In September 2023, United States (16.1%), South Africa (11.8%), United Kingdom (9.0%), Madagascar (8.8%), France (7.9%) and Spain (4.1%) were our major exports destinations while our imports were mainly from China (18.2%), U.A.E. (10.3%), Bahrain (9.3%), India (7.3%), South Africa (6.2%) and France (5.7%).
