

External Trade – 2nd Quarter 2012

1. Introduction

This issue of the Economic and Social Indicators presents external trade statistics for the first and second quarters of 2012 and for the years 2010 and 2011. These statistics are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are at times revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) - Customs Department.

Thus while figures for 2010 published in this indicator are final, those for 2011 are subject to revision as and when the MRA - Customs Department submits latest amendments to Statistics Mauritius.

Data on international trade are compiled as per the recommendations of the United Nations General Trade System. According to this system, all goods entering and leaving the national frontier, including trading activities of the Freeport zone should be accounted for. It is to be noted that all exports of the Freeport are included in re-exports of Mauritius. It is estimated that for the second quarter of 2012 some 37% of freeport exports were sourced locally.

2. Total value of trade and trade balance

Total international trade for the second quarter of 2012 was valued at R 60,558 million, i.e. 9.7% higher than the previous quarter and 13.9% higher than the corresponding quarter of 2011.

During the second quarter of 2012, total exports were valued at R 20,206 million against imports of R 40,352 million. The resulting trade deficit for the second quarter of 2012 worked out to R 20,146 million, 7.6 % higher than the deficit of R 18,718 million in the previous quarter. Compared to the corresponding period of last year , the deficit was higher by 23.5% (R 16,309 million).



3. Exports

3.1 Total exports (Table 1)

Total export proceeds for the second quarter of 2012, including domestic exports¹, re-exports² and ships' stores and bunkers, amounted to R 20,206 million, showing increases of 10.8% over the previous quarter and 9.7% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2011.

Domestic exports, which accounted for 66.9% of total exports, went up by 4.6% from R 12,916 million in the previous quarter to R 13,510 million in the second quarter of 2012. Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2011, domestic exports were lower by 1.2%. In the second quarter of 2012 re-exports stood at R 3,190 million, higher by 22.5% and 33.3% compared to the previous quarter of 2012 and the corresponding quarter of 2011 respectively.

Total exports for the first semester of 2012 were R 38,438 million, showing an increase of 6.2% over the first semester of 2011.

3.2 Exports by SITC section (Table 3) - (First semester 2012)

Exports of “Food and live animals” for the first semester of 2012 amounted to R 11,024 million, showing an increase of 13.9% over the first semester of 2011. Exports of “fish and fish preparations” went up by 38.4% while those for sugar declined by 17.5%.

For the first semester of 2012, exports of “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” were valued at R 3,053 million, lower by 10.4% compared to exports of R 3,407 million for the first six months of 2011. The 10.4% decrease is explained by lower exports of “Textile yarn, fabrics, made-up articles” and “Pearls, precious & semi-precious stones”.

Total exports of “Machinery and transport equipment” for the first semester of 2012 increased by 39.6% from R 785 million in the first semester of 2011 to R 1096 million in the first semester of 2012. This increase is attributable to higher re-exports of “Machinery & transport equipment”.

Export proceeds for the first semester of 2012 from “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” decreased by 3.5% compared to the corresponding period of 2011 from R 15,481 million to R 14,942 million. Exports of “Articles of apparel & clothing accessories”, representing 79.0% of exports of this section decreased by 8.2% compared to the first semester of 2011.

3.3 Exports of Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE) - (First semester 2012)

During the first semester of 2012, exports of EOE amounted to R 22,499 million showing an increase of 0.7% compared to the corresponding period of 2011 (Table 1). Details on exports of these enterprises will be presented in the Economic and Social Indicators on the Export Oriented Enterprises, which will be released on 24 September 2012.


¹ Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin

² Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.

3.4 Exports by country of destination (Table 7) - (First semester 2012)

Analysis of export figures by country of destination for the first semester of 2012 shows that the European countries were our main buyers, purchasing some 59.6% of our exports for a value of R 19,193 million. The United Kingdom remained our main market with R 6,382 million, or 19.8% of total exports. The other major destinations for our exports were France (14.3%), U.S.A (9.6%), South Africa (8.8%), Spain (7.7%), Italy (6.6%), and Madagascar (6.6%) respectively .

Compared to the first six months of 2011, total exports to South Africa, Madagascar and Spain went up by 35.1%, 3.5% and 2.7% respectively while exports to Italy, France and UK fell by 11.6%, 8.1% and 7.0% respectively.



4. Imports

4.1 Total imports - (Table 1)

Total imports for the second quarter of 2012 reached R 40,352 million, showing increases of 9.2% and 16.2% compared to the previous quarter of 2012 and the corresponding quarter of 2011 respectively.

