External Merchandise Trade Statistics – 2nd Quarter 2026

1. Introduction

This issue of Economic and Social Indicators presents external merchandise trade statistics for the first and second quarters of 2026 and the years 2024 and 2025. These statistics are compiled from declarations lodged at the Customs Department of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA), by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are usually revised at a later period and corrections are made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA).

Figures for 2026 are still provisional and subject to revision as and when the Customs Department of the MRA submits latest amendments to Statistics Mauritius.

Data on external merchandise trade are compiled as per the recommendations of the United Nations General Trade System. According to this system, all goods entering and leaving the national frontier, including trading activities of the Freeport zone should be accounted for.

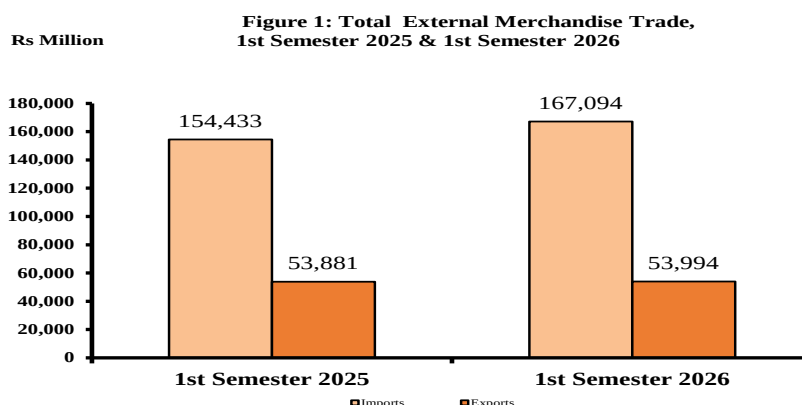
2. Total value of trade and trade balance

Total external merchandise trade for the second quarter of 2026 was valued at Rs 125,290 million, i.e., 30.8% higher than the value of Rs 95,798 million of the previous quarter and 14.9% higher than the value of Rs 109,001 million of the corresponding quarter of 2025.

For the second quarter of 2026, total exports (inclusive of ship's stores & bunkers¹) were valued at Rs 28,887 million against total imports of Rs 96,403 million. In the first quarter of 2026, total exports (inclusive of ship's stores and bunkers) amounted to Rs 25,107 million against total imports of Rs 70,691 million while for the second quarter of 2025, total exports (inclusive of ship's stores & bunkers) amounted to Rs 27,706 million against total imports of Rs 81,295 million.

Compared with the previous quarter, total exports and imports increased by 15.1% and 36.4%, respectively. Compared with the corresponding quarter of 2025, total exports and imports increased by 4.3% and 18.6%, respectively.

The resulting trade deficit for the second quarter of 2026 worked out to Rs 67,516 million, 48.1% higher than the deficit of Rs 45,584 million of the previous quarter and 26.0% higher than the deficit of Rs 53,589 million of the corresponding quarter of 2025.



¹ Ships stores and bunkers, which consist of jet fuel and victuals supplied to foreign vessels and aircraft, are included in total exports and are shown separately

Compared to the first semester of 2025, total exports (inclusive of ship's stores & bunkers) rose from Rs 53,881 million to Rs 53,994 million in the first semester of 2026, showing a marginal increase of around 0.2% (Fig 1). Total imports went up from Rs 154,433 million in first semester of 2025 to Rs 167,094 million in the first semester of 2026, representing an increase of 8.2%. Consequently, the trade deficit for first semester of 2026 worked out to around Rs 113,100 million, 12.5% higher than the deficit of Rs 100,552 million in the first semester of 2025.

3. Total Exports

3.1 Total exports (Tables 1 & 3) – 2nd Quarter & 1st Semester 2026

Total exports proceed for the second quarter of 2026, including domestic exports², re-exports³ and ship's stores and bunkers amounted to Rs 28,887 million, showing an increase of 15.1% compared to the previous quarter. This is mainly explained by increases in "Ships' stores & bunkers" (+29.0%), "Crude materials, inedible, except fuels" (+22.1%), "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (+20.5%), "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (+9.2%), "Food and live animals" (+6.5%) and "Chemicals and related products, n.e.s" (+1.4%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2025, total exports for the second quarter of 2026 increased by 4.3%. This is mainly explained by increases in "Crude materials, inedible, except fuels" (+32.7%), "Ships' stores & bunkers" (+22.0%) and "Chemicals and related products, n.e.s." (+6.2%), partly offset by decreases in "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (-10.1%), "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (-6.8%) and "Food and live animals" (-1.3%).

