

**PRODUCER PRICE INDEX – MANUFACTURING (PPI-M)**  
*(Base year 2018 = 100)*

The Producer Price Index for the manufacturing sector (PPI-M) registered an increase of 0.6 point or 0.3% from March 2026 to April 2026. This is mainly explained by higher prices of “Food products and beverages”, “Rubber and plastic products”, “Chemicals and chemical products” and, “Machinery and equipment, n.e.c” partly offset by lower prices of “Printing and reproduction of recorded media” and “Other manufacturing products” such as gold jewellery.

Compared to April 2025, PPI-M for April 2026 was higher by 12.1 points or 7.5%.

It is to be noted that the above figures are provisional.
