In April 2023, United States (11.5%), France (11.1%), South Africa (9.6%), United Kingdom (8.2%), Italy (7.5%) and Madagascar (7.2%) were our major exports destinations while our imports were mainly from China (15.9%), U.A.E. (13.5%), India (9.1%), South Africa (7.0%), France (5.9%) and Japan (3.4%).
