

## External Trade – 1st Quarter 2014

### 1. Introduction

This issue of Economic and Social Indicators presents external trade statistics for the first quarter of 2014 and for the years 2012 and 2013. These statistics are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are at times revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) - Customs Department.

Thus, while revised figures for 2012 are published in this indicator those for 2013 and 2014 are provisional. It is to be noted that 2013 figures are subject to revision around July 2014, when the MRA - Customs Department submits latest yearly amendments to Statistics Mauritius.

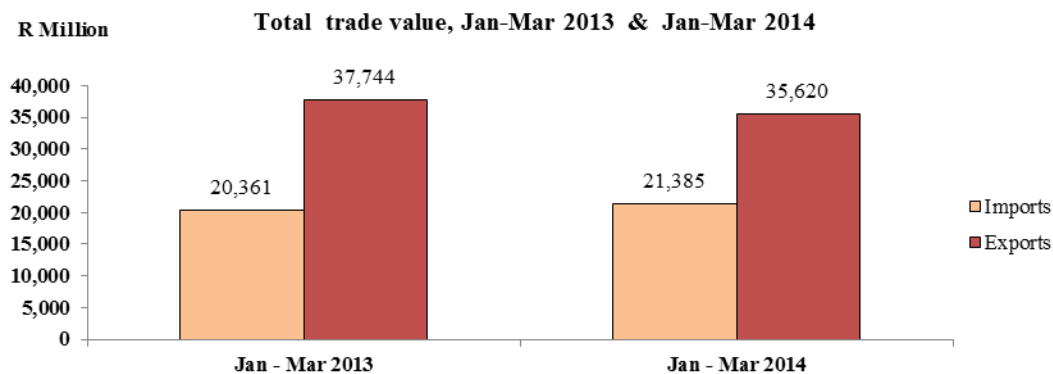
Data on international trade are compiled as per the recommendations of the United Nations General Trade System. According to this system, all goods entering and leaving the national frontier, including trading activities of the Freeport zone should be accounted for.

It is to be noted that all exports of the Freeport are included in re-exports of Mauritius. It is estimated that for the first quarter of 2014 some 13% of Freeport exports were sourced locally.

### 2. Total value of trade and trade balance

Total international trade for the first quarter of 2014 was valued at R 57,005 million, i.e. 19.4% lower than the previous quarter and 1.9% lower when compared to the corresponding quarter of 2013.

During the first quarter of 2014, total exports were valued at R 21,385 million against imports of R 35,620 million. The resulting deficit for the first quarter of 2014 worked out to R 14,235 million, 39.8% lower than the deficit of R 23,640 million of the previous quarter. Compared to the corresponding quarter of last year, the deficit was lower by 18.1% (R 17,383 million).



### 3. Exports

#### 3.1 Total exports (Table 1) – 1st Quarter 2014

Total export proceeds for the first quarter of 2014, including domestic exports<sup>1</sup>, re-exports<sup>2</sup> and ship's stores and bunkers amounted to R 21,385 million, showing a decrease of 9.2% compared to the previous quarter. This decrease is mainly explained by drops in the exports of "Machinery and transport equipment" (-37.7%), "Fish & fish preparations" (-7.4%), "Articles of apparel & clothing accessories" (-7.3%), "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (-5.7%) and "Cane sugar" (-5.7%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2013, total exports for the first quarter rose by 5.0%, mainly explained by increases in "Machinery and transport equipment" (+102.8%), "Live primates" (+26.1%), "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (+21.6%) and "Ship's stores and bunkers" (+7.7%), partly offset by a drop in exports of "Cane sugar" (-16.5%).

Domestic exports, which accounted for 63.7% of total exports, went down by 6.6% from R 14,577 million in the previous quarter to R 13,620 million in the first quarter of 2014. Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2013, domestic exports were lower by 1.3%. In the first quarter of 2014, re-exports stood at R 3,597 million, i.e. lower by 25.4% compared to the previous quarter and higher by 33.6% when compared to the corresponding quarter of 2013.