4.2 Imports by SITC section (Table 10) - (First semester 2012)

Total imports for the first semester of 2012 which amounted to R 77,302 million, increased by 11.8% over the corresponding semester of 2011.

Imports of “Food and live animals” for the first semester of 2012 were valued at R 13,576 million, higher by 11.3% compared to the corresponding period of last year. Increases were noted in imports of “wheat” (26.2%), “fish and fish preparations” (17.1%), “dairy products” (11.0%) and “meat and meat preparations” (3.8%).

The import bill of “*Mineral fuels, lubricants, & related products*” stood at R 18,114 million, representing an increase of 9.4% over the corresponding semester of last year.


Imports of “*Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material*” for the first semester fell by 2.8% to R 12,877 million. The main decreases being in “Textile yarn” (-40.6 %), “Paper, paperboard & articles thereof” (-17.0%) ,“Manufactures of metal” (-11.2%) and “Cotton fabrics” (-5.3%).

For the first semester of 2012, imports of “*Machinery & transport equipment*” which were valued at R 16,838 million increased by 45.1% compared to the same period of last year.

4.3 Imports by country of origin – (First semester 2012)

During the first semester of 2012, imports from the Asian continent, our major supplier, amounted to R 43,705 million, representing 56.5% of total imports.

Our imports originated mainly from the following countries: India (24.5%), China (15.0%), France (8.0%) and South Africa (6.3%). The high share of India in our import bill is explained by the fact that India is our main supplier of petroleum products (Table 13).



5. Trade with Regional Organisations – (First semester 2012)

Total exports to African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) States during the first semester of 2012 stood at R 6,255 million, against imports of R 7,205 million (Table 14). The trade deficit with ACP countries worked out to R 950 million.

During the first semester of 2012, our exports to COMESA countries attained R 3,101 million while imports from these countries amounted to R 1,994 million resulting in a favourable trade balance of R 1,107 million for Mauritius. Madagascar was the main buyer with a share of 68.9%. Our main suppliers were Kenya (33.9%) and Egypt (28.8%) (Table 15).

Trade with SADC countries for the first semester of 2012 showed a deficit of R 469 million, resulting from imports of a value of R 6,233 million and exports worth R 5,764 million. The main supplier was South Africa (77.8%) and our main buyers were South Africa (49.3%) and Madagascar (37.1%) (Table 16).

6. Trade in Freeport Zone - (First semester 2012)

During the first semester of 2012, total imports of the Freeport Zone stood at R 5,051 million, higher by 31.6% compared to the corresponding period of last year (R 3,838 million). The main items imported through the Freeport were “Machinery and transport equipment”, “Beverages and tobacco” and “Fish and fish preparations” (Table 12).

Re-exports to overseas markets valued at R 3,598 million, increased by 18.0% when compared to the first semester of 2011 (R 3,050 million). The main items re-exported by the Freeport were “Fish and fish preparations”, “Machinery & Transport equipment” and “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (Table 6).

7. Forecast 2012

Based on recent past trends and indicative information from various sources, total exports (including ship's stores & bunkers) for the year 2012 are expected to be of the order of R 82,000 million against R 163,000 million for imports. The trade deficit would be around R 81,000 million.

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Notes

(1) Coverage

Trade figures are compiled according to the **General Trade System** as recommended by the United Nations. Using the national boundary as the statistical frontier, the General Trade System is a record of all goods entering (imports) and leaving the country (exports).

- Imports include goods brought in directly for domestic consumption plus goods imported into customs bonded warehouses
- Exports cover domestic exports and re-exports which include re-exports from customs bonded warehouses. Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin. Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.
- Ships stores and bunkers are included in total exports and are shown separately.
- Trade by parcel post is also included in imports and exports

(2) Valuation

Imports are valued on a C.I.F. (Cost, Insurance and Freight) basis whilst exports on a F.O.B. (Free On Board) basis.

C.I.F. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her imports of merchandise, other goods, etc. including all charges for transporting and insuring the goods from the country of exports to the given country but excluding the cost of unloading from the ship, aircraft etc. unless it is borne by the carrier.

F.O.B. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her exports of merchandise and other goods, including all costs of transporting the goods to the Customs frontier, export duties and the cost of loading the goods on to the carrier unless the latter cost is borne by the carrier.

(3) Classification

(i) Commodity Code

Commodities are coded according to the Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature (HS2012). However, for the purposes of economic analysis and to facilitate international comparison of trade by commodity data, the commodities are also classified according to the Standard International Trade Classification (Revision 4) or SITC Rev. 4. The HS and the SITC Rev. 4 are six and five digit codes respectively but have been extended to eight and seven digits to accommodate national requirements.
