## External Merchandise Trade Statistics – 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2026

### 1. Introduction

This issue of Economic and Social Indicators presents external merchandise trade statistics for the first quarter of 2026 and the years 2024 and 2025. These statistics have been compiled from declarations lodged by importers and exporters at Customs Department. Some of these declarations are at times revised at a later period and corrections are made accordingly on the computerised database of the Customs Department of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA).

Thus, while revised figures for 2024 and 2025 are published in this indicator, those for 2026 are still provisional and will be revised, as and when latest amendments are obtained from the Customs Department of the MRA.

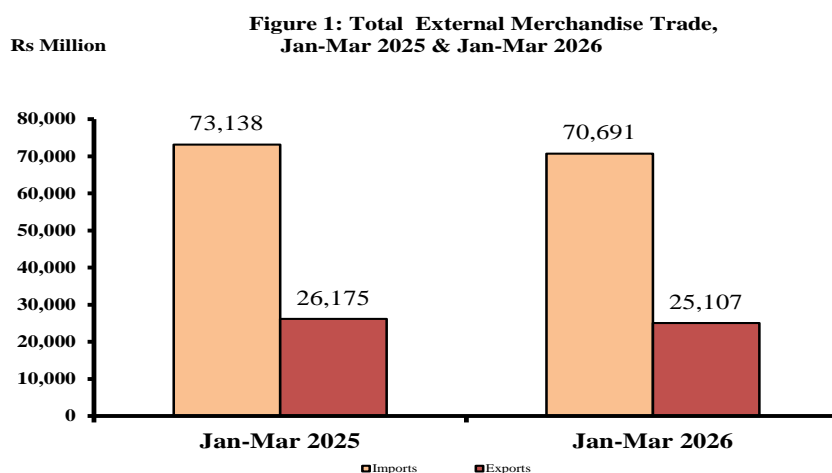
Data on external merchandise trade are compiled as per the recommendations of the United Nations General Trade System. According to this system, all goods entering and leaving the national frontier, including trading activities of the Freeport Zone should be accounted for.

### 2. Total value of trade and trade balance

Total external merchandise trade for the first quarter of 2026 was valued at Rs 95,798 million, i.e. 15.2% lower than the value of Rs 112,920 million of the previous quarter and 3.5% lower than the value of Rs 99,313 million of the corresponding quarter of 2025.

For the first quarter of 2026, total exports (inclusive of ship's stores & bunkers) were valued at Rs 25,107 million against total imports of Rs 70,691 million. In the previous quarter, total exports (inclusive of ship's stores and bunkers) amounted to Rs 26,532 million against total imports of Rs 86,388 million, while for the corresponding quarter of 2025, total exports (inclusive of ship's stores & bunkers) amounted to Rs 26,175 million against total imports of Rs 73,138 million. In the first quarter of 2026, total exports and total imports were lower by 5.4% and 18.2 %, respectively compared to the previous quarter. Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2025, total exports and total imports were lower by 4.1% and 3.3% respectively.

The resulting trade deficit for the first quarter of 2026 worked out to Rs 45,584 million, 23.8% lower than the deficit of Rs 59,856 million of the previous quarter and 2.9% lower than the deficit of Rs 46,963 million of the corresponding quarter of 2025.



### 3. Exports

#### 3.1 Total exports – 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2026

For the first quarter of 2026, total exports proceeds, including domestic exports<sup>1</sup>, re-exports<sup>2</sup> and ship's stores and bunkers amounted to Rs 25,107 million, showing a decrease of 5.4% compared to Rs 26,532 million in the previous quarter. This is mainly explained by decreases in "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (-19.9%), "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (-16.3%), "Chemicals and related products, n.e.s.." (-12.2%) and "Food and live animals" (-7.1%), partly offset by increases in "Machinery and transport equipment" (+61.4%) and "Ship's Stores and Bunkers" (+6.2%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2025, total exports (inclusive of ship's stores & bunkers) for the first quarter of 2026 decreased by 4.1%. This is mainly explained by decreases in "Machinery and transport equipment" (-33.8%), "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (-21.7%), "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (-16.3%) and "Ship's Stores and Bunkers" (-2.2%), partly offset by increases in "Chemicals and related products, n.e.s.." (+15.1%) and "Food and live animals" (+13.7%).

For the first quarter of 2026, domestic exports amounted to Rs 13,159 million, accounting for 52.4% of total exports proceeds. Compared to the previous quarter, domestic exports which amounted to Rs 14,695 million, showed a decrease of 10.5%. This is mainly explained by decreases in "Chemicals and related products, n.e.s.." (-23.8%), "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (-16.0%), "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (-14.6%) and "Food and live animals" (-6.2%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2025, domestic exports were higher by 4.1%, mainly explained by an increase in "Food and live animals" (+17.8%), partly offset by decreases in "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (-8.8%), "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (-8.2%) and "Chemicals and related products, n.e.s.." (-6.5%) (*Table 4*).