Total exports for the first semester of 2026, amounting to Rs 53,994 million increased marginally by 0.2%, compared to the corresponding semester of 2025. This is mainly explained by increases in "Crude materials, inedible, except fuels" (+12.3%), "Chemicals and related products" (+10.5%), "Ships' stores & bunkers" (+10.1%) and "Food and live animals" (+5.4%), partly offset by decreases in "Machinery and transport equipment" (-31.9%), "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (-16.0%) and "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (-11.4%).

Domestic exports, amounting to Rs 14,871 million, accounting for 51.5% of total exports in the second quarter of 2026, increased by 13.0% compared to a value of Rs 13,159 million in the previous quarter. This is mainly explained by increases in "Chemicals and related products, n.e.s." (+48.4%), "Crude materials, inedible, except fuels" (+37.8%), "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (+16.8%), "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (+13.5%) and "Food and live animals" (+8.6%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2025, domestic exports for the second quarter of 2026 were higher by 4.9%, mainly explained by increases in "Chemicals and related products, n.e.s." (+33.8%), "Food and live animals" (+9.3%) and "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (+1.2%), partly offset by decreases in "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (-8.0%) and "Crude materials, inedible, except fuels" (-4.0%).

² Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin.

³ Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.

Domestic exports for the first semester of 2026, valued at Rs 28,030 million were higher by 4.5% compared to the corresponding semester of 2025. This was mainly due to increases in “Chemicals and related products, n.e.s.” (+14.0%) and “Food and live animals” (+13.2%), partly offset by decreases in “Crude materials, inedible, except fuels” (-18.0%), “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (-8.1%) and “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (-3.6%) (*Table 4*).

For the second quarter of 2026, re-exports stood at Rs 3,671 million, i.e. lower by 6.5% compared to the previous quarter, mainly due to decreases in “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (-23.5%), “Food and live animals” (-17.4%), “Chemicals and related products, n.e.s.” (-12.8%) and “Machinery and transport equipment” (-8.9%), partly offset by an increase in “Crude materials, inedible, except fuels” (+14.1%) (*Table 5*).

Re-exports for second quarter of 2026 for merchandise goods declined by 27.4% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2025. This is mainly explained by decreases in “Food and live animals” (-60.0%), “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (-48.3%), “Machinery and transport equipment” (-33.0%) and “Chemicals and related products, n.e.s.” (-4.0%), partly offset by an increase in “Crude materials, inedible, except fuels” (+75.0%).

Re-exports amounting to Rs 7,598 million in the first semester of 2026 decreased by 26.9% compared to the value of Rs 10,387 million in the first semester of 2025. This was mainly due to decreases in “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (-50.0%), “Food and live animals” (-44.6%) and “Machinery and transport equipment” (-36.3%), partly offset by increases in “Crude materials, inedible, except fuels” (+42.8%) and “Chemicals and related products, n.e.s.” (+9.0%).

3.2 Exports of Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE) – 2nd Quarter & 1st Semester 2026

For the second quarter of 2026, exports of EOE amounted to Rs 11,005 million, compared to Rs 9,277 million in the previous quarter and to Rs 10,873 million in the corresponding quarter of 2025, representing changes of +18.6% and +1.2%, respectively. (*Table 1*).

Compared to the first semester of 2025, exports of EOE increased by 0.9%, i.e., from Rs 20,105 million to Rs 20,282 million in the first semester of 2026.

