

External Trade – 4th Quarter 2009

Introduction

This issue of the Economic and Social Indicators presents external trade statistics for the fourth quarter of 2009 and for the years 2008 and 2009. These statistics are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are at times revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) - Customs Department.

Thus while figures for 2008 published in this indicator are final, those for 2009 are subject to revision as and when the MRA - Customs Department submits latest amendments to the Central Statistics Office.

Data on international trade are compiled as per the recommendations of the United Nations General Trade System. According to this system, all goods entering and leaving the national frontier, including trading activities of the Freeport zone should be accounted for. However, it was not possible prior to 2002 to include Freeport transactions in our general trade statistics because of different processing systems at the Customs Department and at the Mauritius Freeport Authority. Since mid-October 2001, transactions of the Freeport are being lodged through the Customs Management System (CMS), thus making it possible to integrate data of the Freeport zone with those of Customs.


Hence, as from 2002, data on imports and exports include transactions through the Mauritius Freeport. It is to be noted that all exports of the Freeport are included in re-exports of Mauritius because it is not possible to distinguish between domestic exports and re-exports of freeport licensees. It is estimated that for the year 2009 some 38% of freeport exports were sourced locally.

1. Total value of trade and trade balance

Total international trade for the fourth quarter of 2009 was valued at Rs 52,098 million, i.e 15.5% higher than the previous quarter and 5.5% lower than the corresponding quarter of 2008.

During the fourth quarter of 2009, total exports were valued at Rs 16,597 million against imports of Rs 35,501 million.

For the year 2009, total exports amounted to Rs 61,784 million, 9.1% lower than in 2008 and imports Rs 118,303 million, 10.5% lower than in 2008, the trade deficit being Rs 56,519 million, i.e 12.0% lower than in 2008. Exclusive of aircraft worth Rs 2,682 purchased in 2009, the trade deficit for the year 2009 compared to the previous year showed a decrease of 16.4 %



2. Exports

2.1 Total exports (Table 1)

Total export proceeds for the fourth quarter of 2009, including domestic exports¹, re-exports² and ships' stores and bunkers, amounted to Rs 16,597 million, showing an increase of 2.4% over the previous quarter but a decrease of 16.4% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2008.

Domestic exports, which accounted for 70.7% of total exports, went down by 5.3% from Rs 12,398 million in the previous quarter to Rs 11,736 million in the fourth quarter of 2009. Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2008, domestic exports were 15.6% lower. For the fourth quarter of 2009 re-exports stood at Rs 2,895 million, i.e higher by 8.0% compared to the previous quarter and lower by 9.3% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2008.

Total exports for the year 2009 reached Rs 61,784 million, showing a decrease of 9.1% over the year 2008.

2.2 Exports by SITC section - (Year 2009)

Exports of “Food and live animals” for the year 2009 amounted to Rs 18,416 million showing a slight decrease of 0.2% over the year 2008. Exports of sugar went down by 20.1% and those of “live primates” by 15.9% (Table 3).

For the year 2009, exports of “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” were valued at Rs 5,130 million, lower by 2.4% when compared to exports of a value of Rs 5,255 million in 2008.

Total exports of “Machinery and transport equipment” for the year 2009 registered a significant decrease of 65.4% compared to the year 2008 mainly attributable to lower re-exports of mobile phones by freeport operators.

Export proceeds from “Miscellaneous manufactured articles”, contributing 49.7% of total exports for year 2009, declined by 0.6% compared to 2008 to reach Rs 27,950 million. For the period under review, exports of “Articles of apparel & clothing accessories” representing 84.4% of exports of this section showed a decrease of 1.3%.

2.3 Exports of Export Oriented Enterprises(EOE) - (Year 2009)

During the year 2009, exports of the EOE is estimated to be around Rs 35,723 million showing an increase of 1.8% compared to 2008 (Table 1).


¹ Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin

² Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.

2.4 Exports by Country of destination - (Year 2009)

Analysis of exports figures by country of destination for the year 2009 shows that the European countries were the main buyers, purchasing some 66.5% of our exports for an amount of Rs 37,429 million. The United Kingdom remained the most important market with a share of 27.0% of total exports. The other major destinations for our exports were France (16.6%), U.S.A (8.3%), Madagascar (6.4%), Italy (5.5%) and South Africa (4.6%) - (Table 7).

Compared to the year 2008, total exports to our major markets namely UK went down by 24.7% while those for France, U.S.A, Madagascar, Italy and South Africa went up by 18.0%, 18.6%, 4.5%, 16.1% and 20.8% respectively. A decrease of 89.9% was also recorded in total exports to the United Arab Emirates as a consequence of the decrease in re-exports of cellular phones. However, it is interesting to note that exports to emerging markets of the region i.e South Africa, Reunion and Seychelles registered increases of the order of 20.8%, 15.3% and 19.9% respectively. Further details are given in Table 7.