For the first quarter of 2026, re-exports stood at Rs 3,927 million, i.e. lower by 8.4% compared to the previous quarter, mainly due to decreases in "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (-33.1%), "Food and live animals" (-16.6%) and "Chemicals and related products, n.e.s.." (-8.1%), partly offset by an increase in "Machinery and transport equipment" (+65.5%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2025, re-exports were lower by 26.4%, mainly due to decreases in "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (-51.3%), "Machinery and transport equipment" (-39.1%) and "Food and live animals" (-18.6%), partly offset by an increase in "Chemicals and related products, n.e.s.." (+23.7%) (*Table 5*).

#### 3.2 Exports by SITC section (Tables 1 & 3) – 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2026

Around 31.9% of total exports for the first quarter of 2026 consisted of "Ship's Stores & Bunkers" (Rs 8,021 million), 31.9% of "Food and live animals" (Rs 8,012 million), 17.4% of "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (Rs 4,363 million) and 7.1% of "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (Rs 1,787 million).

Compared to the first quarter of 2025, the main changes by section were as follows:

- “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” registered a decrease of 21.7%, mainly due to a decrease in “Articles of apparel and clothing accessories” (-17.4%), partly offset by an increase in “Instruments and appliances, n.e.s for medical, surgical, dental or veterinary purposes” (+9.0%).
- “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” decreased by 16.3%, mainly explained by decreases in “Pearls, precious & semi-precious stones” (-30.2%) and “Textile yarns, fabrics, made up articles” (-24.9%).
- “Food and live animals” increased by 13.7%, mainly due to increases in “Live Primates” (+162.5%) and “Cane Sugar” (+7.1%), partly offset by a decrease in “Fish and fish preparations” (-4.7%).

### 3.3 Exports of Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE) – 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2026

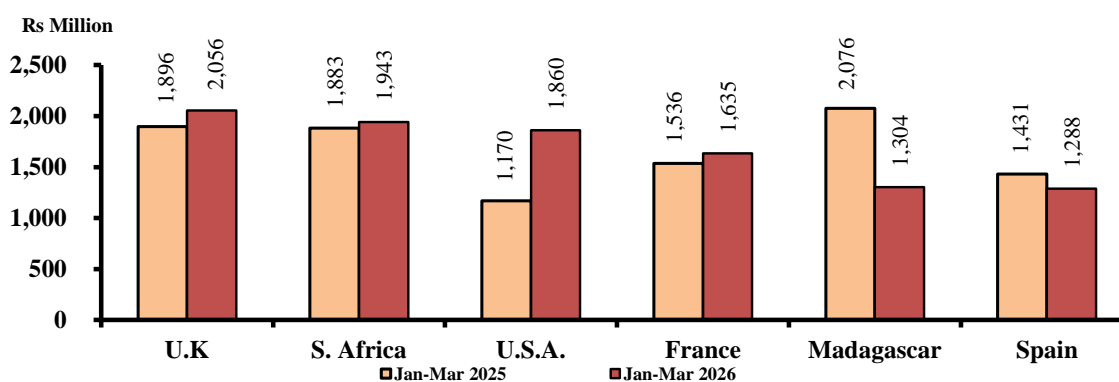
For the first quarter of 2026, exports of EOE amounted to Rs 9,277 million, compared to Rs 9,232 million for the corresponding quarter of 2025 (*Table 1*). Further details on these transactions will be presented in the issue of the Economic and Social Indicator on Export Oriented Enterprises, to be released on 30 June 2026.

### 3.4 Exports by country of destination (*Table 7*) – 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2026

Analysis of exports figures by country of destination for the first quarter of 2026 showed that the European countries were our main buyers, purchasing some 46.7% of our exports excluding ship’s stores and bunkers, for a value of Rs 7,981 million. Among countries, the major destinations for our exports were United Kingdom (12.0%), South Africa (11.4%), U.S.A. (10.9%), France (9.6%), Madagascar (7.6%) and Spain (7.5%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2025, exports to Madagascar and Spain decreased by 37.2% and 10.0%, respectively. On the other hand, exports to U.S.A, United Kingdom, France and South Africa increased by 59.0%, 8.4%, 6.4% and 3.2%, respectively.

