

The **headline** inflation rate for the twelve months ending June 2015 works out to 1.7%, compared to 4.0% for the twelve months ending June 2014.

The **year-on-year** inflation rate for June 2015, as measured by the change in the CPI for June 2015 relative to June 2014, works out to 0.4%.
