

**PRODUCER PRICE INDEX – MANUFACTURING (PPI-M)**  
*(Base year 2018 = 100)*

<b>January 2022</b>	<b>December 2022</b>	<b>January 2023</b>

The Producer Price Index for the manufacturing sector (PPI-M) registered an increase of 0.8 points or 0.5% from December 2022 to January 2023. This increase was mainly due to higher prices of “Food products and beverages”, “Printing and reproduction of recorded media”, “Motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers”, “Fabricated metal products”, “Wearing apparel” and “Other products”, partly offset by lower prices of “Chemicals and chemical products”.

Compared to January 2022, the PPI-M for January 2023 was higher by 17.9 points or 13.7%.

It is to be noted that the above figures are provisional.