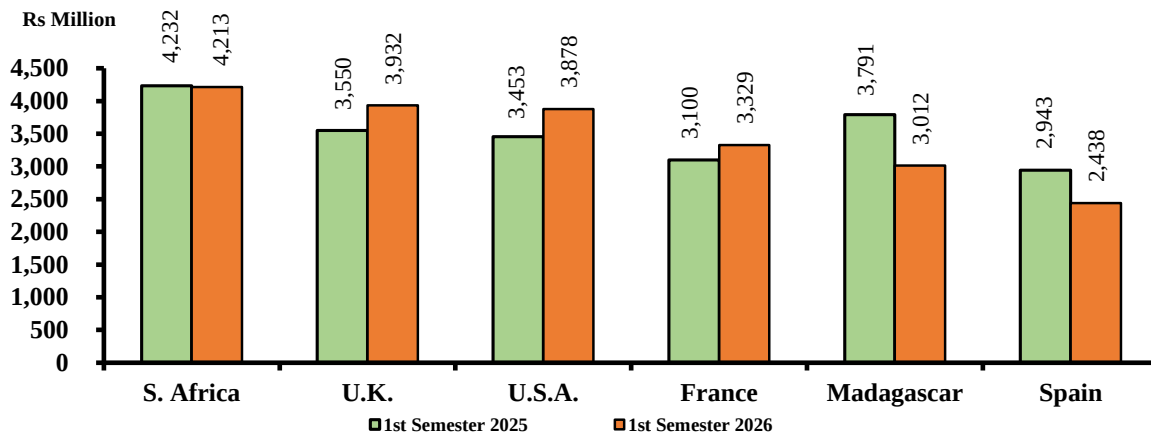

3.3 Exports by country of destination (Table 7) – 2nd Quarter & 1st Semester 2026

Analysis of exports figures by country of destination for the second quarter of 2026 showed that the European countries were our main buyers, purchasing some 43.3% of our exports for a value of Rs 8,035 million. Among countries, the major destinations for our exports were South Africa (12.2%), U.S.A. (10.9%), United Kingdom (10.1%), Madagascar (9.2%), France (9.1%) and Spain (6.2%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2025, exports to Spain, U.S.A., South Africa and Madagascar declined by 23.9%, 11.6%, 3.4% and 0.4%, respectively. In contrast, exports to United Kingdom and France increased by 13.4% and 8.3%, respectively.

Compared to the corresponding semester of 2025, exports to Madagascar, Spain and South Africa decreased by 20.5%, 17.2% and 0.4%, respectively. On the other hand, exports to U.S.A., United Kingdom and France increased by 12.3%, 10.8% and 7.4%, respectively. (Figure 2)

4. Total Imports

4.1 Total imports (Table 10) – 2nd Quarter & 1st Semester 2026

Total imports for the second quarter of 2026 amounted to Rs 96,403 million, showing an increase of 36.4%, compared to the previous quarter. This is mainly due to increases in “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials” (+99.8%), “Chemicals and related products” (+26.3%), “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (+25.3%), “Machinery and transport equipment” (+20.2%), “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (+7.0%) and “Food and live animals” (+6.7%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2025, total imports for the second quarter of 2026 increased by 18.6%. This is mainly due to increases in “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials” (+71.5%), “Chemicals and related products” (+18.9%), “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (+5.3%) and “Machinery and transport equipment” (+2.0%), partly offset by decreases in “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (-9.1%) and “Food and live animals” (-3.3%).

Total imports, amounting to Rs 167,094 million in the first semester of 2026 increased by 8.2% i.e., from Rs 154,433 million in the first semester of 2025. This rise was mainly explained by imports of “Mineral fuels, lubricants, & related products” (+31.9%), “Chemicals and related products” (+12.8%) and “Food and live animals” (+4.4%), partly offset by decreases in “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (-6.7%), “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (-2.7%) and “Machinery & transport equipment” (-2.7%).

4.2 Imports by SITC section (Table 10) – 2nd Quarter 2026

Around 34.1% of imports in the second quarter of 2026 consisted of “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials” (Rs 32,893 million), 20.2% of “Machinery and transport equipment” (Rs 19,456 million), 16.5% of “Food and live animals” (Rs 15,883 million), 10.1% of “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (Rs 9,689 million), 8.1% of “Chemicals and related products” (Rs 7,799 million) and 6.6% of “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (Rs 6,316 million).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2025, total imports for the second quarter 2026 increased by 18.6%. Main changes by section are as follows:

- “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials” increased by 71.5%, mainly due to an increase in “Refined petroleum products” (+75.3%).
- “Chemicals and related products” increased by 18.9%, mainly due to increases in “Plastics in primary forms” (+65.4%), “Plastics in non-primary forms” (+33.9%), “Medicinal & pharmaceutical products” (+9.6%) and “Dyeing & tanning materials” (+7.2%).
- “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” increased by 5.3%, mainly due to increases in “Iron and Steel (+16.4%), “Paper, paperboard & articles thereof” (+11.7%) and “Manufactures of metal, n.e.s” (+7.4%), partly offset by decreases in “Other textile fabrics” (-8.6%) and “Cement” (-8.0%).
- “Machinery and transport equipment” increased by 2.0%, mainly due to increases in “Power generating machinery & equipment” (+535.0%), “Electrical machinery, apparatus & appliances, n.e.s., & electrical parts of household type” (+42.2%), “Office machines & automatic data processing machines” (+34.9%), “Telecommunications & sound recording & reproducing apparatus & equipment” (+2.6%) and “General industrial machinery & equipment, n.e.s., & machine parts, n.e.s” (+0.7%), partly offset by a decrease in “Road vehicles” (-44.1%).
- “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” decreased by 9.1%, mainly due to decreases in “Articles of apparel and clothing” (-28.8%) and “Articles n.e.s, of plastic” (-4.6%), partly offset by an increase in “Professional, scientific & controlling instruments & apparatus, n.e.s” (+34.0%).
- “Food and live animals” decreased by 3.3%, mainly due to decreases in “Fish and fish preparations” (-23.4%) and “Dairy products and bird’s eggs” (-17.6%), partly offset by increases in “Meat and meat preparations” (+44.0%), “Cereal preparations” (+32.2%) and “Vegetables and fruits” (+5.8%).

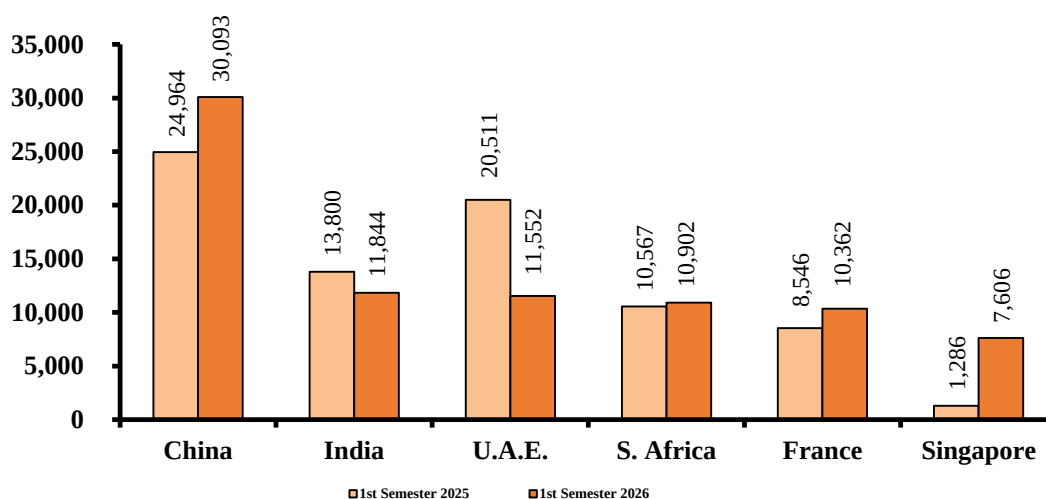
4.3 Imports by country of origin – 2nd Quarter & 1st Semester 2026

During the second quarter of 2026, our imports originated from six main countries, namely: China (17.7%), Singapore (7.4%), India (6.6%), South Africa (6.4%), France (5.6%) and U.A.E. (4.5%) (Table 13). Among continents Asia was our main supplier with a share of Rs 57,553 million, representing 59.7% of total imports.

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2025, total imports from Singapore, China, South Africa and France rose by 895.0%, 27.1%, 23.1% and 10.0% respectively, while imports from U.A.E. and India declined by 66.7% and 6.9% respectively.

