INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL AND TOURISM

JANUARY TO SEPTEMBER 2021

1. INTRODUCTION

This issue of the Economic and Social Indicators presents data on International Travel and Tourism for the first nine months of 2021. A brief on the compilation of these statistics is given at Annex I and a glossary of terms at Annex II.

It is to be noted that following the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic worldwide in 2020, the national borders of Mauritius were closed down as from 20 March 2020 to 30 September 2020. As from 01 October 2020 to 09 March 2021, travel to and from certain destinations were allowed. In 2021, the national borders were once more closed down as from 10 March to 14 July. Afterwards, as from 15 July to 30 September 2021, travel to and from certain destinations were allowed.

2.1 Arrivals in January to September 2021

Compared to the period January to September 2020:

- (i) total arrivals decreased by 93.8% from 431,543 to 26,928;
- (ii) total tourist arrivals dropped by 96.9% from 305,612 to 9,460; those arriving by air decreased by 96.8% from 276,130 to 8,919, while those arriving by sea declined by 98.2% from 29,482 to 541 (Table 6b).
- (iii) the number of excursionists (arriving and leaving on the same day) decreased by 99.6% from 6.641 to 28.

In the first nine months of 2021, there were no cruise ships that arrived in the country.


2.2 Departures in January to September 2021

Compared to the period January to September 2020:

- (i) total departures declined by 91.6% from 482,305 to 40,515; and
- (ii) departures of Mauritian residents decreased by 72.3% from 62,308 to 17,288 (Table 2).


Comparative figures for the first nine months of 2020 and 2021 for Mauritian departures by main country of disembarkation are given in Figure 1 and Table 2. In the first nine months of 2021, the main countries of disembarkation (country of final destination or transit country) for Mauritian residents were France (8,221 or 47.6%), United Arab Emirates (6,200 or 35.9%), India (855 or 4.9%), Reunion Island (684 or 4.0%), Turkey (391 or 2.3%) and United Kingdom (282 or 1.6%).


Figure 2 - Percentage change in main tourism indicators, January-September 2021 compared to January-September 2020



3.1 Tourist Arrivals


Figure 3 – Main changes in tourist arrivals by selected country of residence, January- September 2020 compared to January to September 2021

Compared to the first nine months of 2020, tourist arrivals decreased by 296,152 or 96.9% to reach 9,460 for the corresponding period of 2021 as a result of main changes shown in Figure 3.

In the first nine months of 2021, France, our top tourist generating country, registered a decrease of 97.5%, representing a drop of 76,833 tourist arrivals compared to period January to September 2020. Decreases were also observed among the main markets as follows:

Reunion Island (-99.4%), Italy (-99.0%), Germany (-98.9%), Republic of South Africa (-98.8%), India (-94.3%) and United Kingdom (-94.0%).


Figure 4 - Tourist arrivals from main markets, January- September 2020 and January- September 2021



3.2 Tourist arrivals by age

During the first nine months of 2021, the number of tourists aged 60 years and above was 840 representing 8.9% of tourist arrivals and of whom 2.4% arrived by sea (Tables 6a and 6b).

3.3 Tourist arrivals by air and by main port of last embarkation for selected markets

From Table 7, it is observed that during the first nine months of 2021, tourists from France (78.2%) and United Kingdom (51.8%) arrived mainly by direct flights from their own country of residence. Tourists from Germany, Italy, Netherlands, Switzerland, Russian Federation and Australia travelled mainly through United Arab Emirates and France which were the most used transiting ports. For the first nine months of 2021, the proportion of tourists from Australia, Switzerland and Germany who travelled to Mauritius through United Arab Emirates were 81.1%, 61.4%, 47.7% respectively while the proportion of tourists from Netherlands, Italy and Russian Federation who travelled to Mauritius from France stood at 80.0%, 57.9% and 41.7% respectively.

3.4 Tourist arrivals - Selected tourist destinations in the Indian Ocean region

During the first nine months of 2021, while tourist arrivals in Mauritius dropped by 96.9% compared to the first nine months of 2020, growths were observed for Maldives (+111.5%) and Seychelles (+14.5%). On the other hand, Sri Lanka witnessed a decrease of 92.5% in tourist arrivals (Figure 6).

3.5 Tourist Nights

Compared to January to September 2020:

- the number of nights spent by tourists who departed during January to September 2021 decreased by 88.5% from 4,276,577 to 489,758; and
- the average length of stay increased from 12.1 to 66.9 nights (Table 8).

