

External Trade – 2nd Quarter 2014

1. Introduction

This issue of Economic and Social Indicators presents external trade statistics for the second quarter of 2014 and for the years 2012 and 2013. These statistics are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are at times revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) - Customs Department.

Thus, while revised figures for 2012 are published in this indicator those for 2013 and 2014 are provisional. It is to be noted that 2013 figures are actually under revision following submission of latest yearly amendments from the MRA - Customs Department to Statistics Mauritius.

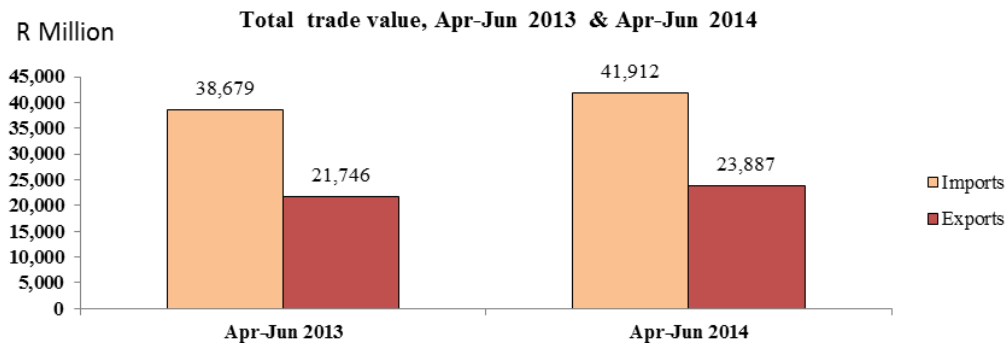
Data on international trade are compiled as per the recommendations of the United Nations General Trade System. According to this system, all goods entering and leaving the national frontier, including trading activities of the Freeport zone should be accounted for.

It is to be noted that all exports of the Freeport are included in re-exports of Mauritius. It is estimated that for the second quarter of 2014 some 12% of Freeport exports were sourced locally.

2. Total value of trade and trade balance

Total international trade for the second quarter of 2014 was valued at R 65,799 million, i.e. 15.4% higher than the previous quarter and 8.9% higher when compared to the corresponding quarter of 2013.

During the second quarter of 2014, total exports were valued at R 23,887 million against imports of R 41,912 million. The resulting deficit for the second quarter of 2014 worked out to R 18,025 million, 26.6% higher than the deficit of R 14,235 million of the previous quarter. Compared to the corresponding quarter of last year, the deficit was higher by 6.4% (R 16,933 million).



3. Exports

3.1 Total exports (Table 1) – 2nd Quarter 2014

Total export proceeds for the second quarter of 2014, including domestic exports¹, re-exports² and ship's stores and bunkers amounted to R 23,887 million, showing an increase of 11.7% compared to the previous quarter. This increase is mainly explained by rises in the exports of "Machinery and transport equipment" (+172.1%), comprising mostly of re-exports of "Telecommunications equipment & accessories". The other main increases are: "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (+23.8%) and "Articles of apparel & clothing accessories" (+14.8%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2013, total exports for the second quarter rose by 9.8%. This is mainly explained by increases in "Machinery and transport equipment" (+487.4%), which is due to increases in the re-exports of "Telecommunications equipment & accessories". Increases were also noted in the exports of "Live primates" (+85.7%), and "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (+25.8%), partly offset by drops in "Ship's stores & bunkers" (-31.8%), exports of "Cane sugar" (-10.5%) and "Fish and fish preparations" (-6.3%).

Domestic exports, which accounted for 65.2% of total exports, increased by 14.3% from R 13,620 million in the previous quarter to R 15,572 million in the second quarter of 2014. Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2013, domestic exports were higher by 3.6%. In the second quarter of 2014, re-exports stood at R 5,455 million, i.e. higher by 51.7% and 116.7% when compared to the previous quarter and the corresponding quarter of 2013 respectively.

3.2 Exports by SITC section (Table 3) – First Semester 2014

Exports of "Food and live animals" for the first semester of 2014 amounted to R 12,751 million, showing a decrease of 5.1% over the corresponding period of 2013. Exports of "Cane Sugar" and "Fish and fish preparations" fell by 13.6% and 3.7% respectively, partly offset by a rise in "Live Primates" (+54.2%).

For the first semester of 2014, exports of "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" were valued at R 4,156 million, higher by 23.9% compared to the figure of R 3,355 million for the same period of 2013. This increase is explained by higher exports of "Pearls, precious and semi-precious stones" (+53.2%) and "Textile yarn, fabrics, made up articles" (+10.8%).

Export proceeds for "Miscellaneous manufactured articles", representing 39.4% of total exports for the first semester of 2014, increased by 7.4% compared to the corresponding period of 2013. Exports of "Articles of apparel & clothing accessories", representing 80.6% of exports of this section, increased by 7.7% compared to the same period of 2013.

¹ Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin

² Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.

