

**PRODUCER PRICE INDEX – MANUFACTURING (PPI-M)**  
*(Base year 2018 = 100)*

The Producer Price Index for the manufacturing sector (PPI-M) registered an increase of 1.0 point or 0.6% from February 2026 to March 2026. This is mainly explained by higher prices of “Food products and beverages” and “Other manufacturing products” such as gold jewellery, partly offset by lower prices of “Other transport equipment”.

Compared to March 2025, PPI-M for March 2026 was higher by 12.6 points or 7.8%.

It is to be noted that the above figures are provisional.