3.6 Employment

Employment data for the tourism sector obtained from the Survey of Employment and Earnings, relate to employment in food service, hotels and travel and other services establishments with 10 or more workers. Latest available data for March 2021 (Table 11) indicate that employment in these establishments decreased by 13.6% to 27,858 as compared to 32,253 for March 2020.

3.7 Accommodation

(i) Licensed hotels in the Island of Mauritius

As at end of September 2021, there were 111 licensed hotels of which 5 were temporarily closed due to renovation works and 14 hotels were used as quarantine centres. The total room capacity of the remaining 92 hotels was 10,810 with 24,824 bed places (Table 9).

During the first nine months of 2021,

- the room occupancy rate of all licensed hotels in operation averaged 10%, lower compared to 26% in the first nine months of 2020; and
- the bed occupancy rate was 8%, lower compared to 22% in the first nine months of 2020 (Table 10).

(ii) 'Large' hotels in the Island of Mauritius

At the end of September 2021, there were 60 'large' hotels (i.e. well-established beach hotels with more than 80 rooms) of which 6 were temporarily closed due to renovation works and 9 hotels were used as quarantine centres. The total room capacity of the remaining 45 'large' hotels was 8,243 with 19,311 bed places. These 'large' hotels represent 49% of all licensed hotels in operation but comprise 76% of total room capacity and 78% of total bed places (Table 9).

During the first nine months of 2021,

- the room occupancy rate of 'large' hotels was 10%, lower than the 26% registered in the first nine months of 2020;
- the bed occupancy rate was 8%, lower than the 23% recorded in the first nine months of 2020 (Table 10).

COMPILATION OF PASSENGER TRAFFIC STATISTICS

Sources of data

The main source of data for the compilation of passenger traffic statistics is the Passport and Immigration Office, which maintains a database of all travellers entering and leaving the country. The data are collected from the passport of travellers, disembarkation cards filled in by non-residents and questions put to non-residents entering the country. At the end of every month, the electronic database of passenger traffic for that particular month is downloaded and supplied to the statistics unit of the Ministry of Tourism within ten days. Additional data on cruises are obtained from the Mauritius Ports Authority.

Tourism earnings

The Bank of Mauritius (BoM) is responsible for the estimation of tourism earnings based on monthly statements of Inward and Outward Remittances of Commercial Banks. As from 2015, BoM is also including data culled from Money changers and Foreign exchange dealers.

Monthly Occupancy Rates

Survey questionnaires are emailed to all hotels at the end of every month to collect data on room/bed nights available and rented during the month for the calculation of room and bed occupancy rates. Non-responses are contacted by phone.

Short-term projections of tourist arrivals

A Tourism Statistics Committee grouping various stakeholders of the tourism industry meet regularly under the chairmanship of Statistics Mauritius to discuss performance of the tourism sector and to provide information for short-term forecast of tourist arrivals.

Publications

The regular publications of the unit are:

- (i) Monthly tourist arrivals uploaded on Statistics Mauritius website
- (ii) Quarterly Economic and Social Indicators on International Travel and Tourism (with a lag of seven weeks)
- (iii) Yearly Digest of International Travel and Tourism
- (iv) Yearly Handbook of statistical data on tourism
- (v) Report of the Survey of Inbound Tourism (last publication- Year 2018)

GLOSSARY OF TERMS

1. Tourist

A tourist is defined as a non-resident staying overnight but less than a year, and who has no employer-employee relationship with a resident.

2. Transit

A transit passenger is one who stops over in the country for flight connections to other destinations. There are two types of transit passengers:

Type I: Passengers who do not leave the transit area of the airport or the harbour.

Type II: Passengers who do leave the airport or harbour and stay in the country overnight but only for flight connection purposes.

Only Type II transit passengers, as defined above, are included in the definition of "Tourists".

3. Excursionist or Same-day Visitor

Excursionists are non-resident visitors, other than those who do not leave the airport, who depart on the same day they arrived.

4. Tourist Nights

"Tourist nights" for year Y refer to nights spent by tourists who departed in year Y.

5. Large Hotels

Large hotels are well established beach hotels with more than 80 rooms.

6. Occupancy rate

The room/bed occupancy rate is the ratio of room/bed nights rented to the total number of room/bed nights available.

= Total number of room/bed nights rented x 100

Total number of room/bed nights available
