

The **headline** inflation rate for the twelve months ending June 2016 works out to 0.9%, compared to 1.7% for the twelve months ending June 2015.

The **year-on-year** inflation rate for June 2016, as measured by the change in the CPI for June 2016 relative to June 2015, works out to 1.1%.