## 4. Imports

### 4.1 Total imports (Table 10) – 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2026

Total imports for the first quarter of 2026 amounted to Rs 70,691 million, showing a decrease of 18.2% compared to Rs 86,388 million in the previous quarter. This is mainly due to decreases in “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (-36.4%), “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (-24.6%), “Chemicals & related products, n.e.s.” (-19.9%), “Food and live animals” (-15.3%), “Machinery & transport equipment” (-15.2%) and “Mineral fuels, lubricants & related products” (-9.9%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2025, total imports for the first quarter of 2026 decreased by 3.3%. This is mainly due to decreases in “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (-11.1%), “Mineral fuels, lubricants & related products” (-9.7%), “Machinery & transport equipment” (-7.7%) and “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (-4.0%), partly offset by increases in “Food and live animals” (+14.1%) and “Chemicals and related products n.e.s.” (+5.8%).

### 4.2 Imports by SITC section (Table 10) – 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2026

Around 23.3% of imports in the first quarter of 2026 consisted of “Mineral fuels, lubricants & related products” (Rs 16,465 million), 22.9% of “Machinery & transport equipment” (Rs 16,181 million), 21.1% of “Food and live animals” (Rs 14,892 million), 10.9% of “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (Rs 7,732 million), 8.7% of “Chemicals & related products, n.e.s.” (Rs 6,177 million) and 8.3% of “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (Rs 5,902 million).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2025, total imports decreased by 3.3%. Main changes by section were as follows:

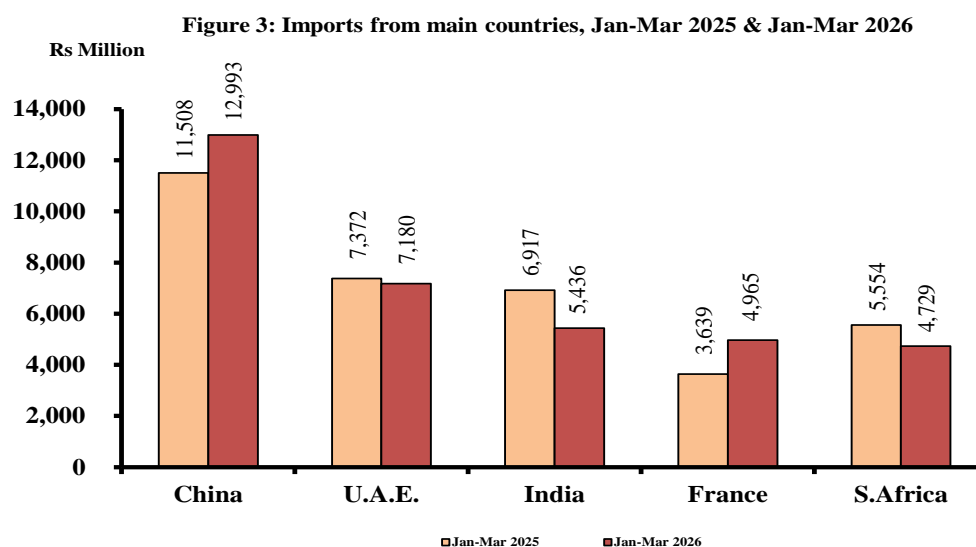
- “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” decreased by 11.1%, mainly due to “Textile yarn” (-51.9%), “Other textile fabrics” (-23.9%), “Paper, paperboard & articles thereof” (-13.2%), “Iron and Steel” (-7.8%) and “Manufactures of metal, n.e.s.” (-7.5%), partly offset by an increase in “Cement” (+38.4%).
- “Mineral fuels, lubricants & related products” decreased by 9.7%, mainly due to “Gas, natural and manufactured” (-9.6%) and “Refined petroleum products” (-8.8%).
- “Machinery and transport equipment” decreased by 7.7%, mainly due to in “Road vehicles” (-36.2%), partly offset by increases in “Power generating machinery & equipment” (+132.0%), “Electrical machinery, apparatus & appliances, n.e.s., & electrical parts of household type” (+33.7%), “General industrial machinery & equipment, n.e.s., & machine parts, n.e.s.” (+2.6%) and “Telecommunications & sound recording & reproducing apparatus & equipment” (+1.5%).
- “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” decreased by 4.0%, due to imports of “Articles of apparel and clothing” (-13.8%), partly offset by increases in “Professional, scientific & controlling instruments & apparatus, n.e.s.” (+24.1%) and “Articles n.e.s, of plastic” (+6.7%).

- “Food and live animals” increased by 14.1%, mainly due to “Meat and meat preparations” (+23.0%), “Fish and fish preparations” (+21.0%) and “Dairy products and bird’s eggs” (+14.7%), partly offset by a decrease in “Vegetables and fruits” (-11.8%).
- “Chemicals and related products, n.e.s.” increased by 5.8%, mainly due to “Medicinal & pharmaceutical products” (+7.8%), partly offset by decreases in “Plastics in non-primary forms” (-5.1%) and “Plastics in primary forms” (-4.3%).

