

## **External Trade – 3rd Quarter 2008**

### **Introduction**

This issue of the Economic and Social Indicators presents external trade statistics for the first three quarters of 2008 and for the years 2006 and 2007. These statistics are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are at times revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) - Customs Department.

Thus while figures for 2007 published in this indicator are final, those for 2008 are subject to revision as and when the MRA - Customs Department submits latest amendments to the Central Statistics Office.


Data on international trade are compiled as per the recommendations of the United Nations General Trade System. According to this system, all goods entering and leaving the national frontier, including trading activities of the Freeport zone should be accounted for. However, it was not possible prior to 2002 to include Freeport transactions in our general trade statistics because of different processing systems at the Customs Department and at the Mauritius Freeport Authority. Since mid-October 2001, transactions of the Freeport are being lodged through the Customs Management System (CMS), thus making it possible to integrate data of the Freeport zone with those of Customs.

Hence, as from 2002, data on imports and exports include transactions through the Mauritius Freeport. It is to be noted that all exports of the Freeport are included in re-exports of Mauritius because it is not possible to distinguish between domestic exports and re-exports of freeport licensees. It is estimated that for the third quarter of 2008 some 42% of freeport exports were sourced locally.

### **1. Total value of trade and trade balance**

Total international trade for the third quarter of 2008 was valued at Rs 52,607 million, i.e 9.5% higher than the previous quarter and 7.4% higher than the corresponding quarter of 2007.

During the third quarter of 2008, total exports were valued at Rs 18,249 million against imports of Rs 34,358 million. This resulted in a trade deficit of Rs 16,109 million, which when compared to deficits of Rs 16,187 million for the previous quarter and Rs 13,840 million for the corresponding quarter of 2007 represented changes of -0.5% and +16.4% respectively.



Based on past trends, total exports for the year 2008 are expected to be of the order of Rs 70,000 million, against Rs 130,000 million for imports. The trade deficit would be around Rs 60,000 million.

## 2. Exports

### 2.1 Total exports (Table 1)

Total export proceeds for the third quarter of 2008, including domestic exports<sup>1</sup>, re-exports<sup>2</sup> and ships' stores and bunkers, amounted to Rs 18,249 million, showing increases of 14.7% and 3.8% compared to the previous quarter and the corresponding quarter of 2007 respectively.

Domestic exports, which accounted for 66.1% of total exports, went up by 16.1% from Rs 10,396 million in the previous quarter to Rs 12,071 million in the third quarter of 2008. Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2007, domestic exports were lower by 7.9%. For the third quarter of 2008 re-exports stood at Rs 3,872 million, i.e higher by 28.3% and 26.7% compared to the previous quarter and the corresponding quarter of 2007 respectively. This rise in re-exports is attributable to an increase in re-exports of cellular phones and fish.

Total exports for the first nine months of 2008 reached Rs 48,477 million, showing a decrease of 2.4% over the first nine months of 2007.

### 2.2 Exports by SITC section - (First nine months 2008)

Exports of "Food and live animals" for the first nine months of 2008 amounted to Rs 12,079 million showing a decrease of 4.7% over the corresponding period of 2007. Exports of sugar went down by 16.7% while those of "fish and fish preparations" stayed almost at the same level (Table 3).

For the first nine months of 2008, exports of "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" were valued at Rs 3,957 million, lower by 10.3% when compared to exports for the first nine months of 2007, valued at Rs 4,413 million.

Total exports of "Machinery and transport equipment" for the first nine months of 2008 registered a slight increase of 2.7% compared to the corresponding nine months of 2007 as a result of an increase in re-exports of mobile phones to the United Arab Emirates (UAE) during the third quarter.

Export proceeds from "Miscellaneous manufactured articles", contributing 49.1% of total exports from January to September 2008, declined by 13.0% compared to the first nine months of 2007 to reach Rs 20,771 million. For the period under review, exports of "Articles of apparel & clothing accessories" representing 84.6% of exports of this section showed a decrease of 14.8%.

### 2.3 Exports of Export Oriented Enterprises(EOE) - (First nine months 2008)

During the first nine months of 2008, exports of the EOE amounted to Rs 25,510 million showing a decrease of 8.9% compared to the corresponding period of 2007 (Table 1). Details on exports of these enterprises will be presented in the Economic and Social Indicators on the Export Oriented Enterprises, which will be released on 12 December 2008.



## 2.4 Exports by Country of destination - (First nine months 2008)

Analysis of exports figures by country of destination for the first nine months of 2008 shows that the European countries purchased some 67.1% of our exports for an amount of Rs 28,355 million. The United Kingdom remained our main market with Rs 13,304 million, 31.5% of total exports. The other major destinations for our exports were France (14.2%), U.S.A (7.1%), Madagascar (6.4%), Italy (4.5%) and Spain (3.4%) - (Table 7).

Compared to the first nine months of 2007, total exports to UK, France, U.S.A and Madagascar went down by 8.7%, 5.9%, 20.8% and 3.1% respectively. A decrease of 27.5% was recorded in total exports to the United Arab Emirates as a consequence of the decrease in re-exports of cellular phones to that country for the first six months of 2008 but during the third quarter, there has been an improvement. Further details are given in Table 7.



## 3. Imports

### 3.1 Total imports - (Table 1)

Total imports for the third quarter of 2008 reached Rs 34,358 million, showing increases of 7.0% over the revised figure of Rs 32,104 million for the previous quarter and 9.4% over the corresponding quarter of 2007.