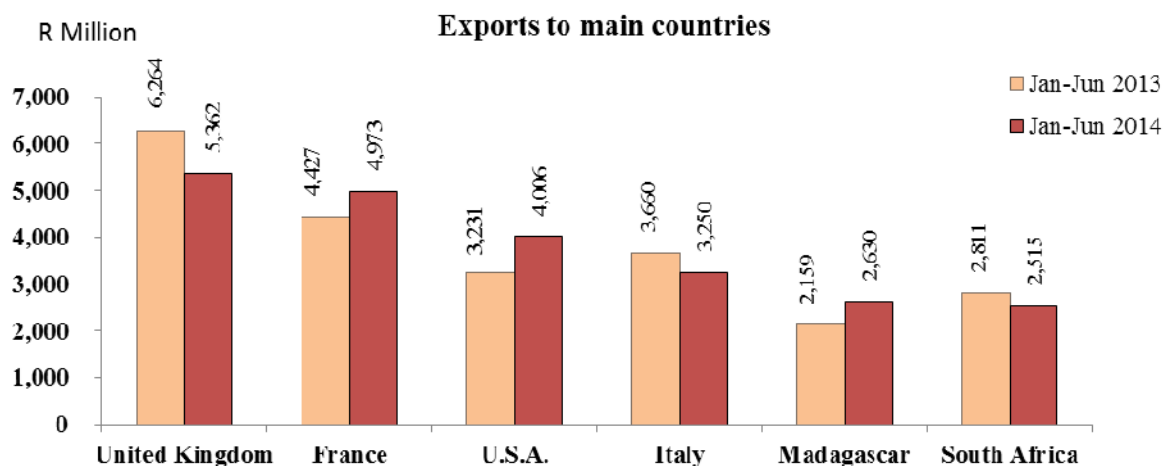
3.3 Exports of Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE) – First semester 2014

During the first semester of 2014, exports of EOE amounted to R 23,475 million showing an increase of 2.0% compared to the corresponding period of 2013 (Table 1). Further details on these transactions will be presented in the issue of the Economic and Social Indicator on Export Oriented Enterprises, to be released on 23 September 2014.

3.4 Exports by country of destination (Table 7) - (First semester 2014)

Analysis of exports figures by country of destination for the first semester of 2014 shows that the European countries were our main buyers, purchasing some 52.4% of our exports for a value of R 20,027 million. The United Kingdom remained our main market with R 5,362 million, 14.0% of total exports. The other major destinations for our exports were France (13.0%), U.S.A (10.5%), Italy (8.5%), Madagascar (6.9%) and South Africa (6.6%).

Compared to the first six months of 2013, total exports to U.S.A, Madagascar and France went up by 24.0%, 21.8% and 12.3% respectively, while those to United Kingdom, Italy and South Africa fell by 14.4%, 11.2% and 10.5% respectively.



4. Imports

4.1 Total imports (Table 1) - 2nd Quarter 2014

Total imports for the second quarter of 2014 reached R 41,912 million, showing increases of 17.7% over the previous quarter and 8.4% when compared to the corresponding quarter of 2013. The increase in imports over the previous quarter is mainly due to increases in imports of “Machinery and transport equipment” (+41.0%), “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (+41.8%), “Chemicals and related products” (+25.5%), and “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (+17.5%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2013, imports in the second quarter of 2014 rose by 8.4% mainly due to increases in imports of “Machinery and transport equipment” (+34.6%), “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (9.8%) and “Chemicals & related products” (+11.4%), partly offset by a decrease in imports of “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related products” (-2.7%).

4.2 Imports by SITC section (Table 10) - (First semester 2014)

Total imports for the first semester of 2014 amounted to R 77,532 million, showing an increase of 1.5% over the corresponding period of 2013. Around 21.6% of imports in the first semester of 2014 consisted of “Machinery and transport equipment” (R 16,764 million), 21.4% of “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials” (R 16,605 million) and 16.5% of “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by materials” (R 12,831 million).

Imports of “Food and live animals” for the first semester of 2014 were valued at R 14,003 million, lower by 3.3% compared to the corresponding period of last year. Decreases were noted in imports of “Fish and fish preparations” (-23.8%) and “Wheat” (-28.0%), partly offset by increases in “Dairy products and bird’s eggs” (+28.9%), “Rice” (+18.0%), “Cereal preparations” (+9.6%) and “Meat and meat preparations” (+9.0%).

