

External Trade – 1st Quarter 2011

1. Introduction

This issue of the Economic and Social Indicators presents external trade statistics for the first quarter of 2011 and for the years 2009 and 2010. These statistics are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are at times revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) - Customs Department.

Thus while figures for 2009 published in this indicator are final, those for 2010 are subject to revision as and when the MRA - Customs Department submits latest amendments to the Central Statistics Office.

Data on international trade are compiled as per the recommendations of the United Nations General Trade System. According to this system, all goods entering and leaving the national frontier, including trading activities of the Freeport zone should be accounted for. However, it was not possible prior to 2002 to include Freeport transactions in our general trade statistics because of different processing systems at the Customs Department and at the Mauritius Freeport Authority. Since mid-October 2001, transactions of the Freeport are being lodged through the Customs Management System (CMS), thus making it possible to integrate data of the Freeport zone with those of Customs.

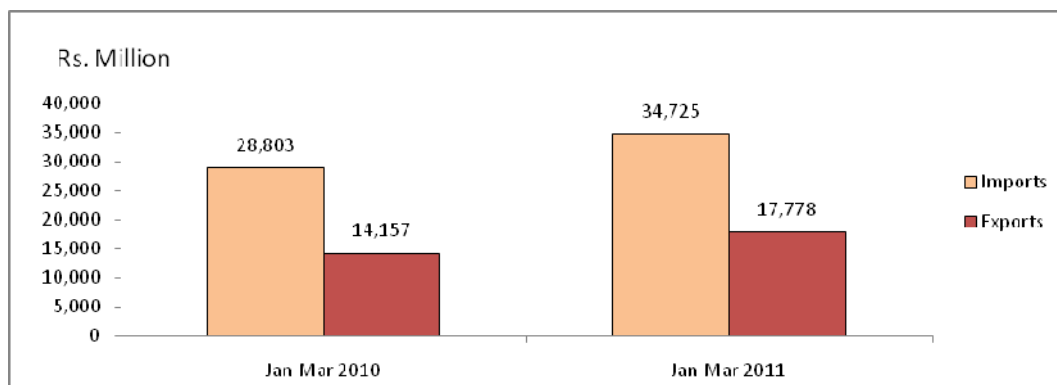
Hence, as from 2002, data on imports and exports include transactions through the Mauritius Freeport. It is to be noted that all exports of the Freeport are included in re-exports of Mauritius because it is not possible to distinguish between domestic exports and re-exports of freeport licensees. It is estimated that for the first quarter of 2011 some 28% of freeport exports were sourced locally.

2. Total value of trade and trade balance

Total international trade for the first quarter of 2011 was valued at Rs 52,503 million, i.e 11.1% lower than the previous quarter but 22.2% higher than the corresponding quarter of 2010.

During the first quarter of 2011, total exports stood at Rs 17,778 million against imports of Rs 34,725 million. This results in a trade deficit of Rs 16,947 million, compared to deficits of Rs 19,554 million (-13.3%) for the previous quarter and Rs 14,646 million (+15.7%) for the corresponding quarter of 2010.

3. Exports

3.1 Total exports (Table 1)

Total export proceeds for the first quarter of 2011, including domestic exports¹, re-exports² and ships' stores and bunkers, amounted to Rs 17,778 million, showing a decrease of 13.0% and a rise of 25.6% compared to the previous quarter and the corresponding quarter of 2010 respectively.

Domestic exports, which accounted for 71.6% of total exports, went down by 12.3% from Rs 14,522 million in the previous quarter to Rs 12,737 million in the first quarter of 2011. Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2010, domestic exports were higher by 30.0%. For the first quarter of 2011 re-exports stood at Rs 2,717 million, declining by 13.3% compared to the previous quarter but higher by 1.7% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2010.

3.2 Exports by SITC section (Table 3)

Exports of "Food and live animals" for the first quarter of 2011 amounted to Rs 4,973 million showing a decrease of 23.5% over the previous quarter. Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2010, total exports of this section increased by 38.0% mostly explained by an increase of 167.1% in the exports of sugar.

During the first quarter of 2011, exports of "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" were valued at Rs 1,653 million, showing increases of 10.6% compared to the previous quarter and 37.6% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2010. The 37.6% increase is explained mainly by higher export of textile yarns and fabrics and made-up articles (68.0%) and pearls and precious stones (26.5%).

Export proceeds from "Miscellaneous manufactured articles", contributing 47.6% of total exports amounted to Rs 7,358 million representing a decrease of 7.8% compared to the fourth quarter of 2010. Compared to the first quarter of 2010, exports of this section registered an increase of 14.0%.

3.3 Exports of Export Oriented Enterprises (Table 1)

During the first quarter of 2011 exports of the EOE amounted to Rs 9,605 million showing a decrease of 9.5% compared to the previous quarter and an increase of 13.3% compared to the corresponding period of 2010. More information of exports of these enterprises will be provided in the Economic and Social Indicators on the Export Oriented Enterprises, which will be released on 29 June 2011.

