

## External Merchandise Trade Statistics – 4th Quarter and Year 2015

### 1. Introduction

This issue of Economic and Social Indicators presents external merchandise trade statistics by quarter for the years 2014 and 2015. These statistics are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are at times revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) - Customs Department.

Thus, while revised figures for 2014 are published in this indicator, those for 2015 are provisional and subject to revision following submission of latest yearly amendments by the MRA - Customs Department.

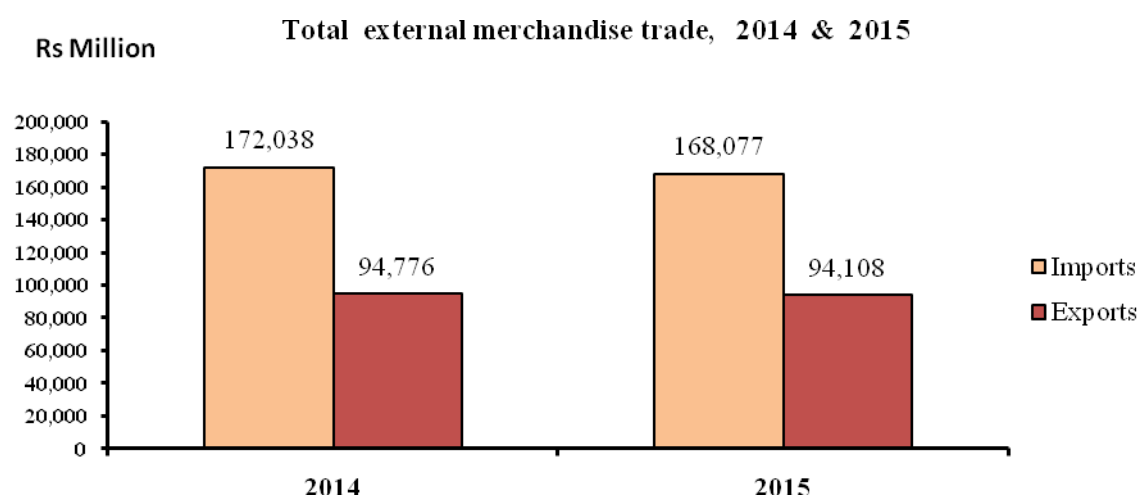
Data on external merchandise trade are compiled as per the recommendations of the United Nations General Trade System. According to this system, all goods entering and leaving the national frontier, including trading activities of the Freeport zone should be accounted for.

It is to be noted that all exports of the Freeport are included in re-exports of Mauritius. It is estimated that for the fourth quarter of 2015 some 9% of Freeport exports were sourced locally.

### 2. Total value of trade and trade balance

Total external merchandise trade for the fourth quarter of 2015 was valued at Rs 66,879 million, i.e. 1.3% higher than the previous quarter and 9.0% lower compared to the corresponding quarter of 2014.

During the year 2015, total trade were valued at Rs 262,185 million i.e 1.7% lower than in 2014. Total exports (including ship's stores & bunkers) were valued at Rs 94,108 million against imports of Rs 168,077 million. The resulting trade deficit worked out to Rs 73,969 million, 4.3% lower than the deficit of Rs 77,262 million of the previous year.



### 3. Exports

#### 3.1 Total exports (Tables 1 & 3) – 4th Quarter 2015

Total export proceeds for the fourth quarter of 2015, including domestic exports<sup>1</sup>, re-exports<sup>2</sup> and ship's stores and bunkers amounted to Rs 22,529 million, showing a decrease of 6.3% compared to the previous quarter. This is mainly explained by a decrease in the exports of "Machinery and transport equipment" (-70.3%), partly offset by increases in exports of "Chemicals and related products" (+28.5%) and "Miscellaneous manufactured goods" (+1.7%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2014, total exports for the fourth quarter of 2015 declined by 8.4%. This is mainly explained by decreases in "Machinery and transport equipment" (-74.7%) and "Ship's stores & bunkers" (-41.3%), partly offset by increases in "Chemicals and related products" (+21.6%) and "Miscellaneous manufactured goods" (+14.9%).

Domestic exports amounting to Rs 15,613 million, accounted for 69.3% of total exports in the fourth quarter of 2015. Compared to the previous quarter figure of Rs 15,352 million, an increase of 1.7% was noted while comparison against the corresponding quarter of 2014 showed an increase of 11.7%.

