# External Merchandise Trade Statistics

3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter 2024

## 1. Introduction

This issue of Economic and Social Indicators presents external merchandise trade statistics from the first to third quarter of 2024 and the years 2023 and 2022. These statistics are compiled from declarations lodged at the Customs Department of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA), by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are usually revised at a later period and corrections are made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA).

Figures for 2024 are still provisional and subject to revision as and when the Customs Department of the MRA submits latest amendments to Statistics Mauritius.


Data on external merchandise trade are compiled as per the recommendations of the United Nations General Trade System. According to this system, all goods entering and leaving the national frontier, including trading activities of the Freeport zone should be accounted for.

## 2. Total value of trade and trade balance

Total external merchandise trade for the third quarter of 2024 was valued at Rs 111,362 million, i.e. 4.8% higher than the value of Rs 106,291 million of the previous quarter and 11.8% higher than the value of Rs 99,604 million of the corresponding quarter of 2023.

For the third quarter of 2024, total exports (inclusive of ship's stores & bunkers<sup>1</sup>) were valued at Rs 29,960 million against total imports of Rs 81,402 million. In the second quarter of 2024, total exports (inclusive of ship's stores and bunkers) amounted to Rs 29,579 million against total imports of Rs 76,712 million. Compared to the previous quarter, total exports were higher by 1.3% and total imports were higher by 6.1%. While compared to the corresponding quarter of 2023, total exports and total imports were higher by 9.3% and 12.7% respectively.

The resulting trade deficit for the third quarter of 2024 worked out to Rs 51,442 million, 9.1% higher than the deficit of Rs 47,133 million of the previous quarter and 14.9% higher than the deficit of Rs 44,790 million of the corresponding quarter of 2023.

Compared to the period Jan-Sep of 2023, total exports (inclusive of ship's stores & bunkers) rose from Rs 78,067 million to Rs 83,444 million in same period of 2024, showing an increase of around 6.9% (Figure 1). Total imports increased by 8.1% for period Jan-Sep of 2024, compared to the corresponding period of 2023. Consequently, the trade deficit for the first nine months of 2024 rose by 8.8% and worked out to around Rs 144,077 million, compared to Rs 132,382 million in the corresponding period of 2023.

### **3. Total Exports**

#### **3.1 Total exports (Tables 1 & 3) – 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter & January to September 2024**

Total exports proceeds for the third quarter of 2024, including domestic exports<sup>2</sup>, re-exports<sup>3</sup> and ship's stores and bunkers amounted to Rs 29,960 million, showing an increase of 1.3%, compared to the previous quarter. This was mainly explained by increases in the exports of "Food and live animals" (+13.4%), "Chemicals and related products" (+10.5%) and "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (+1.3%), partly offset by decreases in the exports of "Machinery and transport equipment" (-14.9%), "Ship's stores & bunkers" (-9.4%) and "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (-3.6%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2023, total exports for the third quarter of 2024 increased by 9.3%. This was mainly explained by increases in the exports of "Ship's stores & bunkers" (+54.9%), "Machinery and transport equipment" (+21.1%), "Chemicals and related products, n.e.s" (+13.7%) and "Food and live animals" (+2.3%), partly offset by decreases in the exports of "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (-13.4%) and "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (-7.5%).

Compared to corresponding period of 2023, total exports for the period Jan-Sep of 2024 increased by 6.9%, which was mainly explained by increases in the exports of "Ship's stores & bunkers" (+60.2%), "Chemicals and related products, n.e.s" (+8.2%) and "Food and live animals" (+2.2%), partly offset by decreases in the exports of "Machinery and transport equipment" (-31.7%), "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (-13.6%) and "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (-9.3%).

Domestic exports, amounting to Rs 16,159 million, accounted for 53.9% of total exports in the third quarter of 2024. Compared to a value of Rs 15,551 million recorded in the second quarter of 2024, domestic exports increased by 3.9%. This was mainly explained by increases in exports of "Crude materials, inedible, except fuels" (+37.8%), "Chemicals and related products, n.e.s" (+32.7%), "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (+3.7%), "Food and live animals" (+3.5%) and "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (+2.1%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2023, domestic exports were higher by 1.1%, mainly explained by increases in exports of "Chemicals and related products, n.e.s" (+33.6%), "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (+25.1%), "Food and live animals" (+1.5%) and "Crude materials, inedible, except fuels" (+0.2%), partly offset by a decrease in the exports of "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (-8.6%).