¹ Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin

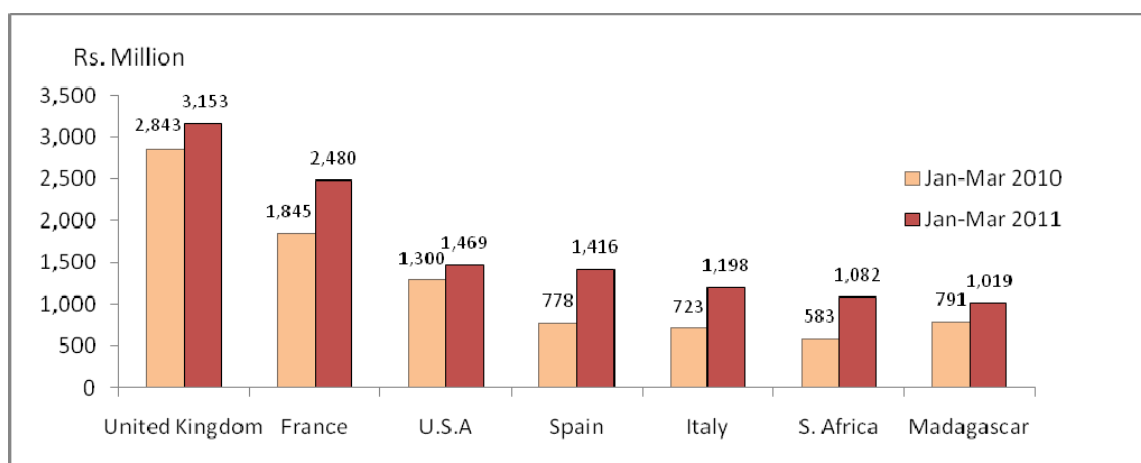
² Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.

3.4 Exports by Country of destination (Table 7)

Analysis by country of destination for the first quarter of 2011 shows that the European countries were the main buyers, purchasing 64.6% of our exports for a value of Rs 9,978 million. The United Kingdom remained our main client to whom we supplied 20.4% or Rs 3,153 million of our total exports. The other major destinations for our exports were France (16.1%), U.S.A (9.5%), Spain (9.2%), Italy (7.8%) and South Africa (7.0%).

Compared to the first quarter of 2010, total exports to our major markets namely France, USA and UK rose by 34.4%, 13.0% and 10.9% respectively. High increase of our exports were noted in Spain (+82.0%) and Italy (+65.7%). Further details are given in Table 7.

4. Imports

4.1 Total imports (Table 1)

Total imports for the first quarter of 2011 dropped by 11.7% from Rs 39,309 million in the previous quarter to Rs 34,725 million but increased by 20.6% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2010.

4.2 Imports by SITC section (Table 10)

Imports of “*Food and live animals*” for the first quarter of 2011 amounted Rs 5,923 million showing a decrease of 13.0% over the previous quarter and an increase of 2.1% over the corresponding quarter of 2010. It is to be noted that imports of “*Fish and fish preparations*” registered a decrease of 4.9% compared to the previous quarter but an increase of 19.2% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2010.

The import bill of “*Mineral fuels, lubricants, & related products*” stood at Rs 9,386 million for the first quarter of 2011 representing increases of 24.1% over the previous quarter and 63.6% compared to the corresponding quarter of last year.

Imports of “*Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material*” declined by 12.2% compared to the previous quarter but showed an increase of 24.7% compared to the first quarter of 2010.

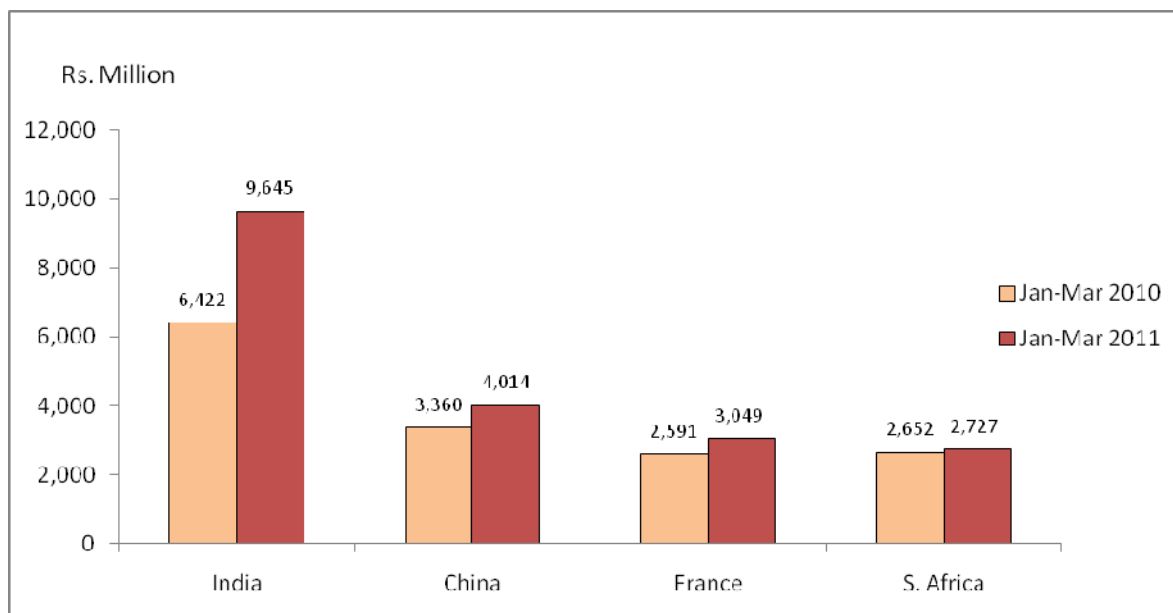
For the first quarter of 2011, imports of “*Machinery & transport equipment*” stood at Rs 5,693 million. Imports of this section dropped by 26.6% compared to the previous quarter and by 1.1% with respect to the corresponding quarter of 2010.

