

EDUCATION STATISTICS - 2017

1. Introduction

This issue of the Economic and Social Indicators presents data on education, compiled on the basis of information collected through the annual survey conducted in schools in March 2017, together with data from other sources. The data refer to the Republic of Mauritius (excluding Agalega) and cover pre-primary, primary, secondary (general and pre-vocational), technical & vocational, tertiary as well as education in specialised institutions.

2. Expenditure

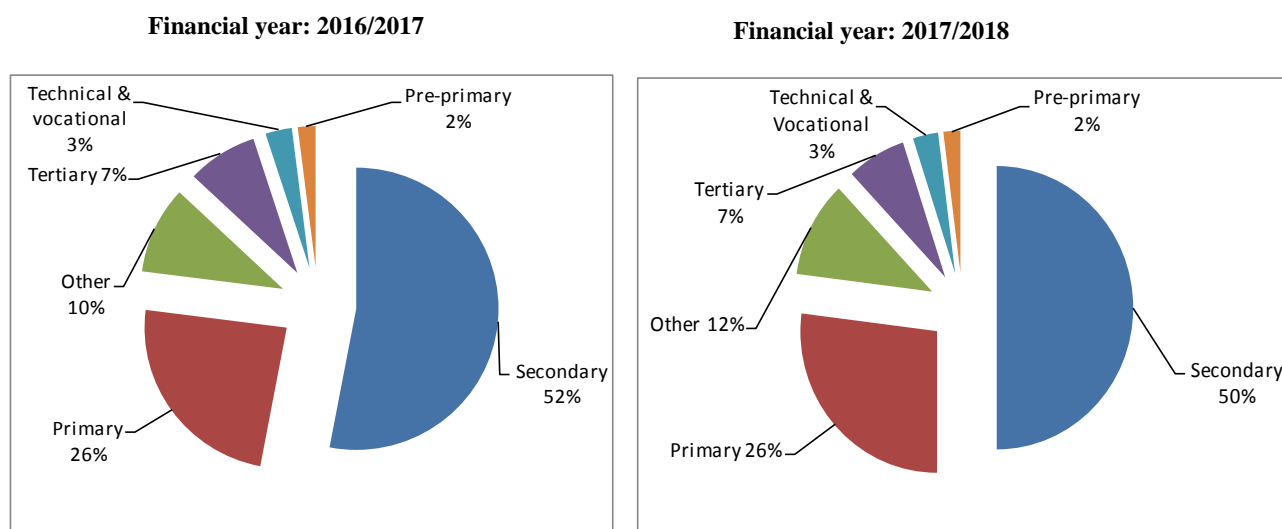
Total government expenditure for the financial years 2016/2017 and 2017/2018 are estimated as follows:

- (i) Financial year 2016/2017: Rs 132,164 million, of which, Rs 16,791 million (12.7%) has been allocated to education and training; and
- (ii) Financial year 2017/2018: Rs 147,232 million, of which, Rs 18,214 million (12.4%) has been allocated to education and training.

Total budget on education and training has been allocated as follows:

- (i) Financial year 2016/2017: 52% to secondary education, 26% to primary education, 7% to tertiary education, 3% to technical and vocational education, 2% to pre-primary education and the remaining 10% to other expenses; and
- (ii) Financial year 2017/2018: 50% to secondary education, 26% to primary education, 7% to tertiary education, 3% to technical and vocational education, 2% to pre-primary education and the remaining 12% to other expenses (Table 2.2 and Figure 1).

3. Pre-primary education

3.1 Schools

The number of schools providing pre-primary education stood at 883 in March 2017: 850 in the Island of Mauritius and 33 in Rodrigues. Of these schools, 630 (71%) were privately run institutions; 190 (22%), operating on government primary school premises, were administered by the Early Childhood Care and Education Authority and the remaining 63 (7%) were administered by either Roman Catholic (RC) or Hindu Education Authorities or Municipal/Village Councils (Table 3.1).

3.2 Enrolment

Enrolment in pre-primary schools decreased by 6%, from 28,866 in March 2016 to 27,276 in March 2017. Girls represented around 49% of the pre-primary school population (Table 3.3). The Gross Enrolment Ratio (pre-primary enrolment as a percentage of the population aged 4 and 5 years) works out to 96% compared to 100% in 2016.