<sup>3</sup> Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.

Compared to corresponding period of 2023, domestic exports for the period Jan-Sep of 2024, was lower by 1.2%. This was mainly due to decreases in the re-exports of “Crude materials, inedible, except fuels” (-13.5%) and “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (-11.1%), partly offset by increases in the re-exports of “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (+20.1%), “Chemicals and related products” (+11.0%) and Food and live animals” (+1.3%).

For the third quarter of 2024, re-exports stood at Rs 5,855 million, i.e. higher by 11.3% compared to the previous quarter, mainly due to increases in the re-exports of “Food and live animals” (+95.3%) and “Chemicals and related products” (+2.0%), partly offset by decreases in the re-exports of “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (-26.1%), “Machinery and transport equipment” (-13.6%) and “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (-6.4%) (*Table 5*).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2023, re-exports of merchandise goods declined by 6.9%, mainly explained by decreases in the re-exports of “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (-67.4%) and “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (-3.1%), partly offset by increases in the re-exports of “Machinery and transport equipment” (+26.1%), “Food and live animals” (+6.1%) and “Chemicals and related products” (+5.9%).

Compared to the corresponding period of 2023, re-exports decreased by 14.7% for the period Jan-Sep of 2024, mainly due to decreases in the re-exports of “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (-63.8%), “Machinery and transport equipment” (-33.6%) and “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (-2.6%), partly offset by increases in the re-exports of “Food and live animals” (+7.8%) and “Chemicals and related products” (+7.0%).

### **3.2 Exports of Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE) – 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter & January to September 2024**

For the third quarter of 2024, exports of EOE amounted to Rs 11,943 million, compared to Rs 11,435 million in previous quarter (+4.4%) and to Rs 12,598 million in the corresponding quarter of 2023 (-5.2%) (*Table 1*).

Compared to the corresponding period in 2023, exports of EOE decreased by 10.1%, from Rs 36,521 million to Rs 32,847 million for the period Jan-Sep of 2024.

Further details on these transactions will be presented in the issue of the Economic and Social Indicator on Export Oriented Enterprises, to be released on 23 December 2024.


### **3.3 Exports by country of destination (Table 7) – 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter & January to September 2024**

Analysis of exports figures by country of destination for the third quarter of 2024 shows that the European countries were our main buyers, purchasing some 39.3% of our exports for a value of Rs 8,647 million. Among countries, the major destinations for our exports were South Africa (12.7%), U.S.A. (12.5%), Madagascar (10.2%), France (8.7%), United Kingdom (8.6%), Spain (6.0%) and Netherlands (4.6%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2023, exports to United Kingdom and Spain dropped by 9.6% and 8.9% respectively in the third quarter of 2024, while exports to Netherlands, Madagascar, South Africa, U.S.A. and France increased by 58.6%, 28.4%, 16.8%, 3.3% and 2.7% respectively.

From Figure 2, compared to the corresponding period of 2023, exports to main markets decreased for the period Jan-Sep of 2024. Exports to Spain, United Kingdom and France witnessed decreases of 10.3%, 9.0% and 6.2% respectively, while exports to Madagascar, Netherlands, South Africa and U.S.A. increased by 42.8%, 11.4%, 4.4% and 4.1% respectively.

#### 4. Total Imports

##### 4.1 Total imports (Table 10) – 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter & January to September 2024

Total imports for the third quarter of 2024 amounted to Rs 81,402 million, showing an increase of 6.1%, compared to the previous quarter. This was mainly due to increases in the imports of “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (+25.3%), “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (+16.8%), “Food and live animals” (+16.3%), “Machinery and transport equipment” (+14.7%) and “Chemicals and related products” (+13.2%), partly offset by decreases in the imports of “Beverage and tobacco” (-22.7%) and “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials” (-19.2%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2023, total imports for the third quarter of 2024 increased by 12.7%. This rise was mainly explained by increases in the imports of “Beverage and tobacco” (+70.0%), “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (+20.4%), “Chemicals and related products, n.e.s.” (+17.6%), “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (+13.7%), “Machinery & transport equipment” (+11.8%) “Food and live animals” (+11.6%) and “Mineral fuels, lubricants, & related products” (+5.0%).