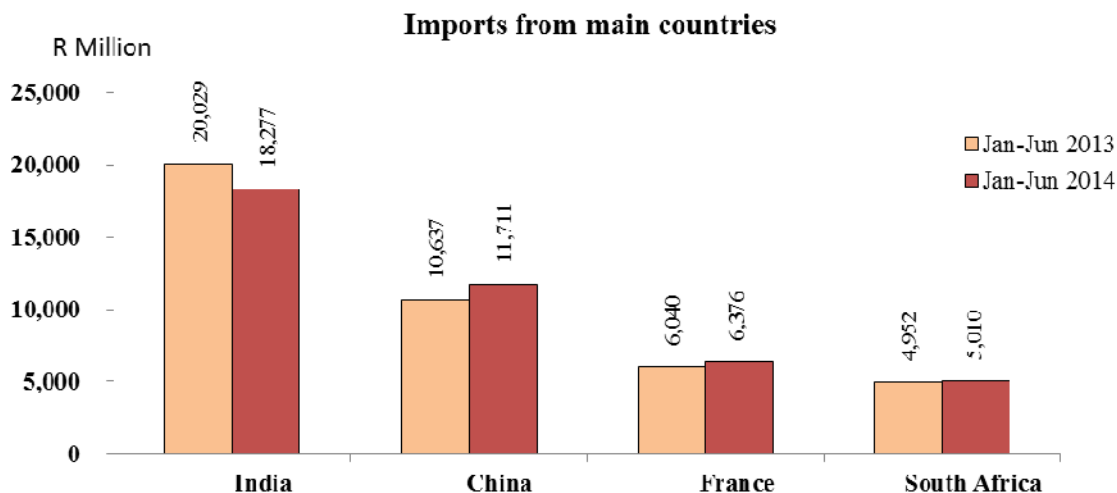
The import bill of “Mineral fuels, lubricants, & related products” stood at R 16,605 million, representing a decrease of 10.5% over the corresponding semester of last year.

Imports of “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” for the first semester of 2014 fell by 4.1% to reach R 12,831 million from R 13,385 million during the corresponding period of 2013. While imports of “Pearls, precious & semi-precious stones” increased by 17.6%, decreases were noted in “Manufactures of metals” (-23.8%), “Iron and steel” (-12.8%) and “Cement” (-11.5%).

For the first semester of 2014, imports of “Machinery & transport equipment” which were valued at R 16,764 million increased by 27.2% compared to the same period of last year. This is mainly due to increases of “Telecommunications equipment & accessories” (+163.9%), mostly meant for re-exports.

4.3 Imports by country of origin – (First semester 2014)

During the first semester of 2014, imports from the Asian continent, our major supplier, amounted to R 43,851 million, representing 56.6% of total imports. Our imports originated mainly from the following countries: India (23.6%), China (15.1%), France (8.2%) and South Africa (6.5%) - (Table 13).



5. Trade with Regional Organisations – (First semester 2014)

Total exports to African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) States during the first semester of 2014 stood at R 6,372 million, against imports of R 7,544 million (Table 14). The trade deficit with ACP countries worked out to R 1,172 million.

During the first semester of 2014, our exports to COMESA member states attained R 3,353 million, while imports from these countries amounted to R 2,195 million resulting in a favorable trade balance of R 1,158 million for Mauritius. Madagascar was the main buyer with a share of 78.4%. Our main suppliers were Kenya (30.8%) and Madagascar (24.8%) – (Table 15).

Trade with SADC countries for the first semester of 2014 showed a deficit of R 819 million, resulting from imports value of R 6,495 million against exports worth R 5,676 million. The main supplier was South Africa (77.1%) and our main buyers were Madagascar (46.3%) and South Africa (44.3%) - (Table 16).

6. Trade in Freeport Zone - (First semester 2014)

During the first semester of 2014, total imports of the Freeport Zone stood at R 6,552 million, higher by 62.7% compared to the corresponding period of last year. The main items imported through the Freeport were “Machinery and transport equipment”, “Fish and fish preparations”, and “Chemicals and related products” (Table 12).

Re-exports to overseas markets valued at R 6,990 million, rose by 108.0% when compared to the first semester of 2013. The main items re-exported through the Freeport were “Telecommunications equipment & accessories” and “Fish and fish preparations” (Table 6).

7. Forecast 2014

Based on past trends and indicative information from various sources, total exports (including ship’s stores and bunkers) for the year 2014 are expected to be of the order of R 94,000 million, against R 175,000 million for imports. The trade deficit would be around R 81,000 million.

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Notes

(1) Coverage

Trade figures are compiled according to the **General Trade System** as recommended by the United Nations. Using the national boundary as the statistical frontier, the General Trade System is a record of all goods entering (imports) and leaving the country (exports).

- Imports include goods brought in directly for domestic consumption plus goods imported into customs bonded warehouses
- Exports cover domestic exports and re-exports which include re-exports from customs bonded warehouses. Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin. Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.
- Ships stores and bunker are included in total exports and are shown separately.
- Trade by parcel post is also included in imports and exports

(2) Valuation

Imports are valued on a C.I.F. (Cost, Insurance and Freight) basis whilst exports on a F.O.B. (Free On Board) basis.

C.I.F. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her imports of merchandise, other goods, etc. including all charges for transporting and insuring the goods from the country of exports to the given country but excluding the cost of unloading from the ship, aircraft etc. unless it is borne by the carrier.

F.O.B. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her exports of merchandise and other goods, including all costs of transporting the goods to the Customs frontier, export duties and the cost of loading the goods on to the carrier unless the latter cost is borne by the carrier.

(3) Classification

Commodity Code

Commodities are coded according to the Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature (HS2012). However, for the purposes of economic analysis and to facilitate international comparison of trade by commodity data, the commodities are also classified according to the Standard International Trade Classification (Revision 4) or SITC Rev. 4. The HS and the SITC Rev. 4 are six and five digit codes respectively but have been extended to eight and seven digits to accommodate national requirements.