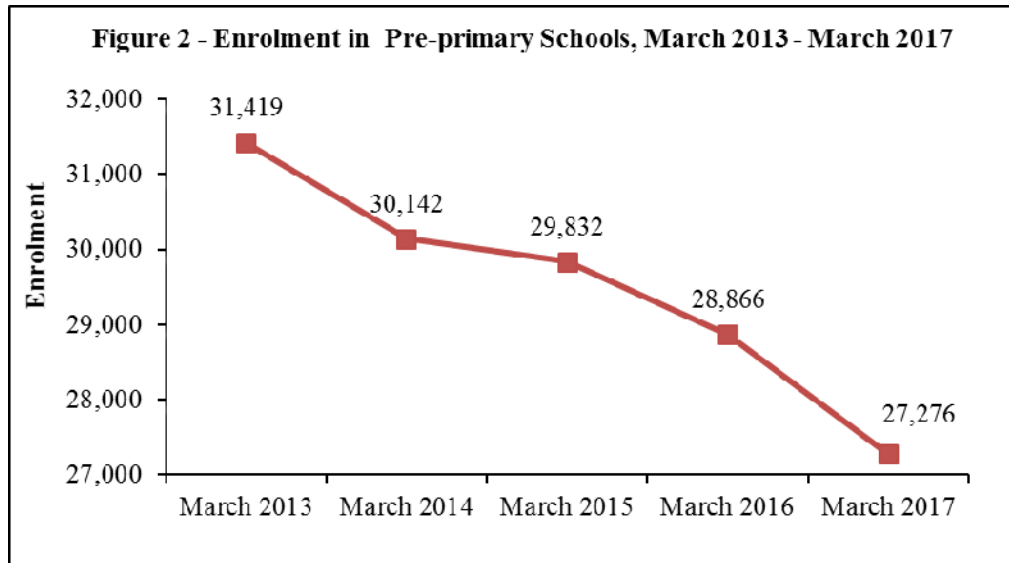


Figure 2 shows a declining trend in enrolment in pre-primary schools over the period 2013 to 2017.

3.3 Personnel

In March 2017, total employment in pre-primary schools stood at 3,223, of whom 2,219 were teachers and 1,004 non-teaching staff (Table 3.4). This represents a decrease of 0.9% compared to 2016. The average number of pupils per teacher works out to 12 as compared to 13 for the previous 5 years.

4. Primary education

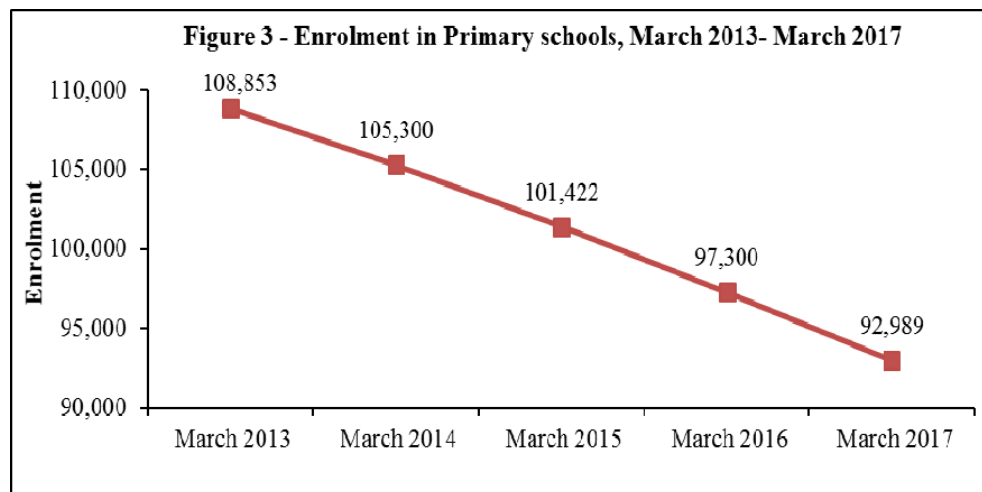
4.1 Schools

In March 2017, there were 318 schools providing primary education, same as in March 2016: 303 in the Island of Mauritius and 15 in Rodrigues. The majority (221) of the schools were run by government, 51 by the Roman Catholic Education Authority, 2 by the Hindu Education Authority and the other 44 were private non-aided schools (Table 4.1).

