at Rs 20,037 million, i.e 16.0 % higher than the year 2006.

The import bill of “*Mineral fuels, lubricants, & related products*” stood at Rs 22,184 million representing a rise of 14.8% compared to the corresponding period of last year.

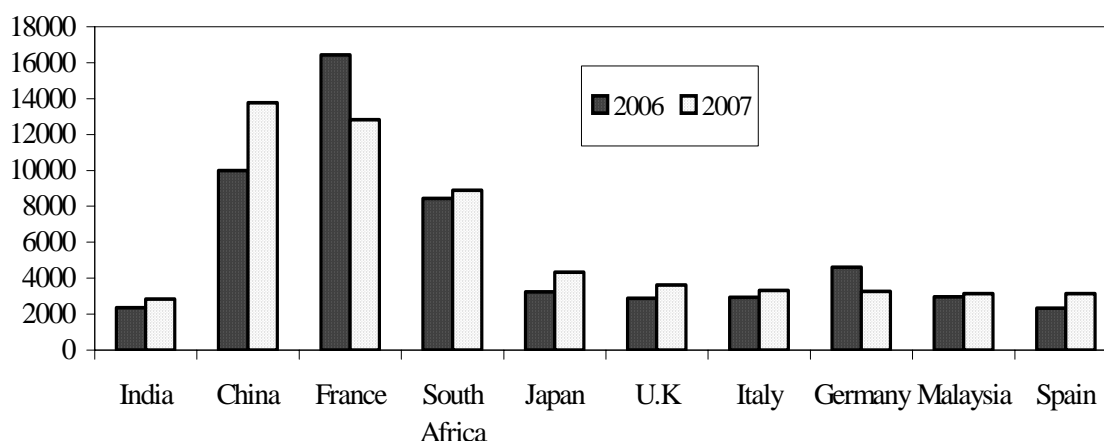
Imports of “*Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material*” for the period under review registered an increase of 13.7% to reach Rs 24,793 million while those of “*Machinery & transport equipment*” were valued at Rs 28,487 million, 20.7% lower as a result of decreases in the imports of cellular phones (-Rs 5,740 million) and aircraft (-Rs 3,971 million).

### 3.3 Imports by country of origin (Table 11)

During the year 2007, imports from the Asian continent, our major supplier, amounted to Rs 62,120 million with a share of 51.3% of total imports.

Our imports originated mainly from the following countries: India (21.2%), China (11.4%), France (10.6%), South Africa (7.4%), Japan (3.6%), U.K (3.0%), Italy (2.7%), Germany (2.7%), Malaysia (2.6%) and Spain (2.6%). The high increase in imports from India (+63.4%) can be explained by the fact that India became our main supplier of petroleum products since the last quarter of 2006.

### 4. Trade with Regional Organisations (Tables 12-14)

Total exports to African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) States during the fourth quarter of 2007 stood at Rs 2,117 million, against imports of Rs 3,714 million (Table 12). The trade deficit with ACP countries worked out to Rs 1,597 million.

During the year 2007, total exports to these countries were valued at Rs 7,585 million and imports at Rs 12,882 million.

Our exports to COMESA countries during the fourth quarter of 2007 attained Rs 1,410 million, while imports from these countries amounted to Rs 1,040 million resulting in a favourable balance of Rs 370 million for Mauritius.

During the year 2007, total exports to COMESA countries amounted to Rs 5,137 million and imports to Rs 3,875 million. Madagascar was the main buyer (75%). The main products exported to Madagascar were cotton fabrics and preparations used in animal feeding. Our main suppliers were Seychelles (29.8%), Egypt (22.2%) and Madagascar

(14.3%). The main products imported from Seychelles were frozen yellowfin tunas and frozen skipjack while iron bars constituted the main product imported from Egypt.

Trade with SADC countries for the fourth quarter of 2007 showed a deficit of Rs 1,373 million, resulting from imports of a value of Rs 3,113 million and exports worth Rs 1,740 million.

For the year 2007, Mauritius imported Rs 10,528 million worth goods from SADC countries while exports were of the order of Rs 6,159 million. The main supplier was South Africa (84.6%) and our main buyers were Madagascar (62.8%) and South Africa (32.6%).

## **5. Trade in Freeport Zone (Table 2)**

During the fourth quarter of 2007, total imports of the Freeport Zone stood at Rs 1,541 million. Compared to the fourth quarter of 2006, freeport imports dropped by 57.9%. Re-exports to overseas markets were valued at Rs 2,668 million, that is 9.6% lower than the previous quarter and 44.8% lower than the corresponding quarter of 2006.

For the year 2007, total imports amounted to Rs 6,008 million compared to Rs 14,074 million, showing a decrease of 57.3% over the previous year. During the same period, re-exports amounted to Rs 10,722 million, 38.3% lower compared to Rs 17,373 million in the year 2006.

It is worth noting that trade carried out by the Freeport has contracted significantly on account of a decrease in trade of mobile phones by Freeport operators.

## Notes

### (1) Coverage

Trade figures are compiled according to the **General Trade System** as recommended by the United Nations. Using the national boundary as the statistical frontier, the General Trade System is a record of all goods entering (imports) and leaving the country (exports).

- Imports include goods brought in directly for domestic consumption plus goods imported into customs bonded warehouses
- Exports cover domestic exports and re-exports which include re-exports from customs bonded warehouses. Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin. Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.
- Ships stores and bunkers are included in total exports and are shown separately.
- Trade by parcel post is also included in imports and exports

### (2) Valuation

Imports are valued on a C.I.F. (Cost, Insurance and Freight) basis whilst exports on a F.O.B. (Free On Board) basis.

C.I.F. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her imports of merchandise, other goods, etc. including all charges for transporting and insuring the goods from the country of exports to the given country but excluding the cost of unloading from the ship, aircraft etc. unless it is borne by the carrier.

F.O.B. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her exports of merchandise and other goods, including all costs of transporting the goods to the Customs frontier, export duties and the cost of loading the goods on to the carrier unless the latter cost is borne by the carrier.

### (3) Classification

#### (i) Commodity Code

Commodities are coded according to the Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature (HS2002). However, for the purposes of economic analysis and to facilitate international comparison of trade by commodity data, the commodities are also classified according to the Standard International Trade Classification (Revision 3) or SITC Rev. 3. The HS and the SITC Rev. 3 are six and five digit codes respectively but have been extended to eight and seven digits to accommodate national requirements.