#### 3.2 Exports by SITC section (Table 3) - 1st Quarter 2014

Exports of "Food and live animals" for the first quarter of 2014 amounted to R 6,196 million, showing a decrease of 6.5% over the corresponding period of 2013. Exports of "Live Primates" rose by 26.1% while those of "Cane Sugar" and "Fish and fish preparations" fell by 16.5% and 0.8% respectively.

For the first quarter of 2014, exports of "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" were valued at R 1,857 million, higher by 21.6% compared to the figure of R 1,527 million for the first quarter of 2013. This increase is explained by higher exports of "Pearls, precious and semi-precious stones (+55.7%)" and "Textile yarn, fabrics, made up articles" (+10.1%).

Export proceeds for "Miscellaneous manufactured articles", representing 40.8% of total exports for the first quarter of 2014, increased by 4.5% compared to the corresponding period of 2013. Exports of "Articles of apparel & clothing accessories", representing 80.3% of exports of this section, increased by 4.1% compared to the first quarter of 2013.

<sup>2</sup> Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.

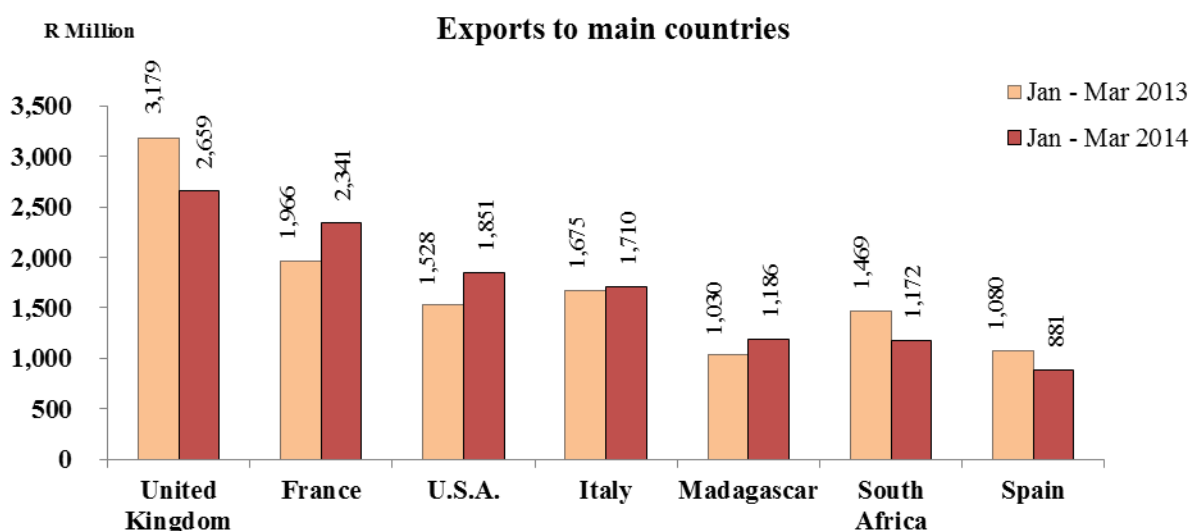
#### 3.3 Exports of Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE) - 1st Quarter 2014

During the first quarter of 2014, exports of EOE amounted to R 10,968 million showing an increase of 0.5% compared to the corresponding period of 2013 (Table 1). Further details on these transactions will be presented in the issue of the Economic and Social Indicator on Export Oriented Enterprises, to be released on 30 June 2014.

### 3.4 Exports by country of destination (Table 7) - (First quarter 2014)

Analysis of exports figures by country of destination for the first quarter of 2014 shows that the European countries were our main buyers, purchasing some 55.6% of our exports for a value of R 9,569 million. The United Kingdom remained our main market with R 2,659 million, 15.4% of total exports. The other major destinations for our exports were France (13.6%), U.S.A (10.8%), Italy (9.9%), Madagascar (6.9%) and South Africa (6.8%).