4.2 Enrolment

In 2017, the primary school population in the Republic of Mauritius stood at 92,989, of whom around 51% was boys. Around 67% was enrolled in government schools and the remaining was in private aided and non-aided schools (Table 4.3).

Distribution by grade (Table 4.5) shows that grade 6 with 17,029 pupils, including 607 repeaters, accounted for the highest number of pupils. The Gross Enrolment Ratio (primary enrolment as a percentage of the population aged 6 to 11 years) works out to be 97%, same as in 2016.



The graph shows a marked decline in primary enrolment from March 2013 to March 2017.

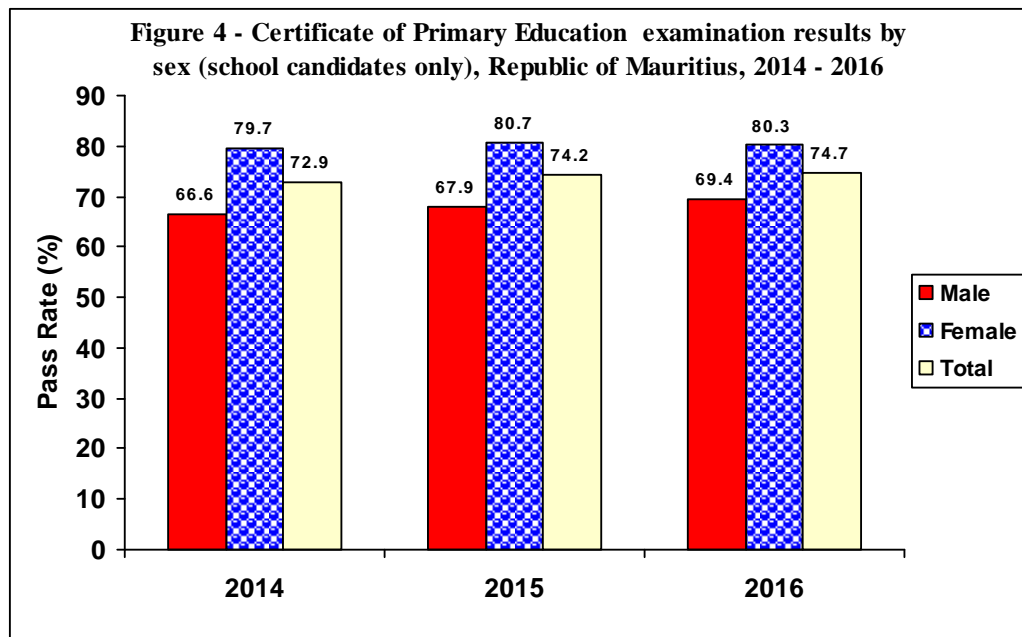
4.3 Personnel

The number of persons employed in primary schools registered a decrease of 216 from 7,994 in March 2016 to 7,778 in March 2017. Of this number, 5,184 were teaching staff: 3,923 General Purpose Teachers and 1,261 Oriental Language Teachers. The remaining 2,594 comprised 248 Head Teachers, 913 Deputy Head Teachers and 1,433 administrative and other workers (Table 4.9). The pupil/teacher (general purpose) ratio in primary schools works out to 24, same as in 2016.

4.4 Certificate of Primary Education (CPE)

In 2016, the number of school candidates who took part in the CPE examination was 19,798. Excluding re-sit, the overall pass rate works out to 69.8% compared to 70.3% in 2015.

It is to be noted that the pass rate, including re-sit school candidates, works out to 74.7%. The performance of girls including re-sit exceeded that of boys with respective pass rates of 80.3% and 69.4% (Table 4.11 and Figure 4).