In the fourth quarter of 2015, re-exports stood at Rs 4,866 million, i.e. lower by 28.2% compared to the previous quarter and by 31.8% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2014. That was mainly due to decreases in the re-exports of "Telecommunications equipment & accessories" by 78.3% compared to the previous quarter and by 84.8% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2014.

#### 3.2 Exports by SITC section (Tables 1 & 3) – Year 2015

Around 34.9% of total exports in the year 2015 consisted of "Miscellaneous manufactured goods" (Rs 32,859 million), 26.6% of "Food and live animals" (Rs 25,066 million) and 14.1% of "Machinery and transport equipment" (Rs 13,289 million).

Compared to 2014, total exports declined by 0.7% mainly due to a decrease of 41.2% in "Ship's stores and bunkers". The main changes at section level were as follows:

"Machinery and transport equipment" increased by 14.7%, due to an increase in the re-exports of "Telecommunications equipment & accessories" (+11.8%).

"Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" rose by 6.0 %, mainly explained by higher exports of "Pearls, precious and semi-precious stones" (+15.5%)".

"Miscellaneous manufactured goods" went up by 7.3% due to rise in the exports of "Articles of apparel & clothing accessories" (+5.3%).

"Food and live animals" showed a slight increase of 0.3%. However, within the section, exports of "Live primates", "Fish and fish preparations" and "Cane sugar" fell by 8.2%, 3.4% and 0.7% respectively.

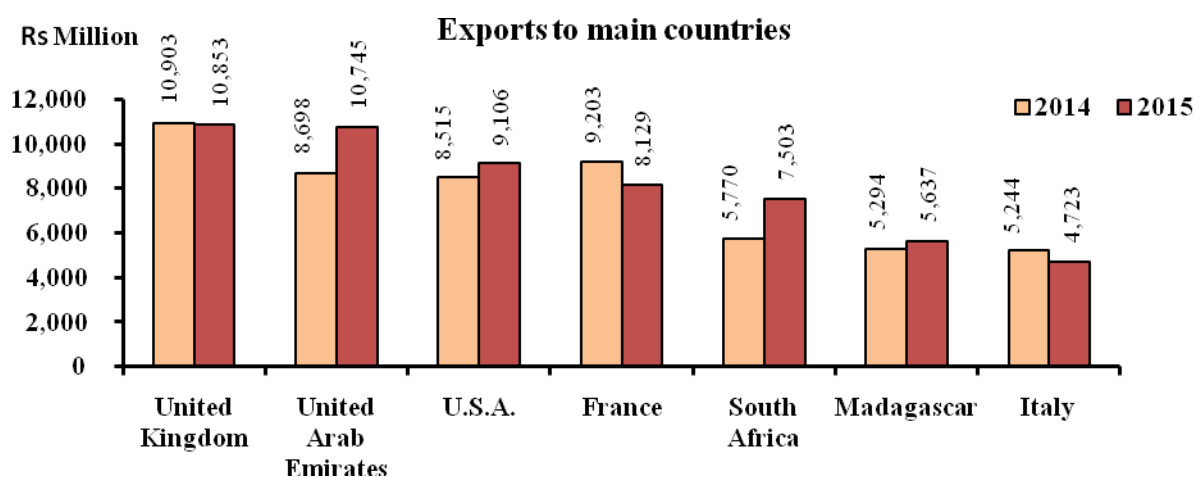
### 3.3 Exports of Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE) – Year 2015

During the year 2015, exports of EOE amounted to Rs 48,687 million, compared to Rs 49,069 million in 2014 (Table 1). Further details on these transactions will be presented in the issue of the Economic and Social Indicator on Export Oriented Enterprises, to be released on 29 March 2016.

### 3.4 Exports by country of destination (Table 7) – Year 2015

Analysis of exports figures by country of destination for the year 2015 shows that the European countries were our main buyers, purchasing some 42.1% of our exports for a value of Rs 36,281 million. The major destinations for our exports were U.K (12.6%), U.A.E (12.5%), U.S.A (10.6%), France (9.4%), South Africa (8.7%), Madagascar (6.5%) and Italy (5.5%).