### 4.3 Imports by country of origin (Table 13) – 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2026

During the first quarter of 2026, our imports originated from five main countries, namely: China (18.4%), U.A.E. (10.2%), India (7.7%), France (7.0%) and South Africa (6.7%). Among continents, Asia was our main supplier with a share of Rs 40,636 million, representing 57.5% of total imports followed by Europe, with a share of Rs 15,308 million, representing 21.7% of total imports and Africa, with a share of Rs 7,833 million, representing 11.1% of total imports.

Compared to the corresponding period of 2025, total imports from India, South Africa and U.A.E. decreased by 21.4%, 14.9% and 2.6%, respectively, while imports from France and China increased by 36.4% and 12.9%, respectively.



### 5. Trade with Member States of Regional Organisations – 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2026

For the first quarter of 2026, exports<sup>1</sup> to African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) States stood at Rs 4,568 million against total imports of Rs 7,006 million. The trade deficit with ACP countries worked out to Rs 2,438 million. South Africa was the main supplier with a value of Rs 4,729 million, representing 67.5% of the total imports from ACP states. South Africa was the main buyer with a share of 42.5% (Rs 1,943 million) followed by Madagascar with a share of 28.5% (Rs 1,304 million) (Table 14).

Exports to COMESA member states for the first quarter of 2026 attained Rs 2,415 million, while total imports from these countries amounted to Rs 2,430 million, resulting in a trade

deficit of Rs 15 million. Madagascar was the main buyer with a share of 54.0% followed by Kenya (26.4%). The main suppliers were Seychelles (45.1%) followed by Egypt (23.0%), Madagascar (15.0%) and Kenya (11.2%) (*Table 15*).

Trade with SADC countries showed a deficit of Rs 3,030 million, as a result of total imports of Rs 6,696 million against exports worth Rs 3,666 million. The main supplier was South Africa (70.6%) and main buyers were South Africa (53.0%) and Madagascar (35.6%) (*Table 16*).

## **6. Trade in Freeport Zone – 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2026**

During the first quarter of 2026, total imports of the Freeport Zone stood at Rs 2,487 million, lower by 12.2% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2025 (*Table 12*). The main items imported were “Chemicals & related products, n.e.s.” (31.5%), “Machinery and transport equipment” (22.4%) and “Food and live animals” (19.1%).

Re-exports were valued at Rs 2,552 million, representing a decrease of 30.6% compared to the corresponding period of 2025 (*Table 6*). The main items were “Chemicals & related products, n.e.s.” (27.2%), “Food and live animals” (22.8%) and “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (22.6%).

## **7. Forecast 2026**

Based on trends and information from various sources, the forecast of total exports for 2026 is estimated around Rs 105 billion, 2.8% lower than the total exports of around Rs 108 billion in 2025. The total imports are maintained at around Rs 320 billion, 1.6% higher than the total imports of around Rs 315 billion in 2025.

The trade deficit for 2026 is forecasted at around Rs 215 billion, 3.4% higher as compared to around Rs 208 billion in 2025.

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## Notes

### (1) Scope and coverage

**External merchandise trade statistics** are compiled according to the General Trade System as recommended by the United Nations. Using the national boundary as the statistical frontier, the General Trade System is a record of all goods entering (imports) and leaving the country (exports).

**Imports** include goods brought in directly for domestic consumption plus goods imported into customs bonded warehouses.

**Exports** cover:

- Domestic exports defined as goods of national origin, that is goods produced in the exporting country.
- Re-exports which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged and include re-exports from customs bonded warehouses.
- Ship's Stores and Bunkers (SSB) are included in total exports and are shown separately.

Trade by parcel post is also included in imports and exports.

### (2) Valuation

**Imports** are valued on a C.I.F. (Cost, Insurance and Freight) basis, whilst exports on a F.O.B. (Free on Board) basis.

**Cost, Insurance and Freight** (C.I.F) value is the value of a country's imports of goods, including all charges for transporting and insuring the goods from the country of exports to the given country but excluding the cost of unloading from the ship, aircraft unless it is borne by the carrier.

**Free on Board** (F.O.B) value is the value of a country's exports of goods, including all costs of transporting the goods to the customs frontier, export duties.

### (3) Classification of commodities

Commodities are coded according to the **Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature (HS 2022)**. However, for the purposes of economic analysis and to facilitate international comparison of trade by commodity data, the commodities are also classified according to **the Standard International Trade Classification (Revision 4) (SITC Rev. 4)**. The HS and the SITC Rev. 4 are six- and five-digit codes respectively but have been extended to eight and seven digits to accommodate national requirements.