Compared to the corresponding semester of 2025, total imports for the first semester of 2026 from Singapore, France, China and South Africa witnessed increases of 491.4%, 21.2%, 20.5% and 3.2% respectively, while imports from U.A.E. and India declined by 43.7% and 14.2% respectively. (Figure 3)

5. Trade with Member States of Regional Organizations – 2nd Quarter 2026

During the second quarter of 2026, total exports to African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) States stood at Rs 5,537 million against imports of Rs 9,482 million (*Table 14*). The trade deficit with ACP countries worked out to Rs 3,945 million. The main buyers were South Africa and Madagascar with shares of 41.0% and 30.8% and our main supplier was South Africa with a share of 65.1%.

Exports for the second quarter of 2026 to COMESA member states attained Rs 2,960 million while imports amounted to around Rs 3,516 million, resulting in a trade deficit of Rs 556 million. Madagascar was the main buyer with a share of 57.7%, followed by Kenya (21.1%). Our main suppliers were Egypt (53.3%), Seychelles (25.7%) and Madagascar (12.9%) (*Table 15*).

Trade with SADC countries showed a deficit of Rs 4,652 million, resulting from imports of Rs 9,214 million against exports worth Rs 4,562 million for the second quarter of 2026. The main suppliers were South Africa (67.0%), Mozambique (14.3%) and Seychelles (9.8%) and our main buyers were South Africa (49.8%) and Madagascar (37.4%) (*Table 16*).

6. Trade in Freeport Zone – 2nd Quarter 2026

During the second quarter of 2026, total imports of the Freeport Zone stood at Rs 2,339 million, lower by 37.4% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2025 and by 6.0% compared to the previous quarter – (*Table 12*). Compared to corresponding semester of 2025, freeport imports declined by 26.5% and for this period, the main items imported were “Chemicals and related products, n.e.s” (30.9%), “Machinery and transport equipment” (23.5%) and “Food and live animals” (15.2%).

Re-exports of the Freeport Zone for the second quarter of 2026 were valued at Rs 2,285 million, representing a decrease of 39.8% compared to the corresponding period of 2025 (*Table 6*), and by 10.5% compared to the previous quarter. Compared to the corresponding semester of 2025, a decrease of 35.3% was recorded in the first semester of 2026. The main items re-exported were “Chemicals and related products” (26.7%), “Food and live animals” (21.3%) and “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (20.1%).

7. Forecast 2026

Based on trends and information from various sources, the forecast of total exports for 2026 is maintained at the previous forecast figures, that is, around Rs 110 billion, representing an increase of 1.9% than the total exports of around Rs 108 billion in 2025.

The total imports will be around Rs 325 billion, 3.2% higher than the total imports of around Rs 315 billion in 2025.

The trade deficit for 2026 is forecasted at around Rs 215 billion, 3.4% higher as compared to around Rs 208 billion in 2025.

Notes

(1) Scope and coverage

External merchandise trade statistics are compiled according to the General Trade System as recommended by the United Nations. Using the national boundary as the statistical frontier, the General Trade System is a record of all goods entering (imports) and leaving the country (exports).

Imports include goods brought in directly for domestic consumption plus goods imported into customs bonded warehouses.

Exports cover:

- Domestic exports defined as goods of national origin, that is goods produced in the exporting country.
- Re-exports which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged and include re-exports from customs bonded warehouses.
- Ship's Stores and Bunkers (SSB) are included in total exports and are shown separately.

Trade by parcel post is also included in imports and exports.

(2) Valuation

Imports are valued on a C.I.F. (Cost, Insurance and Freight) basis, whilst exports on a F.O.B. (Free on Board) basis.

Cost, Insurance and Freight (C.I.F) value is the value of a country's imports of goods, including all charges for transporting and insuring the goods from the country of exports to the given country but excluding the cost of unloading from the ship, aircraft unless it is borne by the carrier.

Free on Board (F.O.B) value is the value of a country's exports of goods, including all costs of transporting the goods to the customs frontier, export duties.

(3) Classification of commodities

Commodities are coded according to the **Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature (HS 2022)**. However, for the purposes of economic analysis and to facilitate international comparison of trade by commodity data, the commodities are also classified according to **the Standard International Trade Classification (Revision 4) (SITC Rev. 4)**. The HS and the SITC Rev. 4 are six- and five-digit codes respectively but have been extended to eight and seven digits to accommodate national requirements.
