

## **External Merchandise Trade Statistics – 4th Quarter and Year 2017**

### **1. Introduction**

This issue of Economic and Social Indicators presents external merchandise trade statistics for the years 2016 and 2017. These statistics are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are at times revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) - Customs Department.


Thus, while revised figures for 2016 are published in this indicator, those for 2017 are provisional and subject to revision as and when MRA - Customs Department submits latest amendments to Statistics Mauritius.

Data on external merchandise trade are compiled as per the recommendations of the United Nations General Trade System. According to this system, all goods entering and leaving the national frontier, including trading activities of the Freeport zone should be accounted for.

### **2. Total value of trade and trade balance**

Total external merchandise trade for the fourth quarter of 2017 was valued at Rs 72,089 million, i.e. 11.8% higher than the previous quarter and 7.5% higher compared to the corresponding quarter of 2016.

During the fourth quarter of 2017, total exports (including ship's stores & bunkers) were valued at Rs 20,171 million against imports of Rs 51,918 million. The resulting trade deficit worked out to Rs 31,747 million, 42.6% higher than the deficit of Rs 22,268 million of the previous quarter and 27.9% higher than the deficit of Rs 24,822 million of the corresponding quarter of 2016.



### 3. Exports

#### 3.1 Total exports (Tables 1 & 3) – 4th Quarter 2017

Total export proceeds for the fourth quarter of 2017, including domestic exports<sup>1</sup>, re-exports<sup>2</sup> and ship's stores and bunkers amounted to Rs 20,171 million, showing a decrease of 4.5% compared to the previous quarter. This is mainly explained by decreases in the exports of "Machinery and transport equipment" (-39.3%), "Food and live animals" (-14.8%) and "Miscellaneous manufactured goods" (-5.5%), partly offset by increases in exports of "Ship's stores and bunkers" (+31.6%) and "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (+8.1%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2016, total exports for the fourth quarter of 2017 dropped by 4.4%. This is mainly explained by decreases in exports of "Food and live animals" (-20.8%), "Machinery and transport equipment" (-7.5%) and "Miscellaneous manufactured goods" (-4.8%), partly offset by increases in exports of "Ship's stores and bunkers" (+36.3%) and "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (+23.9%).

Domestic exports amounting to Rs 13,005 million, accounted for 64.5% of total exports in the fourth quarter of 2017. Compared to a value of Rs 14,900 million recorded in the third quarter of 2017, domestic exports fell by 12.7%. When compared to the corresponding quarter of 2016, a decrease of 6.8% was observed.

In the fourth quarter of 2017, re-exports stood at Rs 4,546 million, i.e. higher by 7.7% compared to the previous quarter but lower by 13.0% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2016. (Table 5)

#### 3.2 Exports by SITC section (Tables 1 & 3) – Year 2017

Around 38.0% of total exports for the year 2017 consisted of "Food and live animals" (Rs 27,450 million), 36.9% of "Miscellaneous manufactured goods" (Rs 26,697 million) and 10.6% of "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (Rs 7,643 million).

Compared to the year of 2016, the main changes by section are as follows:

- "Machinery and transport equipment" fell by 41.4%, mainly due to a decrease in the re-exports of "Telecommunications equipment & accessories" (-83.5%).
- "Miscellaneous manufactured goods" dropped by 12.1% mainly due to decreases in the exports of "Jewellery, goldsmiths & silversmiths" (-49.8%) and "Articles of apparel & clothing accessories" (-10.8%).
- "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" registered an increase of 8.0%, mainly explained by increase in exports of "Textile yarns, fabrics, made up articles" (+5.0%).


### 3.3 Exports of Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE) – Year 2017

During the year of 2017, exports of EOE amounted to Rs 43,145 million, compared to Rs 44,422 million in 2016 (Table 1). Further details on these transactions will be presented in the issue of the Economic and Social Indicators on Export Oriented Enterprises, to be released on 28 March 2018.

### 3.4 Exports by country of destination (Table 7) – Year 2017

Analysis of exports figures by country of destination for the year 2017 shows that the European countries were our main buyers, purchasing some 49.5% of our exports for a value of Rs 35,788 million. Among countries, the major destinations for our exports were U.K (11.9%), France (11.7%), U.S.A (11.2%), South Africa (8.9%), Italy (6.9%), Madagascar (6.6%) and Spain (5.6%).

Compared to the year 2016, total exports to UAE went down by 52.0%, mainly explained by a decrease in re-exports of “Telecommunication equipment and accessories”. Exports to Reunion, Spain and South Africa went up by 18.4%, 15.2% and 1.7% respectively. On the other hand, exports to Madagascar, Italy, UK, USA and France dropped by 16.0%, 10.9%, 8.5%, 7.4% and 5.4% respectively.



## 4. Imports

### 4.1 Total imports (Table 10) – 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter 2017

Total imports for the fourth quarter of 2017 amounted to Rs 51,918 million, showing an increase of 19.7% over the previous quarter. This is mainly due to increases in imports of “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (+34.2%) “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related products” (+28.8%), “Machinery and transport equipment” (+16.7%), “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (+15.9%) and “Food and live animals” (+13.8%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2016, imports in the fourth quarter of 2017 rose by 13.0%. This is mainly due to increases in imports of “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related

products” (+19.2%), “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by materials” (+19.0%) and “Food and live animals” (+17.0%).

#### **4.2 Imports by SITC section (Table 10) – Year 2017**

Around 23.1% of imports in the year of 2017 consisted of “Machinery and transport equipment” (Rs 41,798 million), 20.9% of “Food and live animals” (Rs 37,735 million), 16.9% of “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related products” (Rs 30,515 million), 15.2% of “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (Rs 27,421 million).