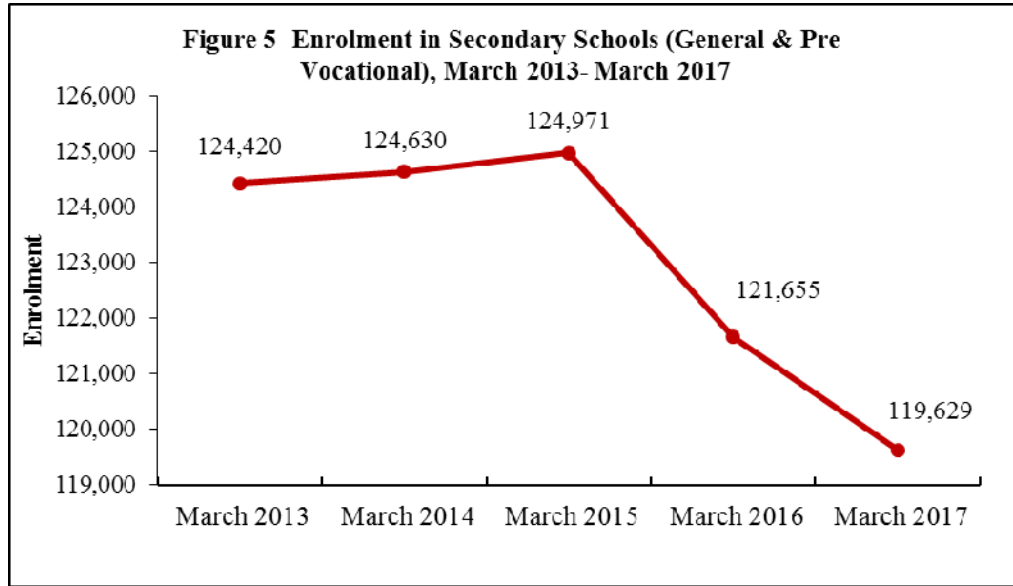


According to the analysis carried out by the Mauritius Examinations Syndicate on performance, the pass rate among the 2015 cohort of school candidates works out to 83.4%.

5. Secondary General and Pre-vocational Education

5.1 General and pre-vocational education

As at March 2017, the number of secondary schools offering both general and pre-vocational education stood at 109 while 66 schools were offering general education only and one pre-vocational education only.



The graph depicts a rise in total secondary (including pre-vocational) enrolment from March 2013 to March 2015 followed by a sharp decline from March 2015 to March 2017.

5.2 Secondary education (General)

5.2.1 Schools

Out of the 175 schools dispensing secondary general education, 168 were in the Island of Mauritius and 7 in Rodrigues. State administered schools numbered 68, while the other 107 were private aided and non-aided schools (Table 5.1).

5.2.2 Enrolment

Secondary education enrolment decreased by 1,281 from 111,863 in 2016 to 110,582 in 2017. Table 5.3 shows that 57,775 (52%) were girls. Around 44% of the secondary school population was in state schools and 56% in private (aided and unaided) schools. Gross Enrolment Ratio (secondary education enrolment as a percentage of the population aged 12 to 19 years) for the general stream was 72%, same as in year 2016.

5.3 Pre-vocational education

5.3.1 Schools

As at March 2017, 110 schools were offering pre-vocational education: 103 in the Island of Mauritius and 7 in Rodrigues. Thirty-seven of these schools were state pre-vocational schools while the remaining 73 were private schools (Table 5.9).

5.3.2 Enrolment

Enrolment in the schools offering pre-vocational education was 9,047 comprising 5,911 boys (Table 5.13). Boys pre-dominate in secondary pre-vocational classes, representing around 65% of enrolment. About 25% of the Year I to Year III students in pre-vocational schools were in state schools. It is to be noted that some 1,765 Year IV students of the prevocational stream joined the 11 Mauritius Institute of Training and Development (MITD) centres as from January 2016 (1,212 boys and 553 girls).