Compared to the corresponding period of 2023, total imports increased by 8.1% for the period Jan-Sep of 2024. This rise was mainly explained by increases in the imports of “Mineral fuels, lubricants, & related products” (+18.8%), “Chemicals and related products, n.e.s.” (+11.0%), “Machinery & transport equipment” (+9.1%), “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (+7.6%) “Food and live animals” (+4.5%) and “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (+1.1%), partly offset by a decrease in the imports of “Beverage and tobacco” (-20.1%).

#### **4.2 Imports by SITC section (Table 10) – 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter 2024**

Around 24.5% of imports in the third quarter of 2024 consisted of “Machinery and transport equipment” (Rs 19,917 million), 19.1% of “Food and live animals” (Rs 15,545 million), 18.9% of “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials” (Rs 15,404 million), 13.6% of “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (Rs 11,051 million), 9.6% of “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (Rs 7,852 million) and 9.3% of “Chemicals and related products” (Rs 7,602 million).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2023, total imports increased by 12.7%. Main changes by section were as follows:


- “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” increased by 20.4%, mainly due to increases in the imports of “Articles n.e.s., of plastic” (+34.2%), “Articles of apparel and clothing” (+19.0%) and “Professional, scientific & controlling instruments & apparatus, n.e.s” (+14.8%).
- “Chemicals and related products, n.e.s.” increased by 17.6%, mainly due to increases in the imports of “Dyeing & tanning materials” (+28.1%), “Plastics in primary forms” (+20.9%) and “Plastics in non-primary forms” (+7.0%), partly offset by a decrease in the imports of “Medicinal & pharmaceutical products” (-3.4%).
- “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” increased by 13.7%, mainly due to increases in the imports of “Textile yarn” (+56.4%), “Paper, paperboard & articles thereof” (+34.1%), “Iron and steel” (+30.9%), “Manufactures of metal, n.e.s” (+20.3%) and “Other textile fabrics” (+10.7%).
- “Machinery and transport equipment” increased by 11.8%, mainly due to increases in the imports of “Telecommunications & sound recording & reproducing apparatus & equipment” (+44.2%), “General industrial machinery & equipment, n.e.s., & machine parts, n.e.s” (+15.5%), “Road vehicles” (+9.2%) and “Electrical machinery, apparatus & appliances, n.e.s., & electrical parts of household type” (+5.4%).
- “Food and live animals” increased by 11.6%, mainly due to increases in the imports of “Vegetables and fruits” (+44.2%), “Meat and meat preparations” (+37.7%), “Cereal preparations” (+30.4%) and “Dairy products and bird’s eggs” (29.7%), partly offset by a decrease in the imports of “Fish and fish preparations” (-11.7%).
- “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials” increased by 5.0%, mainly due to increases in the imports of “Gas, natural and manufactured” (+79.3%) and “Refined petroleum products” (+3.2%).

#### **4.3 Imports by country of origin – 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter & January to September 2024**

During the third quarter of 2024, our imports originated from five main countries, namely: China (18.7%), U.A.E. (13.1%), India (10.5%), France (6.5%) and South Africa (5.7%) (*Table 13*). Among continents, Asia was our main supplier with a share of Rs 46,900 million, representing 57.6% of total imports.

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2023, total imports from U.A.E., India, China and France rose by 107.8%, 59.4%, 30.2% and 14.2% respectively, while imports from South Africa declined by 16.9%.

From Figure 3, compared to the corresponding period of 2023, India, China, South Africa, U.A.E. and France have witnessed increases of 65.3%, 19.4%, 9.9%, 8.6% and 7.4% respectively in total imports for the period Jan-Sep of 2024.



## 5. Trade with Member States of Regional Organizations – 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter 2024

During the third quarter of 2024, total exports to African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) States stood at Rs 6,550 million against imports of Rs 6,905 million (*Table 14*). The trade deficit with ACP countries worked out to Rs 355 million. South Africa was the main supplier, representing 67.0% of the total imports from ACP countries and the main buyers were South Africa and Madagascar with shares of 42.8% and 34.4% respectively.