Compared to the year 2014, total exports to U.A.E went up by 23.5%, mainly explained by re-exports of “Telecommunication equipment and accessories”. Exports to South Africa, U.S.A and Madagascar went up by 30.0%, 6.9% and 6.5% respectively. On the other hand, exports to France and Italy fell by 11.7% and 9.9% respectively.



## 4. Imports

### 4.1 Total imports (Table 10) – 4th Quarter 2015

Total imports for the fourth quarter of 2015 amounted to Rs 44,350 million, showing an increase of 5.7% over the previous quarter. This is mainly due to increases in imports of “Crude materials, inedible, excluding fuels” (+38.4%), “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (+23.9%), “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related products” (+7.4%), “Food and live animals” (+6.0%) and “Machinery and transport equipment” (+5.5%), partly offset by decreases of 36.4% and 3.0% in “Animal & vegetable oils and fats” and “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by materials” respectively.

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2014, imports in the fourth quarter of 2015 fell by 9.3%. This decline is mainly due to decreases in imports of “Animal & vegetable oils and fats” (-36.0%), “Machinery and transport equipment” (-26.2%), “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related products” (-18.0%) and “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (-5.3%)”, partly offset by increases in the imports of “Crude materials, inedible, excluding fuels” (+22.0%), “Beverages & tobacco” (+16.9%) and “Food and live animals” (+4.8%).

## 4.2 Imports by SITC section (Table 10) – Year 2015

Around 24.5% of imports in the year 2015 consisted of “Machinery and transport equipment” (Rs 41,172 million), 19.3% of “Food and live animals” (Rs 32,519 million), 17.9% of “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by materials” (Rs 30,026 million) and 15.1% of “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials” (Rs 25,376 million).

Compared to 2014, total imports decreased by 2.3%. Main changes by section are as follows:

“Food and live animals” increased by 3.7%, due to higher imports of “Wheat” (+18.3%), “Vegetable and fruits” (+14.4%), “Meat and meat preparations” (+13.7%) and “Cereal preparations” (+11.9%), partly offset by decreases in “Dairy products and bird’s eggs” (-12.0%) and “Fish and fish preparations” (-4.0%).

“Mineral fuels, lubricants, & related products” decreased by 23.0%, mainly due to a drop of 25.3% in the imports of “Refined petroleum products”.

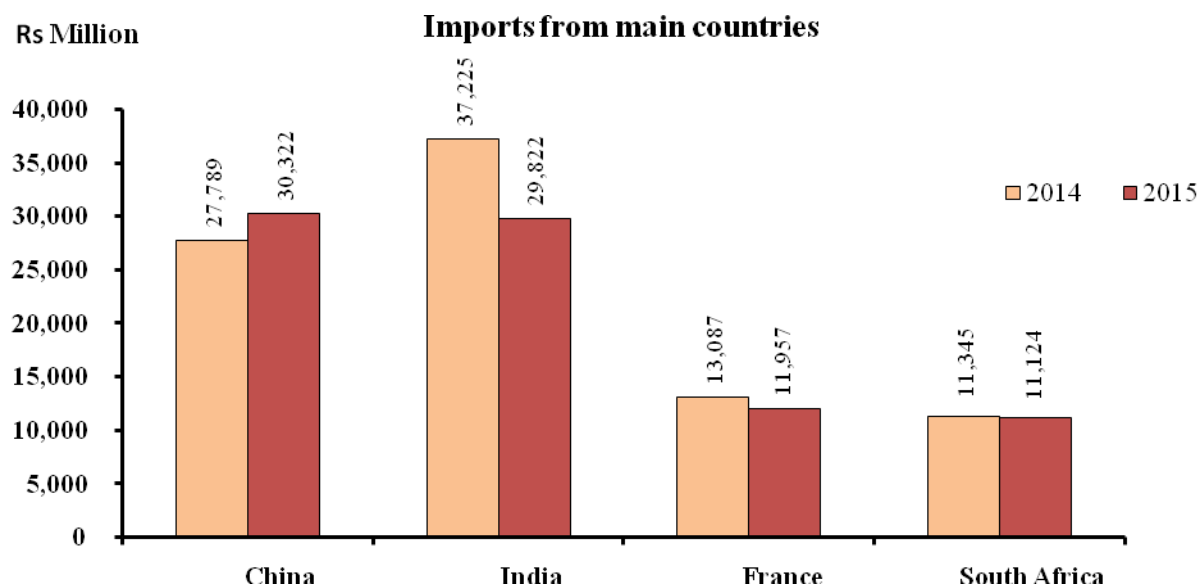
“Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” rose by 8.8%, mainly due to increases in the imports of “Iron and steel” (+33.0%), “Cement” (+14.6%), “Manufactures of metals, n.e.s” (+14.1%), “Cotton fabrics” (+12.5%) and “Pearls & precious stones” (+4.7%).

