

External Trade – 3rd Quarter 2013

1. Introduction

This issue of Economic and Social Indicators presents external trade statistics for the first three quarters of 2013 and for the years 2011 and 2012. These statistics are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are at times revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) - Customs Department.

Thus, while revised figures for 2012 are published in this indicator those for 2013 are provisional and subject to revision around July 2014, when the MRA - Customs Department submits latest yearly amendments to Statistics Mauritius.


Data on international trade are compiled as per the recommendations of the United Nations General Trade System. According to this system, all goods entering and leaving the national frontier, including trading activities of the Freeport zone should be accounted for.

It is to be noted that all exports of the Freeport are included in re-exports of Mauritius. It is estimated that for the third quarter of 2013 some 19% of Freeport exports were sourced locally.

2. Total value of trade and trade balance

Total international trade for the third quarter of 2013 was valued at R 64,448 million, i.e. 6.7% higher than the previous quarter and 9.9% higher when compared to the corresponding quarter of 2012.

During the third quarter of 2013, total exports were valued at R 22,481 million against imports of R 41,967 million. The resulting deficit for the third quarter of 2013 worked out to R 19,486 million, 15.3% higher than the deficit of R 16,894 million of the previous quarter. Compared to the corresponding quarter of last year, the deficit was higher by 1.3% (R 19,229 million).



3. Exports

3.1 Total exports (Table 1) – 3rd Quarter 2013

Total export proceeds for the third quarter of 2013, including domestic exports¹, re-exports² and ship's stores and bunkers amounted to R 22,481 million, showing an increase of 3.4% compared to the previous quarter. This increase is mainly explained by rises in the exports of “Machinery and transport equipment” (+98.9%), “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (+10.2%), “Fish & fish preparations” (+4.9%), and “Articles of apparel & clothing accessories” (+3.8%), partly offset by decreases in “Cane sugar” (-6.3%) and “Ship’s stores and bunkers” (-5.6%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2012, total exports for the third quarter rose by 14.1%, mainly explained by increases in “Ship’s stores and bunkers” (59.2%), “Machinery and transport equipment” (+42.9%), “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (+33.2%), “Fish & fish preparations” (+28.3%), and “Live primates” (+25.5%), partly offset by drops in exports of “Articles of apparel & clothing accessories” (-4.4%) and “Cane sugar” (-1.7%).

Domestic exports, which accounted for 65.8% of total exports, went down by 1.5% from R 15,036 million in the previous quarter to R 14,803 million in the third quarter of 2013. Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2012, domestic exports were higher by 3.6%. In the third quarter of 2013, re-exports stood at R 3,719 million, i.e. higher by 47.8% compared to the previous quarter and 27.3% when compared to the corresponding quarter of 2012.

Total exports for the first nine months of 2013 reached R 64,588 million, showing an increase of 11.4% over the corresponding period of 2012. The 2013 exports consisted mainly of “Articles of apparel and clothing accessories” (R 17,327 million), “Ships’ stores and bunkers” (R 12,022 million), “Fish and fish preparations” (R 10,955 million) and “Cane sugar” (R 7,249 million).

3.2 Exports by SITC section (Table 3) - (First nine months 2013)

Exports of “Food and live animals” for the first nine months of 2013 amounted to R 20,391 million, showing a rise of 16.4% over the corresponding period of 2012. Exports of “Cane Sugar” and “Fish and fish preparations” rose by 21.8% and 18.4% respectively.

For the first nine months of 2013, exports of “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” were valued at R 5,369 million, higher by 18.1% compared to the figure of R 4,547 million for the first nine months of 2012. This increase is explained by higher exports of “Pearls, precious and semi-precious stones (+48.2%)” and “Textile yarn, fabrics, made up articles” (+21.3%).

Export proceeds for “Miscellaneous manufactured articles”, representing 41.0% of total exports for the first nine months of 2013, decreased by 2.9% compared to the corresponding period of 2012. Exports of “Articles of apparel & clothing accessories”, representing 80.4% of exports of this section, decreased by 1.8% compared to the first nine months of 2012.

¹ Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin

² Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.


3.3 Exports of Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE) - (First nine months 2013)

During the first nine months of 2013, exports of EOE amounted to R 35,110 million showing an increase of 5.0% compared to the corresponding period of 2012 (Table 1). Further details on these transactions will be presented in the issue of the Economic and Social Indicator on Export Oriented Enterprises, to be released on 17 December 2013.

3.4 Exports by country of destination (Table 7) - (First nine months 2013)

Analysis of exports figures by country of destination for the first nine months of 2013 shows that the European countries were our main buyers, purchasing some 58.1% of our exports for a value of R 30,529 million. The United Kingdom remained our main market with R 9,057 million, 17.2% of total exports. The other major destinations for our exports were France (12.2%), Italy (10.2%), U.S.A (9.8%), South Africa (8.6%), Madagascar (6.4%) and Spain (5.9%).

Compared to the first nine months of 2012, total exports to Italy, U.S.A and Madagascar went up by 56.8%, 4.1% and 1.0% respectively, while those to Spain, South Africa and France fell by 21.6%, 4.5% and 3.0% respectively.



4. Imports

4.1 Total imports - (Table 1)

Total imports for the third quarter of 2013 reached R 41,967 million, showing increases of 8.6% over the previous quarter of 2013 and 7.8% when compared to the corresponding quarter of 2012. The increase in imports over the previous quarter is mainly due to rise in imports of “Food and live animals” (+26.3%), “Machinery and transport equipment” (+17.3%), “Chemicals and related products” (+10.2%) and “Crude materials, inedible, except fuels” (+9.6%), partly offset by a decrease of 8.4% in “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related products”.