Total imports for the first nine months of 2008 amounted to Rs 97,238 million, showing an increase of 15.1% over the corresponding nine months of 2007.

### 3.2 Imports by SITC section - (First nine months 2008)

Imports of “*Food and live animals*” for the first nine months of 2008 were valued at Rs 18,089 million, i.e 30.4% higher than those of the corresponding period of last year. The most significant increases were noted in imports of rice (+69.8%), dairy products (+44.4%), and fish and fish preparations (+32.8%) – (Table 10).

The import bill of “*Mineral fuels, lubricants, & related products*” stood at Rs 22,448 million, representing a rise of 34.8% over the corresponding nine months of last year.

Imports of “*Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material*” for the first nine months declined by 4.1% to reach Rs 17,701 million.

For the first nine months of 2008, imports of “*Machinery & transport equipment*” which were valued at Rs 18,740 million went up by 5.0%, the most important increase being in “Power generating machinery & equipment” (+88.5%) and “Road vehicles” (+19.4%).


### **3.3 Imports by country of origin – (First nine months 2008)**

During the first nine months of 2008, imports from the Asian continent, our major supplier, amounted to Rs 53,334 million with a share of 54.8% of total imports.

Our imports originated mainly from the following countries: India (25.6%), China (10.8%), South Africa (7.6%), France (7.5%), Japan (4.2%), Spain (3.2%), Malaysia (2.4%), Italy (2.4%), Australia (2.4%) and U.S.A (2.4%). The high share of India in our import bill is explained by the fact that India is our main supplier of petroleum products since the last quarter of 2006 (Table 13).

### **4. Trade with Regional Organisations – (First nine months 2008)**

Total exports to African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) States during the first nine months of 2008 stood at Rs 5,520 million, against imports of Rs 11,043 million (Table 14). The trade deficit with ACP countries worked out to Rs 5,523 million. It is to be noted that in the third quarter of 2008, some Rs 395 million worth of liquefied petroleum gas was imported from Equatorial Guinea.

During the first nine months of 2008 our exports to COMESA countries attained Rs 3,789 million, while imports from these countries amounted to Rs 2,721 million resulting in a favourable trade balance of Rs 1,068 million for Mauritius. Madagascar was the main buyer with a share of 71.4%. The main products exported to Madagascar were preparations used in

animal feed and looped pile cotton fabrics. Our main suppliers were Kenya (27.3%), Egypt (23.0%), Seychelles (19.6%) and Madagascar (12.9%). Our imports from Kenya consisted mainly of cigarettes while urea, cleaning preparations and iron bars constituted the main products imported from Egypt. Frozen yellowfin tunas and frozen skipjack were the main products imported from Seychelles (Table 15).

Trade with SADC countries for the first nine months of 2008 showed a deficit of Rs 4,272 million, resulting from imports of a value of Rs 8,504 million and exports worth Rs 4,232 million. The main supplier was South Africa (87.5%) and our main buyers were Madagascar (63.9%) and South Africa (32.5%) - (Table 16).

## **5. Trade in Freeport Zone - (First nine months 2008)**

During the first nine months of 2008, total imports of the Freeport Zone stood at Rs 3,806 million, a figure which is lower by 14.9% compared to the corresponding period of last year. The main items imported through the Freeport were “Fish and fish preparations”, “Textile yarn, fabrics and made up articles” and “Telecommunications equipment, n.e.s; parts & accessories etc.” (Table 12).

Re-exports to overseas markets were valued at Rs 6,720 million, showing a decrease of 16.5% when compared to the first nine months of 2007. The main items re-exported through the Freeport were “Fish and fish preparations”, “Telecommunications equipment, n.e.s; parts & accessories etc.” and “Articles of apparel and clothing accessories” (Table 6). Items falling under “Articles of apparel and clothing accessories” were sourced mainly from Export Oriented Enterprises.

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## Notes

### (1) Coverage

Trade figures are compiled according to the **General Trade System** as recommended by the United Nations. Using the national boundary as the statistical frontier, the General Trade System is a record of all goods entering (imports) and leaving the country (exports).

- Imports include goods brought in directly for domestic consumption plus goods imported into customs bonded warehouses
- Exports cover domestic exports and re-exports which include re-exports from customs bonded warehouses. Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin. Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.
- Ships stores and bunkers are included in total exports and are shown separately.
- Trade by parcel post is also included in imports and exports

### (2) Valuation

Imports are valued on a C.I.F. (Cost, Insurance and Freight) basis whilst exports on a F.O.B. (Free On Board) basis.

C.I.F. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her imports of merchandise, other goods, etc. including all charges for transporting and insuring the goods from the country of exports to the given country but excluding the cost of unloading from the ship, aircraft etc. unless it is borne by the carrier.

F.O.B. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her exports of merchandise and other goods, including all costs of transporting the goods to the Customs frontier, export duties and the cost of loading the goods on to the carrier unless the latter cost is borne by the carrier.

### (3) Classification

#### (i) Commodity Code

Commodities are coded according to the Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature (HS2007). However, for the purposes of economic analysis and to facilitate international comparison of trade by commodity data, the commodities are also classified according to the Standard International Trade Classification (Revision 4) or SITC Rev. 4. The HS and the SITC Rev. 4 are six and five digit codes respectively but have been extended to eight and seven digits to accommodate national requirements.