Exports to COMESA member states attained Rs 3,365 million while imports from these countries amounted to around Rs 2,242 million, resulting in a trade surplus of Rs 1,123 million. Madagascar was the main buyer with a share of 67.0% followed by Kenya (18.5%). Our main suppliers were Egypt (37.2%), Seychelles (23.2%), Madagascar (18.6%) and Kenya (11.8%) (*Table 15*).

Trade with SADC countries showed a deficit of Rs 725 million, resulting from imports of Rs 6,303 million against exports worth Rs 5,578 million. The main buyers were South Africa (50.2%) and Madagascar (40.4%) and the main suppliers were South Africa (73.3%) and Seychelles (8.2%) (*Table 16*).

## 6. Trade in Freeport Zone – 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter 2024

During the third quarter of 2024, total imports of the Freeport Zone stood at Rs 3,177 million, lower by 8.7% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2023 and higher by 18.3% compared to the previous quarter (*Table 12*).

Compared to the corresponding period of 2023, freeport imports rose by 0.9% for the period Jan-Sept of 2024, mainly explained by increases in the imports of “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (+20.1%), “Machinery and transport equipment” (+6.4%) and “Chemicals and related products, n.e.s.” (+5.3%), partly offset by decreases in the imports of “Food and live animals” (-13.0%) and “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (-0.2%).

In the third quarter of 2024, freeport re-exports were valued at Rs 4,380 million, representing an increase of 29.0% compared to the previous quarter and an increase of 8.1% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2023 (*Table 6*).

Compared to corresponding period of 2023, freeport re-exports decreased by 0.7% for the period Jan-Sep of 2024, mainly explained by decreases in exports of “Machinery and transport equipment” (-48.7%), “Chemicals and related products, n.e.s.” (-6.5%) and “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (-2.4%), partly offset by an increase in the exports of “Food and live animals” (+25.1%).

## **7. Forecast 2024**

Based on trends and information from various sources, the forecast for both total exports and total imports have been revised upwards for 2024. This was mainly due to higher exports of “Ship’s stores & bunkers” and higher imports of petroleum products and some manufactured goods during the first nine months of 2024.

Total exports for 2024 will be around Rs 110 billion, 5.8% higher than Rs 104 billion in 2023. Total imports for 2024 will be around Rs 305 billion, 7.4% higher than the total imports of around Rs 284 billion in 2023.

The trade deficit for 2024 is forecasted at around Rs 195 billion, 8.3% higher as compared to around Rs 180 billion in 2023.

## Notes

### (1) Scope and coverage

**External merchandise trade statistics** are compiled according to the General Trade System as recommended by the United Nations. Using the national boundary as the statistical frontier, the General Trade System is a record of all goods entering (imports) and leaving the country (exports).

**Imports** include goods brought in directly for domestic consumption plus goods imported into customs bonded warehouses.

**Exports** cover:

- Domestic exports defined as goods of national origin, that is goods produced in the exporting country.
- Re-exports which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged and include re-exports from customs bonded warehouses.
- Ship's Stores and Bunkers (SSB) are included in total exports and are shown separately.

Trade by parcel post is also included in imports and exports.

### (2) Valuation

**Imports** are valued on a C.I.F. (Cost, Insurance and Freight) basis, whilst exports on a F.O.B. (Free on Board) basis.

**Cost, Insurance and Freight** (C.I.F) value is the value of a country's imports of goods, including all charges for transporting and insuring the goods from the country of exports to the given country but excluding the cost of unloading from the ship, aircraft unless it is borne by the carrier.

**Free on Board** (F.O.B) value is the value of a country's exports of goods, including all costs of transporting the goods to the customs frontier, export duties.

### (3) Classification of commodities

Commodities are coded according to the **Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature (HS 2022)**. However, for the purposes of economic analysis and to facilitate international comparison of trade by commodity data, the commodities are also classified according to the **Standard International Trade Classification (Revision 4) (SITC Rev. 4)**. The HS and the SITC Rev. 4 are six- and five-digit codes respectively but have been extended to eight and seven digits to accommodate national requirements.