Compared to the first quarter of 2013, total exports to U.S.A, France and Madagascar went up by 21.1%, 19.1% and 15.1% respectively, while those to South Africa and United Kingdom fell by 20.2% and 16.4% respectively.



## 4. Imports

### 4.1 Total imports - (Table 1)

Total imports for the first quarter of 2014 reached R 35,620 million, showing decreases of 24.5% over the previous quarter and 5.6% when compared to the corresponding quarter of 2013. The decrease in imports over the previous quarter is mainly due to drops in imports of “Machinery and transport equipment” (-35.7%), “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (-26.1%), “Chemicals and related products” (-23.9%), “Food and live animals” (-15.3%) and “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related products” (-12.9%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2013, imports in the first quarter of 2014 fell by 5.6% due to decreases in imports of “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related products” (-17.3%), “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (-8.9%) and “Food and live animals” (-7.0%), partly offset by an increase in imports of “Machinery and transport equipment” (+18.1%).

## 4.2 Imports by SITC section (Table 10) - (First quarter 2014)

Total imports for the first quarter of 2014 amounted to R 35,620 million, showing a decrease of 5.6% over the corresponding period of 2013.

Around 23.1% of imports consisted of “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials” (R 8,244 million), 19.5% of “Machinery and transport equipment” (R 6,955 million) and 16.6% of “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by materials” (R 5,900 million).

Imports of “Food and live animals” for the first quarter of 2014 were valued at R 6,832 million, lower by 7.0% compared to the corresponding period of last year. Decreases were noted in imports of “Fish and fish preparations” (-30.0%) and “Wheat” (-28.6%), partly offset by increases in “Dairy products and bird’s eggs” (+19.4%), “Rice” (+13.8%), “Meat and meat preparations” (+11.8%) and “Vegetables and fruits” (+8.2%).

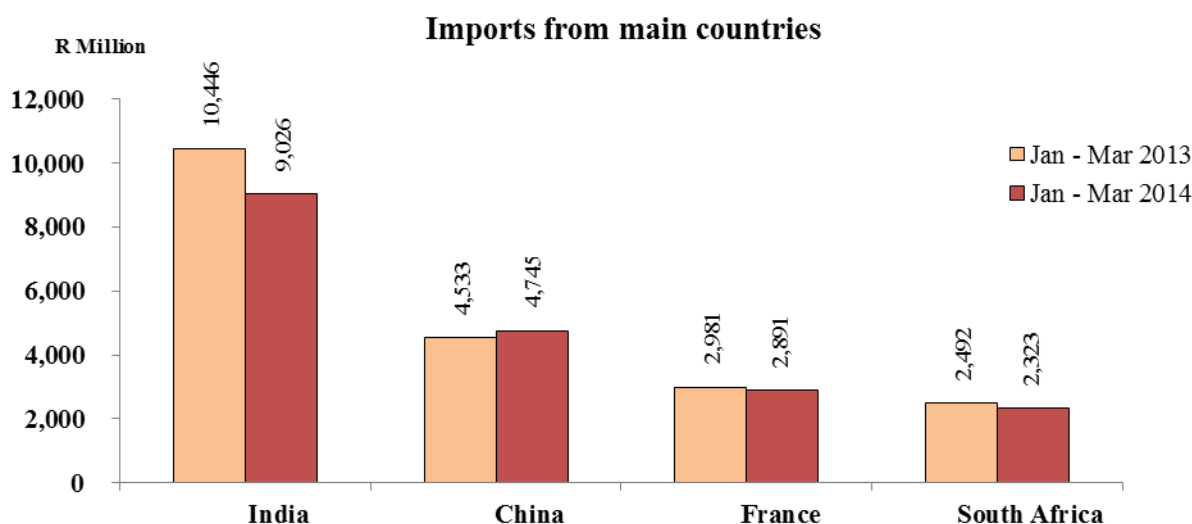
The import bill of “Mineral fuels, lubricants, & related products” stood at R 8,244 million, representing a decrease of 17.3% over the corresponding quarter of last year.