Compared to 2016, total imports increased by 9.3%. Main changes by section are as follows:

- “Mineral fuels, lubricants, & related products” increased by 35.3%, mainly due to an increase of 34.5% in the imports of “Refined petroleum products”.
- “Food and live animals” rose by 9.4%, mainly due to higher imports of “Wheat” (+31.7%), “Meat and meat preparations” (+16.4%) and “Fish and fish preparations” (+13.5%), partly offset by decreases in imports of “Vegetables and fruits” (-1.0%) and “Dairy products and bird’s eggs” (-1.0%).
- “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” increased by 5.2%, mainly due to increases in “Prefabricated buildings; sanitary plumbing, heating & lighting fixtures & fittings, n.e.s” (+35.5%) and “Articles of apparel and clothing” (+13.5%), partly offset by decreases in “Professional, scientific & controlling instruments & apparatus, n.e.s” (-14.8%) and “Jewellery, goldsmiths' & silversmiths' wares, n.e.s” (-7.3%).
- “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” went up by 5.2%, mainly due to increases in the imports of “Iron and steel” (+17.7%), “Textile yarn” (+16.1%) and “Manufactures of metal, n.e.s” (+11.9%), partly offset by decreases in imports of “Cement” (-10.0%), “Cotton fabrics” (-8.0%) and “Pearls, precious & semi-precious stones” (-3.3%).
- “Machinery and transport equipment” increased by 1.2%, mainly due to increases in “Power generating machinery & equipment” (+81.8%), “General industrial machinery & equipment, n.e.s., & machine parts, n.e.s” (+21.1%), and “Electrical machinery, apparatus & appliances, n.e.s., & electrical parts of household type” (+17.8%), partly offset by decreases in imports of “Aircraft , marine vessels and parts” (-37.3%), “Telecommunications and sound recording apparatus and reproducing apparatus and equipment” (-33.1%) and “Machinery specialised for particular industries” (-19.1%).


### 4.3 Imports by country of origin – Year 2017

During the year 2017, almost half of our imports originated from four main countries, namely: China (16.4%), India (16.4%), South Africa (8.5%) and France (7.9%) (Table 13).

Among continents Asia was our main supplier with a share of Rs 92,473 million, representing 51.1% of total imports.

Compared to 2016, total imports from South Africa, France, India and China rose by 24.4%, 11.4%, 8.7% and 1.3% respectively.

### 5. Trade with Member States of Regional Organisations – Year 2017

During the year of 2017, total exports to African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) States stood at Rs 16,065 million against imports of Rs 24,150 million (Table 14). The trade deficit with ACP countries worked out to Rs 8,085 million.

Exports to COMESA member states attained Rs 8,323 million while imports from these countries amounted to Rs 8,713 million, resulting in a trade deficit of Rs 390 million. Madagascar was the main buyer with a share of 57.5%. Our main suppliers were Seychelles (31.2%), Madagascar (29.0%) and Kenya (16.7%) - (Table 15).

Trade with SADC countries showed a deficit of Rs 9,166 million, resulting from imports of Rs 22,091 million against exports worth Rs 12,925 million. The main supplier was South Africa (69.8%) and our main buyers were South Africa (50.0%) and Madagascar (37.0%) (Table 16).

## **6. Trade in Freeport Zone – Year 2017**

During the year 2017, total imports of the Freeport Zone stood at Rs 12,466 million, lower by 16.3% compared to 2016 (Table 12). Re-exports were valued at Rs 13,406 million, representing a decrease of 17.3% compared to 2016 (Table 6). The main items imported and re-exported were “Food and live animals” and “Machinery and transport equipment”.

## **7. Forecast 2018**

Based on recent past trends and information from various sources, total exports for 2018 is forecasted at around Rs 84,000 million and imports at Rs 190,000 million. Trade deficit for 2018 is therefore expected to be around Rs 106,000 million.

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## Notes

### (1) Scope and coverage

**External merchandise trade statistics** are compiled according to the General Trade System as recommended by the United Nations. Using the national boundary as the statistical frontier, the General Trade System is a record of all goods entering (imports) and leaving the country (exports).

**Imports** include goods brought in directly for domestic consumption plus goods imported into customs bonded warehouses.

**Exports** cover:

- Domestic exports defined as goods of national origin, that is goods produced in the exporting country.
- Re-exports which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged and include re-exports from customs bonded warehouses.
- Ship's Stores and Bunkers (SSB) are included in total exports and are shown separately.

Trade by parcel post is also included in imports and exports.

### (2) Valuation

Imports are valued on a C.I.F. (Cost, Insurance and Freight) basis whilst exports on a F.O.B. (Free on Board) basis.

Cost, Insurance and Freight (C.I.F) value is the value of a country's imports of goods, including all charges for transporting and insuring the goods from the country of exports to the given country but excluding the cost of unloading from the ship, aircraft unless it is borne by the carrier.

Free on Board (F.O.B) value is the value of a country's exports of goods, including all costs of transporting the goods to the customs frontier, export duties.

### (3) Classification of commodities

Commodities are coded according to the **Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature (HS2012)**. However, for the purposes of economic analysis and to facilitate international comparison of trade by commodity data, the commodities are also classified according to the **Standard International Trade Classification (Revision 4) (SITC Rev. 4)**. The HS and the SITC Rev. 4 are six and five digit codes respectively but have been extended to eight and seven digits to accommodate national requirements.