4.3 Imports by country of origin (Table 13)

During the first quarter of 2011, imports from the Asian continent, our major supplier, amounted to Rs 19,501 million with a share of 56.2% of total imports.

Our imports originated mainly from the following countries: India (27.8%), China (11.6%), France (8.8%), South Africa (7.9%), Spain (3.2%) and Japan (2.8%). The high share of India in our import bill is explained by the fact that India is our main supplier of petroleum products since the last quarter of 2006. Compared to the first quarter of 2010 changes noted in the import bill were: India (+50.2%), China (+19.5%) and France (+17.7%)

5. Trade with Regional Organisations (Tables 14-16)

Total exports to African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) States during the first quarter of 2011 stood at Rs 2,563 million, against imports of Rs 3,623 million (Table 14). The trade deficit with ACP countries worked out to Rs 1,060 million.

During the first quarter of 2011 our exports to COMESA countries attained Rs 1,417 million, while imports from these countries amounted to Rs 906 million resulting in a

positive trade balance of Rs 511 million for Mauritius. Madagascar was the main buyer with a share of 71.9%. The main products exported to Madagascar were yarn of carded wool. Our main suppliers were Kenya (34.4%), Egypt (21.2%), Zambia (15.5%) and Madagascar (8.6%). The main product imported from Kenya was cigarettes containing tobacco while iron and steel bar constituted the main product imported from Egypt.

Trade with SADC countries for the first quarter of 2011 showed a deficit of Rs 778 million, resulting from imports of a value of Rs 3,170 million and exports worth Rs 2,392 million. The main supplier was South Africa (86.0%) and our main buyers were South Africa (45.2%) and Madagascar (42.6%).

6. Trade in Freeport Zone (Table 2)

During the first quarter of 2011, total imports of the Freeport Zone stood at Rs 1,967 million, a figure which is lower by 21.6% compared to the previous quarter but higher by 47.3% compared to the first quarter of 2010. The main items imported through the Freeport were “Fish and fish preparations” and “Chemicals & related products” (Table 12).

Re-exports to overseas markets were valued at Rs 1,698 million, registering decreases of 21.6% and 10.5% when compared to the previous quarter and the corresponding quarter of 2010 respectively. The main items re-exported by the Freeport were “Fish and fish preparations” and “Articles of apparel and clothing accessories” sourced mainly from Export Oriented Enterprises (Table 6).

7. Forecast 2011

Based on past trends, total exports including ships’ stores and bunkers for the year 2011 are expected to be of the order of Rs 78,000 million, against Rs 161,000 million for imports. The trade deficit would be around Rs 83,000 million.

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Notes

(1) Coverage

Trade figures are compiled according to the **General Trade System** as recommended by the United Nations. Using the national boundary as the statistical frontier, the General Trade System is a record of all goods entering (imports) and leaving the country (exports).

- Imports include goods brought in directly for domestic consumption plus goods imported into customs bonded warehouses
- Exports cover domestic exports and re-exports which include re-exports from customs bonded warehouses. Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin. Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.
- Ships stores and bunkers are included in total exports and are shown separately.
- Trade by parcel post is also included in imports and exports

(2) Valuation

Imports are valued on a C.I.F. (Cost, Insurance and Freight) basis whilst exports on a F.O.B. (Free On Board) basis.

C.I.F. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her imports of merchandise, other goods, etc. including all charges for transporting and insuring the goods from the country of exports to the given country but excluding the cost of unloading from the ship, aircraft etc. unless it is borne by the carrier.

F.O.B. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her exports of merchandise and other goods, including all costs of transporting the goods to the Customs frontier, export duties and the cost of loading the goods on to the carrier unless the latter cost is borne by the carrier.

(3) Classification

(i) Commodity Code

Commodities are coded according to the Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature (HS2007). However, for the purposes of economic analysis and to facilitate international comparison of trade by commodity data, the commodities are also classified according to the Standard International Trade Classification (Revision 4) or SITC Rev. 4. The HS and the SITC Rev. 4 are six and five digit codes respectively but have been extended to eight and seven digits to accommodate national requirements.
