

The **headline** inflation rate for the twelve months ending November 2017 works out to 3.5%, compared to 0.9% for the twelve months ending November 2016.

The **year-on-year** inflation rate for November 2017, as measured by the change in the CPI for November 2017 relative to November 2016, works out to 3.6%.