Imports of “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” for the first quarter of 2014 fell by 8.9% to reach R 5,900 million from R 6,477 million during the corresponding period of 2013. While imports of “Pearls, precious & semi-precious stones” and “Textile yarn” increased by 52.2% and 8.2% respectively, decreases were noted in “Manufactures of metals” (-38.8%), “Cement” (-28.2%), “Paper, paperboard & articles thereof” (-16.1%), “Iron and steel” (-13.4%) and “Cotton fabrics” (-7.6%).

For the first quarter of 2014, imports of “Machinery & transport equipment” which were valued at R 6,955 million increased by 18.1% compared to the same period of last year.

## 4.3 Imports by country of origin – (First quarter 2014)

During the first quarter of 2014, imports from the Asian continent, our major supplier, amounted to R 19,507 million, representing 54.8% of total imports. Our imports originated mainly from the following countries: India (25.3%), China (13.3%), France (8.1%) and South Africa (6.5%) - (Table 13).



## 5. Trade with Regional Organisations – (First quarter 2014)

Total exports to African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) States during the first quarter of 2014 stood at R 2,817 million, against imports of R 3,552 million (Table 14). The trade deficit with ACP countries worked out to R 735 million.

During the first quarter of 2014, our exports to COMESA member states attained R 1,532 million, while imports from these countries amounted to R 998 million resulting in a favorable trade balance of R 534 million for Mauritius. Madagascar was the main buyer with a share of 77.5%. Our main suppliers were Kenya (36.9%) and Egypt (20.2%) – (Table 15).

Trade with SADC countries for the first quarter of 2014 showed a deficit of R 392 million, resulting from imports value of R 3,007 million against exports worth R 2,615 million. The main supplier was South Africa (77.2%) and our main buyers were Madagascar (45.4%) and South Africa (44.8%) - (Table 16).

## 6. Trade in Freeport Zone - (First quarter 2014)

During the first quarter of 2014, total imports of the Freeport Zone stood at R 2,190 million, lower by 4.9% compared to the corresponding period of last year. The main items imported through the Freeport were “Fish and fish preparations”, “Machinery and transport equipment” and “Chemicals and related products” (Table 12).

Re-exports to overseas markets valued at R 2,647 million, rose by 46.5% when compared to the first quarter of 2013. The main items re-exported through the Freeport were “Fish and fish preparations” and “Machinery and transport equipment” (Table 6).

## 7. Forecast 2014

Based on past trends and indicative information from various sources, total exports (including ship’s stores and bunkers) for the year 2014 are expected to be of the order of R 91,000 million, against R 175,000 million for imports. The trade deficit would be around R 84,000 million.

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## Notes

### (1) Coverage

Trade figures are compiled according to the **General Trade System** as recommended by the United Nations. Using the national boundary as the statistical frontier, the General Trade System is a record of all goods entering (imports) and leaving the country (exports).

- Imports include goods brought in directly for domestic consumption plus goods imported into customs bonded warehouses
- Exports cover domestic exports and re-exports which include re-exports from customs bonded warehouses. Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin. Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.
- Ships stores and bunker are included in total exports and are shown separately.
- Trade by parcel post is also included in imports and exports

### (2) Valuation

Imports are valued on a C.I.F. (Cost, Insurance and Freight) basis whilst exports on a F.O.B. (Free On Board) basis.

C.I.F. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her imports of merchandise, other goods, etc. including all charges for transporting and insuring the goods from the country of exports to the given country but excluding the cost of unloading from the ship, aircraft etc. unless it is borne by the carrier.

F.O.B. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her exports of merchandise and other goods, including all costs of transporting the goods to the Customs frontier, export duties and the cost of loading the goods on to the carrier unless the latter cost is borne by the carrier.

### (3) Classification

#### Commodity Code

Commodities are coded according to the Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature (HS2012). However, for the purposes of economic analysis and to facilitate international comparison of trade by commodity data, the commodities are also classified according to the Standard International Trade Classification (Revision 4) or SITC Rev. 4. The HS and the SITC Rev. 4 are six and five digit codes respectively but have been extended to eight and seven digits to accommodate national requirements.