3. Imports

3.1 Total imports - (Table 1)

Total imports for the fourth quarter of 2009 reached Rs 35,501 million, showing an increase of 22.8% over the figure of Rs 28,912 million for the previous quarter and an increase of 0.6% over the corresponding quarter of 2008.

Total imports for the year 2009 stood at Rs 118,303 million, showing a decrease of 10.5% over the year 2008. Exclusive of aircraft imported in 2009, total imports for 2009 went down by 12.7%.

3.2 Imports by SITC section - (Year 2009)

Imports of “*Food and live animals*” for the year 2009 amounted to Rs 22,103 million, i.e 7.2% lower than in 2008. The most significant decreases were noted in imports of rice (8.7%), dairy products 14.4%), and fish and fish preparations (16.1%) – (Table 10).

The import bill of “*Mineral fuels, lubricants, & related products*” stood at Rs 18,372 million, representing a fall of 35.2% over the previous year.

Imports of “*Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material*” for the year 2009 went down by 14.3% to reach Rs 21,449 million.

For the year 2009, imports of “*Machinery & transport equipment*” which were valued at Rs 27,673 million increased by 6.7% compared to 2008. Exclusive of the purchase of aircraft in 2009, imports of this section showed a decrease of 4.3%.

Imports of “*Miscellaneous manufactured articles*” stood at Rs 11,038 million, showing an increase of 2.2% compared to 2008.


3.3 Imports by country of origin – (Year 2009)

During the year 2009, imports from the Asian continent, our major supplier, amounted to Rs 58,884 million with a share of 49.8% of total imports.

Our imports originated mainly from the following countries: India (18.7%), China (12.6%), France (11.7%), South Africa (8.7%), Japan (3.2%), Malaysia (2.9%), Australia (2.8%) and Thailand (2.6%) (Table 13).

4. Trade with Regional Organisations – (Year 2009)

Total exports to African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) States during the year 2009 stood at Rs 8,061 million, against imports of Rs 13,590 million (Table 14). The trade deficit with ACP countries worked out to Rs 5,529 million.

During the year 2009 our exports to COMESA countries attained Rs 4,997 million, while imports from these countries amounted to Rs 3,319 million resulting in a favourable trade balance of Rs 1,678 million for Mauritius. Madagascar was the main buyer with a share of 72.2%. The main products exported to Madagascar were preparations used in animal feeding and yarn of carded wool. Our main suppliers were Kenya (32.8%), Egypt (25.1%), Madagascar (16.4%) and Swaziland (9.2%). Our imports from Kenya consisted mainly of cigarettes while urea, iron bars, cleaning preparations and processed cheese constituted the main products imported from Egypt. Food preparations and parts of slide fastener were the main products imported from Swaziland (Table 15).

Trade with SADC countries for the year 2009 showed a deficit of Rs 4,571 million, resulting from imports of a value of Rs 11,985 million and exports worth Rs 7,414 million. The main supplier was South Africa (85.4%) and our main buyers were Madagascar (48.6%) and South Africa (35.0%) - (Table 16).

5. Trade in Freeport Zone - (Year 2009)

During the year 2009, total imports of the Freeport Zone stood at Rs 5,837 million, a figure which is higher by 13.0% compared to 2008. The most significant increases were noted in imports of “Fish and fish preparations”, and “Crude materials, inedible, except fuels” (Table 12).

Re-exports to overseas markets were valued at Rs 7,326 million, showing a decrease of 16.3% when compared to the year 2008. This is mainly attributable to a contraction in the re-exports of “Telecommunications equipment, n.e.s” coupled with decreases in the re-exports of “Beverages and tobacco” and “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials” (Table 6).

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Notes

(1) Coverage

Trade figures are compiled according to the **General Trade System** as recommended by the United Nations. Using the national boundary as the statistical frontier, the General Trade System is a record of all goods entering (imports) and leaving the country (exports).

- Imports include goods brought in directly for domestic consumption plus goods imported into customs bonded warehouses
- Exports cover domestic exports and re-exports which include re-exports from customs bonded warehouses. Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin. Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.
- Ships stores and bunkers are included in total exports and are shown separately.
- Trade by parcel post is also included in imports and exports

(2) Valuation

Imports are valued on a C.I.F. (Cost, Insurance and Freight) basis whilst exports on a F.O.B. (Free On Board) basis.

C.I.F. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her imports of merchandise, other goods, etc. including all charges for transporting and insuring the goods from the country of exports to the given country but excluding the cost of unloading from the ship, aircraft etc. unless it is borne by the carrier.

F.O.B. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her exports of merchandise and other goods, including all costs of transporting the goods to the Customs frontier, export duties and the cost of loading the goods on to the carrier unless the latter cost is borne by the carrier.

(3) Classification

(i) Commodity Code

Commodities are coded according to the Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature (HS2007). However, for the purposes of economic analysis and to facilitate international comparison of trade by commodity data, the commodities are also classified according to the Standard International Trade Classification (Revision 4) or SITC Rev. 4. The HS and the SITC Rev. 4 are six and five digit codes respectively but have been extended to eight and seven digits to accommodate national requirements.