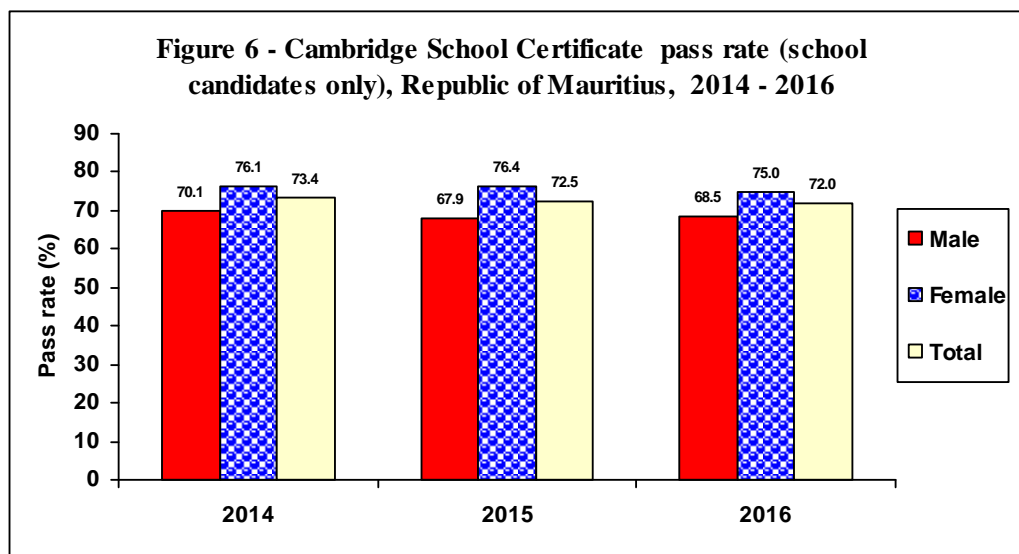
5.4 Personnel

The number of teachers working in secondary schools offering general and pre-vocational education decreased by 178 from March 2016 to 9,181 in March 2017.

The secondary education teaching staff in the general stream stood at 8,222 (3,202 males and 5,020 females), representing a decrease of 1.6% over the 2016 figure. The pupil/teacher ratio works out to 13. On the other hand, the pre-vocational education teaching staff was 959, of whom 594 were females, giving an average of 9 pupils per teacher (Table 5.18).

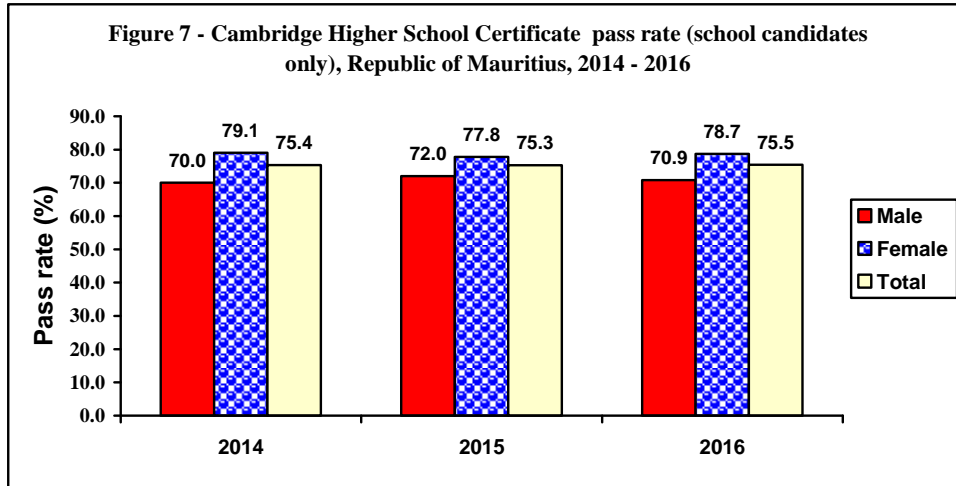
5.5 Cambridge School Certificate (SC)

In 2016, out of 15,455 candidates (7,097 males and 8,358 females) who took part in the Cambridge School Certificate examination, 11,129 were successful. Comparison with the 2015 results shows that the overall pass rate decreased from 72.5% to 72.0% (Table 5.19 and Figure 6).



5.6 Cambridge Higher School Certificate (HSC)

The number of students taking part in the 2016 Cambridge Higher School Certificate examination stood at 9,285, of whom 58% were females. The overall pass rate is 75.5%, higher than the 2015 figure of 75.3% (Table 5.20 and Figure 7).



5.7 Technical and Vocational Education

In 2016, there were 7,290 students (of whom 79% were males) enrolled in publicly funded technical and vocational courses compared to 6,884 in 2015. Thirty five per cent of the students were enrolled in full-time courses, 46% in part-time courses and the rest (19%) in apprenticeship courses (Table 5.21).