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2012, imports in the third quarter of 2013 rose by 7.8% due to increases in imports of “Crude materials, inedible, except fuels” (+32.3%), “Food and live animals” (+27.2%), and “Machinery and transport equipment” (+12.7%).

4.2 Imports by SITC section (Table 10) - (First nine months 2013)

Total imports for the first nine months of 2013 amounted to R 117,878 million, showing an increase of 1.4% over the corresponding period of 2012.

Around 22.4% of imports consisted of “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials” (R 26,428 million), 18.3% of “Machinery and transport equipment” (R 21,580 million) and 17.2% of “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by materials” (R 20,235 million).

Imports of “Food and live animals” for the first nine months of 2013 were valued at R 23,496 million, higher by 13.5% compared to the corresponding period of last year. Increases were noted in imports of “Fish and fish preparations” (+25.7%), “Rice” (+23.1%), “Wheat” (+22.5%) and “Vegetables and fruits” (+14.6%).


The import bill of “Mineral fuels, lubricants, & related products” stood at R 26,428 million, representing an increase of 2.7% over the corresponding nine months of last year.

Imports of “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” for the first nine months of 2013 fell by 1.7% to reach R 20,235 million from R 20,582 million during the corresponding period of 2012. While imports of “Cotton fabrics” and “Pearls, precious & semi - precious stones” increased by 19.4% and 18.6% respectively, decreases were noted in “Manufactures of metals” (-19.4%), “Cement” (-10.0%), and “Iron and steel” (-7.3%).

For the first nine months of 2013, imports of “Machinery & transport equipment” which were valued at R 21,580 million decreased by 11.5% compared to the same period of last year.

4.3 Imports by country of origin – (First nine months 2013)

During the first nine months of 2013, imports from the Asian continent, our major supplier, amounted to R 66,019 million, representing 56.0% of total imports. Our imports originated mainly from the following countries: India (25.0%), China (14.2%), France (8.1%) and South Africa (6.2%) - (Table 13).



5. Trade with Regional Organisations – (First nine months 2013)

Total exports to African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) States during the first nine months of 2013 stood at R 9,885 million, against imports of R 11,714 million (Table 14). The trade deficit with ACP countries worked out to R 1,829 million.

During the first nine months of 2013, our exports to COMESA member states attained R 4,786 million, while imports from these countries amounted to R 3,890 million resulting in a favourable trade balance of R 896 million for Mauritius. Madagascar was the main buyer with a share of 70.0%. Our main suppliers were Seychelles (27.3%), Kenya (24.7%) and Egypt (19.1%) – (Table 15).

Trade with SADC countries for the first nine months of 2013 showed a deficit of R 1,165 million, resulting from imports value of R 10,163 million against exports worth R 8,998 million. The main supplier was South Africa (71.8%) and our main buyers were South Africa (50.2%) and Madagascar (37.2%) - (Table 16).

6. Trade in Freeport Zone - (First nine months 2013)

During the first nine months of 2013, total imports of the Freeport Zone stood at R 6,061 million, lower by 15.4% compared to the corresponding period of last year. The main items imported through the Freeport were “Fish and fish preparations”, “Machinery and transport equipment” and “Chemicals and related products” (Table 12).

Re-exports to overseas markets valued at R 5,797 million, rose by 4.6% when compared to the first nine months of 2012. The main items re-exported through the Freeport were “Fish and fish preparations”, “Chemicals and related products” and “Machinery and transport equipment” (Table 6).

7. Forecast 2013

Based on past trends and indicative information from various sources, total exports (including ship's stores and bunkers) for the year 2013 are expected to be of the order of R 87,000 million, against R 170,000 million for imports. The trade deficit would be around R 83,000 million.

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Notes

(1) Coverage

Trade figures are compiled according to the **General Trade System** as recommended by the United Nations. Using the national boundary as the statistical frontier, the General Trade System is a record of all goods entering (imports) and leaving the country (exports).

- Imports include goods brought in directly for domestic consumption plus goods imported into customs bonded warehouses
- Exports cover domestic exports and re-exports which include re-exports from customs bonded warehouses. Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin. Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.
- Ships stores and bunker are included in total exports and are shown separately.
- Trade by parcel post is also included in imports and exports

(2) Valuation

Imports are valued on a C.I.F. (Cost, Insurance and Freight) basis whilst exports on a F.O.B. (Free On Board) basis.

C.I.F. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her imports of merchandise, other goods, etc. including all charges for transporting and insuring the goods from the country of exports to the given country but excluding the cost of unloading from the ship, aircraft etc. unless it is borne by the carrier.

F.O.B. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her exports of merchandise and other goods, including all costs of transporting the goods to the Customs frontier, export duties and the cost of loading the goods on to the carrier unless the latter cost is borne by the carrier.

(3) Classification

Commodity Code

Commodities are coded according to the Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature (HS2012). However, for the purposes of economic analysis and to facilitate international comparison of trade by commodity data, the commodities are also classified according to the Standard International Trade Classification (Revision 4) or SITC Rev. 4. The HS and the SITC Rev. 4 are six and five digit codes respectively but have been extended to eight and seven digits to accommodate national requirements.