“Machinery & transport equipment” decreased by 2.0%, mainly due to decreases in imports of “Aircraft, marine vessel & parts” (-76.3%) and “Power generating machinery & equipment” (-20.6%).

## 4.3 Imports by country of origin – Year 2015

During the year 2015, imports from the Asian continent, our major supplier, amounted to Rs 93,267 million, representing 55.5% of total imports. Our imports originated mainly from the following countries: China (18.0%), India (17.7%), France (7.1%) and South Africa (6.6%) - (Table 13).

Compared to 2014, total imports from China rose by 9.1% while those from India and France declined by 19.9% and 8.6% respectively.



## 5. Trade with Regional Organisations – Year 2015

Total exports to African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) States during the year 2015 stood at Rs 16,486 million against imports of Rs 18,918 million (Table 14). The trade deficit with ACP countries worked out to Rs 2,432 million.

During the year 2015, exports to COMESA member states attained Rs 8,156 million while imports from these countries amounted to Rs 6,220 million, resulting in a trade surplus of Rs 1,936 million. Madagascar was the main buyer with a share of 69.1%. Our main suppliers were Seychelles (30.3%) and Madagascar (25.1%) - (Table 15).

Trade with SADC countries for the year 2015 showed a deficit of Rs 1,932 million, resulting from imports value of Rs 16,614 million against exports worth Rs 14,682 million. The main supplier was South Africa (67.0%) and our main buyers were South Africa (51.1%) and Madagascar (38.4%) - (Table 16).

## 6. Trade in Freeport Zone – Year 2015

During the year 2015, total imports of the Freeport Zone stood at Rs 21,347 million, higher by 17.9% compared to 2014 – (Table 12). Re-exports to overseas market were valued at Rs 21,975 million, representing an increase of 15.8% over 2014 (Table 6). The main item imported and re-exported was “Telecommunications equipment & accessories”.

## 7. Forecast 2016

Based on recent past trends and information from various sources, total exports for 2016 is forecasted at around Rs 95,000 million and imports at Rs 171,000 million. Trade deficit for 2016 is therefore expected to be around Rs 76,000 million.

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## Notes

### (1) Scope and coverage

**External merchandise trade statistics** are compiled according to the General Trade System as recommended by the United Nations. Using the national boundary as the statistical frontier, the General Trade System is a record of all goods entering (imports) and leaving the country (exports).

**Imports** include goods brought in directly for domestic consumption plus goods imported into customs bonded warehouses.

**Exports** cover:

- Domestic exports defined as goods of national origin, that is goods produced in the exporting country.
- Re-exports which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged and include re-exports from customs bonded warehouses.
- Ship's Stores and Bunkers (SSB) are included in total exports and are shown separately.

Trade by parcel post is also included in imports and exports.

### (2) Valuation

Imports are valued on a C.I.F. (Cost, Insurance and Freight) basis whilst exports on a F.O.B. (Free on Board) basis.

Cost, Insurance and Freight (C.I.F) value is the value of a country's imports of goods, including all charges for transporting and insuring the goods from the country of exports to the given country but excluding the cost of unloading from the ship, aircraft unless it is borne by the carrier.

Free on Board (F.O.B) value is the value of a country's exports of goods, including all costs of transporting the goods to the customs frontier, export duties.

### (3) Classification of commodities

Commodities are coded according to the **Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature (HS2012)**. However, for the purposes of economic analysis and to facilitate international comparison of trade by commodity data, the commodities are also classified according to **the Standard International Trade Classification (Revision 4) (SITC Rev. 4)**. The HS and the SITC Rev. 4 are six and five digit codes respectively but have been extended to eight and seven digits to accommodate national requirements.