6. Special Education Needs (SEN)

6.1 Schools

As at March 2017, there were 71 Special Education Needs schools in the Republic of Mauritius registered with the Ministry of Education and Human Resources, Tertiary Education and Scientific Research. Twenty-two schools were run by Government, while the other 49 were run by NGOs and the Roman Catholic Education Authority (Table 6.1).

6.2 Enrolment

The number of students enrolled in the 71 special schools stood at 2,594 (of whom 65% were boys) as at March 2017, representing an increase of 79 compared to 2,515 in March 2016 (Table 6.3).

Table 6.6 shows that the two most frequent types of impairment among the pupils were Intellectual Impairment (33%) and Other disabilities (10%).

6.3 Personnel

As at March 2017, there were 733 persons employed in the special education needs institutions and representing an increase of 5% compared to 698 as at March 2016. Out of

these, 411 were teaching staff, and 64 were medical and para-medical staff. The remaining 258 were administrative and ancillary workers (Table 6.7).

7. ICT in Education

In March 2017, out of the 883 pre-primary schools in the Republic of Mauritius, 474 (54%) had computers. All primary and secondary schools (general & pre-vocational) were equipped with computers. Availability of internet access for students in schools was as follows: 15% in pre-primary, 35% in primary and 94% in secondary (Table 7.1).

8. Tertiary Education

As at December 2016, the total number of students (part-time and full-time) enrolled on tertiary-level programmes (including Distance Education) was 48,089 compared to 48,970 in December 2015, representing a decrease of 1.8% (Tables 8.1,a & b).

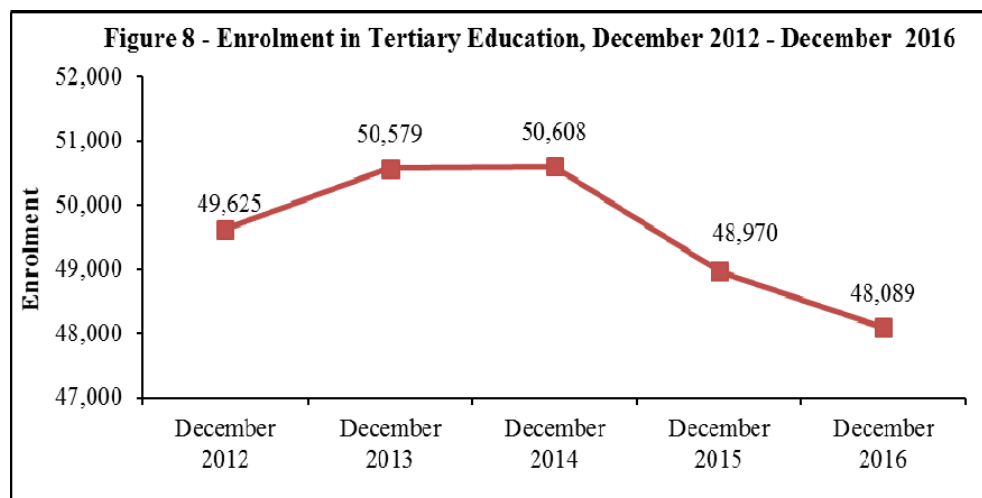


Figure 8 gives the evolution of total tertiary enrolment over the period 2012 to 2016. Total enrolment rose from 2012 to 2013, stabilized in 2014 and then decreased from 2014 to 2016.

The majority of students (80%) were enrolled in tertiary education locally in both public-funded institutions (44%) and private institutions (36%). The remaining 20% of the students were enrolled in tertiary education overseas (Table 8.1b).

The Gross Enrolment Ratio (tertiary education enrolment as a percentage of the population aged 20 to 24 years), which was 47.4 % in 2015, decreased to 46.6 % in 2016.

Definition of Indicators Used

(1) Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER)

Number of pupils enrolled in a given level of education, regardless of age, expressed as a percentage of the population in the relevant age-group

(2) Pupil/ Teacher Ratio

The average number of pupils per teacher at a given level of education in a given year

(3) Transition Rate (TR)

The proportion of pupils progressing from the primary cycle (i.e Std VI) to the secondary cycle (Form I and Year I Prevoc), expressed as a percentage of the number of pupils enrolled at Std VI in primary school
